ON THE HILL

THE GAME

Mercyhurst will play for a share of the NEC Regular Season Title Saturday in New Britain, Connecticut. With a win, the Lakers guarantee a share of the title with Central Connecticut. However, Mercyhurst is still ineligible for the postseason as it reclassifies. CCSU, Duquesne, Wagner and Mercyhurst can share the regular season title if the Dukes, Seahawks, and Lakers are victorious this weekend.

The game is set to kickoff at noon and will be streamed on NEC Front Row.

ABOUT THE LAKERS

The Lakers are out to a 2-0 start in the month of November, similar to their 2-0 start to October. Mercyhurst has beaten in-state rivals in back-to-back weeks, taking down Saint Francis, 16-15 on the road and Robert Morris 27-13 at home. The Lakers offense found it's rhythm once again, recording 378 total yards against the Colonials, going 3-for-3 on trips to the redzone and had just one turnover.

The Lakers struggled to find the endzone in the first half, settling for two field goals, but tremendous play from Brian Trobel in the second half led the Lakers to their four official conference victory of the season.

SCOUTING THE BLUE DEVILS

The Blue Devils sit atop the NEC Standings with a 5-1 conference record, but have not secured the automatic qualifier to the FCS playoffs yet with their loss to Duquesne last weekend.

Running Back Elijah Howard has been a

dominant force for the Blue Devils all season, leading the league in total rushing yards (915) and rushing yards per game (91.5). Quarterback Brady Olson has been equally as dangerous, leading the NEC in efficiency (134.4) and passing yards per game (236.4). Olson has thrown 20 touchdowns on the year with just six interceptions with a 59.1 completion percentage.

ABOUT THE SERIES

Mercyhurst and CCSU met for the first time last season in New Britain. The Blue Devils took the first ever meeting 38-20. Lakers quarterback Adam Urena threw for 286 yards, a touchdown, and three interceptions.

 TEAM NOTES**CHAMPIONSHIP IMPLICATIONS**

While the Lakers are still ineligible for the NCAA postseason, the team will fight for a share of the NEC Regular Season Title on Saturday. Mercyhurst needs a win to share the title with at least CCSU, but it could be a four way tie between the Lakers, Blue Devils, Wagner, and Duquesne depending on the results of those contests.

TAKING THE LEAGUE BY STORM

If the Lakers win a share of the NEC title, they would be the fastest team to win the league in their first full season of NEC play. Sacred Heart previously did it, joining the league in 1998 and winning the regular season title in 2001 in their fourth season of NEC play.

RECORD NOTES

The Lakers have a shot at their first .500 or better season since 2019 when they finished 6-5. Despite a 1-4 start, the Lakers found their footing in NEC play with a 4-2 record since.

Mercyhurst has secured its first winning conference record since the 2014 season when the Lakers went 6-3 in PSAC play under the direction of Marty Schaeztle.

LAST MEETING

Mercyhurst and CCSU battled for the first time on the gridiron last season. After Mercyhurst scored the opening touchdown, the Blue Devils responded with 31 unanswered points, taking a 31-7 lead in the third quarter. Brian Trobel scored all three touchdowns for the Lakers in the 38-20 loss at Arute Field.

BEST OF THE BEST

The Lakers were tested in the non-conference slate, playing four opponents ranked in the top 25 of the media and coaches poll. YSU was receiving votes when the Lakers saw them. Sacramento State was 21, Montana State was ranked 5 and South Dakota State was ranked second.

NEW LOOK

The Lakers bring in 56 new faces for the 2025 season, including 30 freshmen and 26 transfers.

 OFFENSIVE NOTES**SCORING FIRST**

Mercyhurst is 4-0 when scoring first. The Lakers have just one come-from-behind win, happening Nov. 8 at Saint Francis.

2000 YARD PASSER

Adam Urena has surpassed 2000 passing yards for the third season in a row. Urena is the first Lakers quarterback with 2000 passing yards since Doug Altavilla had back-to-back season with 2000 passing yards in 2016 and 2017.

TRIPLE TROBEL

Brian Trobel recorded his third game of the season with over 100 rushing yards against RMU. Trobel went for a career-high 150 yards on 16 carries. The senior has three games with multiple touchdowns, all against NEC opponents.

SHARING THE WEALTH

The Lakers have a three-headed monster in the wide receiver room in Dylan Evans, Evan Van Dyke and Rylan Davison. The three have combined for 1428 yards and eight touchdowns on the year.

CONVERTING

The Lakers have been successful converting on third and fourth down opportunities. On third down, Mercyhurst converts at a clip of 40 percent and on fourth down, the Lakers have converted 18-of-35 times. Mercyhurst's 35 fourth down conversion attempts are the most in the FCS.

AIR RAID

In NEC games, the Lakers average 198.2 yards per contest which is second-best in the league behind CCSU. Mercyhurst has the best completion percentage in NEC games at 63.2 percent.

RECORD SETTING

The Laker offense posted 647 yards of total offense against New Haven, the most since at least 2012 and the most in the FCS era. Lakers quarterbacks recorded 370 yards in the air while Mercyhurst rushers combined for 277 yards on the ground.

The Lakers have tallied 600+ yards of total offense four times since 2012. Mercyhurst posted 600+ yards of total offense twice in the 2014 season. They posted 628 yards in a 45-38 win over Gannon (10/11/14) and 640 yards in a 59-49 win over California (Pa.) (11/8/14). The Lakers also recorded 628 yards against Gannon in a 2013 51-21 victory (10/17/13).

SHUTTING DOWN THE PASS

The Lakers have one of the best pass defenses in the NEC, allowing 150.2 yards through the air to NEC foes and only given up a league-best five passing touchdowns.

OUT OF THE ENDZONE

The Lakers have held opponents to just one touchdown in the last two games. They also held both Saint Francis and Robert Morris under 20 points. The Lakers are 5-1 when allowing under 21 points.

SACKS

Mercyhurst recorded three sacks in a game for the second time this season. Kyler Laing, Donovan Everette, and Jonas King combined for four sacks at Wagner while Laing, King, and Jaiden Allos tallied four against Robert Morris

HEAD COACH

RYAN RIEMEDIO

Ryan Riemedio enters his fourth season as Head Coach of the Mercyhurst football program in 2025. Appointed to the role in January 2022 after being named head coach-in-waiting the previous fall, Riemedio took the reins following the retirement of 20-year head coach Marty Schaetzle. He became just the sixth head coach in program history.

In 2024, Riemedio guided the Lakers through a historic transition, as the program moved from NCAA Division II to the Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS). Despite the heightened level of competition, the Lakers remained competitive and laid a solid foundation for the future. The team showed resilience and growth against FCS opponents, highlighting the staff's ability to prepare and develop players at the next level. The move marked a new era for Mercyhurst football, with Riemedio at the forefront of its evolution.

Over his first three seasons, Riemedio's teams achieved multiple milestones. In 2023, the Lakers earned their first PSAC win under his leadership in dramatic fashion—a last-second, 36–35 road victory over Clarion. That season also marked an offensive surge, with the Lakers scoring 40 or more points in three games, a program-first for a head coach in their first two seasons. The offense set a school record with a 59.85% completion rate and finished fifth all-time in single-season passing touchdowns with 23.

In 2022, his debut season, Riemedio led the team to a 2–0 start with dominant wins over Alderson Broaddus and Lock Haven, outscoring opponents 94–35. That year featured All-PSAC performances from Dustin Shoaf and Jacob Holl, with Holl earning national recognition on the D2Football.com Top 100.

Riemedio previously spent a decade on the Mercyhurst staff in multiple roles, including Defensive Coordinator, Assistant Head Coach, and Recruiting Coordinator. In 2022, his defense ranked among the top 50 in NCAA Division II in Total Defense, Rushing Defense, Passing Yards Allowed, and 4th Down Conversions. Four players earned PSAC West All-Conference honors under his defensive leadership.

Off the field, Riemedio is recognized as a leader in diversity and professional development. He participated in the NCAA Leadership Collective and the NCAA/NFL Coaches Academy in 2021, and he remains active on several university committees, including the Presidential Search Committee, Staff Senate, and as chair of the AthL.E.A.D. Student-Athlete Committee. He also coordinates the football program's community outreach, DEI initiatives, and social media strategy.

Before joining Mercyhurst, Riemedio coached at Monterey Peninsula College (JUCO) in California, where he served as Defensive Coordinator and helped lead the team to a conference championship and bowl appearance. Across three seasons at MPC, he coached multiple All-State and All-Conference players, with more than 40 athletes moving on to four-year institutions.

Riemedio holds a bachelor's degree in corporate fitness from Minot State University, where he was a two-year starter and team captain at linebacker. He earned his associate's degree from Monterey Peninsula College, where he also played on two conference championship teams.

A native of Marina/Seaside, California, Riemedio lives in Erie with his wife Morgan, daughters Amelia and Tallulah, and son Tripp.
