ON THE HILL

THE GAME

The Lakers kick off a three-week stretch of long travel with a trip to Sacramento State Sept. 13. This week's trip to California is the longest of the season, as the trip from Mercyhurst to Hornet stadium is 2,170 miles. Kick off is set for 6:00 pm PT/9:00 pm ET and will be streamed on ESPN+. Saturday's contest will be the first meeting between the Lakers and the Hornets.

ABOUT THE LAKERS

The Lakers earned their first win of the year last Saturday in the home opener at Saxon Stadium, taking a 48-14 victory over NEC newcomer New Haven. Mercyhurst's offense was rolling as it posted 647 yards of total offense. Quarterback Adam Urena passed for 347 yards while Brian Trobel led the run game with 114 yards; His first 100+ yard game as a Laker. The win moved the Lakers to 1-1 on the year after falling to Youngstown State on the road in week one.

SCOUTING THE HORNETS

The Hornets started the 2025 season 0-2 with losses to then #3 South Dakota State and Nevada, both on the road. The Hornets fell to SDSU 20-3, posting just 136 yards of total offense. In Week 2, the #18/16 Hornets fell to unranked Nevada on the road. The offense found their footing from game one, tallying 371 total yards, but the Hornets gave up 413 yards to the Wolf Pack. Sacramento State comes into the Week 3 meeting with the Lakers ranked 21 in the AFCA Coaches poll and the Stats Perform FCS Top 25.

ABOUT THE SERIES

Saturday's contest will be the first meeting between Sacramento State and Mercyhurst.

 **TEAM NOTES****EARNING MILES**

The Lakers will travel almost 4,900 miles during the non-conference slate. The longest trip of the year will happen week three when Mercyhurst makes its way to California to take on Sacramento State. From Mercyhurst to Hornet Stadium is 2,170 miles.

FULL SLATE

The Lakers will play their first full Division I slate in 2025, the second year competing in the FCS. In 2024, Mercyhurst faced four non-DI opponents, going 3-1. The Laker defense recorded two shutout performances in those games holding Buffalo State and Lincoln (CA) scoreless.

GOLDEN STATE CONNECTIONS

12 players on the team come from California JUCOs, including QB Adam Urena and his brother, Austin, who spent two seasons at Citrus Community College.

Head coach Ryan Riemedio is a native of Seaside, California and played football at Monterey Peninsula College, just a 3 hour car ride from Sacramento.

BEST OF THE BEST

The Lakers face a challenging non-conference schedule with three teams ranking in the AFCA Coaches Poll top 25 through Week 3. The Lakers' Week 5 opponent, South Dakota State is ranked 2, Week 3 opponent Sacramento State came in at 21 and Week 4 foe Montana State is #6 in the poll. Week 1 opponent YSU was receiving votes in the poll and is now ranked 25 after a 56-17 win over RMU.

PRESEASON OUTLOOK

The Lakers were selected seventh out of eight teams in the NEC Preseason Coaches Poll. No Lakers earned a spot on the All-NEC Preseason Team voted on by the leagues' coaches, but five earned a spot on the Phil Steele NEC Preseason All-Conference Team.

QB Adam Urena was named the NEC Preseason Offensive Player of the Year by the Phil Steele team while Brian Trobel earned a First Team selection and OL Joey Balgo, WR Rylan Davison, and DE Jonas King were named to the Second Team.

NEW LOOK

The Lakers bring in 56 new faces for the 2025 season, including 30 freshmen and 26 transfers.

 **OFFENSIVE NOTES****BALANCED ATTACK**

The Laker offense posted 647 yards of total offense, the most since at least 2012 and the most in the FCS era. Lakers quarterbacks recorded 370 yards in the air while Mercyhurst rushers combined for 277 yards on the ground.

The Lakers have tallied 600+ yards of total offense four times since 2012. Mercyhurst posted 600+ yards of total offense twice in the 2014 season. They posted 628 yards in a 45-38 win over Gannon (10/11/14) and 640 yards in a 59-49 win over California (Pa.) (11/8/14). The Lakers also recorded 628 yards against Gannon in a 2013 51-21 victory (10/17/13).

NEW KID ON THE HILL

Dylan Evans earned a second consecutive NEC Prime Performer nod following a career effort Saturday vs New Haven. Evans caught seven passes for 157 yards and ran in a 8-yard touchdown. Evans leads the NEC in receiving yards (252), yards per catch (18), and yards per game (126).

TRIPLE THREAT

The Lakers have the NEC's leading passer, rusher, and receiver. Adam Urena is averaging 329 passing yards per game, almost 50 yards better than second-leading passer AJ Duffy of New Haven (280).

Brain Trobel lead the conference in yards (14), yards per carry (9.6) and yards per game (77).

On the receiving side, Dylan Evans leads the NEC in yards (252), yards per catch (18.0) and yards per game (126.0). Evans 126 yards per game is 41 yards better than the second-leading receiver in the league.

MOOKIE MADNESS

Jameir "Mookie" Gamble was named the NEC Rookie of the Week following an outstanding week two performance. The frosh recorded 67 all purpose yards in th 48-14 win over New Haven. Through two games, Gamble is the second-leading rusher for the Lakers with 75 yards on 14 carries, averaging 5.3 yds/carry.

RED ZONE SUCCESS

The Lakers have scored seven touchdowns in their 10 trips to the redzone this season for a conversion percentage of 70 percent.

FIRST DOWNS

Mercyhurst's 50 first downs is tied for seventh most in the FCS through week two.

THIRD DOWN

The Lakers have been successful on both sides of the ball on third down. The offense is converting 50 percent of its third down chances while the defense is holding opponents to 27.3 third down conversion percentage.

 **DEFENSIVE NOTES****SHUTTING DOWN THE PASS**

Through the first two games of the season, the Lakers have allowed 148.5 passing yards per game, good for 21st best in FCS.

TOUGH TO SCORE

The Lakers held New Haven scoreless for over 42 minutes of game time. The Chargers scored their first touchdown with 8:05 on the game clock in the first quarter and didn't add to their tally until 9:36 remaining in the fourth quarter. The Lakers forced six punts and a turnover on downs between the Chargers scoring drives.

THREE AND OUT

The Lakers defense has allowed just 29 first downs in the first two games of the year compared the offense's 50.

SCORING DEFENSE

The Lakers have held opponents to an average of 19 points per game through the first two contests, tied for 25th best in FCS.

- Urena's passing efficiency of 155.9 is second best in the NEC behind Duquesne's Tyler Riddell (190.3).
- Tallied his 12th consecutive game with 200+ passing yards and seventh career game with 300+ yards in the 48-14 win over NH
- In 2024 he became, Mercyhurst's

first quarterback with 2,000 passing yards in a season since Doug Altavilla in 2017 (2,345).

- Named the Phil Steele NEC Preseason Offensive Player of the Year.

ALEX GEVAUDAN

- Entered the New Haven game in the fourth quarter, completing 4-of-5 passes for 23 yards and an interception.
- Came in for Urena at YSU for a 2-pt conversion attempt after Urena's helmet came off on the previous play. Completed the pass to WR Dylan Evans for the score.

HEAD COACH

RYAN RIEMEDIO

Ryan Riemedio enters his fourth season as Head Coach of the Mercyhurst football program in 2025. Appointed to the role in January 2022 after being named head coach-in-waiting the previous fall, Riemedio took the reins following the retirement of 20-year head coach Marty Schaetzle. He became just the sixth head coach in program history.

In 2024, Riemedio guided the Lakers through a historic transition, as the program moved from NCAA Division II to the Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS). Despite the heightened level of competition, the Lakers remained competitive and laid a solid foundation for the future. The team showed resilience and growth against FCS opponents, highlighting the staff's ability to prepare and develop players at the next level. The move marked a new era for Mercyhurst football, with Riemedio at the forefront of its evolution.

Over his first three seasons, Riemedio's teams achieved multiple milestones. In 2023, the Lakers earned their first PSAC win under his leadership in dramatic fashion—a last-second, 36–35 road victory over Clarion. That season also marked an offensive surge, with the Lakers scoring 40 or more points in three games, a program-first for a head coach in their first two seasons. The offense set a school record with a 59.85% completion rate and finished fifth all-time in single-season passing touchdowns with 23.

In 2022, his debut season, Riemedio led the team to a 2–0 start with dominant wins over Alderson Broaddus and Lock Haven, outscoring opponents 94–35. That year featured All-PSAC performances from Dustin Shoaf and Jacob Holl, with Holl earning national recognition on the D2Football.com Top 100.

Riemedio previously spent a decade on the Mercyhurst staff in multiple roles, including Defensive Coordinator, Assistant Head Coach, and Recruiting Coordinator. In 2022, his defense ranked among the top 50 in NCAA Division II in Total Defense, Rushing Defense, Passing Yards Allowed, and 4th Down Conversions. Four players earned PSAC West All-Conference honors under his defensive leadership.

Off the field, Riemedio is recognized as a leader in diversity and professional development. He participated in the NCAA Leadership Collective and the NCAA/NFL Coaches Academy in 2021, and he remains active on several university committees, including the Presidential Search Committee, Staff Senate, and as chair of the AthL.E.A.D. Student-Athlete Committee. He also coordinates the football program's community outreach, DEI initiatives, and social media strategy.

Before joining Mercyhurst, Riemedio coached at Monterey Peninsula College (JUCO) in California, where he served as Defensive Coordinator and helped lead the team to a conference championship and bowl appearance. Across three seasons at MPC, he coached multiple All-State and All-Conference players, with more than 40 athletes moving on to four-year institutions.

Riemedio holds a bachelor's degree in corporate fitness from Minot State University, where he was a two-year starter and team captain at linebacker. He earned his associate's degree from Monterey Peninsula College, where he also played on two conference championship teams.

A native of Marina/Seaside, California, Riemedio lives in Erie with his wife Morgan, daughters Amelia and Tallulah, and son Tripp.
