The Game

« Johns Hopkins (4-1, 1-0 Centennial) opens the back half of its 2024 schedule as the Blue Jays welcome Franklin & Marshall (3-2, 1-1 CC) to Homewood Field.

A Look Back

« Johns Hopkins improved to 4-1 overall as the Blue Jays grabbed a win in its CC opener with a 51-7 victory at Gettysburg last Friday night.
« The Diplomats went on the road last Saturday and dropped a heart-breaking 23-17 decision at league-leading Ursinus.

Victory Number 600

« Johns Hopkins grabbed the 600th victory in program history with the 51-7 win at Gettysburg last Friday.
« With the win, Johns Hopkins improved its all-time record to 600-491-57 (.547).

The Facts

« This is the 139th season of Johns Hopkins football. JHU first fielded a team in 1882.
« Johns Hopkins enters this week's game with an all-time record of 600-491-57 (.547).
« Overall, JHU owns 16 Centennial Conference titles (all won since 2002) and has qualified for the NCAA Playoffs 12 times (all since 2005).

Oh Captain, My Captain

« In a vote of the team, four players were selected to serve as captains of the 2024 Johns Hopkins football team.
« Graduate student **Will Leger** (TE) along with seniors **Oliver Craddock** (LB), **Bay Harvey** (QB) and **Cole Peters** (LB) will lead the team as co-captains in 2024. Harvey is in his second year as a co-captain, while Craddock, Leger and Peters are first-time captains for the Blue Jays.

Poll Position

« Johns Hopkins checks in at #20 in this week's AFCA Poll and is 21st in the D3football.com Poll.
« Since the AFCA debuted its poll in 1999, this week's #20 ranking marks the 137th time in 252 polls that the Blue Jays have appeared in the top 25.
« The Blue Jays are in the D3football.com Top-25 for the 159th time in 266 polls since D3football launched its poll in 2003.

Oktoberfest

« Johns Hopkins flipped the calendar to October with the recent game against Rowan and the month has been good to the Blue Jays of late.
« Including last week's win against the Bullets, the Blue Jays have won 43 of their last 46 games in the month of October dating back to 2010.

Things to Know - F&M

« Franklin & Marshall comes to Homewood Field looking to bounce back from a tight 23-17 loss at Ursinus last Saturday. The loss snapped a two-game F&M winning streak.

« The 3-2 Diplomats are two scores away from being 5-0 as they fell at TCNJ, 17-13, in week two. TCNJ ran out the final 8:01 to preserve the win; Ursinus held off a late scoring chance for the Dips last week.

« F&M is the only team in the Centennial in the top three in the league in total offense (3rd / 383.2) and total defense (2nd / 288.6). « After playing three of their first four games at home, today's game is the second of four away games in a six-week span to close the season for the Diplomats.

« The Diplomats have dominated the middle two quarters thus far as they hold a 69-33 scoring advantage in the second and third quarters combined, including a 30-7 margin in the third quarter.

Diplomats to Watch**Connor Hille (So. • LB)**

« Active player who has emerged as one of the top young linebackers in the CC this season. Counts 32 tackles, one sack, three forced fumbles and one pass breakup to his credit.

Jack O'Hearen (Sr. • WR)

« The top wide receiver in the Centennial Conference as he has 30 receptions for 541 yards and four TDs. Needs 10 receptions to become the 16th player in F&M history to reach 100 career receptions.

Ty Tremba (Sr. • QB)

« Front-runner for CC Offensive Player of the Year honors. Has thrown for 1,516 yards and nine TDs thus far. Closing in on 6,000 career passing yards (5,571) and 50 career TD passes (48).

« The Blue Jays had been just 10-8 in their previous 18 games in the month of October before jump-starting the current 46-game run with a 49-24 win at Susquehanna (10-23-2010).

« During their October run dating back to 2010, the Jays have lost just once at home.

For Openers

« Johns Hopkins topped Gettysburg in its Centennial opener last week at the Battlefield. With the win, the Blue Jays have now won four straight and 14 of their last 16 CC openers dating back to 2008. « Dating back to the formation of the league in 1983, Johns Hopkins is now 29-12 all-time in Centennial openers.

« Seven of JHU's 12 losses in CC openers took place from 1983-1990. Translation: Johns Hopkins is now 28-5 in its last 33 league openers with last week's win.

Random, But Noteworthy

« Johns Hopkins rang up a season-high 582 yards of total offense last week at Gettysburg. This marked the 81st time in school history that JHU has topped the 500-yard mark ... the Blue Jays are 80-1 in those 81 games.

« The Blue Jays improved to 45-17-1 in games played on Friday night (dating back to 1982).

« Johns Hopkins' next four opponents (F&M, Ursinus, Muhlenberg, Dickinson) are a combined 14-6 (.700) with three of those six losses coming when they have played each other.

Defense Among Centennial's Best

« While the 51-point effort in last week's win at Gettysburg may have grabbed the headlines, the Blue Jay defense quietly turned in another stand-out showing.

« The seven points allowed mark the third time in five games the Blue Jays have allowed 13 points or less and the 219 yards allowed marked the second time JHU has held the opposition under 220 yards. « Entering this week's game, Johns Hopkins leads the Centennial in total defense (282.6), ranks second in scoring defense (17.4) and passing defense (159.4) and ranks third in rushing defense (123.2). JHU is also the only team in the league allowing the opposition to complete less than 53% of its pass attempts (.477).

More Defense

« The 144 yards JHU allowed at CNU earlier this season marked the first time JHU has held a team under 150 yards since the Jays limited Gettysburg to 139 on Oct. 22, 2022.

« The three points the Blue Jays held CNU to were the fewest the Captains have scored in a home game since 2003.

Series History

« Johns Hopkins and Franklin & Marshall are meeting for the 75th time in a series that dates to a 10-7 F&M win on October 19, 1912. « The all-time series is tied 36-36-2, although it has been Johns Hopkins with the upper hand lately as the Blue Jays have won 23 of the last 26.

« There have been long runs of dominance in the series. F&M went 7-0-1 against JHU from 1950-57, only to have the Blue Jays go 8-4-1 in the next 13 meetings.

« A 14-7 win against F&M in 1990 was the first for JHU against the Diplomats since 1970.

A Final Defense

« The Blue Jay defense has not allowed a point in the first quarter since the first game of the season at Ithaca.

« JHU allowed two touchdowns at Ithaca in the first 7:20 of the game, but the Jays held the Bombers scoreless for the final 7:40 and didn't allow a point in the first quarter against Christopher Newport, Salisbury, Rowan or Gettysburg.

Paxton's Record-Tying Night

« Johns Hopkins freshman kicker **Brad Paxton** entered the Blue Jay record book in the win at Gettysburg. For his efforts, he was honored as the Centennial Conference Special Teams Player of the Week.

« Paxton hit all six of his extra points and was 3-for-3 on field goals as he was good from 27, 20 and 30 yards in the victory against the Bullets. His 15 points tied the Johns Hopkins single-game record for points by a kicker.

« **Alex Lachman** originally set the record with 15 points in a game against Moravian in 2007 and then matched his own record in 2009 against Franklin & Marshall. Prior to Paxton's showing, those were the only two instances in school history that a kicker had 15 points in a game.

Starting QB Streak at 13

« Senior **James Rinello** got his first career start when the Blue Jays hosted Rowan on October 4. With the 20-13 win over the Profs, he extend a remarkable streak for Johns Hopkins starting quarterbacks that dates back 18 years to the 2006 season.

« Including **Rinello's** win in that game, 13 consecutive Johns Hopkins quarterbacks have won their first career start for the Blue Jays, a streak that started with **Shane Kibbe's** 21-14 win over Randolph-Macon early in that 2006 season.

Schroeder Tops 1,000

« Junior **Geoff Schroeder** rushed for 64 yards on 12 carries in last week's win at Gettysburg and, in the process, entered the Blue Jay record book.

« Schroeder's 64-yard effort pushed his career rushing total to 1,034 yards, making him the 30th player in Johns Hopkins history to top the 1,000-yard mark.

Rich Inches Closer to 1,000

« Senior **Andrew Rich** rushed for a team-high 84 yards on nine carries last week at Gettysburg and inched closer to 1,000 for his career.

« Rich enters this week's game needing just 55 yards to become the 31st player in program history to top 1,000 career rushing yards.

Talarico Closing on Kane's Record

« Senior **EJ Talarico** had one kickoff return for 20 yards last week at Gettysburg and enters this week's game against F&M within striking distance of the school record for kickoff return yardage.

« In his career, Talarico has returned 51 kickoffs for 1,183 yards, which leaves him just 77 yards shy of overtaking **Bruce Kane** (1,259 yards / 1977-80) as JHU's career kickoff return yardage leader.

Comeback Jays

« Johns Hopkins erased a 17-0 second-quarter deficit to grab the 27-23 come-from-behind win at Ithaca in the season opener.

« The 17-point deficit is the largest Johns Hopkins has overcome to win a game since November 6, 1999, when the Jays posted a 35-33 win against F&M after trailing 27-10.

« Since 1971, last week's come-from-behind win is believed to be the sixth time the Blue Jays have come from 17 points down (or more) to win.

« The largest come-from-behind win on record for the Jays came in 1983, when Hopkins spotted Lebanon Valley a 24-0 second-quarter lead before rallying for a 35-31 victory.

Wodicka's Debut

« The game at Ithaca marked the head coaching debut for Johns Hopkins' **Dan Wodicka**.

« With the win, Wodicka became just the second Johns Hopkins head coach in the last 104 years to post a win in his debut. After **Ray Van Orman** picked up a 34-14 win over Mount St. Mary's in 1920, the next JHU head coach to win his first game was **Greg Chimera** in 2019 (17-12 at Randolph-Macon).

« A 2014 Johns Hopkins graduate, Wodicka spent the last five years (2019-23) on the Blue Jay staff including the last two years as the defensive coordinator.

« Wodicka launched his coaching career with a two-year stint as the Johns Hopkins wide receivers coach (2014-15) and made stops at Northern Michigan (2016) and Williams (2017-18) before returning to Homewood in 2019 as the special teams coordinator and defensive line coach.

« During his now 11 seasons with the program (four as a player, six as an assistant coach and this year as the head coach), Wodicka has helped Johns Hopkins to a record of 103-17 (.858), eight Centennial Conference titles and seven trips to the NCAA Playoffs.

« Wodicka graduated as Johns Hopkins' career leader in receptions with 260, which went for 3,148 yards and 16 touchdowns. He remains second in school history in receptions and is also second in receiving yards.

« Wodicka took over for **Greg Chimera**, who left Johns Hopkins after the 2023 season to become the offensive coordinator at Penn.

« Wodicka's ties to Johns Hopkins go beyond the football field. His father, George, is a 1982 Johns Hopkins graduate and was a classmate of **Jim Margraff**'s. In addition, Dan's sister, Maggie, played on the Blue Jay women's basketball team and graduate in 2020.

A Hopkins Man Shall Lead Them

« For the 45th consecutive year, a Johns Hopkins graduate is leading the Blue Jay football program.

« **Jerry Pfeifer**, a 1965 JHU graduate, guided the Blue Jays from 1980-89 before turning the program over to **Jim Margraff '82**, who would become Hopkins' career leader in victories (221) over a 29-year career from 1990-2018.

« When Margraff passed away suddenly after the Blue Jays' run to the 2018 NCAA Semifinals, **Greg Chimera '09** was appointed the head coach and served from 2019-2023 before **Dan Wodicka** took over on February 1, 2024.

At Home at Homewood

« Including the recent win against Rowan, the Blue Jays have enjoyed a dominant recent run at Homewood Field.

« Since the start of the 2014 season, the Blue Jays are 51-6 (.895) at Homewood Field; they are 67-9 (.882) at Homewood since 2010.

« JHU won a school-record 19 consecutive games at home from midway through the 2019 season until the 2023 NCAA Quarterfinal.

Grehan Named to AllState AFCA Good Works Team

Johns Hopkins senior linebacker **Thomas Grehan** is among the 22 college football players from all Divisions of the NCAA and NAIA who has been named to the 33rd Allstate AFCA Good Works Team® for outstanding contributions to their communities it was announced.

Grehan is the sixth Johns Hopkins football player named to the team as he joins **Jim Sanders** (2005), **Brian Nickel** (2006), **Tim Miller** (2009), **Alan Gorny** (2022) and **Spencer Uggla** (2023).

With Grehan's selection, Johns Hopkins is one of just six schools in the nation to have a player named to the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team® in each of the last three years. In addition to Johns Hopkins, Ashland, Bethel, Georgia, Morningside and St. John's (MN) have also been represented on the team in each of the last three years.

Team officials from across the country nominated players from their schools for the prestigious award based on their work off the field. A list of a record 178 nominees was announced in July before the final 22-player roster and a head coach were chosen by the selection panel, which includes former Good Works Team players, journalists and officials from Allstate and the AFCA. The team is represented by individuals from colleges and universities across the country for their unwavering commitment to community service and their "good works" off the field.

Road Warriors

« Johns Hopkins went a perfect 5-0 on the road in 2023 and won its ninth consecutive road game with the win at Gettysburg on October 11.

« The current nine-game road winning streak is tied for the fourth-longest road winning streak in program history.

« In their last 22 road games dating back to 2019, the Blue Jays are 19-3. All three losses came against teams ranked in the top 20 at the time of the game (#6 Muhlenberg-2019 | #4 Mount Union-2021 | #18

« Dating back to 2013, JHU is 52-9 overall on the road (48-5 in the regular season).

Close Calls

« Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of 16 games. Those 16 losses have come by a total of 114 points for an average margin of defeat of 7.1 points. The setbacks have come by one, two (twice), three (four times), four, five (twice), seven, eight, 10, 15 (twice) and 28 points in that time.

« Translation, 12 of Johns Hopkins' 16 losses since the start of the 2013 season have come by a touchdown or less.

Peters Closing on 150

« Senior **Cole Peters** posted a team-high eight tackles against Salisbury, added seven against Rowan and continues to lead the team in tackles with 42 through five games.

« Peters' sixth tackle against the Sea Gulls was also the 125th of his career. He is Johns Hopkins' career active leader in tackles with 140 as he closes in on 150 career tackles..

I'm Honored

« Johns Hopkins returns two players who earned All-America honors in 2023.

« Graduate student **Will Leger** (TE) was a Third Team All-American by D3football.com, while junior **Michael Nwosu** (OL) was a Fourth Team D3football.com All-American.

« Nwosu was the only sophomore offensive lineman in the nation to earn All-America honors from D3football.com in 2023 - the other 19 offensive lineman on the team were either juniors, seniors or graduate students.

More Honors

« Of the 16 Johns Hopkins players who earned All-Centennial Conference honors in 2023, 11 return in 2024.

« Returning First Team All-Centennial selections include **Cole Crotty** (WR), **Will Leger** (TE), **Michael Nwosu** (OL), **Cole Peters** (LB) and **EJ Talarico** (Ret. Spec.).

« Back for the 2024 season after grabbing Second Team All-Centennial honors are **Oliver Craddock** (LB), **Bay Harvey** (QB), **Matthew Konkol** (DL), **PJ Penders** (DB) and **Isaac Urquidi** (DL), while **Carson Bourdo** (DB) is back after earning Honorable Mention All-CC honors in 2023.

« In addition to earning first team honors last season, Crotty was the Centennial Conference Rookie of the Year.

It's All Academic

« One year after setting a national record with eight CoSIDA Academic All-Americans in 2021, Johns Hopkins once again led the nation as six Blue Jays earned College Sports Communicators (formerly CoSIDA) Academic All-America status in 2022. JHU's eight AAAs produced by one team, in any sport, in any division, in any year ... ever.

« Johns Hopkins followed up the 2021 and 2022 Academic All-America haul with three more selections in 2023 as **Luke Schuermann** (DL/1st Team), **JR Woods** (OL/2nd Team) and **Josh Polce** (WR/2nd Team) grabbed AAA honors.

« Since 2011, the Johns Hopkins football team has produced 42 CoSIDA/CSC Academic All-Americans. No other Division III program has produced even 30 during that time. In fact, only three other programs - Carnegie Mellon (28), MIT (23) and Rose-Hulman (20) have even produced 20 during that time.
