Hampden-Sydney College plays on the road at Emory & Henry College in non-conference action on Saturday afternoon, October 16, at 1 p.m. in Emory. Following a designated bye week last weekend, the visiting Tigers are 2-3 overall, while the host Wasps are 3-2 overall.

H-SC dropped a hard-fought 32-30 decision at home to visiting Washington and Lee on Oct. 2 on Fulton Field at Lewis C. Everett Stadium. The Generals converted four of four two-point conversions on the day and stopped the Tigers on their lone two-point attempt with just 29-seconds remaining for the dramatic outcome. E&H dropped a difficult 34-31 decision on the road at Randolph-Macon on Oct. 9 in Ashland. The Wasps had rallied from a 24-14 deficit at halftime to take a 31-27 lead early in the fourth quarter ... but the Yellow Jackets scored the game-winning touchdown with just 19-seconds remaining for the victory.

H-SC is competing in its 127th season of football, and the Tigers are enjoying their 46th year as a charter member of the Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC). E&H was also a charter member of the ODAC; however, the Wasps are now transitioning to NCAA Division II.

The Series

E&H narrowly leads the overall series between the two schools, 39-37, including a 56-17 home win the last time they played in 2019. H-SC, however, is 16-4 against the Wasps under the direction of head coach Marty Favret, including 14 consecutive wins between 2002 and 2015. The Tigers and E&H first met on the gridiron in 1922, resulting in a 13-0 home shutout for H-SC.

Scouting The Tigers

H-SC is led offensively by senior quarterback and team captain Tanner Bernard. Through five games, Bernard has passed for 1,426 yards (97-147) and eight touchdowns with four interceptions.

The running game features the tandem of senior Kaleb Smith and sophomore Josh Jones. Smith missed the opening game, but has rushed for 263 yards on 52 attempts (5.1) with three touchdowns, adding 201 yards receiving on 17 receptions. Jones has rushed for 193 yards on 52 carries with three touchdowns, adding 146 yards receiving on 15 catches.

Sophomore wide receiver Braeden Bowling, fifth-year wide receiver and second-year team captain Dillon Costello, and fifth-year slot receiver Nick Kallivokas lead the receiving group. Bowling has 444 yards receiving on 24 receptions with two touchdowns, Costello has 359 yards receiving on 22 catches with two touchdowns, and Kallivokas has 137 yards receiving on five catches with three touchdowns.

Sophomore safety Will Pickren leads the Tigers on defense with 58 tackles, including four for loss, with one interception and four pass breakups. Fifth-year linebacker and team captain Brendan Weinberg has 54 tackles, including eight for loss, with one sack. Sophomore safety James-Ryan Salvi adds 37 tackles, including two for loss, one interception and a forced fumble.

Junior placekicker Jack Breedlove is a perfect 10-10 on PATs, and 3-5 on field goals, including a collegiate-best of 39 yards. Sophomore placekicker Palmer Smith is a perfect 7-7 on PATs, and 1-2 on field goals, including a collegiate-best of 31 yards.

Sophomore left-footed punter George Langhammer has averaged 40.7 yards on 18 punts, including a collegiate-best of 67 yards, with three fair caught and three downed inside the 20.

Sophomore wide receiver Iceysis Lewis has averaged 25.6 yards on 12 kick returns, including a collegiate-best of 72 yards. Classmate and wide receiver Brice Wilson has also averaged 25.6 yards ... on eight kick returns, including a collegiate-best of 43 yards.

Scouting The Wasps

E&H is expected to be led offensively by quarterback Kyle Short, running back Devontae Jordan and wide receiver Kashawn Cosey. Through five games, Short has passed for 944 yards (75-129) and nine touchdowns with four interceptions. Jordan has rushed for 945 yards on 140 attempts (6.8) with 13 touchdowns, adding 71 yards receiving on three receptions. Cosey has 28 receptions for 287 yards and two touchdowns.

Linebacker Brent Butler and defensive end Jay Swegheimer have 35 and 30 tackles, respectively, including 1.5 for loss by Butler, while Swegheimer has 6.5 for loss, 2.5 sacks, one interception, one pass breakup and four quarterback hurries.

Placekicker Cameron Jones is 26-28 on PATs, and 3-4 on field goals, including a long of 37 yards. Punter Ethan Muncy has averaged 43.3 yards on six punts, including a long of 60 yards, with three fair caught and two inside the 20.

Tanner Bernard ranks first in the ODAC and 13th in DIII yards per pass attempt (9.70), first in the ODAC and 19th in DIII passing yards per game (285.2), first in the ODAC and 23rd in DIII completion percentage (.660), first in the ODAC and 24th in DIII passing yards (1,426), first in the ODAC and 28th in DIII total offense (291.2), first in the ODAC and 34th in DIII passing efficiency (160.0), second in the ODAC and 35th in DIII passing yards per completion (14.70) and second in the ODAC and 47th in DIII completions per game (19.40).

George Langhammer ranks first in the ODAC and 11th in DIII punting (40.7).

Will Pickren ranks second in the ODAC and 11th in DIII total tackles (58).

Brendan Weinberg ranks second in the ODAC and 46th in DIII in tackles for loss (6.5). He is third in the ODAC and 16th in DIII total tackles (54).

Brice Wilson ranks second in the ODAC and 34th in DIII kick return average (25.6).

Iceysis Lewis ranks third in the ODAC and 36th in DIII kick return average (25.6).

Braeden Bowling ranks third in the ODAC and 54th in DIII receiving yards (444). He is third in the ODAC and 56th in DIII receiving yards per game (88.8).

Last Game (10/2)

W&L converted four of four two-point conversions on the day and stopped H-SC on its lone two-point attempt with just 29-seconds remaining for a dramatic 32-30 road win at Everett Stadium. The host Tigers drove 83 yards on seven plays to score the last-minute touchdown, but needed the two points to tie, and the visiting Generals denied the potential game-tying opportunity on an incomplete pass.

The closely-played contest for first place in the league standings saw H-SC get on the scoreboard first when Tanner Bernard ran eight yards to the end zone at 9:49 of the opening quarter. Palmer Smith added the first of his three PATs for the early 7-0 advantage. It was a quick three-play, 74-yard possession that featured a 68-yard pass completion from Bernard to Kaleb Smith.

The Tigers got the ball back courtesy of an interception by sophomore safety James-Ryan Salvi and promptly drove to the W&L 28, but the drive stalled and a 45-yard field goal attempt by Palmer Smith was blocked. The Generals responded with a nine-play, 82-yard drive that resulted in a one-yard scoring run by Josh Breece at 10:57 of the second quarter. W&L converted the first of its four two-point attempts, a run by Stephen Murrin, and it was an 8-7 game. H-SC answered with a late first-half field goal to lead 10-8 at halftime, the kick coming from 31 yards by Palmer Smith

with only six-seconds remaining in the half. It capped a nine-play, 29-yard drive for the lead at the intermission.

The Tigers struck again early in the third quarter when Bernard connected with Nick Kallivokas for a 42-yard touchdown pass at 13:32, making it 17-8. It was a four-play, 67-yard drive that included a 22-yard completion from Bernard to Kallivokas to get it started.

W&L answered with a 15-play, 82-yard drive that ended with a two-yard scoring pass from Murrin to Alex Vaught at 5:53 of the third quarter. Alex Wertz added the two-point conversion via a run and it was a 17-16 contest. It appeared that the hosts were driving for a go-ahead touchdown late in the third quarter, as a 39-yard completion from Bernard to Braeden Bowling had the ball inside the visitor 10, but unfortunately, a fumble ensued on the tackle and the Generals recovered—taking a 24-17 advantage early in the fourth quarter when Murrin found Coby Kirkland for a 70-yard passing touchdown at 14:50. Breece converted the two-point attempt via another run, following the quick four-play, 94-yard possession.

H-SC responded quickly when Bernard connected with Dillon Costello on a 42-yard scoring play at 12:52, capping a quick five-play, 67-yard drive that also included a 23-yard pass play from Bernard to Costello—tying the game at 24-24.

W&L then drove 74 yards on 12 plays with Breece scoring the decisive touchdown on a 15-yard run with 5:43 on the clock. The eventual game-winning two-point conversion was via another Murrin run.

H-SC made it exciting at the end when Kaleb Smith found fifth-year tight end and team captain Ed Newman in the end zone on fourth-and-goal at the W&L three-yard line, as Smith looked to run before making a jump pass over the middle to Newman for the touchdown with just 29-seconds left to play. The Tigers had to go for the two-point conversion to tie the contest, but Bernard's pass attempt was incomplete after pressure from the Generals. The long drive was jump-started via a 61-yard completion from Bernard to Bowling on the first play of the possession that started with 3:09 on the

clock. H-SC did convert a successful onside kick by Palmer Smith that was recovered by sophomore linebacker Dorian Green, but the four-straight incompletions allowed the visitors to gain possession and kneel down once to end it.

Bernard passed for a career-high and a game-high 393 yards (22-34) and two touchdowns with no interceptions, adding 12 yards on the ground and one touchdown. Kaleb Smith had 23 yards rushing on 11 attempts, adding 101 yards receiving on seven catches. Costello had a game-high 128 yards receiving and one touchdown on eight receptions, Kallivokas added 64 yards receiving and one touchdown on two catches, Bowling had 99 yards receiving on three catches and Newman had 17 yards receiving and one touchdown on three catches. Brice Wilson had two kickoff returns for 49 yards. George Langhammer punted two times for an average of 44.5 yards, including a long of 46 yards, and both downed inside the 20. Palmer Smith was 3-3 on PATs and 1-2 on field goals.

Will Pickren had a career-high and game-high 18 tackles, including one for loss, Brendan Weinberg had 11 tackles, including 1.5 for loss, and Salvi added a career-high 10 tackles, including one for loss and his first career interception to lead the defense.

Topping the Century Mark

Kaleb Smith surpassed 100 yards rushing for the fourth time in his collegiate career with his 114-yard effort against Shenandoah (9/18). His career-best was a 214-yard game on a career-high 30 carries and one touchdown against Guilford (10/20/18) at Everett Stadium, adding a career-high 12 receptions for career-high 118 yards receiving, totaling a career-high 332 all-purpose yards.

William V. Campbell Trophy®

Kaleb Smith has been named a semifinalist for the 2021 William V. Campbell Trophy®, college football's premier scholar-athlete award, as announced on September 29 by the National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame (NFF). He is among 176 semifinalists from all divisions, while one of only two from the ODAC and 39 selected from Division III. Kaleb is a Dean's List student majoring in

mathematical economics with a 3.37 GPA, and is the son of Brandon and Renee Smith of Rocky Mount.

Hampden-Sydney Football

H-SC has a 126-year history of football, amassing 564 wins (564-481-38) since beginning in 1892. The Tigers have experienced great success over the years, including nine ODAC Championships, nine Mason-Dixon Conference Championships, seven NCAA Division III Championship appearances, 85 All-Americans, 13 Academic All-America selections and 205 First Team All-ODAC honorees. H-SC also played in the 1970 and 1971 Knute Rockne Bowls (NCAA College Division East Regional Championship).

ODAC Football Preseason Poll

H-SC was picked second in the 2021 ODAC Football Preseason Poll. The Tigers garnered 27 points for second among the seven schools, their highest preseason ranking since 2016. Randolph-Macon was picked first with 36 points, ahead of H-SC (27), Bridgewater (26), Washington and Lee (25), Shenandoah (14), Ferrum (13) and Guilford (6).

Preseason All-American

Ed Newman was named to the 2021 D3football.com Preseason All-America Third Team. He started all five games this past spring and led the Tigers with 19 receptions for 281 receiving yards and two touchdowns. Ed was recognized as a 2020-21 D3football.com All-America Second Team selection, and was also named First Team All-ODAC and VaSID All-State, and to the ODAC All-Academic Team.

Team Captains

Leading the Tigers are Tanner Bernard, Dillon Costello, Ed Newman and Brendan Weinberg. Costello becomes a two-time team captain after serving in the leadership role last season, as well. Tanner is the son of Jason and Marsha Bernard. Dillon is the son of Chris and Shelly Costello. Ed is the son of Walt and Cindy Newman. Brendan is the son of Craig and Jill Weinberg.

MARTY FAVRET is in his 22nd year as the Head Football Coach at Hampden-Sydney College during 2021-22, and is the second winningest coach in Tiger football history. Coach Favret took over a program that had won just four games in three years prior to his arrival in 2000, and has firmly restored the winning tradition at Hampden-Sydney, amassing 15 winning seasons and an overall record of 137-79 (.634) over 21-plus seasons. His program is 88-47 (.652) in Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC) games, while earning five ODAC Championships and making six NCAA Division III Football Championship playoff appearances. He trails only the legendary Stokeley Fulton, who compiled a record of 143-99-5 from 1960-84.

Favret has been named the ODAC Coach of the Year five times, most recently in 2013 when the Tigers finished 9-3 overall, including 6-1 in the ODAC. He also earned the honor in 2011 (8-3, 5-1 ODAC), 2009 when the program posted a perfect 10-0 regular season (10-1, 6-0 ODAC), 2007 (8-3, 5-1 ODAC) and in 2003 (9-1, 5-1 ODAC). Winning football and high-octane offenses have become the norm as his teams have won eight or more games in ten of the last 17 falls seasons, and the 2003 Tigers led the nation in scoring (47.2), while his 2005 team led the nation in total offense (525.2). Favret also ranks second all-time at H-SC for winning percentage (.640) among coaches with at least five seasons.

H-SC was able to play an abbreviated five-game schedule during the Spring of 2021, after the traditional 2020 fall season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Tigers finished 4-1 overall, including 3-1 in the ODAC, winning the third-place game of the ODAC's first-ever Football Championship Weekend. Based upon winning percentage (4-1, .800), it was the finest season for the program since 2010 (9-2, .818). Ed Newman was named to the D3football.com All-America Second Team at tight end, while offensive lineman Brad Gholson was named to the All-Region Second Team. H-SC had 11 All-ODAC selections, including six that earned First Team honors, while offensive lineman Tyler Howerton was voted the ODAC's 2020-21 Harry G. "Doc" Jopson Scholar-Athlete Award Winner as the conference's top male scholar-athlete. Howerton was also the ODAC/Virginia Farm Bureau Insurance Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year after being selected as one of 12 finalists nationwide for the prestigious 2020 William V. Campbell Trophy® ... the academic heisman for college football. Will Pickren, a freshman safety, was named the ODAC Rookie of the Year.

In 2019, H-SC finished an uncharacteristic 1-9 overall, including 0-8 in the ODAC, with six All-ODAC selections--two earning First Team honors, while Major Morgan was named the Touchdown Club of Richmond's Small College Wide Receiver of the Year for the second consecutive season. In addition, Tyler Howerton was voted to the 2019 Academic All-America® Division III Football First Team, and Rhett Andersen was tabbed to the 2019 Academic All-America® Division III Football Second Team, as selected by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA). Howerton was also named a 2020 Goldwater Scholar, the College's first ever physics department recipient.

In 2018, the Tigers tied for second in the ODAC (4-3) and had nine All-ODAC selections, including four on the First Team, while running back Kaleb Smith earned ODAC Rookie of the Year honors. In addition, the Touchdown Club of Richmond named Major Morgan the Commonwealth's Small College Wide Receiver of the Year. H-SC finished third in Division III passing offense (381.0) and 19th in total offense (457.3).

In 2017, H-SC was 6-4 overall while finishing second in the ODAC (4-2). The team had 12 All-ODAC selections, including the ODAC Offensive Player of the Year in receiver Cam Johnson. The Tigers finished 12th in Division III passing offense (320.8).

In 2015, the Tigers enjoyed their ninth consecutive winning season, posting a 6-4 record (4-3 ODAC). The team had 14 All-ODAC selections, including five First Team honorees, and the ODAC Rookie of the Year in running back Kyree Koonce.

In 2014, H-SC repeated as ODAC Champions, Favret's fifth conference title and the program's ninth overall while becoming the first team to win back-to-back ODAC titles since 2005. Finishing the year at 7-4 (5-2 ODAC), the Tigers again had a strong award showing with 11 named All-ODAC, including three First Team choices. Additionally, quarterback Nash Nance won the Touchdown Club of Richmond's Lanier Award as the top player in Virginia in NCAA Division II, III and NAIA.

In 2013, Favret won his fourth ODAC Championship, the programs' eighth and for the first time in school history, H-SC advanced to the second round of the NCAA Playoffs. The Tigers finished the season 9-3 (6-1 ODAC) with a No. 18 national ranking (D3football.com). On October 19, 2013, Favret won his 100th game with a 33-12 victory over Emory & Henry College. He coached three All-Americans, and his first D3football.com South Region Offensive Player of the Year in Nash Nance. Favret was named the ODAC Coach of the Year for the fifth time, and was the Virginia Sports Information Directors (VaSID) Co-Coach of the Year, the third time being recognized by the organization. H-SC placed 13 on the All-ODAC Team, including nine First Team selections.

In 2012, the Tigers posted another winning record at 6-4 (4-3 ODAC) while leading the conference in scoring offense (36.5, 28th in Division III). H-SC had 12 players on All-ODAC teams, including six on the First Team. For the fourth-straight season, Favret coached an All-American as junior tackle Will Ferrell earned the honor from the American Football Coaches Association (AFCAs).

In 2011, Favret's Tigers won their third ODAC Championship since 2007 and advanced to the NCAA Playoffs for the third consecutive season. Favret and crew finished 8-3 (5-1 ODAC), including a 5-0 mark at home to extend the win-streak at Everett Stadium to 15 (ended at 16 the following season). H-SC ranked second in Division III passing offense (340.6), and seventh in both total offense (474.5) and scoring (41.9). Favret was named the ODAC Coach of the Year for the fourth time while also capturing the same honors from VaSID.

In 2010, Favret guided the Tigers (9-2, 5-1 ODAC) to nine wins for the third time in his tenure while receiving a bid and home game in the NCAA Playoffs for the second consecutive season. The Tigers capped off the regular season with a 34-28 win over archrival Randolph-Macon. H-SC ranked 10th in Division III passing offense (307.6).

In 2009, Favret led his squad to a perfect 10-0 regular season record (10-1, 6-0 ODAC) for just the second time in school history (1971), and the program's sixth overall ODAC Championship. That season also marked the third time Favret was named the ODAC Coach of the Year, as well as earning VaSID and Touchdown Club of Richmond Coach of the Year honors. With the seventh win of that season, he also became the second winningest coach in Tiger football history. H-SC ranked 10th in Division III passing offense (310.0).

From 2002 through 2008, the Tigers won eight or more games during six of the seven seasons (53-18). H-SC won its first ODAC title under Favret in 2007 (8-3, 5-1 ODAC), earning a NCAA Playoff appearance while finishing eighth in Division III passing offense (317.0), 11th in total offense (465.5) and 19th in scoring (35.8). The program finished among the Top Five in Division III total offense and passing offense during 2003, 2005 and 2008, and was second nationally in scoring (45.0) in 2005. The 2004 squad was among the Top 15 nationally in the three offensive categories.

After serving as offensive coordinator and assistant head coach at Catholic University for six seasons, Favret was named Hampden-Sydney head coach on December 30, 1999. In his six seasons at Catholic, he was the architect of one of the most prolific offenses in NCAA Division III. Under his direction, CUA finished in the Top 30 in the country in scoring five times. His offenses set 75 school records, including the school's Top Three single-season scoring records. Over the course of his last three seasons at Catholic, he helped guide the Cardinals to a 29-1 regular season record and three NCAA Playoff appearances. In 1999, CUA's first year as an ODAC football member, the school claimed the conference title while the Favret-led offense topped the conference in both total offense and scoring.

Before joining the Catholic staff, Favret served for four years as the head junior varsity football coach at Gonzaga College High School in Washington, D.C. He became the Purple Eagles' varsity offensive coordinator in 1991, helping the team earn a No. 6 ranking in 1993.

Favret was a three-year starter at shooting guard for the Catholic University basketball team from 1981-84, serving as team captain during his junior and senior seasons. He set a school record as a sophomore when he connected on 18 consecutive shots. Prior to graduating from Gonzaga College High School, Favret played basketball for two years and baseball for one.

Favret was born in Washington, DC and graduated from the Catholic University of America in 1984 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in history. He and his wife, Cynthia, reside in Hampden-Sydney and have two daughters, Rebecca (31) and Amanda (29).
