ON THE HILL

THE GAME

Mercyhurst looks to stop a two-game losing streak Saturday at Saint Francis. This will be the first meeting between the Lakers and the Red Flash in Loretto since Mercyhurst took down SFU 13-6 in 1996. This will be the second meeting since Mercyhurst joined the FCS and the NEC last season. The Lakers scored their first unofficial NEC victory last season over the Red Flash in Erie, 21-20.

Saturday's game will be broadcast on NEC Front Row with kickoff set for Noon.

ABOUT THE LAKERS

Mercyhurst has suffered two consecutive losses after starting conference play 2-0 with wins over LIU and Wagner. The Lakers have lost the last two at home to Duquesne and Stonehill. Duquesne handled the Lakers 37-0 while Stonehill used an early lead to take down Mercyhurst 22-15.

The Green and Blue have been slow starting games offensively, getting out scored in the first quarter 72-36 and in the first half 145-93.

The Lakers went 0-of-3 on fourth down conversion attempts against Stonehill, which is unusual for the Lakers team that had converted on fourth down 55 percent of the time prior to that game.

SCOUTING THE RED FLASH

Saint Francis is winless on the year and winless in NEC games in 2025. The Red Flash is last in the conference in scoring offense (10.8) and scoring defense (34.7). SFU is last in rush attempts (234) and rushing yards per game (75.2) and well

as rushing defense (217.2 yds/gm) with 22 rushing touchdowns allowed.

SFU quarterback Nick Whitfield Jr. is fourth in the NEC in passing yards per game, averaging 116.2 per contest. Whitfield also leads the league in interceptions with 11.

Inside linebacker Geno Calgaro has been excellent for the SFU defense as he leads the NEC in total tackles (77) and is sixth in tackles for a loss (8.5).

ABOUT THE SERIES

The two Pennsylvania schools met nine times prior to last year's contest in Erie. The Lakers and the Red Flash met four years in a row from 1981-84 and renewed the rivalry from 1992-97. The Lakers led the all-time series 9-1-1. The teams tied 6-6 in the first ever meeting in 1981.

 TEAM NOTES**LAST MEETING**

The Lakers earned a dramatic 21-20 victory over the Red Flash in last year's meeting in Erie. The Lakers were down 20-13 in the final five minutes of the fourth quarter with the ball. Urena and the Laker offense marched 66 yards down the field in 11 plays, to make it 20-19 in favor of SFU. Mercyhurst converted on the two point conversion on a pass from offensive lineman Ryan Welch.

SCORING FIRST

Mercyhurst is 3-0 in contest in which they score first. They are also 3-0 in contest in which they lead at half time.

PROTECT THE BALL

The Lakers are 2-0 in contest in which they win the turnover battle. Turnovers have plagued the team as they have a -6 turnover margin.

BEST OF THE BEST

The Lakers were tested in the non-conference slate, playing four opponents ranked in the top 25 of the media and coaches poll. YSU was receiving votes when the Lakers saw them and is currently 18/24. Sacramento State was 21 and is now RV, Montana State is ranked 5 and South Dakota State is ranked second.

FULL SLATE

The Lakers will play their first full Division I slate in 2025, the second year competing in the FCS. In 2024, Mercyhurst faced four non-DI opponents, going 3-1. The Laker defense recorded two shutout performances in those games holding Buffalo State and Lincoln (CA) scoreless.

GOLDEN STATE CONNECTIONS

12 players on the team come from California JUCOs, including QB Adam Urena and his brother, Austin, who spent two seasons at Citrus Community College.

Head coach Ryan Riemedio is a native of Seaside, California and played football at Monterey Peninsula College, just a 3 hour car ride from Sacramento.

NEW LOOK

The Lakers bring in 56 new faces for the 2025 season, including 30 freshmen and 26 transfers.

 OFFENSIVE NOTES**RUN GAME**

The run game has been vital in the Lakers NEC games. In their two NEC wins, the Lakers are averaging 143 rushing yards per game. In NEC losses, the Lakers average just 55 per game. The Lakers are 3-0 when out rushing opponents this season.

CONVERTING

The Lakers have been successful converting on third and fourth down opportunities. On third down, Mercyhurst converts at a clip of 50 percent and on fourth down, the Lakers have converted 15-of-30 times. Mercyhurst's 30 fourth down conversion attempts are tied for most in the FCS.

AIR RAID

The Lakers average the most passing yards per contest among NEC squads, excluding New Haven, with 226.3 per contest. Nearly 69 percent of the Lakers total offense comes through the air.

20 IS KEY

The Lakers are 2-0 in contests in which they score 20 or more points. Their third win over Wagner, the Lakers were just one shy of 20 in the 19-7 victory.

RECORD SETTING

The Laker offense posted 647 yards of total offense against New Haven, the most since at least 2012 and the most in the FCS era. Lakers quarterbacks recorded 370 yards in the air while Mercyhurst rushers combined for 277 yards on the ground.

The Lakers have tallied 600+ yards of total offense four times since 2012. Mercyhurst posted 600+ yards of total offense twice in the 2014 season. They posted 628 yards in a 45-38 win over Gannon (10/11/14) and 640 yards in a 59-49 win over California (Pa.) (11/8/14). The Lakers also recorded 628 yards against Gannon in a 2013 51-21 victory (10/17/13).

DEFENSIVE NOTES

SHUTTING DOWN THE PASS

The Lakers have one of the best pass defenses in the NEC, allowing 174.7 yards through the air per game and just 158 in conference games.

BALL HAWKS

Mercyhurst has forced three fumbles and caught four interceptions through the first four games of conference play.

NEC SACKS

Five of the Lakers six sacks on the season have come during conference play. Graduate linebacker Kyler Laing leads the way with 2.5 sacks for 14 yards.

THIRD QUARTER

The Mercyhurst defense has held opponents to just 37 points during the third quarter of games, the lowest of any quarter.

ADAM URENA

- NEC Prime Performer (Week 1, 2, & 3)
- Urena's 198.2 passing yards per game are third in the NEC behind New Haven's AJ Duffy and CCSU's Brady Olson
- Leads the NEC with a 65.1 completion percentage in 2025
- Has 179 completions on the season, second in the NEC
- Streak of games with 200+ passing yards came to an end at SDSU. He reached 16 games with 200+ against Montana State. The streak dated back to the 2023 campaign.
- Threw for a career-high 349 yards against New Haven, completing 21-of-27 passes
- In 2024 he became, Mercyhurst's first quarterback with 2,000 passing yards in a season since Doug Altavilla in 2017 (2,345).
- Named the Phil Steele NEC Preseason Offensive Player of the Year.

ALEX GEVAUDAN

- Started and played the entire game for an injured Urena at Wagner. Completed 13-of-24 passes with one 76 yard TD pass.
- Entered the New Haven game in the fourth quarter, completing 4-of-5 passes for 23 yards and an interception.
- Came in for Urena at YSU for a 2-pt conversion attempt after Urena's helmet came off on the previous play. Completed the pass to WR Dylan Evans for the score.

HEAD COACH

RYAN RIEMEDIO

Ryan Riemedio enters his fourth season as Head Coach of the Mercyhurst football program in 2025. Appointed to the role in January 2022 after being named head coach-in-waiting the previous fall, Riemedio took the reins following the retirement of 20-year head coach Marty Schaetzle. He became just the sixth head coach in program history.

In 2024, Riemedio guided the Lakers through a historic transition, as the program moved from NCAA Division II to the Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS). Despite the heightened level of competition, the Lakers remained competitive and laid a solid foundation for the future. The team showed resilience and growth against FCS opponents, highlighting the staff's ability to prepare and develop players at the next level. The move marked a new era for Mercyhurst football, with Riemedio at the forefront of its evolution.

Over his first three seasons, Riemedio's teams achieved multiple milestones. In 2023, the Lakers earned their first PSAC win under his leadership in dramatic fashion—a last-second, 36–35 road victory over Clarion. That season also marked an offensive surge, with the Lakers scoring 40 or more points in three games, a program-first for a head coach in their first two seasons. The offense set a school record with a 59.85% completion rate and finished fifth all-time in single-season passing touchdowns with 23.

In 2022, his debut season, Riemedio led the team to a 2–0 start with dominant wins over Alderson Broaddus and Lock Haven, outscoring opponents 94–35. That year featured All-PSAC performances from Dustin Shoaf and Jacob Holl, with Holl earning national recognition on the D2Football.com Top 100.

Riemedio previously spent a decade on the Mercyhurst staff in multiple roles, including Defensive Coordinator, Assistant Head Coach, and Recruiting Coordinator. In 2022, his defense ranked among the top 50 in NCAA Division II in Total Defense, Rushing Defense, Passing Yards Allowed, and 4th Down Conversions. Four players earned PSAC West All-Conference honors under his defensive leadership.

Off the field, Riemedio is recognized as a leader in diversity and professional development. He participated in the NCAA Leadership Collective and the NCAA/NFL Coaches Academy in 2021, and he remains active on several university committees, including the Presidential Search Committee, Staff Senate, and as chair of the AthL.E.A.D. Student-Athlete Committee. He also coordinates the football program's community outreach, DEI initiatives, and social media strategy.

Before joining Mercyhurst, Riemedio coached at Monterey Peninsula College (JUCO) in California, where he served as Defensive Coordinator and helped lead the team to a conference championship and bowl appearance. Across three seasons at MPC, he coached multiple All-State and All-Conference players, with more than 40 athletes moving on to four-year institutions.

Riemedio holds a bachelor's degree in corporate fitness from Minot State University, where he was a two-year starter and team captain at linebacker. He earned his associate's degree from Monterey Peninsula College, where he also played on two conference championship teams.

A native of Marina/Seaside, California, Riemedio lives in Erie with his wife Morgan, daughters Amelia and Tallulah, and son Tripp.
