The Game

« Johns Hopkins (1-0) welcomes Ursinus (1-0) to Homewood Field for the Centennial Conference opener for both teams. This week's game between the Blue Jays and Bears is the only CC game featuring two teams that won their season opener.

A Look Back

« Johns Hopkins went on the road and topped Stevenson, 53-18, last Saturday. The Blue Jays were the only Centennial Conference team to win on the road in week one.

« Ursinus was the first team in the league to play a game this season as the Bears opened up last Friday night (Sept. 3) and topped Alvernia, 42-6.

The Facts

- « This is the 136th season of Johns Hopkins football. JHU first fielded a team in 1882.
- « Johns Hopkins enters this week's game with an all-time record of 564-487-58 (.535).
- « Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 101-17 (.856) overall and 82-8 (.911) in the Centennial Conference.
- « Overall, JHU owns 14 Centennial Conference titles (all won since 2002) and has qualified for the NCAA Playoffs 10 times (all since 2005).

Oh Captain, My Captain

- « In a vote of the team last spring, four players were selected to serve as captains of the 2021 Johns Hopkins football team.
- « Graduate student **Macauley Kilbane** (DB) and seniors **Ross Andersson** (DB), **Joe Tischler** (DL) and **Emmett Turner** (TE) will lead the Blue Jays this season. This will be Kilbane's second season serving as a co-captain.
- « Dating back to 1947, Kilbane is just the 14th player to serve as a captain more than one season.

Poll Position

- « Johns Hopkins was listed as receiving votes in the D3football.com preseason poll, but jumped to number 25 in this week's rankings.
- « Since the D3football.com Poll debuted in 2003, this week's #25 ranking marks the 112th time Johns Hopkins has appeared in the top 25.
- « The AFCA Poll, which the Johns Hopkins office of Athletic Communications has used to reference JHU's official ranking at the time of a game since that poll debuted in 1999, will be issued for the first time during the 2021 season later in September.

It's Been a While

- « Last week's game at Stevenson marked the first time since 2015 that the Blue Jays have opened a season on a Saturday.
- « Since 2015, the Blue Jays had opened three times on a Thursday night (2016, 2018, 2019) and once on a Friday night (2017) before last week's Saturday game at SU.

Things to Know - Ursinus

« Ursinus comes to Homewood Field fresh off a 42-6 season-opening win against Alvernia. The Bears have now won four straight season openers and eight of their last nine dating back to 2012.

« Last week's game was the first for Ursinus on a Friday night since 2013.

« The win against Alvernia was the 99th for head coach **Peter Gallagher**, who is already the all-time winningest coach in UC history.

« In a dominating effort, the Ursinus defense held the Golden Wolves to just 79 yards passing and a combined 4-of-16 on third and fourth-down conversions.

« The UC offense proved to be the most balanced in the Centennial on the opening weekend as the Bears were the only team in the league to go over 200 yards rushing (218) and passing (255) in week one.

« A win this week against Johns Hopkins would push UC's winning streak to three games dating back to 2019.

« This week's game at Johns Hopkins kicks off a brutal four-game run for the Bears, who follow the game against JHU by playing Muhlenberg, F&M and Susquehanna in successive weeks.

Bears to Watch

Jonathan Klee (Sr. • LB)

« A co-captain in 2021 who rang up a career-high 14 tackles, including one sack and 2.5 for losses, in the season opener.

« Entered the season with four career tackles before posting a Centennial-high 14 stops last week.

Jack Psenicksa (Jr. • QB)

« Made an immediate splash in starting debut by tying the UC single-game record with five TD passes against Alvernia.

« Finished the opener by going 19-of-32 for 255 yards with the five TD tosses.

Sam Ragland (Sr. • QB)

« A co-captain, two-time First Team All-Centennial selection and the top running back in the Centennial Conference.

« Topped 2,000 career rushing yards with 184 in his season debut against Alvernia and went over 4,000 all-purpose yards in the victory as well (4,005).

Back-to-Back

« The Blue Jays closed the 2019 season with a 51-28 win at Stevenson in the Centennial-MAC Bowl Series. A scant 652 days later and the Blue Jays and Mustangs met last week in the 2021 season opener for both teams.

« How rare is it for Johns Hopkins to have played a team in consecutive games (even over different seasons)? The last time on record of the Johns Hopkins football team playing the same team in consecutive games came in '07 and '08 ... as in, 1907 and 1908.

« The Blue Jays capped the 1907 season with a 7-0 win at home against Maryland on Thanksgiving Day (11-28-1907) and then opened the 1908 season with a 10-0 win against Maryland at home.

Quite a Run

« The Centennial Conference includes 10 teams for football, which translates into a nine-game league record and one non-conference game each season. This has been the scheduling format since Susquehanna joined the league in 2010.

« With last week's 53-18 win at Stevenson the Blue Jays have now won 10 consecutive regular-season non-conference games dating back to 2011.

For Openers

« Including last week's win at Stevenson, Johns Hopkins has won its last 10 season openers dating back to 2011.

« During the 10-game winning streak in season openers, the Blue Jays have outscored the opposition 423-180 and only two of the 10 games have been decided by 15 points or less.

Centennial Openers

« Since the formation of the Centennial Conference for football in 1983, Johns Hopkins is 25-12 in its 37 league-opening games.

« The Blue Jays have actually lost their last two CC openers - both to Susquehanna as SU handed JHU a 37-35 loss in the 2018 CC-opener and a 28-27 defeat in 2019.

« Prior to the losses in its 2018 and 2019 CC openers, the Blue Jays had won 10 consecutive league openers.

« Johns Hopkins' 25 CC-opening wins are the most in league history.

On This Date

« This week's game against Ursinus will be just the fifth the Blue Jays have ever played on September 11.

« JHU first played a game on this date in 1987 and topped St. Peter's, 19-6, that day. Wins against W&L (31-14) and Kean (35-17) followed in 1999 and 2004, respectively, before the Blue Jays dropped their last game on this date, 41-37, at Randolph-Macon in 2010.

Sweet September

« Dating back to 2010, Johns Hopkins is now 38-4 in the month of September after last week's win over Stevenson.

« Also dating back to 2010, the Blue Jays are 18-1 at home and 20-3 on the road in the month of September.

Series History

« Johns Hopkins and Ursinus are meeting for the 63rd time in a series that dates to a 12-0 Johns Hopkins victory on October 11, 1958.

« The Blue Jays lead the all-time series 37-21-4 and are 22-14-1 against UC since the formation of the Centennial Conference in 1983. JHU has currently won eight of the last nine against UC.

« The 37 games between the two teams since the formation of the Centennial Conference have generally either been very tight (16 decided by six points or less) or blowouts (15 decided by 14+).

« UC had won five of six vs. JHU before the Blue Jays' current 8-1 run against the Bears.

« The 506 passing yards for the Blue Jays at SU are the third-highest single-game total in school history.

« Junior quarterback **Ryan Stevens** made his starting debut a successful one last week at Stevenson as he was 31-of-46 for 483 yards and five touchdowns against one interception to fuel the 53-18 victory over the Mustangs.

« The 483 yards for Stevens are the most ever in a season opener for a JHU quarterback and the third-highest single-game total in school history.

« For this efforts, Stevens was named the Centennial Conference Offensive Player of the Week and he was also named to the D3football.com Team of the Week.

« The Blue Jay defense had several outstanding individual performances last week at Stevenson and senior defensive back **Finn Zechman** was honored as the Centennial Conference Defensive Player of the Week for his efforts.

« Zechman totaled five tackles, one interception, one forced fumble and two pass breakups in the victory.

« Senior wide receiver **Harrison Wellmann** turned in an 11-reception, 230-yard, two-touchdown performance last week. The 230 yards receiving are a career high and the third-highest single-game total in school history.

« Johns Hopkins returns three players who earned All-Centennial Conference honors in 2019 in graduate students **Macauley Kilbane** (DB) and **Ryan Hubley** (WR) and senior **Harrison Wellmann** (WR).

« Kilbane earned First Team All-CC in 2018 and 2019, while Hubley was a first team selection in 2018 and a second team honoree in 2019; Wellmann was a first team honoree in 2019 as well.

« In addition to earning All-Centennial honors in 2019, **Macauley Kilbane** (2nd Team) and **Harrison Wellmann** (3rd Team) also earned D3football.com All-South honors that year as well.

« Johns Hopkins led Division III and tied Stanford for the national lead among all NCAA schools with four CoSIDA Academic All-America selections in 2020-21 (AAA teams were selected with career statistics the primary criteria instead of season statistics in 2020-21 due to COVID-19 limiting or eliminating some teams' seasons).

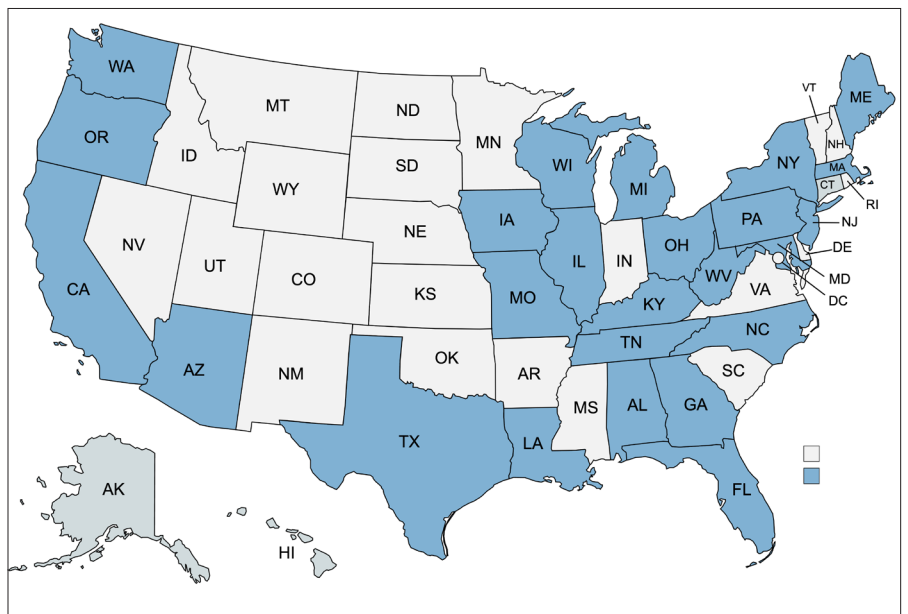

« **Ryan Hubley** (WR) and **Macauley Kilbane** (DB) were named First Team CoSIDA Academic All-Americans, while **Ross Andersson** (DB) and **Jacob Fetterolf** (OL) were second team selections.

« The four Academic All-America selections are the most in school history, topping the three AAAs Johns Hopkins produced in 2011, 2013, 2015, 2016 and 2017.

« The four AAA selections for the football team were part of a haul of 18 CoSIDA Academic All-Americans Johns Hopkins produced across all of its athletic programs in 2020-21 ... the 18 are a school record for one year (previous record was 13 in 2013-14).

Starting QB Streak at 11

« **Ryan Stevens** got his first career start at quarterback in the 53-18 season-opening win at Stevenson. With that, he became the first Blue Jay other than **David Tammamo** to start a game at quarterback since early in the 2017 season, when **Zack Baker** started a game at Dickinson.

« Including last week's win and dating back to 2006, 11 consecutive Johns Hopkins quarterbacks have now won their first career start for the Blue Jays, a streak that started with **Shane Kibbe's** 21-14 win over Randolph-Macon early in that 2006 season.

Close Calls

« Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of 11 games. Those 11 losses have come by a total of 56 points with setbacks by five, three, five, seven, four, three, two, eight, one, three and 15 points. Translation, 10 of Johns Hopkins' 11

losses since the start of the 2013 season have come by a touchdown or less. The 31-16 loss to Muhlenberg (Nov. 2, 2019) marked the first time JHU had lost a regular season game by more than nine points in more than 10 years (2009 season opener at Delaware Valley).

On a Roll

« Johns Hopkins is 89-6 in its last 95 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season.

« The Blue Jays are 97-14 in their last 111 games overall since late in the 2010 season.

« Dating back farther, Johns Hopkins is 164-42 (.796) since the start of the 2002 season, 170-45 (.791) since the start of the 2001 season and 175-50 (.778) since the start of the 2000 season.

At Home at Homewood

« Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 53-7 (.883) at Homewood Field.

« Johns Hopkins had won 12 consecutive games at Homewood Field before the loss on September 14, 2019 against Susquehanna. This is tied for the longest home winning streak in school history. JHU previously won 12 straight games at home from 2014-15.

Offensive Player Notes of Interest

Ryan Stevens (Jr. • QB)

« Went 31-of-46 for 483 yards with 5 TDs against 1 INT in the season opener against Stevenson.

« 483 passing yards for Stevens is the most ever by a JHU quarterback in a season opener and the third-best total in school history.

« Five TD passes are the most in an opener for a JHU QB since Jon Germano had five at Randolph-Macon in 2015.

« The 483 passing yards are the most ever by a left-handed QB in Centennial Conference history (Michael McCabe - Muhl. 471 vs. DC - 1999)

« Named Centennial Conference Offensive Player of the Week and to the D3football.com Team of the Week for his effort against Stevenson.

« After one game, leads the nation in passing yards (483) and ranks second in total offense (488).

Ryan Hubley (Gr. • WR)

« Jumped to ninth on JHU's career receptions list with three against Stevenson. Now has 156 receptions in his career.

« Ranks 15th in school history in career receiving yards (1,761) and tied for 19th in touchdown receptions (12).

« Has at least three receptions in 24 straight games and 27 of the 28 he's played in during his career.

Will Leger (Fr. • TE)

« Got the start at tight end in the season opener at Stevenson and responded with four receptions for 37 yards. Included in his career-opening effort was a three-yard touchdown reception just before halftime that gave JHU a 27-3 lead.

Quinn Revere (Gr. • WR)

« Enjoyed a memorable first game as a Blue Jay with seven receptions for 126 yards and one touchdown in the 53-18 season-opening victory at Stevenson.

« The 126 receiving yards are the most by a Johns Hopkins player in his first game since Sam Skinner had 137 against FDU-Madison on September 13, 1996.

Harrison Wellmann (Sr. • WR)

« Posted 11 receptions for 230 yards and two touchdowns in the 53-18 season-opening victory at Stevenson.

« The 230 receiving yards are a career high and the third-highest single-game total in school history.

« 230 receiving yards were the third-best total in the nation by a Division III receiver on the opening weekend of games.

« Boosted his career totals to 109 receptions for 1,754 yards and 19 touchdowns with effort at SU.

« Ranks 16th in school history in career receiving yards, 15th in receptions and tied for eighth in touchdown receptions.

Danny Wolf (Jr. • RB)

« Led the Blue Jays in rushing with 11 carries for 45 yards against Stevenson and added one reception for 18 yards in the victory.

« Co-holder of the Johns Hopkins single-game record for rushing touchdowns with four in a 51-28 win at Stevenson in the 2019 Centennial-MAC Bowl Series.

Defensive Player Notes of Interest

Ross Andersson (DB)

« Posted four tackles and had one interception in the season opener at Stevenson. Returned INT 27 yards to set up a Blue Jay touchdown late in the first half that gave JHU a 27-3 lead.

« Enters this week's game needing eight tackles to reach 75 for his career.

Macauley Kilbane (DB)

« Rang up eight tackles and had one pass breakup in the season opener against Stevenson.

« Last tackle against Stevenson was the 150th of his career and his PBU was the 23rd of his career. Since 2001, his 23 pass breakups rank second at Johns Hopkins (Sam Eagleson (2008-11) had 27).

Nick Seidel (DB)

« Paced the Blue Jays with nine tackles in the season-opening win against Stevenson.

« Led the Blue Jays in tackles in 2019 with 81 and now has 134 career tackles to his credit.

Joe Tischler (DL)

« JHU's most experienced returning defensive linemen as he's played in 23 games in his career.

« Notched two tackles at Stevenson and now has 38 tackles, including seven TFLs and four sacks, in his career.

Duncan Van Kouteren (LB)

« Made the first start of his career in the season opening win at Stevenson and posted a career-high seven tackles.

« Led JHU in special teams tackles in 2019 with 12.

Finn Zechman (DB)

« Enjoyed one of the strongest games of his career in the win against Stevenson with five tackles, one interception, one forced fumble and two pass breakups.

« Named the Centennial Conference Defensive Player of the Week for his effort against the Mustangs.

« Needs two tackles to reach 75 in his career.
