### The Game

« Johns Hopkins makes its 2022 Homewood Field debut as the Blue Jays (2-0, 1-0 CC) welcome Juniata (0-2, 0-1 CC) to Homewood Field. This is Hopkins' first game at home after playing five consecutive away games dating back to last season.

### A Look Back

« Johns Hopkins moved to 2-0 overall and 1-0 in the Centennial with a 36-29 win at Ursinus last Saturday.

« Juniata slipped to 0-2 overall and 0-1 in the Centennial with a 35-19 loss to McDaniel. Dating back to last season, it was the seventh consecutive loss for the Eagles.

### The Facts

- « This is the 137th season of Johns Hopkins football. JHU first fielded a team in 1882.
- « Johns Hopkins enters this week's game with an all-time record of 575-489-58 (.538).
- « Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 112-19 (.855) overall and 91-9 (.910) in the Centennial Conference.
- « Overall, JHU owns 15 Centennial Conference titles (all won since 2002) and has qualified for the NCAA Playoffs 11 times (all since 2005).

### Oh Captain, My Captain

- « Six players were selected to serve as captains of the 2022 Johns Hopkins football team in a vote of the team late in preseason camp.
- « Two players - graduate students **Ross Andersson** (DB) and **Emmett Turner** (TE) - are in their second season as captains, while they are joined this season by fellow graduate students **Chris Bedell** (DL) and **Nick Seidel** (DB) and seniors **Matt Dubois** (LB) and **JR Woods** (OL).
- « Dating back to 1947, Andersson and Turner are just the 15th and 16th players to serve as a captain more than one season.
- « The six captains this season are the most in program history.

### Poll Position

- « Johns Hopkins is ranked ninth in this week's D3football.com Poll. The first AFCA Poll of the 2022 season has not been released yet.
- « Johns Hopkins was ranked 13th in the final AFCA Poll of the 2021 season and 14th in the final D3football.com Poll.

### Five Away

- « The five-game run of road games for the Blue Jays, which was capped with last week's win at Ursinus, is the longest for Johns Hopkins since the Blue Jays played seven straight games away from home between the 2009 and 2010 seasons.

### Things to Know - Juniata

« The Eagles come to Homewood Field looking to break into the win column after dropping season-opening games against Grove City (63-6) and McDaniel (35-19).

« In last week's loss to the Green Terror, Juniata trailed just 16-13 at the half and 22-19 through three quarters before McDaniel tacked on 13 points in the final seven minutes to seal the win.

« **Noah Wright** spearheaded the effort against McDaniel as he was an efficient 13-of-25 for 184 yards with three touchdowns, while **Hunter Wolfley** topped the 100-yard rushing mark (135) and **Austin Nash** topped 100 yards receiving (114).

« The Eagle defense was stingy against the run last week as McDaniel generated just 2.8 yards per rushing attempt (42-118) while Juniata forced a pair of turnovers and had a pair of sacks on the day.

« Juniata is one of three teams currently competing as an associate member in the Centennial Conference (Susquehanna, Moravian) that will depart after the 2022 season. Each of those three teams competes in all other sports in the Landmark Conference, which will sponsor football for the first time in 2023.

### Eagles to Watch

#### Seth Bernstein (Sr. • LB)

« Through two games, Bernstein leads the team in solo tackles (10), ranks second in overall tackles (17) and counts two tackles for loss and one sack to his credit.

#### Jake Matchock (Sr • DB)

« Through two games, Matchock is tied for the Centennial lead with 22 tackles and already has two interceptions and two forced fumbles to his credit. Matchock is making return to the field this year as he played in two games as a freshman in 2019, the 2020 season was canceled and he did not play in 2021.

#### Hunter Wolfley (So • RB)

« Wolfley enters this week's game ranked third in the Centennial Conference in rushing yards per game (116.0) and ranks second in yards per attempt (7.5) through two games. A year ago as a freshman, Wolfley finished fifth in the Centennial in rushing (68.7) and added seven rushing TDs.

### Blue Jay Bullet Points

« **Quinn Revere** has two TD catches in three straight games and 15 in 14 games at JHU.

« **Spencer Ugla** has 130 rushing yards in two games this season - he had 193 in 12 games prior to this season.

« **Ross Andersson** needs six tackles to reach 100 for his career, while **Duncan Van Kouteren** needs nine.

« JHU has outscored the opposition 55-7 in the first half of its two games, but has been outscored 36-35 after halftime.

« As a team, Johns Hopkins ranks third in the nation in KOR average (37.25).

### Centennial Openers

« Including last week's win at Ursinus, Johns Hopkins is now 27-12 in its 39 league-opening games since the formation of the Centennial Conference for football in 1983.

« Johns Hopkins' 27 CC-opening wins are the most in league history.

### For Openers

« Including the win at Case Western, Johns Hopkins has now won its last 11 season openers dating back to 2011.

« During the 11-game winning streak in season openers, the Blue Jays have outscored the opposition 477-194 and only two of the 11 games have been decided by 15 points or less.

### Quite a Run

« The Centennial Conference includes 10 teams for football, which translates into a nine-game league record and one non-conference game each season. This has been the scheduling format since Susquehanna joined the league in 2010.

« With the 54-14 win at Case Western, the Blue Jays have now won 11 consecutive regular-season non-conference games dating back to 2011.

### Sweet September

« Dating back to 2010, Johns Hopkins is 43-4 in the month of September.

« Also dating back to 2010, the Blue Jays are 24-3 on the road in the month of September.

### 35+ in Eight Straight

« Dating back to last season, Johns Hopkins has scored at least 35 points in eight consecutive games and 13 times in 14 games. The eight-game run is tied for the longest such streak in school history. Most recently, the Blue Jays scored 35+ in eight straight from 2019-21 (2020 season canceled).

### Record-Breaking

« Sophomore **EJ Talarico** etched his name into the Johns Hopkins record book in last week's win at Ursinus as his 96-yard kickoff return for a touchdown is the longest in school history.

« Talarico's return was one yard longer than the previous record of 95 yards; there have been four, 95-yard kickoff returns in school history with the most recent coming from **Harrison Wellmann** at Dickinson in 2019.

« Through two games, Talarico is averaging 34.0 yards on seven kickoff returns (7-238-1).

### Wolf Into Top 5, Closing on Top 20

« Senior running back **Danny Wolf** rushed for 140 yards and one touchdown last week at Ursinus and has 208 yards and two scores through two games this season.

« His efforts thus far in 2022 push his career totals 1,312 rushing yards and 26 touchdowns on just 231 career carries.

« Wolf is now tied with **Brandon Cherry** for fourth place on JHU's career rushing touchdowns list and ranks 22nd in career rushing yards. He needs just 68 yards to move into the top 20 in school history in career rushing yards.

### Series History

« Johns Hopkins and Juniata are meeting for the 16th time in a series that dates to a 7-0 Juniata win on October 5, 1929 at Homewood Field.

« The Blue Jays have won the last 14 meetings - all of which have come since the Eagles joined the Centennial in 2007 - to grab a 14-1 lead in the series.

« Since winning 12-0 in 2008, Johns Hopkins has outscored the Eagles 641-113 in the last 12 meetings, including a 77-0 win early in the 2021 season in the last meeting between the two teams.

### Stevens Tops 4,000, Reaches 40

« With 480 passing yards through two games, **Ryan Stevens** became just the ninth quarterback in school history to top 4,000 career passing yards. He now has 4,401, all but 80 of which have come since the start of the 2021 season.

« In addition, with two TD passes at Ursinus last week, Stevens became just the sixth JHU quarterback with 40 or more career touchdown passes; he now has 40 and needs five to move into the top five in school history.

### Closing on 200

« **Nick Seidel**, Johns Hopkins' career active leader in tackles, has been credited with six tackles through two games and is closing quickly on 200 for his career. Entering this week's game against Juniata, Seidel has 187 career tackles to his credit. He also counts 15 pass breakups and seven interceptions, including one last week at Ursinus, on his resume.

### I'm Honored

« Johns Hopkins returns two players who earned All-America honors in 2021.

« Junior **Luke Schuermann** (DL) was a First Team All-American by both AP and D3football.com, while **JR Woods** (OL) was a First Team AP All-American and a Second Team D3football.com All-American.

### More Honors

« Of the 16 Johns Hopkins players who earned All-Centennial Conference honors in 2021, 10 return in 2022.

« Returning First Team All-Centennial selections include **Luke Schuermann** (DL), **Danny Wolf** (RB) and **JR Woods** (OL).

« Back in 2022 after earning Second Team All-Centennial honors a year ago are **Garrett Brophy** (OL), **Duncan Van Kouteren** (LB), **Quinn Revere** (WR), **Nick Seidel** (DB) and **Ryan Stevens** (QB).

« Rounding out JHU's returning All-CC performers are **Chris Bedell** (DL) and **Emmett Turner** (TE), who earned honorable mention status in 2021.

### It's All Academic - Part I

« Johns Hopkins set a national record with eight CoSIDA Academic All-Americans in 2021. The eight are the most AAAs produced by one team, in any sport, in any division, in any year ... ever.

« Among the eight AAAs a year ago, six are back for the 2022 season and they include **Ross Andersson** (DB / 1st Team), **Chris Bedell** (DL / 2nd Team), **Alan Gorny** (OL / 1st Team), **Luke Schuermann** (DL / 1st Team), **Emmett Turner** (TE / 2nd Team) and **JR Woods** (OL / 1st Team).

« The eight AAA selections for the football team were part of a haul of 25 CoSIDA Academic All-Americans Johns Hopkins produced across all of its athletic programs in 2021-22 ... the 25 are a school record for one year and give Johns Hopkins 43 in the last two years.

### Close Calls

« Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of 13 games. Those 13 losses have come by a total of 81 points with setbacks by five, three, five, seven, four, three, two, eight, one, three, 15 (twice) and 10 points. Translation, 11 of Johns Hopkins' 13 losses since the start of the 2013 season have come by a touchdown or less.

### On a Roll

« Johns Hopkins is 99-7 in its last 106 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season.

« The Blue Jays are 109-16 in their last 125 games overall since late in the 2010 season.

« Dating back farther, Johns Hopkins is 175-44 (.799) since the start of the 2002 season, 181-47 (.794) since the start of the 2001 season and 186-52 (.782) since the start of the 2000 season.

### At Home at Homewood

« Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 53-7 (.883) at Homewood Field.

« Johns Hopkins had won 12 consecutive games at Homewood Field before the loss on September 14, 2019 against Susquehanna. This is tied for the longest home winning streak in school history. JHU previously won 12 straight games at home from 2014-15.
