ON THE HILL THE GAME

Mercyhurst returns home from their first road NEC game of the year to take on Duquesne at Saxon Stadium. Both the Dukes and the Lakers enter the game with a 2-0 record in NEC games. Saturday's contest will be broadcast on NEC Front Row with kickoff scheduled for 6 p.m.

Two of the best offenses in the NEC meet on Saturday in Erie. The Dukes and Lakers have put up staggeringly similar numbers through the first seven weeks of competition. The Lakers average 353 yards per game and the Dukes put up 355 per contest. Both teams have veteran quarterbacks at the helm in Adam Urena and Tyler Riddell. Riddell has the best efficiency rating the NEC at 153.5 with 18 touchdowns and only three interceptions while Urena touts the best completion percentage (68.5) while averaging a league-high 205.7 yards per contest.

ABOUT THE LAKERS

Mercyhurst is coming off a 19-7 victory over Wagner in their last outing on Staten Island. The Lakers were without quarterback Adam Urena with sophomore Alex Gevaudan starting in his place. Gevaudan completed 13-of-24 pass attempts for 191 yards and a touchdown. Running back Brian Trobel was the star of the show for the Lakers, scoring three touchdowns with 206 all-purpose yards. He earned NEC Offensive Player of the Week honors for his efforts.

The Laker defense had one of their best outings of the year, holding the Seahawks to just seven points. They forced three fumbles in the game while posting a season-high four sacks for 30 yards lost. Kyle Laing was named a prime performer by the NEC office with 2.5 sacks on the day and six total tackles

SCOUTING THE DUKES

Duquesne also comes into Saturday's contest with a 2-0 NEC record, earning wins over Stonehill (34-14) and Saint Francis (52-7). The Dukes played two FBS teams in the nonconference slate in Pitt and Akron. They played #10/12 Lehigh as well, falling 35-21.

ABOUT THE SERIES

The Lakers and the Dukes have met 10 times previously. The first meeting was in 1981 and the final meeting before 2024 was in 1993. The Lakers owned a 7-1-1 record in the first nine meetings. Since Mercyhurst moved up to FCS in 2024, the Lakers and the Dukes matchedup in Pittsburgh, where Duquesne pulled out a 31-24 win in the first meeting in 31 years.

 TEAM NOTES**LAKE SHOW, 2-0**

The Lakers have won both of their NEC competitions to start the 2025 season. Mercyhurst pulled out victories over LIU at home, 22-13 and picked up its first road win of the year at Wagner, 19-7.

PROTECT THE BALL

The Lakers recorded their first game without a turnover in 2025 at Wagner.

EARNING MILES

After the season is over, the Lakers will travel over 6,500 miles on the year. The nonconference slate included trips to California, Montana, and South Dakota. In league play, the Lakers make trips to Connecticut, Staten Island, and Loretto, Pennsylvania.

BEST OF THE BEST

The Lakers have been tested in the non-conference slate, playing four opponents ranked in the top 25 of the media and coaches poll. YSU was receiveign votes when the Lakers saw them and is currently 18/24. Sacramento State was 21 and is now RV, Montana State is ranked 5 and South Dakota State is ranked second.

FULL SLATE

The Lakers will play their first full Division I slate in 2025, the second year competing in the FCS. In 2024, Mercyhurst faced four non-DI opponents, going 3-1. The Laker defense recorded two shutout performances in those games holding Buffalo State and Lincoln (CA) scoreless.

GOLDEN STATE CONNECTIONS

12 players on the team come from California JUCOs, including QB Adam Urena and his brother, Austin, who spent two seasons at Citrus Community College.

Head coach Ryan Riemedio is a native of Seaside, California and played football at Monterey Peninsula College, just a 3 hour car ride from Sacramento.

PRESEASON OUTLOOK

The Lakers were selected seventh out of eight teams in the NEC Preseason Coaches Poll. Five Lakers earned a spot on the Phil Steele NEC Preseason All-Conference Team.

QB Adam Urena was named the NEC Preseason Offensive Player of the Year by the Phil Steele team while Brian Trobel earned a First Team selection and OL Joey Balgo, WR Rylan Davison, and DE Jonas King were named to the Second Team.

NEW LOOK

The Lakers bring in 56 new faces for the 2025 season, including 30 freshmen and 26 transfers.

 OFFENSIVE NOTES**AMONG THE BEST**

The Lakers tout one of the best offenses in the NEC. Mercyhurst averages the second most total offense per game (353.6), and the most passing yards per game (238.6) in the NEC.

RECORD SETTING

The Laker offense posted 647 yards of total offense against New Haven, the most since at least 2012 and the most in the FCS era. Lakers quarterbacks recorded 370 yards in the air while Mercyhurst rushers combined for 277 yards on the ground.

The Lakers have tallied 600+ yards of total offense four times since 2012. Mercyhurst posted 600+ yards of total offense twice in the 2014 season. They posted 628 yards in a 45-38 win over Gannon (10/11/14) and 640 yards in a 59-49 win over California (Pa.) (11/8/14). The Lakers also recorded 628 yards against Gannon in a 2013 51-21 victory (10/17/13).

TIME OF POSSESSION

Mercyhurst has led time of possession in six of seven contests this season, averaging over 33 minutes of game time with the ball. The Dukes are a close second in the NEC in TOP, averaging 32:33 with the ball.

CONVERTING

The Lakers have been successful converting on third and fourth down opportunities. On third down, Mercyhurst converts 42 percent of the time and on fourth down, the Lakers have converted 14-of-24 times (58.3%). Mercyhurst's 21 fourth down conversion attempts are tied for the most in the FCS with Marist.

CONNECTING

Lakers quarterbacks have one of the best completion percentages in the FCS, connecting on 66.9% of their passes. That number is tied for 17th in the FCS and second in the NEC

RUNNING WILD

In NEC contests, the Lakers average the most rushing yards per game with 143, just ahead of Duquesne (141). The Lakers also have the leading rusher in NEC contests in Brian Trobel. Trobel has run for 188yds vs NEC opponents, averaging 94 yds/gm.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

SHUTTING DOWN THE PASS

The Lakers have one of the best pass defenses in the NEC, allowing 183.9 yards through the air per game and just eight TDs. Only SFU and Stonehill have better pass defenses in the NEC.

SHOWING UP BIG

The Lakers had one of their best defensive games of the season at Wagner. Mercyhurst tallied a season-high four sacks against the Seahawks and forced three fumbles.

THIRD DOWN STOPS

In their first two conference games, the Lakers are allowing opponents to convert on third down just 28 percent of the time.

THIRD QUARTER STAND

The Lakers held Wagner to just 20 total yards of offense in the third quarter on Saturday.

ADAM URENA

- NEC Prime Performer (Week 1, 2, & 3)
- Urena's 241.0 passing yards per game lead the NEC and are 16th in the FCS.
- Has a 68.8 completion percentage in 2025, good for 16th best in the FCS
- Has 140 completion on the season, leading the NEC
- Streak of games with 200+ passing yards came to an end at SDSU. He reached 16 games with 200+ against Montana State. The streak dated back to the 2023 campaign.
- Threw for a career-high 349 yards against New Haven, completing 21-of-27 passes
- Averages 23 completions per game, seventh in the FCS
- In 2024 he became, Mercyhurst's first quarterback with 2,000 passing yards in a season since Doug Altavilla in 2017 (2,345).
- Named the Phil Steele NEC Preseason Offensive Player of the Year.

ALEX GEVAUDAN

- Started and played the entire game for an injured Urena at Wagner. Completed 13-of-24 passes with one 76 yard TD pass.
- Entered the New Haven game in the fourth quarter, completing 4-of-5 passes for 23 yards and an interception.
- Came in for Urena at YSU for a 2-pt conversion attempt after Urena's helmet came off on the previous play. Completed the pass to WR Dylan Evans for the score.

HEAD COACH

RYAN RIEMEDIO

Ryan Riemedio enters his fourth season as Head Coach of the Mercyhurst football program in 2025. Appointed to the role in January 2022 after being named head coach-in-waiting the previous fall, Riemedio took the reins following the retirement of 20-year head coach Marty Schaetzle. He became just the sixth head coach in program history.

In 2024, Riemedio guided the Lakers through a historic transition, as the program moved from NCAA Division II to the Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS). Despite the heightened level of competition, the Lakers remained competitive and laid a solid foundation for the future. The team showed resilience and growth against FCS opponents, highlighting the staff's ability to prepare and develop players at the next level. The move marked a new era for Mercyhurst football, with Riemedio at the forefront of its evolution.

Over his first three seasons, Riemedio's teams achieved multiple milestones. In 2023, the Lakers earned their first PSAC win under his leadership in dramatic fashion—a last-second, 36–35 road victory over Clarion. That season also marked an offensive surge, with the Lakers scoring 40 or more points in three games, a program-first for a head coach in their first two seasons. The offense set a school record with a 59.85% completion rate and finished fifth all-time in single-season passing touchdowns with 23.

In 2022, his debut season, Riemedio led the team to a 2–0 start with dominant wins over Alderson Broaddus and Lock Haven, outscoring opponents 94–35. That year featured All-PSAC performances from Dustin Shoaf and Jacob Holl, with Holl earning national recognition on the D2Football.com Top 100.

Riemedio previously spent a decade on the Mercyhurst staff in multiple roles, including Defensive Coordinator, Assistant Head Coach, and Recruiting Coordinator. In 2022, his defense ranked among the top 50 in NCAA Division II in Total Defense, Rushing Defense, Passing Yards Allowed, and 4th Down Conversions. Four players earned PSAC West All-Conference honors under his defensive leadership.

Off the field, Riemedio is recognized as a leader in diversity and professional development. He participated in the NCAA Leadership Collective and the NCAA/NFL Coaches Academy in 2021, and he remains active on several university committees, including the Presidential Search Committee, Staff Senate, and as chair of the AthL.E.A.D. Student-Athlete Committee. He also coordinates the football program's community outreach, DEI initiatives, and social media strategy.

Before joining Mercyhurst, Riemedio coached at Monterey Peninsula College (JUCO) in California, where he served as Defensive Coordinator and helped lead the team to a conference championship and bowl appearance. Across three seasons at MPC, he coached multiple All-State and All-Conference players, with more than 40 athletes moving on to four-year institutions.

Riemedio holds a bachelor's degree in corporate fitness from Minot State University, where he was a two-year starter and team captain at linebacker. He earned his associate's degree from Monterey Peninsula College, where he also played on two conference championship teams.

A native of Marina/Seaside, California, Riemedio lives in Erie with his wife Morgan, daughters Amelia and Tallulah, and son Tripp.
