HEAD COACH ROB SMITH

While insiders in the collegiate football world expected the Humboldt State program to improve after Rob Smith was named head coach in 2008, few could have predicted the rapid progress and level of success the Jacks would achieve under Smith's guidance.

In only his fourth year directing the program, Smith led his team to the top of the Great Northwest Athletic Conference in 2011, achieving HSU's first-ever GNAC title. In 2012, Smith's fifth season, the Jacks narrowly missed repeating despite the loss of 24 seniors from the previous season, battling to the season's final game.

Smith joined the Lumberjacks in February, 2008 and became the 15th head coach in the history of the Humboldt State football program, which dates back to 1924.

Smith begins his sixth season with a legacy of success that has earned him respect among his peers at all levels of NCAA coaching. As coach of the Lumberjacks, he has twice been chosen GNAC Coach of the Year. For his entire career, Smith has earned the award nine times, also claiming it in 2001 and 2003 while coaching Western Washington in the GNAC, and being selected in 1989, 1995, 1996, 1999 and 2000 when WWU was a member of the Columbia Football Association.



ARCATA — Halloween is three weeks away, but the Lumberjacks are already experiencing a frightful football season. Though they've been cursed with injuries, the scariest monster is of their own creation.

“Turnovers continue to haunt us,” HSU head coach Rob Smith said. “We can't give our opponents so many opportunities while taking away our own.”

In last week's loss to Western Oregon, the Lumberjacks gave the ball away four times, including three via interceptions. That number matched the giveaways from the previous week's loss to Dixie State, something HSU will have to diminish if the Jacks hope to win on Saturday.

Following consecutive home games, Humboldt State (0-5, 0-4) goes on the road for a Great Northwest Athletic Conference battle against Western Oregon (2-3, 2-2). The Jacks and Wolves will take the field in Monmouth, Ore., for a 1 p.m. kickoff Saturday.

Head-to-Head

Historically, the Lumberjacks and Wolves have been evenly matched, with HSU holding a 19-16 edge in the all-time series. Western Oregon gained ground a year ago by dealing Humboldt State two of its four losses. The Wolves defeated the Jacks, 42-14, in Arcata, then ended the Jacks' hopes of a second straight GNAC title with a 38-22 win in the season-finale at Monmouth. ...Humboldt State and Western Oregon met for the first time during the 1929 season, a game that ended in a 31-0 Wolves' victory.

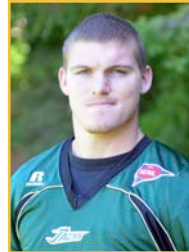

Injury Report

For the first time this season, the Lumberjacks came out of a game without a serious injury, surviving the loss to Central Washington unscathed. Even better, some of those players knocked out of action in earlier games are starting to trickle back into the lineup. Offensive tackle Jonathan Rowe, who played his first game since the season-opener last week, continues to get stronger, as does running back Daniel Wyatt, who also made his first appearance since going down in HSU's first game. Offensive lineman Lucas Govan and defensive back Eric Paopao will both suit up for practice this week, hoping to be ready to return Saturday.

Lumberjack Notes

While progress was made last week, particularly on the defensive side of the line, the same issues continue to impede the Lumberjacks' success. The aforementioned turnovers are most prominent, HSU giving up the ball 17 times while taking it away only 10 times. Interceptions are the most imbalanced area, with the Jacks picking off two passes and opponents grabbing 12. That trend has led the HSU coaching staff to consider a change at quarterback, where three players are listed as potential starters on this week's early depth chart. “The quarterback is always a focal point of the offense because he's the one who leads the team down the field,” Smith said. “We have to get better play out of that position, and all three of our quarterbacks understand that. They'll compete throughout this week's practices for the starting assignment.” ...Starting every game at quarterback thus far has been junior Kyle Morris, who has completed 89 of 178 passes for 849 yards, with three touchdowns and

eight interceptions. His backup, sophomore Casey Mintz, has seen more time on the field in the past two games, throwing for 189 yards, completing 21-39 passes with three interceptions. The third candidate, senior transfer Spencer Phillips, has played in one game, going 4-10 for 23 yards, with one interception in his only appearance. ... True freshman Chase Krivashei continues his outstanding start to his collegiate career, pulling down 14 more passes in last week's loss. That number ties him for second on the HSU single-game high list, one short of the 15 receptions recorded by Hall-of-Famer Dustin Creager against Western Oregon in 2004. Krivashei also leads the GNAC with an average of 8.2 catches per game... Another freshman, Miquan Johnson, was brought into action last week, forsaking his redshirt season to help the Lumberjacks this fall. In doing so, he became the seventh HSU player employed at safety this fall. His impressive debut featured eight tackles, including six solos, one for a loss and a pass break-up. "After two days of practicing at the position, Miquan stepped

forward and did a great job," Smith said. "It's nice to see a freshman approach a challenge the way he did." ... As a team, the Lumberjacks lead the GNAC in kickoff coverage, averaging 60.4 net yards per boot thanks to the leg of Matt Bruder and coverage of the unit led by Taylor Mitchell.

Opponent Notes

Western Oregon is home for the second straight weekend, hoping for a win after dropping last week's game, 34-32, to Azusa Pacific. ... Quarterback Ryan Bergman ranks first in the GNAC in passing yards per game with an average of 269.6. Tyrell Williams has been the big-play receiving threat, indicated by his GNAC leadership of 14.8 yards per catch.

Smith Says

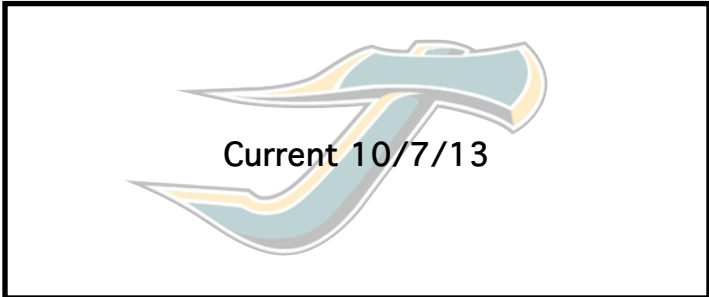
