A Look Back

The Game

- $^{\rm w}$ Johns Hopkins improved to 6-1 overall and 5-1 in the Centennial with a 50-0 win at Gettysburg last Saturday.
- « Susquehanna kept its perfect season alive as the River Hawks eased past McDaniel, 45-16.

The Facts

- « This is the 136th season of Johns Hopkins football. JHU first fielded a team in 1882.
- « Johns Hopkins enters this week's game with an all-time record of 569-488-58 (.536).
- « Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 106-18 (.855) overall and 87-9 (.907) in the Centennial Conference.
- « Overall, JHU owns 14 Centennial Conference titles (all won since 2002) and has qualified for the NCAA Playoffs 10 times (all since 2005).

Oh Captain, My Captain

- $^{ ext{ iny In}}$ In a vote of the team last spring, four players were selected to serve as captains of the 2021 Johns Hopkins football team.
- « Graduate student Macauley Kilbane (DB) and seniors Ross Andersson (DB), Joe Tischler (DL) and Emmett Turner (TE) will lead the Blue Jays this season. This will be Kilbane's second season serving as a co-captain.
- « Dating back to 1947, Kilbane is just the 14th player to serve as a captain more than once.

Poll Position

- $\,^{\prime\prime}$ Johns Hopkins will carry a pair of top-20 rankings into this week's game against Susquehanna as the Blue Jays check in at #20 in both the AFCA and D3football. com polls this week.
- « Since the AFCA Poll debuted in 1999, this week's #20 ranking marks the 105th time JHU has been ranked in the top 25. More recently, the Blue Jays are in the top 25 for the 88th time in the last 96 polls dating back to 2011.
- « Since the D3football.com Poll debuted in 2003, this week's #20 ranking marks the 119th time Johns Hopkins has appeared in the top 25.

Things to Know - Susquehanna

- « Susquehanna comes to Homewood Field riding the crest of a school-record 15-game winning streak that dates back to early in the 2019 season. In fact, the River Haws haven't lost a regular season game in regulation since Oct. 6, 2018 a span of 23 games. « The River Hawks have played just one game that has been decided by less than 17 points, this cocon.
- «The River Hawks have played just one game that has been decided by less than 17 points this season - a 30-28, five-overtime win at F&M on September 11.
- «The River Hawks bring the Centennial's top defense to Homewood. SU leads the CC in total defense (242.9) and pass defense (174.1) and ranks third in scoring (14.0) and rushing defense (68.7), forced turnovers (15) and sacks (19).
- « SU has scored nearly as many points in the second quarter (97) as it has allowed total (98) all season.
- « The 'Hawks have scored at least 30 points in every game this season and 45+ in each of the last three.
- « Balance is a key for the SU offense as the River Hawks have generated at least 200 yards passing in all but one game and at least 120 yards rushing in every game.
- « Seven different players have at least 100 receiving yards on the year and five different players have rushed for 100+.

River Hawks to Watch

Elijah Hoffman (Sr. • PK)

«Top kicker in the Centennial Conference as he is 10of-12 on FGs and 34-of-36 on extra points this season. Has made nine consecutive field goals dating back to the game at F&M on September 11.

Michael Ruisch (Sr. • QB)

- $^{\circ}$ Headliner on a deep and talented Susquehanna offense. Has thrown for 1,653 yards and 21 touchdowns against just two interceptions and has rushed for 205 yards and three scores on the year.
- $^{\rm w}$ Enters this week's game needing just 225 passing yards to reach 6,000 for his career.

Craig Roumes (Sr. • OLB)

- « Leading candidate for Centennial Conference Defensive Player of the Year honors. Ranks second on the team in tackles (42) and counts 6.5 TFLs, 3.0 sacks, 5 PBUs and two interceptions to his credit.
- « First Team All-Centennial and Second Team D3football.com All-South in 2019.

On This Date

- « Since 1950, Johns Hopkins has played nine games on October 30 and the Blue Jays are 4-5 all-time on this date.
- « JHU has won its last two games on this date with victories against Ursinus in 2004 (20-14) and Juniata in 2010 (48-0).

Road Warriors

- « Last week's game at Gettysburg was the last in a stretch that saw the Blue Jays play four of five games on the road.
- « The Blue Jays played at Juniata (Sept. 18) and at Moravian (Sept. 25), hosted F&M (Oct. 2) and then played at Muhlenberg (Oct. 15) and at Gettysburg (Oct. 23) during the five-game stretch.
- « This week's game against Susquehanna will be just the second home game for the Blue Jays since September 11.

Before The Bye

- « The game against F&M on Oct. 2 was the last game for the Blue Jays before their bye week. Including the win against the Diplomats and dating back to 2011, the Blue Jays are 45-3 in games played before their bye.
- « The Centennial Conference went to the leaguewide bye in the middle of the season in 2011.

After the Bye

- « Dating back to 2011, when the Centennial Conference went to a league-wide bye in the middle of the season, Johns Hopkins is 41-4 in regular season games played after the bye week.
- « In games played after the bye since 2011, and including last week's game at Gettysburg, the Blue Jays are 20-3 in regular season games played on the road and 21-1 in regular season games played at home.

Oktoberfest

- « Johns Hopkins flipped the calendar to October for its game against F&M and the month has been good to the Blue Jays of late.
- « Including the three games in October this season, the Blue Jays have won 33 of their last 35 games in the month of October dating back 2010.
- « Ironically, the Blue Jays had been just 10-8 in their previous 18 games in the month of October before jump-starting the current 35-game run with a 49-24 win at Susquehanna (10-23-2010).

Scoring Notes of Interest

- «Johns Hopkins has scored 355 points in its first seven games of the 2021 season. That's the most
- points JHU has scored in any seven-game span in school history.
- $^{\circ}$ The previous JHU record for most points scored in a seven-game span was 352, which the Blue Jays scored in the first seven games of the 2018 season.
- $^{\circ}$ In 28 quarters this season, the Blue Jays have scored 10 or more points in 17 of the 28 and 20 or more in seven of 28.
- « JHU has scored 124 points in the second quarter and has outscored the opposition 68-7 in the first quarter and 85-7 in the third quarter.

Series History

- « This week's game will be the 19th game in a series that dates to an 8-7 Susquehanna win on November 1, 1941.
- « JHU leads the all-time series 12-5-1. SU has won the last two, but JHU has won nine of the last 11 meetings, including eight of 10 since the River Hawks joined the Centennial Conference in 2010.
- « The last three meetings have been decided in the last minute as JHU edged Susquehanna, 38-34, at Homewood Field in 2017 before the 'Hawks grabbed a 37-35 win early in 2018 and a 28-27 victory in 2019.

JHU Ranks Fifth in the Nation in Scoring

- « Among Division III teams, Johns Hopkins enters this week's game against Susquehanna ranked fifth in the nation in scoring offense at 50.7 points per game. JHU is one of just five NCAA Division III teams currently averaging more than 50 points per game.
- « In addition to ranking fifth among Division III teams in scoring offense, Johns Hopkins is also one of just seven teams in all divisions of the NCAA to currently be averaging better than 50 points per game. The Blue Jays' 50.7 points per outing are tied for sixth among the 656 football-playing schools in the NCAA.

Scoring in All Three Phases

- « Johns Hopkins got two defensive touchdowns and had two kickoff returns for touchdowns in the 54-6 win at Moravian (Sept. 25). Add in a safety recorded by the defense, and 26 of JHU's 54 points did not come from the offense.
- « The last time JHU scored in all three phases (offense-defense-special teams) was in the 2018 season opener against Randolph-Macon.
- $^{\circ}$ The last time Johns Hopkins scored twice on defense in a game was on September 10, 2011, when the Jays returned two INTs for TDs.

Quite a Run

« In the last 22 quarters and six minutes, Johns Hopkins has outscored the opposition 288-44.

Quite a Run - Part II

- « The Johns Hopkins defense has been on quite a run since late in the second quarter against Ursinus. Since then, the opposition has had 82 offensive possessions. Consider ...
- « Those 82 opponent possessions have ended with 1 safety, 2 touchdowns, 3 field goals, 6 interceptions, 6 fumbles lost, 8 turnovers on downs and 48 punts ... eight others ended with the conclusion of either the second or fourth quarter.

Defense Among the Centennial/National Leaders

- « The Blue Jay defense enters this week's game ranked among the best in the Centennial Conference and the NCAA in a number of statistical categories.
- « Through seven games, JHU ranks first in the Centennial in scoring defense (10.9) and rushing defense (56.4) and second in total defense (244.0), pass defense (187.6) and sacks (20).
- « Nationally, the Blue Jays rank ninth in rushing defense, 12th in scoring defense, 20th in total defense and 10th in opponent third-down percentage (.252).

Lethal Weapon Three

« Johns Hopkins features one of the top wide receiver trios in the nation in Harrison Wellmann, Quinn Revere and Ryan Hubley - all three rank among the top four in the Centennial Conference in receptions and receiving yards.

State of Affairs « The 95-man Johns Hopkins roster features players WA from 25 different states and one foreign country (Switzerland). The breakdown ... - «Wellmann headlines the group as he has 58 receptions for 868 yards and 11 touchdowns, while Revere (45-705-6) and Hubley (45-602-3) are not far behind.
- « On the year, they have 2,175 combined receiving yards on 148 receptions with 20 touchdowns. They have more combined receptions and yards than all but one other team in the Centennial Conference.
- « Breaking it down by game, they have combined for 20 or more receptions in all but one game, have rolled up more than 300 receiving yards five times and accounted for four or more touchdowns in four different games.

Starting QB Streak at 11

- « Ryan Stevens got his first career start at quarterback in the 53-18 season-opening win at Stevenson. With that, he became the first Blue Jay other than **David Tammaro** to start a game at quarterback since early in the 2017 season, when **Zack Baker** started a game at Dickinson.
- «Including that win and dating back to 2006, 11 consecutive Johns Hopkins quarterbacks have now won their first career start for the Blue Jays, a streak that started with **Shane Kibbe's** 21-14 win over Randolph-Macon early in that 2006 season.

Returning All-Centennial Selections

- « Johns Hopkins returns three players who earned All-Centennial Conference honors in 2019 in graduate students **Macauley Kilbane** (DB) and **Ryan Hubley** (WR) and senior **Harrison Wellmann** (WR).
- « Kilbane earned First Team All-CC in 2018 and 2019, while Hubley was a first team selection in 2018 and a second team honoree in 2019; Wellmann was a first team honoree in 2019.

Returning D3football.com All-South Honorees

« In addition to earning All-Centennial honors in 2019, **Macauley Kilbane** (2nd Team) and **Harrison Wellmann** (3rd Team) also earned D3football.com All-South honors that year as well.

It's All Academic - Part I

- « Johns Hopkins led Division III and tied Stanford for the national lead among all NCAA schools with four CoSIDA Academic All-America selections in 2020-21 (AAA teams were selected with career statistics the primary criteria instead of season statistics in 2020-21 due to COVID-19 limiting or eliminating some teams' seasons).
- « Ryan Hubley (WR) and Macauley Kilbane (DB) were named First Team CoSIDA Academic All-Americans, while Ross Andersson (DB) and Jacob Fetterolf (OL) were second team selections.
- « The four Academic All-America selections are the most in school history, topping the three AAAs Johns Hopkins produced in 2011, 2013, 2015, 2016 and 2017.
- « The four AAA selections for the football team were part of a haul of 18 CoSIDA Academic All-Americans Johns Hopkins produced across all of its athletic programs in 2020-21 ... the 18 are a school record for one year (previous record was 13 in 2013-14).

Close Calls

« Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of 12 games. Those 12 losses have come by a total of 71 points with setbacks by five, three, five, seven, four, three, two, eight, one, three and 15 points (twice). Translation, 10 of Johns Hopkins' 12 losses since the start of the 2013 season have come by a touchdown or less.

On a Roll

- « Johns Hopkins is 94-7 in its last 101 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season.
- lpha The Blue Jays are 103-15 in their last 118 games overall since late in the 2010 season.
- « Dating back farther, Johns Hopkins is 169-43 (.797) since the start of the 2002 season, 175-46 (.792) since the start of the 2001 season and 180-51 (.779) since the start of the 2000 season.

At Home at Homewood

- $^{\mbox{\tiny w}}$ Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 55-7 (.887) at Homewood Field.
- « Johns Hopkins had won 12 consecutive games at Homewood Field before the loss on September 14, 2019 against Susquehanna. This is tied for the longest home winning streak in school history. JHU previously won 12 straight games at home from 2014-15.

Offensive Player Notes of Interest

Ryan Hubley (Gr. • WR)

- « Tied for second on the team in receiving with 45 receptions for 602 yards and three touchdowns.
- « Ranks six in school history in receptions (198), 10th in receiving yards (2,331) and tied for 16th in touchdown receptions (14).
- « Has at least three receptions in 30 straight games and 33 of the 34 he's played in during his career.

Will Leger (Fr. • TE)

« Got the start at tight end in the season opener at Stevenson and responded with four receptions for 37 yards. Included in his career-opening effort was a three-yard touchdown reception just before halftime that gave JHU a 27-3 lead. « Added one reception in each of the next three games and now has seven catches for 58 yards and one TD in five games.

Ryan Stevens (Jr. • QB)

- « Is 180-of-270 (.667) for 2,498 yards and 21 touchdowns against five interceptions through seven games.
- « Ranks second in the nation in passing yards per game (356.9), second in total offense (364.3), 21st in pass efficiency (166.3), 19th in completion percentage (.667) and 13th in TD passes (21).
- «Went 31-of-46 for 483 yards with 5 TDs against 1 INT in the season opener against Stevenson.
- « 483 passing yards is the most ever by a JHU
- quarterback in a season opener and the thirdbest total in school history.
- « Five TD passes are the most in an opener for a JHU QB since Jon Germano had five at Randolph-Macon in 2015.
- «Followed up effort in opener by going 22-of-25 (.880) for 364 yards with six TDs and one INT in a 49-21 win over Ursinus.
- « Went 24-of-36 for 358 yards with three TDs in a 77-0 win at Juniata and was 27-of-37 for 276 yards with one TD and one INT at Moravian.
- « Wrapped up first half of season by going 23-of-35 for 376 yards with one TD and added 24 rushing yards for 400 yards of total offense against F&M.
- « Was 26-of-48 for 275 yards with no touchdowns and two INTs at #22 Muhlenberg.
- « Fueled 50-0 win at Gettysburg by going 27-of-43 for 366 yards and five touchdowns.
- « The 483 passing yards against Stevenson are the most ever by a left-handed QB in Centennial Conference history (Michael McCabe - Muhl. 471 vs. DC - 1999).
- « Named Centennial Conference Offensive Player of the Week and to the D3football.com Team of the Week after wins against Stevenson and Ursinus.

Quinn Revere (Gr. • WR)

- « Tied for second on the team in receiving with 45 receptions for 705 yards and six touchdowns in seven games.
- « Enjoyed a memorable first game as a Blue Jay with seven receptions for 126 yards and one touchdown in the 53-18 season-opening victory at Stevenson.
- « The 126 receiving yards are the most by a Johns Hopkins player in his first game since Sam Skinner had 137 against FDU-Madison on September 13, 1996.
- « Came back with six receptions for 115 yards and one touchdown (60 yards) in a 49-21 win over Ursinus, added six receptions for 112 yards and two scores against Juniata and had a career-best nine receptions for 107 yards at Moravian.
- $^{\rm w}$ Added seven receptions for 68 yards against F&M.
- « Centennial Conference Offensive Player of the Week after totaling nine receptions for 166 yards and two TDs at Gettysburg.
- « Four consecutive 100-yard receiving games to start the season tied the JHU record (Bill Stromberg/1980-81) Revere is the first to have four straight 100-yard receiving games in one season.

Harrison Wellmann (Sr. • WR)

- «Leads the team in receiving with 58 receptions for 868 yards and 11 touchdowns in seven games.
- « Had scored at least two touchdowns in five straight games dating back to last season before scoring just once against F&M. Still, has scored 15 TDs in last eight games (13 receiving / 2 KOR).
- « Ranks fourth in the nation in receiving TDs (11), eighth in receptions per game (8.0) and fifth in receiving yards per game (124.0).
- « Posted 11 receptions for 230 yards and two touchdowns in the 53-18 season-opening victory at Stevenson.
- « The 230 receiving yards are a career high and the third-highest single-game total in school history.
- « Came back with eight receptions for 68 yards and a career-high three touchdown receptions in a 49-21 win over Ursinus and added 10 receptions for 142 yards and two scores at Juniata.
- « Had seven receptions for 72 yards and returned two kickoffs for touchdowns (90, 73) in a 54-6 win at Moravian. Named Centennial Special Teams Player of the Week for his effort, which set a JHU record and tied an NCAA Division III record for kickoff returns for a TD in a game.
- $^{\rm w}$ Counted nine receptions for 180 yards and one TD in a win against F&M and had five receptions for 84 yards at #22 Muhlenberg.
- $^{\rm w}$ Rang up six receptions for 92 yards and three TDs in a 50-0 win at Gettysburg.
- « Boosted his career totals to 154 receptions

for 2,392 yards and 28 touchdowns with effort at Gettysburg.
