The Game

« Johns Hopkins (4-0, 3-0 CC) hits the road for the third time this season and closes out the front half of the 2022 schedule as the Blue Jays head to Franklin & Marshall (2-2, 1-2 CC).

A Look Back

« Johns Hopkins moved to 4-0 overall and 3-0 in the Centennial with a 54-0 victory over Moravian at Homewood Field last Friday night.
« F&M saw its overall record dip to 2-2 with a 22-7 loss to Ursinus at home last Saturday.

The Facts

« This is the 137th season of Johns Hopkins football. JHU first fielded a team in 1882.
« Johns Hopkins enters this week's game with an all-time record of 577-489-58 (.539).
« Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 114-19 (.857) overall and 93-9 (.912) in the Centennial Conference.
« Overall, JHU owns 15 Centennial Conference titles (all won since 2002) and has qualified for the NCAA Playoffs 11 times (all since 2005).

Oh Captain, My Captain

« Six players were selected to serve as captains of the 2022 Johns Hopkins football team in a vote of the team late in preseason camp.
« Two players - graduate students **Ross Andersson** (DB) and **Emmett Turner** (TE) - are in their second season as captains, while they are joined this season by fellow graduate students **Chris Bedell** (DL) and **Nick Seidel** (DB) and seniors **Matt Dubois** (LB) and **JR Woods** (OL).
« Dating back to 1947, Andersson and Turner are just the 15th and 16th players to serve as a captain more than one season.
« The six captains this season are the most in program history.

Poll Position

« Johns Hopkins is ranked seventh in this week's AFCA Division III Coaches Poll and eighth in the D3football.com Poll. The Blue Jays were ranked ninth in both polls last week before inching up slightly this week.

Sweet September

« The calendar flips from September to October with this week's game against F&M, but it's worth taking a quick look back at September.
« Dating back to 2010, and including the four wins this season, Johns Hopkins is 45-4 in the month of September.
« During the September run dating back to 2010, the Blue Jays are 24-3 on the road and 21-1 at Homewood Field.

Things to Know - F&M

« Franklin & Marshall welcomes Johns Hopkins to Shadek Stadium looking to bounce back from a 22-7 loss to Ursinus last Saturday at home.

« In a strange scheduling twist, this is Johns Hopkins' first visit to Lancaster since 2018.

« F&M is led by first-year coach Tom Blumenauer, who spent the previous six seasons as the offensive coordinator at Williams College. For two of those seasons - 2017 & 2018 - the tight ends/wide receivers coach at Williams was current Blue Jay defensive coordinator **Dan Wodicka**.

« Johns Hopkins will face one of the top defensive units in the nation thus far as F&M is allowing just 17.8 points and 265.8 yards per game. The Diplomats have also forced a remarkable 14 turnovers, including 13 interceptions through four games. The 13 interceptions are the most of any team in any division of the NCAA.

« The Diplomats are averaging 26.0 points per game and have used a balanced attack (145.5 rushing / 137.0 passing) in the early season. Although they rank eight in the CC in total offense, they are fifth in scoring offense and lead the league in red zone offense (93%).

Diplomats to Watch

Justin Gerhart (Jr • DB)

« Counts 15 tackles, five interceptions and two pass breakups to his credit through four games. He tied the F&M single-game record with three interceptions in a tight 39-36 loss to nationally-ranked Susquehanna and he is currently tied for the national lead with his five INTs.

Jacob Hille (So. • LB)

« Has emerged as one of the top young defensive players in the Centennial Conference this season. Leads the team in tackles (34) and has two TFLs, one sack, one forced fumble and one fumble recovery. He ranks third in the Centennial Conference in tackles and fifth in tackles per game (8.5).

Aaron Rascoe (Jr. • RB)

« Headliner on offense as he has rushed for 312 yards and five touchdowns in four games. Rascoe is tied for the Centennial lead with his five rushing touchdowns and ranks fourth in rushing yards per game (78.0).

Blue Jay Bullet Points

« **Spencer Ugгла** has 268 rushing yards in four games this season - he had 193 in 12 games prior to this season.

« **Artie Collins** leads the team in receptions (24) and receiving yards (334) ... he had 19 receptions for 241 yards entering the season.

« JHU has outscored the opposition 77-7 in the first quarter and 149-7 in the first half this season.

« The opposition has advanced into the red zone against the Johns Hopkins defense just six times in four games.

Oktoberfest

« Johns Hopkins flips the calendar to October for its game against F&M this week - and the month has been good to the Blue Jays of late.

« The Blue Jays have won 34 of their last 37 games in the month of October dating back 2010.

« Ironically, the Blue Jays had been just 10-8 in their previous 18 games in the month of October before jump-starting the current 37-game run with a 49-24 win at Susquehanna (10-23-2010).

Before The Bye

« Including last week's win against Moravian and dating back to 2011, the Blue Jays are 49-3 in games played before their bye week.

« The Centennial Conference went to the league-wide bye in the middle of the season in 2011.

« Johns Hopkins has made it to its bye week unbeaten seven times since 2011 (2011-16, 2021) and suffered a single loss before the bye each year from 2017-19.

35+ in 10 Straight

« With the 54-point showing in last week's win against Moravian, Johns Hopkins has now scored at least 35 points in a school-record 10 consecutive games dating back to last season.

« The previous record for most consecutive 35-point games was eight. The Blue Jays first scored 35+ in eight straight from 2015-16 and bridged the 2019-21 seasons with an eight-game run as well.

« Dating back to late in the 2019 season, the Blue Jays have reached the 35-point mark in 18 of their last 19 games.

70+

« Johns Hopkins topped the 70-point mark for just the fifth time in school history with the recent 70-0 win against Juniata.

« The JHU school record for points in a game is 87 (Loyola/1924), while Hopkins has also hit the 70 mark against Gettysburg (83/2011), Juniata (77/2021) and Swarthmore (73/1997).

One Record Broken, One Record Tied

« Johns Hopkins set a school record with a 63-point showing in the first half of its recent game against Juniata. The previous record of 49 was set in the first half at McDaniel in 2017.

« JHU also tied the school record for most points scored in a quarter with a 35-point effort in the first quarter against Juniata. The Blue Jays scored 35 points in the first quarter at McDaniel in 2017.

JHU 3rd, Talarico 7th in Kickoff Returns

« Through four games, Johns Hopkins ranks third in the nation in kickoff return average as a team as the Blue Jays have returned nine kickoffs for 318 yards, an average of 35.33 yards per return.

« In addition, sophomore **EJ Talarico** currently ranks seventh in the nation in kickoff returns by an individual as he is averaging 34.0 yards on seven kickoff returns (7-238-1).

Revere Tied for 6th in Receiving TDs

« Despite not scoring a touchdown last week against Moravian, graduate student **Quinn Revere** continues to rank among the national leaders in receiving touchdowns.

« On the year, Revere has 22 receptions for 216 yards and six touchdowns. He is currently tied for sixth in the nation in receiving TDs with his six thus far.

« Dating back to last season, Revere had two TD catches in four consecutive games before not having one against Moravian.

Series History

« Johns Hopkins and Franklin & Marshall are meeting for the 73rd time in a series that dates to a 10-7 F&M win on October 19, 1912.

« F&M leads the all-time series 36-34-2, although it has been Johns Hopkins with the upper hand lately as the Blue Jays have won 21 of the last 24.

« There have been long runs of dominance in the series. F&M went 7-0-1 against JHU from 1950-57, only to have the Blue Jays go 8-4-1 in the next 13 meetings.

« A 14-7 win against F&M in 1990 was the first for JHU against the Diplomats since 1970.

Wolf Into Top 5, Closing on Top 20

« Senior running back **Danny Wolf** rushed for 140 yards and one touchdown at Ursinus and has 208 yards and two scores this season.

« His efforts thus far in 2022 push his career totals 1,312 rushing yards and 26 touchdowns on just 231 career carries.

« Wolf is now tied with **Brandon Cherry** for fourth place on JHU's career rushing touchdowns list and ranks 22nd in career rushing yards. He needs just 68 yards to move into the top 20 in school history in career rushing yards.

Stevens Closing on 5,000, Reaches 50

« With 906 passing yards and 13 touchdown passes through four games, **Ryan Stevens** is closing quickly on 5,000 career passing yards and 50 career touchdown passes.

« In 19 career games played, he has 4,827 passing yards and 46 touchdown passes to his credit. He ranks eighth in school history in career passing yards and fifth in

touchdown passes.

It's Been a While

« The Johns Hopkins defense posted its second consecutive shutout last week with the 54-0 victory over Moravian. This came one week after topping Juniata 70-0 to give the Blue Jays back-to-back shutouts for the first time since 2008.

« JHU held Juniata to just 123 yards of total offense and limited Moravian to just 106. This marks the first time the Blue Jays have held consecutive opponents under 200 yards of total offense since a three-game run early in the 2012 season.

« In the recent win against Juniata, the Blue Jays held the Eagles to -14 rushing yards. The last time Hopkins held a team to negative rushing yards was on November 7, 2009, when the Blue Jays held F&M to -20 in a 51-13 victory.

Schuermann Breaks Out

« Reigning Centennial Conference Defensive Player of the Year **Luke Schuermann** played just the first half against Juniata and not much longer against Moravian, but made his mark in limited time.

« Schuermann posted six tackles, including 3.5 for losses and one sack, in the win against the Eagles and added four tackles against Moravian.

« Through four games, Schuermann has 17 tackles, including 6.5 for losses and 3.5 sacks.

Closing on 200

« **Nick Seidel**, Johns Hopkins' career active leader in tackles, has been credited with six tackles through three games and is closing quickly on 200 for his career. Entering this week's game against F&M, Seidel has 191 career tackles to his credit. He also counts 18 pass breakups and eight interceptions, including one last week against Moravian, on his resume.

It's All Academic

« Johns Hopkins set a national record with eight CoSIDA Academic All-Americans in 2021. The eight are the most AAAs produced by one team, in any sport, in any division, in any year ... ever.

« Among the eight AAAs a year ago, six are back for the 2022 season and they include **Ross Andersson** (DB / 1st Team), **Chris Bedell** (DL / 2nd Team), **Alan Gorny** (OL / 1st Team), **Luke Schuermann** (DL / 1st Team), **Emmett Turner** (TE / 2nd Team) and **JR Woods** (OL / 1st Team).

« The eight AAA selections for the football team were part of a haul of 25 CoSIDA Academic All-Americans Johns Hopkins produced across all of its athletic programs in 2021-22 ... the 25 are a school record for one year and give Johns Hopkins 43 in the last two years.

Close Calls

« Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of 13 games. Those 13 losses have come by a total of 81 points with setbacks by five, three, five, seven, four, three, two, eight, one, three, 15 (twice) and 10 points. Translation, 11 of Johns Hopkins' 13 losses since the start of the 2013 season have come by a touchdown or less.

On a Roll

« Johns Hopkins is 101-7 in its last 108 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season.

« The Blue Jays are 111-16 in their last 127 games overall since late in the 2010 season.

« Dating back farther, Johns Hopkins is 177-44 (.801) since the start of the 2002 season, 183-47 (.796) since the start of the 2001 season and 188-52 (.783) since the start of the 2000 season.

At Home at Homewood

« Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 55-7 (.887) at Homewood Field.

« Johns Hopkins had won 12 consecutive games at Homewood Field before the loss on September 14, 2019 against Susquehanna. This is tied for the longest home winning streak in school history. JHU previously won 12 straight games at home from 2014-15.
