## HEAD COACH DAVID PATRICK



David Patrick, a veteran collegiate and international coach with 17 years of coaching experience, was named the 15th head coach of Sacramento State men's basketball on April 5, 2022.

Patrick, 46, a renowned recruiter with worldwide connections, has been a part of winning teams at every stop of his coaching career. He has recruited 11 players that have played in the NBA (including seven

draft picks - four first rounders) and has coached 28 players that have gone on to play professionally, including 19 in the NBA.

A native of Bermuda who moved to Australia at the age of 10, Patrick did not come to the United States until his senior year of high school. After playing professionally overseas, he entered the coaching ranks where he began putting together impressive recruiting classes while coaching with some of college basketball's brightest minds, including Porter Moser, Eric Musselman, Randy Bennett and Jamie Dixon. He played collegiately for Jim Boeheim.

### COACHING EXPERIENCE/WINNING

- 2021-22 : Oklahoma associate head coach - NIT Second Round. Was the team's defensive coordinator and the Sooners finished among the top 50 teams in the nation in scoring defense, allowing just 65.0 points per game.
- 2020-21: Arkansas associate head coach - NCAA Tournament Elite 8. Finished 25-7 and Arkansas made its deepest run in the NCAA Tournament since 1996. As defensive coordinator, the Razorback defense went from 12th in the SEC the year before his arrival to fifth under his guidance.
- 2018-20: UC Riverside head coach - In his second season, he led the Highlanders to the most wins (17) in the program's Div. I era, and received invitations to play in the CIT and CBI before the pandemic put a halt to those tournaments. The Highlanders went 9-22 the year before his arrival. He was a finalist for the Hugh Durham Coach of the Year award, given annually to the top mid-major men's basketball head coach. The 2019-20 team finished eighth in the nation in scoring defense, allowing just 60.6 points per game.
- 2019-pres: Australian National Team assistant coach - Helped coach the team to a bronze medal at the 2021 Olympics, Australia's first men's basketball Olympic medal. The 2019 team reached the FIBA World Cup Final Four, which included the country's first-ever win over the United States.
- 2016-18: TCU assistant head coach - In his first season, TCU won the 2017 NIT championship, and improved its win total (24) by 12 games from the previous season. It was the program's first postseason championship. The Horned Frogs won 20+ games both seasons, including the program's first NCAA Tournament appearance (2018) in 20 years and a No. 6 seed.
- 2012-16: LSU assistant head coach - LSU increased its win total each of his first three years on staff, culminating in a 2015 NCAA Tournament appearance, the program's first since 2009. The Tigers also qualified for the 2014 NIT.
- 2010-12: Houston Rockets player personnel scout - Scouted for NBA and NCAA prospects. Participated on the Rockets trade and draft committees.
- 2006-10: Saint Mary's associate head coach - Saint Mary's improved each season during his four years, culminating in a 2010 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 appearance, West Coast Conference Tournament championship and then school-record 28 wins. The program also reached the 2008 NCAA Tournament, and 2009 NIT quarterfinals.
- 2005-06: Nicholls State assistant coach - In his lone season, the program went 19-10, a nine-win improvement from the previous season before Patrick arrived.

## GAME PREVIEW

- Sacramento State (1-1) will play the third and final leg of its season-opening three game road trip on Monday at Denver. Tip at Hamilton Gymnasium is 6 p.m. PST.
- The Hornets will be playing their second game in three days. They are coming off a 65-55 road win at UC San Diego, which was first year head coach David Patrick's first Hornet victory since taking over the reins on April 5.
- In that win, the Hornets were 14-of-25 from the 3-point line, and all but five of their field goal makes came from distance.
- Monday's game will mark the first of a rare non-conference home and home against Denver, as the Hornets will host the Pioneers on Dec. 7 at the Nest.
- The two teams have played each other just three times with the Hornets holding a 2-1 lead in the series. The last meeting came on a neutral floor in Cheney, Wash., as part of the Eastern Classic on Nov. 27, 2016. The Pioneers won, 72-61, behind 17 apiece from Jake Pemberton and Daniel Amigo. Marcus Graves led the Hornets with 16 points.
- Monday will mark just the second time the Hornets have played in Denver, and first since a 74-53 Sacramento State win in 2006 when Haron Hargrave buried eight 3-pointers.
- The UCLA game marked the Hornet head coaching debut of David Patrick, who became Sacramento State's 15th head coach in program history (1948-pres.).
- Patrick, who is 46, is a veteran collegiate and international coach with 17 years of coaching experience. A native of Bermuda who moved to Australia at the age of 10, Patrick came to the United States prior to his senior year of high school. He is a renowned recruiter with worldwide connections and has won at every stop of his coaching career.
- Last year's Hornet squad, under the guidance of interim head coach Brandon Laird, posted an 11-18 overall record and 6-14 mark in the Big Sky Conference. The Hornets have not finished higher than seventh place in the Big Sky each of the last seven seasons.
- Sacramento State was selected sixth in both the Big Sky media and coaches polls.
- The Hornets return just six players, including the team's second (Zach Chappell 11.6 ppg in '21-22) and fourth (Cameron Wilbon 9.1 ppg in '21-22) leading scorers.
- Denver will be playing the finale of its season-opening three-game homestand which included a 68-63 win over Big Sky foe Idaho, and 90-68 over non-Div. I Colorado College. The Pioneers are shooting .515 from the field, including 11-for-13 from Lukas Kisunas.
- Last season, the Pioneers finished 11-21 overall and 7-11 in the Summit League. They return eight players from a year ago (three starters) and welcome eight newcomers.

## MULTIMEDIA OPTIONS

- Monday's game will be televised on Altitude 2 (channel 681 on DirecTV), and will be streamed on Pioneer All-Access, which is a subscription based service.
- There will be no radio for Monday's game.
- For the second straight season, all Hornet home games, and games played at a Big Sky Conference venue, will be streamed on ESPN+.
- In addition, every home game this year will be broadcast live on ESPN 1320 AM with 26th-year play-by-play man Steve McElroy calling the action.
- Links for all multimedia options, including live stats for every game, can be found next to each game on the men's basketball schedule at hornetsports.com.

## A LOOK AT THE UC SAN DIEGO GAME

- Sacramento State buried 14 3-pointers on the way to a 65-55 road win at UC San Diego on Saturday evening at LionTree Arena.
- All but five of the Hornets' field goal makes were from beyond the 3-point line as the team went 14-for-25 (56%) from distance. That included eight triples in the first half, and six more after halftime.
- Sacramento State, which led for nearly 34 minutes of game clock, held a five point half-time lead and scored the first five points of the second half to go up, 34-24, at the 17:40 mark. The Tritons got would get no closer than five points the rest of the way. The Hornets led by double digits the final seven minutes.
- Five different Hornets striped multiple 3-balls, including Zach Chappell who scored a game-high 19 points on 6-for-9 shooting, and 5-of-6 from distance.
- Sacramento State had 17 assists (and just 11 turnovers) on its 19 made buckets. The team shot 40% overall (19-47) from the field and 68% (13-19) from the free throw line. Each of the Hornets' final seven points were from the free throw line.

## THE NEW LEADER

- The David Patrick era began against UCLA as the 46-year old took over the reigns of the program when he was named the 15th coach in program history on April 5.
- Patrick, who was Oklahoma's associate head coach last season, has recruited 11 players that have played in the NBA, including seven draft picks (four 1st rounders). He has coached 28 players that have gone on to play professionally, including 19 in the NBA.
- Throughout his career, Patrick has put together impressive recruiting classes while coaching with some of college basketball's brightest minds, including Porter Moser, Eric Musselman, Randy Bennett and Jamie Dixon. He also played collegiately for Jim Boeheim.
- This will be his second stint as a head coach as Patrick was at UC Riverside from 2018-20. In his second year, he led the Highlanders to their most wins (17) in the team's Div. I era.
- Patrick has been an associate head coach at Oklahoma (2021-22) and Arkansas (2020-21), an assistant head coach at TCU (2016-18) and LSU (2012-16), and an assistant coach at Saint Mary's (2006-10) and Nicholls State (2005-06).
- He has also been with the Australian National Team as an assistant coach from 2019 to the present, and worked for the Houston Rockets as a personnel scout from 2010-12.
- Patrick played professionally four years overseas. Collegiately, he played in 28 games as a freshman for Jim Boeheim where he helped the 1995-96 Syracuse squad to win the NCAA Tournament national championship game. He finished his collegiate career by playing three seasons at Louisiana (then called Southwestern Louisiana) from 1997-00.

## THE REST OF THE STAFF HAS A NEW LOOK AS WELL

- Every member of the Sacramento State coaching staff is brand new. Here is a look:
- **Associate head coach Michael Czepil** - The Melbourne, Australia native coached four years at UC Riverside (2018-22), including the first two with Patrick. Czepil served the last two seasons as the Highlanders associate head coach.
- **Assistant coach Loren Leath** - A member of the Sacramento State Men's Basketball Hall of Fame, Leath shined for the Hornets as a player from 2005-09. Leath spent the past 10 years as either a coach or Vice President of the AAU powerhouse Oakland Soldiers.
- **Assistant coach Hays Myers** - Was Patrick's first hire. Worked with Patrick for a total of five seasons at Arkansas (2020-21) and LSU (2012-16). Has 11 years of coaching experience, including the last six with Eric Musselman at both Arkansas and Nevada.
- **Director of Operations Tyson Batiste** - Spent the 2021-22 season as a grad assistant at Texas Tech, where the Red Raiders advanced to the Sweet 16. Was a grad assistant at Arkansas in 2020-21 when he first crossed paths with Patrick.
- **Director of Scouting & Analytics Elijah Roth** - Spent one year (2021-22) as a video scout and analytics consultant for Sports Info Solutions. Was a graduate assistant on the same staff as Patrick and Myers at Arkansas (2020-21) when the team made the Elite Eight.

## 7 NEW PLAYERS, INCLUDING 6 DIV. I TRANSFERS

- Sacramento State's roster is comprised of 13 players, including seven new to the Hornets. Of those seven newcomers, six are transfers from Div. I programs.
- That includes guards Gianni Hunt (Oregon State), Quadry Adams (St. Bonaventure) and Austin Patterson (Wofford), forwards Hunter Marks (Hartford) and Akol Mawein (Oklahoma), and center Callum McRae (UC Riverside).
- The other newcomer is Kiir Kiir Chol Deng, who will be a true freshman after playing in the NBA Global Academy in Australia. Deng is the only freshman on the roster.

## 6 PLAYERS RETURN FROM LAST SEASON

- Only six players return from last season's team which finished 11-18 overall and 6-14 in Big Sky Conference play.
- That includes guards Zach Chappell, Chris Holley, Rick Barros III, Xavier Ford, Teiano Hardee and Cameron Wilbon.
- Chappell (11.6 ppg in '21-22) and Wilbon (9.1 ppg in '21-22) were the team's second and fourth leading scorers a year ago, respectively. Barros (.444) and Hardee (.440) were the team's top 3-point shooters (by percentage) last season.
- Of the six players, three are from Sacramento, including Chappell, Barros and Holley.
- Chappell (27 starts) and Wilbon (26 starts) were both starters last season, and were two of just four Sacramento State players to average at least six points per contest.

### ROSTER HAS AN INTERNATIONAL LOOK

- The Hornets' roster has an international look, as four players and two coaches were raised on foreign soil.
- Four of those individuals are from Australia in Hunter Marks, Akol Mawein, head coach David Patrick and associate head coach Michael Czepil.
- Callum McRae hails from New Zealand, and Kiir Kiir Chol Deng is from South Sudan.
- Sacramento State is one of just 13 men's basketball teams in the country to have a roster that features players from at least three different countries (other than the United States).

### PLENTY OF SIZE ON THIS YEAR'S ROSTER

- Sacramento State has plenty of size this season, and could be among the tallest teams on the West Coast.
- The Hornets feature four players that stand at 6-foot-9 or taller. That includes 7-foot-1, 280-pound center Callum McRae, who will be the tallest player in program history.
- Three players stand at 6-foot-9 - Kiir Kiir Chol Deng, Hunter Marks and Akol Mawein.

### DEFENSE AND REBOUNDING STRESSED BY PATRICK

- David Patrick has stressed defense and rebounding, and the early returns have the Hornets pretty good in both areas.
- Sacramento State has outrebounded both teams it has played thus far, and is averaging 3.0 more boards per game than the opposition (36.5-33.5).
- Defensively, in their game against a mid-major opponent (and not a UCLA team which was a Sweet 16 squad a year ago), the Hornets limited UC San Diego to 38% shooting from the field and just 2-for-16 from long range.

### CHAPPELL OFF TO A GREAT START

- One of the Hornets' top returners, Zach Chappell, is off to a very nice start.
- He is the only Hornet to score in double figures in both games, and is coming off a game-high 19 points on 5-for-6 3PT shooting at UC San Diego.
- Chappell is shooting 56% (5-9) from distance this season, and is now a 39% shooter from long range in his two-plus seasons in a Sacramento State uniform.
- Chappell is averaging 14.5 points, 4.0 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 1.5 steals per game. His scoring average is five points per game better than the next Hornet (Akol Mawein 9.5 ppg).

### HOISTING FROM DISTANCE

- Through two games, it appears Sacramento State will not be shy about shooting a 3-pointer.
- The Hornets have attempted at least 18 treys in both games, and are averaging 21.5 attempts per contest. The Hornets are already 16-for-43 (.372) from long range.
- By comparison, opponents have attempted 17 less three balls than Sacramento State. In fact, 42% of the team's field goal attempts thus far have come from the 3-point arc.
- The Hornets opened the season by going 2-for-18 from distance at UCLA, and followed that with 14-of-25 at UC San Diego. The 14 made three balls were three shy of the Hornet Div. I era single-game record of 17, set against Idaho State in 2004.

### NOTABLES

- Sacramento State has used the same starters in both games - Hunt, Patterson and Chappell at guards, Mawein at forward, and McRae at center.
- The Hornets have used a steady rotation of seven players thus far. The five starters plus guard Cameron Wilbon and forward Hunter Marks. Teiano Hardee has also played in both games, but is receiving 2.8 minutes of playing time per contest.
- Sacramento State is getting to the free throw line at a nice rate (18.0 FTA per game), but is connecting on those freebies at just 64% (23-for-36).
- Point guard Gianni Hunt has recorded at least four assists in both games (4.5 per game). He is averaging 31.3 minutes per game, and is the only true point guard on the squad.
- Guard Cameron Wilbon, who will run the point at times, has been very good in his role as a sixth man. He is averaging 9.5 points and 6.0 rebounds per game.
- David Patrick will try to turn the program around in the same fashion that head football coach Troy Taylor flipped the Hornet football program from an after thought to what is currently the second ranked team in the nation at the FCS level with a 10-0 record.
