- Riding a three-game winning streak, the Weber State football team returns home for the final regular season home game as the Wildcats host Sacramento State Saturday.
- Saturday's game will kickoff at 12 p.m. from Stewart Stadium.
- The game will be televised throughout the state on KJZZ TV and will be streamed online on Pluto TV channel 235 and WatchBigSky.com with Dave Fox, Alema Harrington and Tony Parks calling the action.
- Radio broadcast will be on 1430 KLO and kloradio.com with Steve Klauke and former Wildcat head coach and athletic director Jerry Graybeal on the call.
- Live stats will be at WeberStateSports.com.

#### OPENING DRIVE

- Weber State improved to 6-2 overall and 4-1 in Big Sky Conference play following Saturday's 35-30 win at No. 22 North Dakota.
- The Wildcats remained fourth in the country in this week's STATS FCS poll, the highest national ranking in school history.
- Sophomore quarterback Jake Constantine was named the Big Sky Player of the Week after his performance in Saturday's win.
- Sacramento State is 2-6 overall and 0-5 in Big Sky games, and has lost five-straight games heading into Saturday's game.
- Head coach Jay Hill is in his fifth season as head coach of the Wildcats. He has a combined record of 32-25 overall and is 24-13 in Big Sky games.
- Sacramento State is coached by former Weber State head coach Jody Sears who is in his fifth season as head coach of the Hornets.
- Saturday's game will be Senior Day and the final regular season home game for 16 Wildcat seniors who will be honored before the game.
- WSU is looking to win seven or more games in three-straight seasons for the first time ever.
- This will be the 23rd all-time meeting between Weber State and Sacramento State with the Wildcats holding a 14-8 all-time series lead. Weber State has won three-straight games against the Hornets. The 'Cats are 10-1 all-time against Sacramento State in Ogden.

## WEBER STATE FOOTBALL HISTORY

Weber State began playing Division I football in 1962 and one year later, became a charter member of the Big Sky Conference. WSU has captured three Big Sky titles and advanced to the FCS Playoffs five times in school history, including last year. Weber State's list of legendary head coaches includes Sark Arslanian, Mike Price, Dave Arslanian and Ron McBride.

The 'Cats have had 51 players earn All-American honors and have had 37 players drafted in the NFL. Former WSU quarterback Jamie Martin won the 1991 Walter Payton Trophy and then had a long career in the NFL. Several other Wildcats have also played in the NFL, including Paul McQuistan who won a Super Bowl ring in 2015 with the Seattle Seahawks.

Every Weber State football and men's basketball game will air live on KLO radio 1430 AM. Each game will also be streamed at kloradio.com and WeberstateSports.com.



**Steve Klauke**, the 2016 Utah Sportscaster of the Year, is in his third season as voice of the Wildcats and will call all football and men's basketball game for the Wildcats. Klauke is a three-time Utah Sportscaster of the Year and is also the voice of the Salt Lake Bees,

which he has done for the last 22 years.

Klauke will be joined on football broadcasts this season by former Weber State head coach and athletic director **Jerry Graybeal**. Graybeal was the head coach at Weber State from 1998-04 and served as athletic director from 2005-09.

## LAST GAME - WEBER STATE 35, NORTH DAKOTA 30

GRAND FORKS, N.D. - It was a battle of two nationally-ranked teams and it was fourth-ranked Weber State who came away with a 35-30 win over 22nd ranked North Dakota Saturday afternoon.

The Wildcats had their best offensive showing of the season, totaling a season-high 450 yards with 318 passing and 132 rushing. North Dakota finished with 321 yards of total offense.

Weber State was also a season best 8 of 16 on third down conversion attempts and scored on all four attempts in the red zone.

The Wildcats jumped out to a 14-0 lead after a Constantine seven-yard touchdown run and a 69-yard pass play from Constantine to Darryl Denby.

UND tied the game with a touchdown

with 4:28 left. Weber State went back in front with a 15-yard touchdown from Constantine to Justin Malone with 43 seconds left in the half, but the Fighting Hawks went 70 yards in 27 seconds and scored on a 22-yard pass play with 12 seconds left. The extra point was missed and Weber State led 21-20 at halftime.

The Fighting Hawks went back in front early in the third quarter on a 29-yard field goal, before Constantine found Denby again for a 13-yard touchdown to make 28-23 Wildcats after three quarters. Davis opened the fourth quarter with a three-yard touchdown pass that put the Wildcats up 35-23.

The Wildcats attempted a field goal with 2:56 remaining when North Dakota blocked the kick and returned it 60 yards for a touchdown to make it 35-30, but the Wildcats held on for the win.

## WILDCATS REMAIN FOURTH IN THE NATION IN LATEST POLL

Weber State remained fourth in the country in this week's STATS FCS poll, which is the highest ranking in school history. Weber State has been ranked in at least one of the two national polls for 26 weeks, dating back to November of 2016, which is the longest streak in school history.

WSU is also ranked fifth in this week's AFCA Coaches poll. The Wildcats are one of three nationally ranked Big Sky teams in the top 10 with Eastern Washington fifth and UC Davis sixth.

## HOME SWEET HOME

Weber State is back home for the final regular season home game Saturday against Sacramento State. The Wildcats have won seven-straight home games, and have won 10 of the last 11 and 16 of the last 18 games played at Stewart Stadium.

Weber State has only finished a season undefeated at home twice in school history, finishing 6-0 in 1991 and 1997. The seven-straight home games is currently tied for the third longest home winning streak in school history.

## FOURTH-STRAIGHT WINNING SEASON SECURED

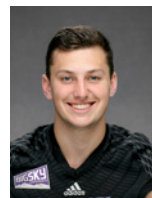
With their sixth win of the season on Saturday at North Dakota, the Wildcats have secured a winning season for the fourth-straight season. That marks just the third time in school history, Weber State has posted winning seasons in four-straight years.

In addition, the Wildcats have the opportunity to win seven or more games in three-straight seasons, which would be the first time that has occurred in school history. Weber State won seven games in 2016 and a school-record 11 games in 2017.

## SENIOR DAY FOR 16 WILDCATS

Saturday's game will mark the final regular season home game of the season and will be Senior Day for 16 Wildcat seniors. Weber State will honor its seniors prior to Saturday's game. ## JAKE CONSTANTINE NAMED BIG SKY PLAYER OF THE WEEK



After leading his team to its third-straight win, Weber State sophomore quarterback Jake Constantine has been honored as the ROOT SPORTS Big Sky Conference Offensive Player of the Week.

The sophomore from Camarillo, California, was responsible for four touchdowns and threw for a career-high 318 yards in the win.

He finished the day 27 of 41 passing for 318 yards and threw three touchdown passes and ran for another touchdown in the win. He started the scoring with a seven-yard touchdown run in the first quarter, then found Darryl Denby for a 69-yard touchdown early in the second quarter, the longest passing play for the Wildcats this season. He connected with Justin Malone for a 15-yard touchdown late in the second quarter, then found Denby again for a 13-yard touchdown in the third quarter.

In seven games played season, Constantine has thrown for 1,134 yards and nine touchdowns. He currently ranks sixth in the Big Sky in passing at 162 yards per game and is 10th in the league in total offense.

### ANOTHER 100 YARD RUSHING GAME FOR JOSH DAVIS



Wildcat red shirt freshman Josh Davis had another big game, in helping the Wildcats to Saturday's win. He finished with 28 carries for 107 yards and a touchdown in the win, his fourth game this season of rushing for at least 100 yards.

Davis, a native of Sandy, Utah, is currently third in the Big Sky and 10th in the nation in rushing at 115.1 yards per game. He is first in the nation in rushing among freshmen. Davis has totaled 806 rushing yards with five touchdowns on the season.

He also has 213 punt return yards and 113 receiving yards this season, giving him 1,132 all-purpose yards. He leads the Big Sky and is sixth in the nation in all-purpose yards per game at 161.7.

Davis has been named to the watch list for the Jerry Rice Award, recognizing the top freshman in the country.

### DEFENSE LEADING NATION

The Wildcat defense continues to rank as one of the top units in the country. Weber State leads the Big Sky in several defensive categories and rank in the tops of the country in many as well.

The Wildcat defense is first in the Big Sky in total defense (332.4), rushing defense (127.9), opponent first downs (17.5) and opponent third down conversion (28.7%). Weber State is also second in the league in scoring defense (23.0) and turnover margin (+10).

On a national basis, Weber State is first in the nation in turnovers gained at 23 and ranks third in the nation in fumbles recovered with 11. WSU is also ninth in the nation in turnover margin at +10, and eighth in interceptions with 12. On the year, Weber State has committed 13 turnovers and has forced 23 turnovers.

Senior linebacker Landon Stice recorded his fourth interception of the season in Saturday's win, which is tied for the most in the Big Sky. The Wildcats have had at least one interception in seven of eight games this season.

### THIRD DOWN LOCKDOWN

Weber State had its best game of the season on third down attempts, finishing 8 of 16 on third down conversions in Saturday's win. On the season the Wildcats are last in the Big Sky in third downs, at 24.6 percent.

Defensively, Weber State held North Dakota to 4 of 12 on third down attempts. The Wildcats lead the Big Sky and are ninth in the country in third down defense, holding opponents to 28.7 percent of attempts.

### TEAM CAPTAINS

Five players have been selected as team captains, as voted by their teammates. Senior running back Treshawn Garrett, senior running back and special teams player Brady May, senior offensive lineman Iosua Opeta, senior linebacker LeGrand Toia and junior defensive end Jonah Williams will be the captains this season. Toia was also a captain last year.

### INJURY REPORT

Weber State senior captain Brady May missed his second-straight game Saturday with an ankle injury. Red shirt freshman Kaden Jenks suffered a season-ending ankle and leg injury in the October 20 game. Weber State sophomore offensive lineman Tyler Downs is also out with a leg injury.

### QUICK HITS

Senior wide receiver Darryl Denby had a season-high 107 receiving yards and had two touchdowns in a game for the first time in his career. Denby also reached a milestone, becoming the 20th player in Weber State history to reach 1,500 career yards. He now has 1,515 career receiving yards on 107 receptions with 12 touchdowns... Weber State scored touchdowns on every attempt in the red zone in Saturday's win, the first time the 'Cats have accomplished that feat this season...WSU was 4 of 4 on red zone attempts with four touchdowns...The Wildcats lead North Dakota 7-0 after the first quarter Saturday and have led their opponents after the first quarter in six of the eight games this season...WSU is outscoring its opponents 63-28 on the season in the first quarter.

### LOOKING AHEAD

After Saturday, the Wildcats will hit the road for the final two regular season games against two of their biggest rivals.

Weber State will play Nov. 10 at Southern Utah and Nov. 17 at Idaho State.

# GAME 9 - SACRAMENTO STATE

## ABOUT SACRAMENTO STATE



The Sacramento State Hornets are 2-6 overall and enter Saturday's game with an 0-5 record in Big Sky play. Sacramento State opened the year with a win over St. Francis and won at Northern Colorado in a non-conference game but have lost its last five games, including a 41-14 home loss to Portland State last week.

The Hornets rank second in the Big Sky in passing defense, allowing 192.4 yards per game. They are first in the conference in passing yards per completion at 17, which is fourth best in the country. Sacramento State is also second in the Big Sky in penalties, and third in red zone defense. They rank 12th in total defense and 13th in rushing defense.

Individually, sophomore running back Elijah Dotson is second in the Big Sky and fifth in the nation in rushing yards, averaging 132.3 yards per game. He had 183 yards in Saturday's game against Portland State, his fifth-straight 100 yard rushing game. He averaged 9.6 yards per carry and had an 83-yard touchdown run. Dotson has moved past 1,000 yards this season and has six carries of at least 50 yards on the season.

Sacramento State finished 7-4 last season and was 6-2 in Big Sky play. The Hornets were picked to finish fifth in the coaches poll and seventh in the media poll this season.

## HEAD COACH JODY SEARS

The Hornets are coached by former Weber State coach Jody Sears who is in his fifth season as the head coach at Sacramento State. Sears has posted a 20-33 record in five seasons at Sacramento State and is 13-24 in Big Sky games. He was named the Big Sky Coach of the Year last season after guiding the Hornets to a 7-4 record and a 6-2 mark in Big Sky play.

Prior to becoming head coach at Sacramento State, Sears was the head coach at Weber State in 2012 and 2013, compiling a 4-19 overall record and a 3-13 mark in Big Sky play.

## SERIES HISTORY

Weber State and Sacramento State have met every season since the Hornets joined the Big Sky in 1996. Weber State holds a 14-8 all-time series lead over the Hornets. The last four games in the season have all been played as non-conference games. This is the first Big Sky counting game between the two schools since 2013.

The Wildcats have won the last four meetings, including a 31-24 win last season in Sacramento. WSU beat the Hornets 14-7 in the last game in Ogden in 2016.

In games played in Ogden, Weber State holds a 10-1 all-time lead and has won the last two games. Sacramento State's only win at Stewart Stadium was in 2013.

Jay Hill is in his fifth season as the head coach at Weber State. In addition to his duties as head coach, Hill also serves as the defensive coordinator for the Wildcats. After a historic season in 2017, Hill was named the Utah Coach of the Year as part of the Governor's State of Sport Awards.

Hill has led the Wildcats to back-to-back FCS Playoff appearances and three-straight winning seasons.

In 2017, Hill led Weber State to its best season in school history. The Wildcats won the Big Sky Conference title, won a school-record 11 games, won two games in the FCS Playoffs and were ranked in the top five in the nation, the highest ranking in school history. Weber State also had eight players earn All-American honors, the most ever, and had 17 players earn Big Sky All-Conference honors, including a league-best eight on the first team.

Hill engineered the Wildcat defense that was one of the best in the country in 2017. Weber State finished in the top 10 in the country in interceptions, turnovers gained and red zone defense. The Wildcats led the Big Sky in total defense, scoring defense, rushing defense, interceptions, pass efficiency defense and red zone defense.

In 2017, eight Wildcats earned All-American honors, the most in a season in WSU history. Taron Johnson and Andrew Vollert were consensus All-Americans with Xequille Harry, Brady May, Josua Opeta, Rashid Shaheed, LeGrand Toia and Trey Tuttle also earning All-America honors. Hill has now coached 10 All-Americans at Weber State and has also coached 51 players to Big Sky All-Conference honors and 45 Wildcats that have earned Academic All-Big Sky honors.

Hill, 43, was named the 11th head coach in Weber State football history in December 2013.

He spent 13 years (2001-13) as an assistant coach at the University of Utah, including the last nine seasons as a full-time assistant under Kyle Whittingham. Prior to that, he spent four years as a graduate assistant and administrative assistant with the Utes under legendary coaches Ron McBride and Urban Meyer.

The Lehi, Utah, native played college football at Ricks Junior College, where he earned junior college All-American honors at cornerback. He went on to play two seasons (1998-99) at Utah under Ron McBride. As a senior he led the Mountain West in interceptions, was named Utah's Defensive MVP and earned second team All-Conference honors. He later played briefly in the XFL and signed free agent contracts with the Buffalo Bills and New York Giants.

He and his wife Sara have four children: Ashtyn, Alayna, Jacob and Allie.
