A Look Back

- « This is the 137th season of Johns Hopkins football. JHU first fielded a team in 1882.
- « Johns Hopkins enters this week's game with an all-time record of 576-489-58 (.539).
- $^{\circ}$ Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 113-19 (.856) overall and 92-9 (.911) in the Centennial Conference.
- $^{\prime\prime}$ Overall, JHU owns 15 Centennial Conference titles (all won since 2002) and has qualified for the NCAA Playoffs 11 times (all since 2005).

Oh Captain, My Captain

- $^{\circ}$ Six players were selected to serve as captains of the 2022 Johns Hopkins football team in a vote of the team late in preseason camp.
- « Two players graduate students **Ross Andersson** (DB) and **Emmett Turner** (TE) are in their second season as captains, while they are joined this season by fellow graduate students **Chris Bedell** (DL) and **Nick Seidel** (DB) and seniors **Matt Dubois** (LB) and **JR Woods** (OL).
- « Dating back to 1947, Andersson and Turner are just the 15th and 16th players to serve as a captain more than one season.
- « The six captains this season are the most in program history.

- « Johns Hopkins is ranked ninth in this week's AFCA Division III Coaches Poll and ninth in the D3football.com Poll. This week's AFCA Poll is the first of the 2022 season.
- $^{\rm w}$ Johns Hopkins was ranked 13th in the final AFCA Poll of the 2021 season and 14th in the final D3football.com Poll.

- $^{\mbox{\tiny (4)}}$ Dating back to 2010, Johns Hopkins is 44-4 in the month of September.

Things to Know - Moravian

- « Moravian comes to Homewood Field looking to bounce back from a 37-3 loss at Susquehanna last Saturday. The Greyhounds are 1-2 overall and 1-1 in the Centennial - none of their first three games have been decided by less than 15 points.
- « The Greyhounds will bring one of the youngest teams in the nation to Homewood as 34 of their 84 players are freshmen and 24 others are sophomores. There are just eight seniors and three fifth-year players on the team.
- « This week's game at Johns Hopkins is the third road game already for the Greyhounds, who will play five of their first seven away from Rocco Calvo Field.
- « Moravian ranks second in the CC in time of possession (32:48) and the 'Hounds held the ball for more than 38 minutes in their win against Gettysburg.
- « The Greyhounds have been outscored 51-16 in the second half of their three games and have allowed 14 sacks thus far.
- « Moravian is one of three teams competing as an associate member in the Centennial Conference (Susquehanna, Juniata) that will depart after the 2022 season. Each of those three teams competes in all other sports in the Landmark Conference, which will sponsor football for the first time in 2023.

Greyhounds to Watch

Brad Bryan (Jr • WR)

«One of the top big-play receivers in the Centennial. Has 10 catches for 223 yards and two touchdowns. His 22.3 yards per reception is the best in the CC. In first season as a wide receiver after playing quarterback in 2021.

Jared Jenkins (So. • QB)

«Jenkins is in his first season as the starting quarterback and has thrown for 614 yards and five TDs while also rushing for a score. He earned Centennial Offensive Player of the Week honors after throwing for 321 yards and four TDs in a win against Gettysburg.

Nick Levinski (Jr. • LB)

« Ranks second in the Centennial in tackles (28) and tackles per game (9.3). Has already surpassed his tackle total from last season, when he had 26 in five games.

- « Since 1982, Johns Hopkins is 40-17-1 (.698) on Friday nights, including 36-13-1 (.730) at Homewood Field.
- « Johns Hopkins has won 12 straight home games on Friday night dating back to 2008. The last home loss on a Friday night for the Blue Jays was a 41-10 setback to Gettysburg in 2007.
- « This will be just the second trip to Homewood Field on Friday night for Moravian. Johns Hopkins topped the Greyhounds, 41-0, in the teams' only other meeting under the FNL in 2019.

Before The Bye

- « Including last week's win against Juniata and dating back to 2011, the Blue Jays are 48-3 in games played before their bye week.
- « The Centennial Conference went to the leaguewide bye in the middle of the season in 2011.
- « Johns Hopkins has made it to its bye week unbeaten seven times since 2011 (2011-16, 2021) and suffered a single loss before the bye each year from 2017-19.

35+ in Nine Straight

- With the 70-point showing in last week's win against Juniata, Johns Hopkins has now scored at least 35 points in a school-record nine consecutive games dating back to last season.
- « The Blue Jays first scored 35+ in eight straight from 2015-16 and bridged the 2019-21 seasons with an eight-game run as well.
- « Dating back to late in the 2019 season, the Blue Jays have reached the 35-point mark in 17 of their last 18 games.

Series History

- « This week's game will be the 23rd in a series that dates to a 40-20 Moravian victory on November 1, 1975.
- $^{\mbox{\tiny d}}$ The Blue Jays lead the all-time series 15-7 and have won 12 straight against Moravian.
- « JHU is 12-2 against MC since the Greyhounds joined the CC in 2007. Moravian won the first two games between the teams as CC foes (2007, 2008) before JHU jump-started its current 12-game run with a 27-0 victory in 2009.
- « Johns Hopkins has held Moravian to seven points or less in seven of the last 12 meetings.

70+

- $^{\rm w}$ Johns Hopkins topped the 70-point mark for just the fifth time in school history with last week's 70-0 win against Juniata.
- « The JHU school record for points in a game is 87 (Loyola/1924), while Hopkins has also hit the 70 mark against Gettysburg (83/2011), Juniata (77/2021) and Swarthmore (73/1997).

One Record Broken, One Record Tied

- « Johns Hopkins set a school record with a 63-point showing in the first half of last week's game against Juniata. The previous record of 49 was set in the first half at McDaniel in 2017.
- « JHU also tied the school record for most points scored in a quarter with a 35-point effort in the first quarter last week. The Blue Jays scored 35 points in the first quarter at McDaniel in 2017.

JHU 3rd, Talarico 8th in Kickoff Returns

- « Through three games, Johns Hopkins ranks third in the nation in kickoff return average as a team as the Blue Jays have returned eight kickoffs for 288 yards, an average of 37.25 yards per return.
- « In addition, sophomore **EJ Talarico** currently ranks eighth in the nation in kickoff returns by an individual as he is averaging 34.0 yards on seven kickoff returns (7-238-1).

Revere Tied for 3rd in Receiving TDs

- « Graduate student **Quinn Revere** continued his torrid streak of finding the end zone last week against Juniata as he had four receptions for 40 yards with two of his four catches going for touchdowns.
- « Through three games, Revere has 16 receptions for 142 yards and six touchdowns. He is currently tied for third in the nation in receiving TDs with his six thus far.
- « Dating back to last season, Revere has two TD catches in each of JHU's last four games.

It's Been a While

- « The Blue Jays held the Eagles to -14 rushing yards and just 123 yards of total offense. The last time Hopkins held a team to negative rushing yards was on November 7, 2009, when the Blue Jays held F&M to -20 in a 51-13 victory.

Wolf Into Top 5, Closing on Top 20

- « Senior running back **Danny Wolf** rushed for 140 yards and one touchdown at Ursinus and has 208 yards and two scores this season.
- « His efforts thus far in 2022 push his career totals 1,312 rushing yards and 26 touchdowns on just 231 career carries.
- « Wolf is now tied with **Brandon Cherry** for fourth place on JHU's career rushing touchdowns list and ranks 22nd in career rushing yards. He needs just 68 yards to move into the top 20 in school history in career rushing yards.

Stevens Tops 4,000, Reaches 40

- « With 623 passing yards through three games, **Ryan Stevens** became just the ninth quarterback in school history to top 4,000 career passing yards. He now has 4,544, all but 80 of which have come since the start of the 2021 season.

Schuermann Breaks Out

- « Reigning Centennial Conference Defensive Player of the Year **Luke Schuermann** played just the first half last week against Juniata, but made his mark in limited time.
- « Schuermann posted six tackles, including 3.5 for losses and one sack, in the win against the Eagles.
- $^{\rm w}$ Through three games, Schuermann has 13 tackles, including 6.5 for losses and 3.5 sacks. His 6.5 TFLs are tied for 10th in the nation.

Closing on 200

« **Nick Seidel**, Johns Hopkins' career active leader in tackles, has been credited with six tackles through three games and is closing quickly on 200 for his career. Entering this week's game against Juniata, Seidel has 187 career tackles to his credit. He also counts 16 pass breakups and seven interceptions, including one at Ursinus this season, on his resume.

It's All Academic

- « Johns Hopkins set a national record with eight CoSIDA Academic All-Americans in 2021. The eight are the most AAAs produced by one team, in any sport, in any division, in any year ... ever.
- « Among the eight AAAs a year ago, six are back for the 2022 season and they include **Ross Andersson** (DB / 1st Team), **Chris Bedell** (DL / 2nd Team), **Alan Gorny** (OL / 1st Team), **Luke Schuermann** (DL / 1st Team), **Emmett Turner** (TE / 2nd Team) and **JR Woods** (OL / 1st Team).
- « The eight AAA selections for the football team were part of a haul of 25 CoSIDA Academic All-Americans Johns Hopkins produced across all of its athletic programs in 2021-22 ... the 25 are a school record for one year and give Johns Hopkins 43 in the last two years.

Close Calls

« Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of 13 games. Those 13 losses have come by a total of 81 points with setbacks by five, three, five, seven, four, three, two, eight, one, three, 15 (twice) and 10 points. Translation, 11 of Johns Hopkins' 13 losses since the start of the 2013 season have come by a touchdown or less.
