The Game

« Johns Hopkins (2-0, 1-0 Centennial) hits the road for the second time in 2021 as the Blue Jays head to Juniata (0-2, 0-1). Kickoff at Knox Stadium is set for 2 pm.

A Look Back

« Johns Hopkins improved to 2-0 on the year with a 49-21 win over Ursinus at Homewood Field last Saturday.
« Juniata slipped to 0-2 on the year as the Eagles went on the road and fell at McDaniel, 27-9.

The Facts

« This is the 136th season of Johns Hopkins football. JHU first fielded a team in 1882.
« Johns Hopkins enters this week's game with an all-time record of 565-487-58 (.535).
« Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 102-17 (.857) overall and 83-8 (.912) in the Centennial Conference.
« Overall, JHU owns 14 Centennial Conference titles (all won since 2002) and has qualified for the NCAA Playoffs 10 times (all since 2005).

Oh Captain, My Captain

« In a vote of the team last spring, four players were selected to serve as captains of the 2021 Johns Hopkins football team.
« Graduate student **Macauley Kilbane** (DB) and seniors **Ross Andersson** (DB), **Joe Tischler** (DL) and **Emmett Turner** (TE) will lead the Blue Jays this season. This will be Kilbane's second season serving as a co-captain.
« Dating back to 1947, Kilbane is just the 14th player to serve as a captain more than once.

Poll Position

« Johns Hopkins was listed as receiving votes in the D3football.com pre-season poll, but jumped to number 25 in the first in-season poll (Sept. 5) and moved to number 21 this week.
« Since the D3football.com Poll debuted in 2003, this week's #21 ranking marks the 113th time Johns Hopkins has appeared in the top 25.
« The AFCA Poll, which the Johns Hopkins office of Athletic Communications has used to reference JHU's official ranking at the time of a game since that poll debuted in 1999, will be issued for the first time during the 2021 season later in September.

Things to Know - Juniata

« Juniata welcomes Johns Hopkins to Knox Stadium looking for its first win of the season. The Eagles have fallen to Grove City (39-14) and McDaniel (27-9) to open the year.

« The Eagles are led by first-year head coach **Joshua Carter**, who Blue Jay fans may remember from his standout career at Muhlenberg from 1998-2001. Carter rang up more than 2,700 receiving yards, 33 TD receptions and more 6,600 all-purpose yards in a career that saw him earn All-America honors and CC Offensive Player of the Year honors (2000).

« Offensively, Juniata is averaging better than 235 yards per game through the air, but just 47.5 yards rushing. The Eagles have scored just three first-half points in two games thus far.

• Defensively, the Eagles are coming off a strong performance against McDaniel as the Green Terror managed just 285 yards of total offense and didn't score an offensive touchdown until early in the fourth quarter.

Eagles to Watch

Aaron Goldberg (Sr. • QB)

« A native of nearby Westminster, Maryland, Goldberg is in his first season as Juniata's starting quarterback. He did enter the season having played in nine games, including seven in 2019.

« Is 37-of-71 (.521) for 398 yards through two games. Has not thrown a TD pass and has two INTs thus far.

Michael Grapin (Fr. • LB)

« Making an early impact as a freshman as he leads the team in solo (10) and overall (18) tackles. Posted 11 tackles and forced a fumble in first career game.

« Tied for fifth in the Centennial in overall tackles and tackles per game.

Clay Spencer (Sr. • WR)

« Juniata's biggest threat on the outside as he leads the team in receptions (13) and receiving yards (235) through two games.

« Tied for fourth in the Centennial Conference in receptions (13) and ranks fourth in receiving yards (235) and receiving yards per game (117.5). His 18.5 yards per reception is the highest among the 14 players in the CC with 10 or more receptions.

« Breaking it down, between September 12 and October 30, the Blue Jays will play at home just once (Oct. 2 vs. F&M).

Scoring Surge

« Johns Hopkins has scored 102 points in its first two games of the 2021 season. That's the most points JHU has scored in the first two games of a season since 2015, when the Blue Jays scored 111 through the first two.

« Dating back to the 2019 season, JHU has scored at least 42 points in five straight games, 49 or more in three straight and 50 or more in three of the last five.

« Johns Hopkins currently ranks 10th in the nation in scoring offense.

« The high-scoring Johns Hopkins offense ranks among the national leaders in a number statistical categories. A quick look at where the Blue Jays rank nationally in several key offensive statistics:

Quite a Run

« The Centennial Conference includes 10 teams for football, which translates into a nine-game league schedule and one non-conference game each season. This has been the scheduling format since Susquehanna joined the league in 2010.

« With the season-opening 53-18 win at Stevenson the Blue Jays have now won 10 consecutive regular-season non-conference games dating back to 2011.

Centennial Openers

« Since the formation of the Centennial Conference for football in 1983, and including last week's 49-21 win over Ursinus, Johns Hopkins is 26-12 in its 38 league-opening games.

« Prior to losses in its 2018 and 2019 CC openers (2 losses by a total of 3 points), the Blue Jays had won 10 consecutive league openers.

« Johns Hopkins' 26 CC-opening wins are the most in league history.

On This Date

« This week's game against Juniata will be just the fifth the Blue Jays have ever played on September 18.

« JHU first played a game on this date in 1982, when the Jays fell to Dickinson, 14-10. Wins have since followed in 2004 (24-14 vs. Carnegie Mellon), 2009 (41-23 vs. Gettysburg) and 2010 (29-21 vs. Gettysburg).

Sweet September

« Dating back to 2010, Johns Hopkins is now 39-4 in the month of September after last week's win over Ursinus.

Series History

« Johns Hopkins and Juniata are meeting for the 15th time in a series that dates to a 7-0 Juniata win on October 5, 1929 at Home-wood Field.

« The Blue Jays have won the last 13 meetings - all of which have come since the Eagles joined the Centennial in 2007 - to grab a 13-1 lead in the series.

« Since winning 12-0 in 2008, Johns Hopkins has outscored the Eagles 564-113 in the last 11 meetings, including a 57-26 win late in the 2009 season in the last meeting between the two teams.

« Also dating back to 2010, the Blue Jays are 19-1 at home and 20-3 on the road in the month of September.

In the Record Book

« The 596 yards of total offense and 53 points the Blue Jays scored at Stevenson on September 4th are both the second-best totals in school history in a season opener.

« The 506 passing yards for the Blue Jays at SU are the third-highest single-game total in school history.

I'm Honored - Again

« Junior quarterback **Ryan Stevens** was named the Centennial Conference Offensive Player of the Week and to the D3football.com Team of the Week after his performance in the season-opening win at Stevenson. For good measure, he repeated both of those honors after leading the Blue Jays past Ursinus in week two.

« In last week's win over the Bears, he was 22-of-25 (.880) for 364 yards and six touchdowns against one interception. The six TD passes are a career high and the most for a JHU quarterback since **Jon Germano** had six against Ursinus in 2016.

Returning All-Centennial Selections

« Johns Hopkins returns three players who earned All-Centennial Conference honors in 2019 in graduate students **Macauley Kilbane** (DB) and **Ryan Hubley** (WR) and senior **Harrison Wellmann** (WR).

« Kilbane earned First Team All-CC in 2018 and 2019, while Hubley was a first team selection in 2018 and a second team honoree in 2019; Wellmann was a first team honoree in 2019.

Returning D3football.com All-South Honorees

« In addition to earning All-Centennial honors in 2019, **Macauley Kilbane** (2nd Team) and **Harrison Wellmann** (3rd Team) also earned D3football.com All-South honors that year as well.

It's All Academic - Part I

« Johns Hopkins led Division III and tied Stanford for the national lead among all NCAA schools with four CoSIDA Academic All-America selections in 2020-21 (AAA teams were selected with career statistics the primary criteria instead of season statistics in 2020-21 due to COVID-19 limiting or eliminating some teams' seasons).

« **Ryan Hubley** (WR) and **Macauley Kilbane** (DB) were named First Team CoSIDA Academic All-Americans, while **Ross Andersson** (DB) and **Jacob Fetterolf** (OL) were second team selections.

« The four Academic All-America selections are the most in school history, topping the three AAAs Johns Hopkins produced in 2011, 2013, 2015, 2016 and 2017.

« The four AAA selections for the football team were part of a haul of 18 CoSIDA Academic All-Americans Johns Hopkins produced across all of its athletic programs in 2020-21 ... the 18 are a school record for one year (previous record was 13 in 2013-14).

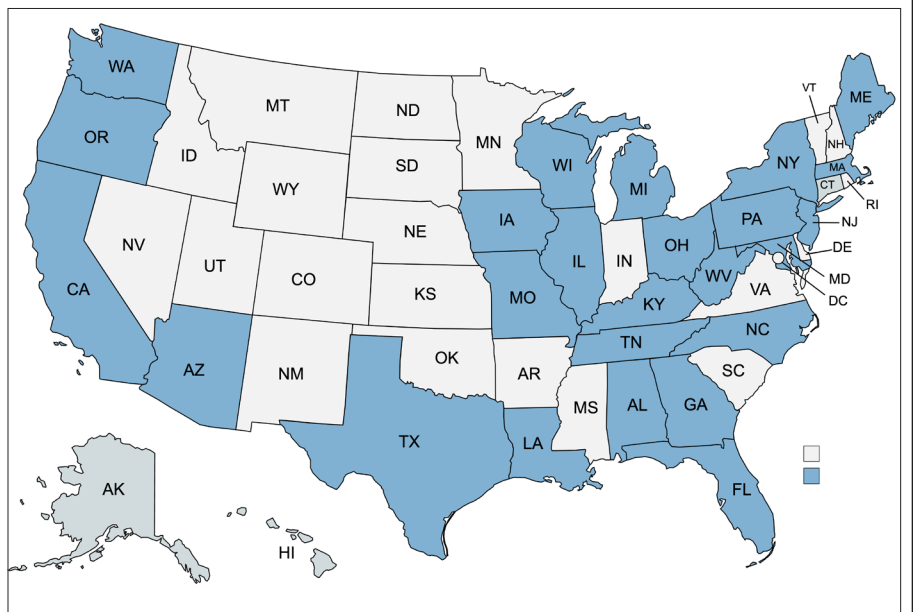

« **Ryan Stevens** got his first career start at quarterback in the 53-18 season-opening win at Stevenson. With that, he became the first Blue Jay other than **David Tammaro** to start a game at quarterback since early in the 2017 season, when **Zack Baker** started a game at Dickinson. « Including that win and dating back to 2006, 11 consecutive Johns Hopkins quarterbacks have now won their first career start for the Blue Jays, a streak that started with **Shane Kibbe's** 21-14 win over Randolph-Macon early in that 2006 season.

Close Calls

« Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of 11 games. Those 11 losses have come by a total of 56 points with setbacks by five, three, five, seven, four, three, two, eight, one, three and 15 points. Translation, 10 of Johns Hopkins' 11 losses since the start of the 2013 season have come by a touchdown or less. The 31-16 loss to Muhlenberg (Nov. 2, 2019) marked the first time JHU had lost a regular season game by more than nine points in more than 10 years (2009 season opener at Delaware Valley).

On a Roll

« Johns Hopkins is 90-6 in its last 96 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season.
 « The Blue Jays are 98-14 in their last 112 games overall since late in the 2010 season.
 « Dating back farther, Johns Hopkins is 165-42 (.797) since the start of the 2002 season, 171-45 (.792) since the start of the 2001 season and 176-50 (.779) since the start of the 2000 season.

At Home at Homewood

« Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 54-7 (.885) at Homewood Field.
 « Johns Hopkins had won 12 consecutive games at Homewood Field before the loss on September 14, 2019 against Susquehanna. This is tied for the longest home winning streak in school history. JHU previously won 12 straight games at home from 2014-15.

Offensive Player Notes of Interest

Ryan Hubley (Gr. • WR)

« Third on the team in receiving with nine receptions for 183 yards and three touchdowns.
 « Ranks ninth in school history in receptions (162), 13th in receiving yards (1,912) and tied for 16th in touchdown receptions (14).
 « Has at least three receptions in 25 straight games and 28 of the 29 he's played in during his career.

Will Leger (Fr. • TE)

« Got the start at tight end in the season opener at Stevenson and responded with four receptions for 37 yards. Included in his career-opening effort was a three-yard touchdown reception just before halftime that gave JHU a 27-3 lead.
 « Added one reception for eight yards against Ursinus and now has five catches for 45 yards and one TD in two games.

Ryan Stevens (Jr. • QB)

« Is 53-of-71 (.746) for 847 yards and 11 touchdowns against two interceptions through two games.
 « Leads the nation in touchdown passes and passing yards and ranks second in passing yards per game (423.5) and pass efficiency (220.3).
 « Went 31-of-46 for 483 yards with 5 TDs against 1 INT in the season opener against Stevenson.
 « 483 passing yards is the most ever by a JHU quarterback in a season opener and the third-best total in school history.
 « Five TD passes are the most in an opener for a JHU QB since Jon Germano had five at Randolph-Macon in 2015.
 « Followed up effort in opener by going 22-of-25 (.880) for 364 yards with six TDs and one INT in a 49-21 win over Ursinus.
 « The 483 passing yards against Stevenson are the most ever by a left-handed QB in Centennial Conference history (Michael McCabe - Muhl. 471 vs. DC - 1999)
 « Named Centennial Conference Offensive Player of the Week and to the D3football.com Team of the Week after wins against Stevenson and Ursinus.

Quinn Revere (Gr. • WR)

« Second on the team in receiving with 13 receptions for 241 yards and two touchdowns in two games.
 « Enjoyed a memorable first game as a Blue Jay with seven receptions for 126 yards and one touchdown in the 53-18 season-opening victory at Stevenson.
 « The 126 receiving yards are the most by a Johns Hopkins player in his first game since Sam Skinner had 137 against FDU-Madison on September 13, 1996.

« Came back with six receptions for 115 yards and one touchdown (60 yards) in a 49-21 win over Ursinus.

Harrison Wellmann (Sr. • WR)

« Leads the team in receiving with 19 receptions for 298 yards and five touchdowns in two games.
 « Tied for the Division III national lead with five TD receptions and ranks eighth in receptions per game (9.5) and receiving yards per game (149).
 « Posted 11 receptions for 230 yards and two touchdowns in the 53-18 season-opening victory at Stevenson.
 « The 230 receiving yards are a career high and the third-highest single-game total in school history.
 « Came back with eight receptions for 68 yards and a career-high three touchdown receptions in a 49-21 win over Ursinus.
 « Boosted his career totals to 117 receptions for 1,822 yards and 22 touchdowns with effort against Ursinus.
 « Ranks 15th in school history in career receiving yards, 15th in receptions and tied for sixth in touchdown receptions.

Danny Wolf (Jr. • RB)

« Leads the team in rushing with 20 carries for 108 yards and one touchdown and has two receptions for 40 yards in two games.
 « Led the Blue Jays in rushing with 11 carries for 45 yards against Stevenson and added one reception for 18 yards in the victory.
 « Came back with nine carries for 63 yards and one TD (27 yards) and added a 22-yard reception against Ursinus.
 « Co-holder of the Johns Hopkins single-game record for rushing touchdowns with four in a 51-28 win at Stevenson in the 2019 Centennial-MAC Bowl Series.

Defensive Player Notes of Interest

Ross Andersson (DB)

« Has eight tackles and one interception through two games.
 « Posted four tackles and had one interception in the season opener at Stevenson. Returned INT 27 yards to set up a Blue Jay touchdown late in the first half that gave JHU a 27-3 lead.
 « Added four tackles in the 49-21 win over Ursinus.
 « Enters this week's game needing four tackles to reach 75 for his career.

Macauley Kilbane (DB)

« Ranks second on the team in tackles (16) and has one INT and one PBU in two games
 « Rang up eight tackles and had one pass breakup in the season opener against Stevenson.
 « Posted eight tackles, including one TFL, and one interception in the 49-21 win over Ursinus.
 « Last tackle against Stevenson was the 150th of his career and his PBU was the 23rd of his career. Since 2001, his 23 pass breakups rank second at Johns Hopkins (Sam Eagleson (2008-11) had 27).

Nick Seidel (DB)

« Leads the team with 17 tackles and has two PBUs in two games.
 « Paced the Blue Jays with nine tackles in the season-opening win against Stevenson.
 « Tied for the team lead with eight tackles and added two PBUs in the 49-21 win over Ursinus.
 « Led the Blue Jays in tackles in 2019 with 81 and now has 142 career tackles to his credit.

Joe Tischler (DL)

« JHU's most experienced returning defensive linemen as he's played in 24 games in his career.
 « Notched two tackles at Stevenson and added five tackles, including half a sack, and one fumble recovery in the 49-21 win over Ursinus.
 « Now has 43 tackles, including 8.0 TFLs and 4.5 sacks, in his career.

Duncan Van Kouteren (LB)

« Ranks third on the team in tackles (14) through two games.
 « Made the first start of his career in the season opening win at Stevenson and posted a career-high seven tackles.
