- « This is the 136th season of Johns Hopkins football. JHU first fielded a team in 1882.
- « Johns Hopkins enters this week's game with an all-time record of 571-488-58 (.537).
- $^{\rm w}$ Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 108-18 (.857) overall and 89-9 (.908) in the Centennial Conference.
- « Overall, JHU owns 14 Centennial Conference titles (all won since 2002) and has qualified for the NCAA Playoffs 10 times (all since 2005).

Oh Captain, My Captain

- $^{ ext{ iny In}}$ In a vote of the team last spring, four players were selected to serve as captains of the 2021 Johns Hopkins football team.
- « Graduate student Macauley Kilbane (DB) and seniors Ross Andersson (DB), Joe Tischler (DL)

and **Emmett Turner** (TE) will lead the Blue Jays this season. This will be Kilbane's second season serving as a co-captain.

 $\,^{\vee}$ Dating back to 1947, Kilbane is just the 14th player to serve as a captain more than once.

Poll Position

- « Johns Hopkins will carry a pair of top-20 rankings into this week's game at McDaniel as the Blue Jays check in at #17 in both the AFCA and D3football.com Polls this week.
- « Since the AFCA Poll debuted in 1999, this week's #17 ranking marks the 107th time JHU has been ranked in the top 25. More recently, the Blue Jays are in the top 25 for the 90th time in the last 98 polls dating back to 2011.
- « Since the D3football.com Poll debuted in 2003, this week's #17 ranking marks the 121st time Johns Hopkins has appeared in the top 25.

Things to Know - McDaniel

- « McDaniel welcomes Johns Hopkins to Gill Stadium for the final game of the 2021 regular season. The Terror are coming off a 7-3 victory at Gettysburg that snapped a six-game losing streak.
- « The Terror are literally two plays away from entering this week's game with a chance to finish .500 as they dropped a tough 18-14 decision to Ursinus and fell in double-overtime to Moravian, 37-31, during their six-game skid.
- « Head coach **Demarcus White** and his staff are building with defense as the Terror have forced 18 turnovers, allow just 115.1 yards per game on the ground and have held five of nine opponents to 24 points or less, including league-leading Muhlenberg (23).
- « Offensively, McDaniel is averaging just 12.0 points per game and has been held below 10 points five times in eight games. A young group has started to find its footing late in the season as the Terror are averaging 17 points per game over their last four outings.

Green Terror to Watch

John Allan Furgeson (Sr. • QB)

« Has thrown for 1,410 yards and five touchdowns against 11 interceptions on the year. Coming off a solid 21-of-33 performance at Gettysburg in which he threw for 200 yards, his second best total of the season.

Nah'Shon Godfrey (Gr. • FS)

- « One of the top defensive players in the Centennial Conference has played in all 29 games since the start of the 2018 season for McDaniel and 37 games in his career.
- $^{\rm w}$ Leads the team with 74 tackles and posted the 200th tackle of his career in the win at Gettysburg last Saturday.

Sam Welcher (Sr. • DL)

« Latest in a long line of outstanding defensive linemen that have come through the Green Terror program. Counts 8.5 sacks and 10 tackles for losses among his 37 tackles on the year. Ranks second in the Centennial Conference in sacks and 10th in TFLs.

I'm Honored

« After last week's win against Dickinson, a Johns Hopkins player grabbed the Centennial Conference Defensive Player of the Week Award for the fourth time this season.

« Senior DB **Nick Seidel** nabbed Defensive POW honors for the second time in as many weeks as he posted five tackles, had two interceptions, recovered a fumble and had one pass breakup to his credit in the victory.

On This Date

- « Since 1950, Johns Hopkins has played nine games on November 13 and the Blue Jays have compiled a 4-5 record on this date.
- « The Blue Jays have won their last two games played on this date as they scored 12-9 and 34-10 wins over McDaniel in 2004 and 2010, respectively.

The Race for the Boot

« The race for the Centennial Conference Championship title and possession of the coveted Boot comes down to the final week of the season with four teams still in contention to grab at least a share of the championship. Below is a look at the four teams still alive and the scenarios for each that are still in play:

Johns Hopkins: JHU grabs the outright title with a win and a Muhlenberg loss. The Blue Jays get a share if both teams have the same result this week.

Muhlenberg: Same as Johns Hopkins ... MC grabs the outright title with a win and a Johns Hopkins loss. The Mules get a share if both teams have the same result this week.

Susquehanna: The River Hawks get a share of the title with a win over Juniata and losses by Johns Hopkins and Muhlenberg.

Ursinus: The Bears can get a share of the title with a win over Dickinson and losses by Johns Hopkins and Muhlenberg.

The Race for the Bid

- « The Centennial Conference champion receives an automatic bid to the NCAA Playoffs. In the case of co-champions, a tie-breaking procedure is in place to determine which team will earn the automatic bid.
- « There are still several scenarios that can play out with one game remaining in the regular season. Below is a glance as the simplest possibility for each team that can still get a share of the conference title.

Series History

- « Johns Hopkins and McDaniel are meeting for the 99th time in a series that dates to a 16-0 win by then Western Maryland in 1894.
- « JHU leads the all-time series 58-35-5 and has won 19 straight against the Green Terror.
- « The teams have met every year since 1947 except one (1963 game canceled after President Kennedy assassination).
- « JHU topped then Western Maryland, 21-14, on November 10, 2001 to snap WMC's 33-game Centennial winning streak.
- « Since the win in 2001, JHU has won 19 straight against the Terror, has scored at least 42 points in eight straight meetings and has held McDaniel to 14 points or less 13 times in those 19 games.

Johns Hopkins: The Blue Jays grab the automatic bid with a win and a Muhlenberg loss.

Muhlenberg: The Mules get the automatic bid a win over Moravian.

Susquehanna: The River Hawks' only chance at the automatic bid would be in a four-way tie situation that brings secondary criteria into the equation.

Ursinus: The Bears' only chance at the automatic bid would be in a four-way tie situation that brings secondary criteria into the equation.

Centennial-MAC Bowl Series

- « The top three teams in the Centennial Conference and the Middle Atlantic Conference not selected for the NCAA Playoffs will compete in the 2021 Centennial-MAC Bowl Series on November 20.
- « The #1 seed from each league will host a crossover game against the #2 seed from the other league. The number three teams in each league will play each other with the host school/league rotating each year.

Road Warriors

- « This week's game at McDaniel will be the Blue Jays' sixth road game of the season. This is the first time Johns Hopkins has played six regular season road games since 2010.
- « Johns Hopkins is 4-1 on the road this season and 28-6 on the road (regular season and playoffs) since the start of the 2015 season.

Before The Bye

- « The game against F&M on Oct. 2 was the last game for the Blue Jays before their bye week. Including the win against the Diplomats and dating back to 2011, the Blue Jays are 45-3 in games played before their bye.
- « The Centennial Conference went to the league-wide bye in the middle of the season in 2011.

After the Bye

- « Dating back to 2011, when the Centennial Conference went to a league-wide bye in the middle of the season, Johns Hopkins is 43-4 in regular season games played after the bye week.
- « In games played after the bye since 2011, and including last week's game against Dickinson, the Blue Jays are 20-3 in regular season games played on the road and 23-1 in regular season games played at home.

JHU Ranks Ninth in the Nation in Scoring

- « Among Division III teams, Johns Hopkins enters this week's game against McDaniel ranked ninth in the nation in scoring offense at 47.8 points per game. JHU is one of just 11 NCAA Division III teams currently averaging more than 47 points per game.
- « In addition to ranking ninth among Division III teams in scoring offense, the Blue Jays' 47.8 points per outing are tied for 12th among the 656 football-playing schools in the NCAA.


Scoring Notes of Interest

- $^{\circ}$ Johns Hopkins has scored 430 points in its first nine games of the 2021 season. The 430 points already rank as the ninth-best single-season total in school history.
- « In 36 quarters this season, the Blue Jays have scored 10 or more points in 21 of the 36 and 20 or more in eight of 36.
- « JHU has scored 161 points in the second quarter and has outscored the opposition 82-10 in the first quarter and 106-21 in the third quarter.
- « The 161 points Johns Hopkins has scored in the second quarter this season are more than 56 Division III teams, including four in the Centennial Conference, have scored all season.

November Reign

- « Johns Hopkins is 41-5 in regular season games played in the month of November this century, including 22-2 since 2010.
- « The Blue Jays are 13-2 in their last 15 regular season road games in the month of November dating back to 2007.
- « JHU has not lost a regular season home game in the month of November since 2007. The Blue Jays have won 15 consecutive regular season home games in November since that loss to F&M in 2007.
- « In this century, Johns Hopkins is 22-2 in regular season home games in the month of November.

Scoring in All Three Phases

- « Johns Hopkins got two defensive touchdowns and had two kickoff returns for touchdowns in the 54-6 win at Moravian (Sept. 25). Add in a safety recorded by the defense, and 26 of JHU's 54 points did not come from the offense.
- « The last time JHU scored in all three phases (offense-defense-special teams) was in the 2018 season opener against Randolph-Macon.
- « The last time Johns Hopkins scored twice on defense in a game was on September 10, 2011, when the Jays returned two INTs for TDs.

Quite a Run

« In the last 30 quarters and six minutes, Johns Hopkins has outscored the opposition 363-78.

Quite a Run - Part II

- « The Johns Hopkins defense has been on quite a run since late in the second quarter against Ursinus. Since then, the opposition has had 108 offensive possessions. Consider ...
- « Those 108 opponent possessions have ended with 1 safety, 6 touchdowns, 5 field goals, 12 interceptions, 10 fumbles lost, 9 turnovers on downs and 57 punts ... eight others ended with the conclusion of either the second or fourth quarter.

Defense Among the Centennial/National Leaders

- « The Blue Jay defense enters this week's game ranked among the best in the Centennial Conference and the NCAA in a number of statistical categories.
- « Through nine games, JHU ranks first in the Centennial in scoring defense (12.2), rushing defense (71.0), passing defense (184.7), total defense (255.7) and caused turnovers (25) and second in sacks (28).
- « Nationally, the Blue Jays rank 15th in rushing defense, 17th in scoring defense, 25th in total defense, sixth in opponent third-down percentage (.248) and tied for 15th in sacks.

Lethal Weapon Three

- « Johns Hopkins features one of the top wide receiver trios in the nation in Harrison Wellmann, Quinn Revere and Ryan Hubley all three rank among the top five in the Centennial Conference in receptions and receiving yards.
- « Wellmann headlines the group as he has 69 receptions for 1,039 yards and 12 touchdowns, while Revere (58-829-8) and Hubley (61-722-3) are not far behind.
- « On the year, they have 2,590 combined receiving yards on 188 receptions with 23 touchdowns. They have more combined receptions and yards than all but one other *team* in the Centennial Conference.
- « Breaking it down by game, they have combined for 20 or more receptions in all but one game, have rolled up more than 300 receiving yards five times and accounted for four or more touchdowns in four different games.
- « Johns Hopkins is the only Division III team in the nation with three players with 58 or more receptions (JHU is actually the only team with more than one) and the only team with two more players with 825 or more receiving yards.

Starting QB Streak at 11

- « **Ryan Stevens** got his first career start at quarterback in the 53-18 season-opening win at Stevenson. With that, he became the first Blue Jay other than **David Tammaro** to start a game at quarterback since early in the 2017 season, when
- than **David Tammaro** to start a game at quarterback since early in the 2017 season, when **Zack Baker** started a game at Dickinson.
- «Including that win and dating back to 2006, 11 consecutive Johns Hopkins quarterbacks have now won their first career start for the Blue Jays, a streak that started with **Shane Kibbe's** 21-14 win over Randolph-Macon early in that 2006 season.

Returning All-Centennial Selections

- « Johns Hopkins returns three players who earned All-Centennial Conference honors in 2019 in graduate students **Macauley Kilbane** (DB) and **Ryan Hubley** (WR) and senior **Harrison Wellmann** (WR).
- « Kilbane earned First Team All-CC in 2018 and 2019, while Hubley was a first team selection in 2018 and a second team honoree in 2019; Wellmann was a first team honoree in 2019.

Returning D3football.com All-South Honorees

« In addition to earning All-Centennial honors in 2019, **Macauley Kilbane** (2nd Team) and **Harrison Wellmann** (3rd Team) also earned D3football.com All-South honors that year as well.

It's All Academic - Part I

- « Johns Hopkins led Division III and tied Stanford for the national lead among all NCAA schools with four CoSIDA Academic All-America selections in 2020-21 (AAA teams were selected with career statistics the primary criteria instead of season statistics in 2020-21 due to COVID-19 limiting or eliminating some teams' seasons).
- « Ryan Hubley (WR) and Macauley Kilbane (DB) were named First Team CoSIDA Academic All-Americans, while Ross Andersson (DB) and Jacob Fetterolf (OL) were second team selections.
- « The four Academic All-America selections are the most in school history, topping the three AAAs Johns Hopkins produced in 2011, 2013, 2015, 2016 and 2017.
- « The four AAA selections for the football team were part of a haul of 18 CoSIDA Academic All-Americans Johns Hopkins produced across all of its athletic programs in 2020-21 ... the 18 are a school record for one year (previous record was 13 in 2013-14).

Close Calls

« Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of 12 games. Those 12 losses have come by a total of 71 points with setbacks by five, three, five, seven, four, three, two, eight, one, three and 15 points (twice). Translation, 10 of Johns Hopkins' 12 losses since the start of the 2013 season have come by a touchdown or less.

On a Roll

- « Johns Hopkins is 96-7 in its last 103 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season.
- « The Blue Jays are 105-15 in their last 120 games overall since late in the 2010 season.
- « Dating back farther, Johns Hopkins is 171-43 (.799) since the start of the 2002 season, 177-46 (.794) since the start of the 2001 season and 182-51 (.781) since the start of the 2000 season.

At Home at Homewood

- « Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 57-7 (.891) at Homewood Field.
- « Johns Hopkins had won 12 consecutive games at Homewood Field before the loss on September 14, 2019 against Susquehanna. This is tied for the longest home winning streak in school history. JHU previously won 12 straight games at home from 2014-15.



Offensive Player Notes of Interest

Ryan Hubley (Gr. • WR)

- « Second on the team in receiving with 61 receptions for 722 yards and three touchdowns.
- « Ranks sixth in school history in receptions (214), ninth in receiving yards (2,451) and tied for 16th in touchdown receptions (14).
- « Has at least three receptions in 32 straight games and 35 of the 36 he's played in during his career.
- « A nominee for the 2021 Mayo Clinic Comeback Player of the Year Award after having his 2019 season ended with a broken leg and broken collarbone suffered on the same play against Franklin & Marshall (game 6).

Will Leger (Fr. • TE)

« Got the start at tight end in the season opener at Stevenson and responded with four receptions for 37 yards. Included in his career-opening effort was a three-yard touchdown reception just before halftime that gave JHU a 27-3 lead. « Added one reception in each of the next three games and now has seven catches for 58 yards and one TD in five games.

Ryan Stevens (Jr. • QB)

- « Is 230-of-335 (.687) for 3,019 yards and 24 touchdowns against six interceptions through nine games.
- « Fourth player in school history to throw for 3,000+ in a season. His 3,019 yards thus far rank fifth in school history.
- « Ranks third in the nation in passing yards per game (335.4), sixth in total offense (340.9), 22nd in pass efficiency (164.4), 13th in completion percentage (.687) and 22nd in TD passes (24).
- «Went 31-of-46 for 483 yards with 5 TDs against
- 1 INT in the season opener against Stevenson.
- « 483 passing yards is the most ever by a JHU quarterback in a season opener and the thirdbest total in school history.
- « Five TD passes are the most in an opener for a JHU QB since Jon Germano had five at Randolph-Macon in 2015.
- « Followed up effort in opener by going 22-of-25 (.880) for 364 yards with six TDs and one INT in a 49-21 win over Ursinus.
- « Went 24-of-36 for 358 yards with three TDs in a 77-0 win at Juniata and was 27-of-37 for 276 yards with one TD and one INT at Moravian.
