HOWARD UNIVERSITY (BISON) 1-5 vs BETHUNE COOKMAN (WILDCATS) 4-1

THE GAME: This is a Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference match-up between the Bison of Howard University and the Wildcats of Bethune Cookman University. The Bison (1-5, 0-3 MEAC) dropped a 27-22 decision to North Carolina Central on the road this past Saturday for their third straight loss. The Wildcats (4-1, 1-0 MEAC) are coming off a 27-7 home win over Delaware State this past Saturday for their first conference win.

COACH'S SHOW: Coach Harrell is heard every Sunday at 12 noon on the Coach's Show on In and Out of Sports on WOL1450am or www.1450am.com.

SERIES RECORD: BCU won last year's game at Greene Stadium and leads the series, 18-13-1. Howard last won in 2007.

THE COACHES: Howard University is coached by Gary "Flea" Harrell (Howard, '94), who is in his third year and has a 13-15 record to date. BCU is coached by Brian Jenkins (Cincinnati, '93), who is in his fifth season there and has a 41-12 record to date.

NEXT UP: Howard hosts Florida A&M next Saturday for homecoming at 1:05 pm while the Wildcats travel to Savannah, Ga to take on the Tigers of Savannah State.

PRODUCTIVE CAREER: McGhee is one of only a few FCS quarterbacks who has over 2,100 yards rushing and more than 6,300 yards passing. The native of Pittsburgh, Pa is now second on the MEAC and Howard all-time list for total offense in a career with 8,525 yards. McGhee has accounted for 60 touchdowns during his career. He needs 1,321 yards to surpass Ted White as the all-time leader in total offense of 9,846 yards of total offense for a career. He needs 118 to surpass Bernard Hawk of Bethune Cookman for second place and 1700 to surpass White.

SCOUTING THE WILDCATS: BCU is ranked Number 18 in the FCS national poll and Number 1 in two Black College polls. BCU is the preseason favorite to win the MEAC. The Wildcats have won two of the past three conference titles. Nationally, the Wildcats rank 4th in rushing defense, 6th in time of possession and 7th in third down conversion defense. BCU leads the MEAC in time of possession, in rushing defense and in Red Zone offense. Jordan leads the

team in rushing with 276 yards and 4 TDs; Williams in passing with 836 yards and 5 TDs; and Gordon in receiving with 17 for 176 yards and a TD. Defensively, Dantzler, Williams and Richards spearhead the unit.

BISON HOOVES: McGhee leads the MEAC in total offense, is 2nd in passing, 4th in scoring and rushing and 9th in all-purpose yards. Fleck leads the MEAC in punting, Rollins is first in tackles, Parker is 6th in all-purpose yards and Matt Colvin is 2nd in receiving yards per game. In the MEAC statistics, Howard leads in first downs and in 4th down conversions and is 2nd in total offense.

SEASON SURPRISE: Devin Rollins is having an all-conference season. The junior middle linebacker from Miami, FL leads the MEAC in tackles with 61, 3 for losses and a sack. Khari Brown is also having a fine season, second on the team in tackles with 37, two for losses and a sack.

TURNOVER FACTOR: The Bison have recovered 5 fumbles, but have just one interception in six games.

SLOW STARTS: The Bison have been outscored, 72-28 in the first quarter this season and 104-51 in the first half. They have fared better in the second half, holding a 31-21 advantage in the fourth quarter.

CUMULATIVE EFFECT: Howard has been plagued all season by dropped passes. Last season, the Bison ranked among the nation's best on third down conversions at 47 percent. But the dropped passes have helped lower the percentage to 32 percent through five games.

RETURNING HOME: The Bison have 10 players from the state of Florida on the roster, 5 of whom start.

GETTING BETTER: The Howard offensive line was one of the stronger units headed into the season, featuring four of the five starters. But the Bison have been hit with some key injuries that have forced some young players to get extended playing time. At times, it has resulted in some missed assignments and untimely penalties. Despite that, offensive line coach Manny Martinez has been able to coach up the unit and last week, the offense rolled up almost 500 yards of total offense and controlled the clock for 35 minutes.

OFF TO A FINE START: After having his best season in 2013, John Fleck was determined to come back even stronger in 2014. The 6-2 junior from Indianapolis, IN worked heavily on leg strength and it has paid off. He averages almost 43 yards per punt on the season to lead the MEAC and he is 15th in the country. Fleck's numbers stick out: Ten of his 29 attempts have been fair caught; seven have landed inside the 20-yard line; and seven have been for 50 yards or more, including a career-best 64 yarder against Morehouse. His booming kickoffs deep in the end zone has resulted in six touchbacks. He was named the MEAC Special Teams Player of the Week following the Rutgers game.

A FIRST: When the Bison opened the season at Akron and at Rutgers, it marked the first time that Howard has played back-to-back FBS opponents to open the season. This is also only the second time that the Bison have played a 12-game schedule.

MR. VERSATILITY: Richard Aiyegoro is one of the more versatile players on the squad. The 5-7 senior plays the slot position on offense, returns kickoffs and punts and he is the holder on field goals and PATs. Aiyegoro had his best day as a receiver vs NCCU, catching 8 passes for 83 yards.

COACHING KINSHIP: Head Coach Harrell, offensive coordinator Ted White, special teams' coordinator Bobby Jones and tight ends coach Jimmie Johnson all played at Howard. Rayford Petty the defensive coordinator, has twice been head coach for the Bison. Ronald Bolton, the secondary coach, is in his second tenure with the Bison.

THE VALUE OF LEADERSHIP: While McGhee's exploits on the playing field are well documented, the senior QB is equally impressive in the classroom where he has a 3.2 GPA and has a member of the MEAC Commissioner's All Academic team for the past two years, and in the community where he is a candidate for the AFCA's Good Works Award for FCS players. McGhee will graduate this December.

INJURY REPORT: Starting strong safety Julien David injured his foot in the Rutgers game and is out for the season following surgery. Deonta Allen Wright injured his knee against Rutgers and is also out. Ibrahima Kebe and Tavius Brown, who both missed the NCCU game, are questionable.

Third Season

Gary "Flea" Harrell returns to the sidelines after taking a leave of absence for a year and he is anxious to get back to continue on the Road To Glory. It did not take Harrell long to put his stamp on the Howard University football program. Using a slogan "The Road To Redemption" in his first season in 2011, Harrell was able to turn the Bison's fortunes around by leading them to a 5-6 mark. It was significant because the win total exceeded the total number of victories the three previous seasons combined.

Harrell was among the finalists for the Eddie Robinson Award, presented to the top coach in FCS and the MEAC Coach of the Year.

With his philosophy in place, Harrell would lead Howard to a 7-4 record and a 6-2 mark in the MEAC. It was the first winning season for the Bison in a decade and the second place finish in the conference was the best in over a decade.

The Miami, Fla. native is no stranger to coaching at Greene Stadium, making his career debut as the Bison wide receivers coach in 2002. After two seasons with Howard, Harrell had coaching stints at Texas Southern (2004-2006) and Florida A&M (2006-2008) as the wide receivers coach. He continued his matriculation towards a head coaching job by serving as the quarterbacks coach at Morgan State University (2008-2009) and the wide receivers coach for Team Michigan, a member of the All-American Football League (2008). Prior to being named the head coach at his alma mater, Harrell completed two seasons as the offensive coordinator for Bowie State University's football team.

Affectionately known as "The Flea," Harrell was a fan favorite for his calculating and precise on-the-field exploits. He is the all-time leading receiver in school history and ranks among the tops in MEAC history.

He also holds the season record for punt returns (29) and return yards in a season (417). Harrell was a four-year letter winner at Howard University. "Howard has a strong legacy of achievement," Harrell said. "Every member of Howard University football accepts the responsibility of representing the program with dignity and pride on and off the field. We started out as the Road To Redemption in an attempt to bring the program back to respectability. We are now entering the next phase, The Road To Glory. It is our goal to have a program that is competitive year in and year out."

As a starter for Howard's undefeated 1993 team, Harrell and his teammates won the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference championship and were crowned the Black National College champions. He set the benchmark for wide receivers at Howard and holds the school record for most receptions in a game (13) and in a career (184).

Harrell made his professional debut in the National Football League with the New York Giants (1994-96), followed by a season for the World League's Frankfurt Galaxy (1996) and two seasons in the Canadian Football League with the Montreal Alouettes (1996-97).

Harrell is a 1994 graduate of Howard University with a degree in marketing. He was inducted into the Howard University Hall of Fame in November 2005 and received a proclamation from the City of Miami declaring it Gary "Flea" Harrell Day. Harrell attended the Miami Northwestern High School.

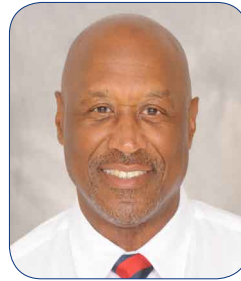

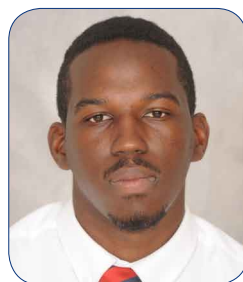
