THE GAME

The Lakers begin the home slate of the 2025 season against NEC newcomer New Haven. The game will not count against the NEC record for the Lakers. It was announced New Haven was joining the conference in May 2025, and they began their first season of competition in the league this fall as the NEC's 10th full-time member. Kick off is set for Noon on Saturday at Saxon Stadium. The contest will be streamed on NEC Front Row.

ABOUT THE LAKERS

The Lakers opened the 2025 campaign on the road at Youngstown State last Thursday, falling 24-15 in a hard fought battle. Mercyhurst went down 21-7 in the first half, but stellar

defense play to start the second half helped the Lakers gain momentum. Mercyhurst pulled within nine with seven minutes to play in the fourth quarter off of a Dylan Evans touchdown and 2-point conversion. However, a costly turnover on the next Lakers possession allowed YSU to take a 24-15 victory in the season opener at Stambaugh Stadium.

SCOUTING THE CHARGERS

The Chargers played their first contest as a Division I school last Saturday, falling to Marist 31-14. Quarterback AJ Duffy was named the NEC Offensive Player of the Week following the game. Duffy posted 377 passing yards, completing 56 percent of his pass attempts, while throwing for two touchdowns. Duffy

SHINING AT SAXON

The Lakers went 3-1 at home in 2024, averaging 41.5 points in games played at Saxon Stadium. Three of the four games were against non-DI opponents, but the Lakers scored their first-ever DI win in the final game of the season at home in a 21-20 win over Saint Francis.

HOME OPENERS

Since 2005, MU is 11-8 in home openers. The last home-opening win came in 2023 when the Lakers defeated Lock Haven, 41-29.

FULL SLATE

The Lakers will play their first full Division I slate in 2025, the second year competing in the FCS. In 2024, Mercyhurst faced four non-DI opponents, going 3-1. The Laker defense recorded two shutout performances in those games holding Buffalo State and Lincoln (CA) scoreless.

BEST OF THE BEST

The Lakers face a challenging non-conference schedule with three teams ranking in the AFCA Coaches Poll top 25 through Week 2. The Lakers' Week 5 opponent, South Dakota State is ranked 2, Week 3 opponent Sacramento State came in at 16, and Week 4 foe Montana State is T-3 in the poll. Week 1 opponent YSU was receiving votes in the poll and still garnered 17 points in the Week 2 poll.

PRESEASON OUTLOOK

The Lakers were selected seventh out of eight teams in the NEC Preseason Coaches Poll. No Lakers earned a spot on the All-NEC Preseason Team voted on by the leagues' coaches, but five earned a spot on the Phil Steel NEC Preseason All-Conference Team.

QB Adam Urena was named the NEC Preseason Offensive Player of the Year by the Phil Steele team while Brian Trobel earned a First Team selection and OL Joey Balgo, WR Rylan Davison, and DE Jonas King were named to the Second Team

EARNING MILES

The Lakers will travel almost 4,900 miles during the non-conference slate. The longest trip of the year will happen week three when Mercyhurst makes its way to California to take on Sacramento State. From Mercyhurst to Hornet Stadium is 2,170 miles.

NEW LOOK

The Lakers bring in 56 new faces for the 2025 season, including 30 freshmen and 26 transfers.

GOLDEN STATE CONNECTIONS

12 players on the team come from California JUCOs, including QB Adam Urena and his brother, Austin, who spent two seasons at Citrus Community College.

Head coach Ryan Riemedio is a native of Seaside, California and played football at Monterey Peninsula College in Monterey.

TEAM OFFENSIVE NOTES

2025 DEBUT

Led by quarterback Adam Urena, the Lakers offense looked strong in the season debut, despite costly turnovers. Urena threw for 311 yds and two passing TDs, but also threw two interceptions.

The team relied on the passing game again as they did in 2024, converting 14 of 20 first downs through the air. The offense tallied 374 yds of total offense.

NEW KID ON THE HILL

Urena had a new favorite target in game one in redshirt sophomore transfer from New Hampshire, Dylan Evans. Evans caught seven passes for 95 yds and a TD. He also converted a 2-pt conversion attempt in the fourth quarter. Evans was named an NEC Prime Performer for his work in Week 1.

AIR RAID

Mercyhurst scored both of its touchdowns and the 2-pt conversion through the air at YSU. The Lakers averaged 9.7 yds/completion.

RUSHING ATTACK

Brian Trobel was the Lakers' leading rusher against the Penguins. Trobel ran for 40 yards, averaging 5.7 yards per carry and a long of 16 yds.

MOOKIE MADNESS

Freshman Jameir "Mookie" Gamble made his presence known in Week 1. Gamble recorded 39 all-purpose yards, rushing for 21 and receiving for 18. He caught a 12-yard pass from Urena in the Lakers fourth quarter touchdown drive, converting on third down to extend the drive.

SHUTTING DOWN THE PASS

The Lakers allowed just 114 passing yards in the season opener, which ranks 15th in the FCS.

In 2024, the Lakers allowed 198.1 passing yards per game, which ranked 40th in FCS. Mercyhurst has allowed 300+ passing yards just four times in the past four seasons.

The Lakers held YSU to a 112.27 pass efficiency, good for 37th in FCS in Week 1.

STRONG FINISH

The Lakers did not allow a touchdown in the second half at YSU and held the Penguins to 17 passing yards and 66 rush yards in the second half.

RYAN RIEMEDIO

Ryan Riemedio enters his fourth season as Head Coach of the Mercyhurst football program in 2025. Appointed to the role in January 2022 after being named head coach-in-waiting the previous fall, Riemedio took the reins following the retirement of 20-year head coach Marty Schaetzle. He became just the sixth head coach in program history.

In 2024, Riemedio guided the Lakers through a historic transition, as the program moved from NCAA Division II to the Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS). Despite the heightened level of competition, the Lakers remained competitive and laid a solid foundation for the future. The team showed resilience and growth against FCS opponents, highlighting the staff's ability to prepare and develop players at the next level. The move marked a new era for Mercyhurst football, with Riemedio at the forefront of its evolution.

Over his first three seasons, Riemedio's teams achieved multiple milestones. In 2023, the Lakers earned their first PSAC win under his leadership in dramatic fashion—a last-second, 36–35 road victory over Clarion. That season also marked an offensive surge, with the Lakers scoring 40 or more points in three games, a program-first for a head coach in their first two seasons. The offense set a school record with a 59.85% completion rate and finished fifth all-time in single-season passing touchdowns with 23.

In 2022, his debut season, Riemedio led the team to a 2–0 start with dominant wins over Alderson Broaddus and Lock Haven, outscoring opponents 94–35. That year featured All-PSAC performances from Dustin Shoaf and Jacob Holl, with Holl earning national recognition on the D2Football.com Top 100.

Riemedio previously spent a decade on the Mercyhurst staff in multiple roles, including Defensive Coordinator, Assistant Head Coach, and Recruiting Coordinator. In 2022, his defense ranked among the top 50 in NCAA Division II in Total Defense, Rushing Defense, Passing Yards Allowed, and 4th Down Conversions. Four players earned PSAC West All-Conference honors under his defensive leadership.

Off the field, Riemedio is recognized as a leader in diversity and professional development. He participated in the NCAA Leadership Collective and the NCAA/NFL Coaches Academy in 2021, and he remains active on several university committees, including the Presidential Search Committee, Staff Senate, and as chair of the AthL.E.A.D. Student-Athlete Committee. He also coordinates the football program's community outreach, DEI initiatives, and social media strategy.

Before joining Mercyhurst, Riemedio coached at Monterey Peninsula College (JUCO) in California, where he served as Defensive Coordinator and helped lead the team to a conference championship and bowl appearance. Across three seasons at MPC, he coached multiple All-State and All-Conference players, with more than 40 athletes moving on to four-year institutions.

Riemedio holds a bachelor's degree in corporate fitness from Minot State University, where he was a two-year starter and team captain at linebacker. He earned his associate's degree from Monterey Peninsula College, where he also played on two conference championship teams.

A native of Marina/Seaside, California, Riemedio lives in Erie with his wife Morgan, daughters Amelia and Tallulah, and son Tripp.
