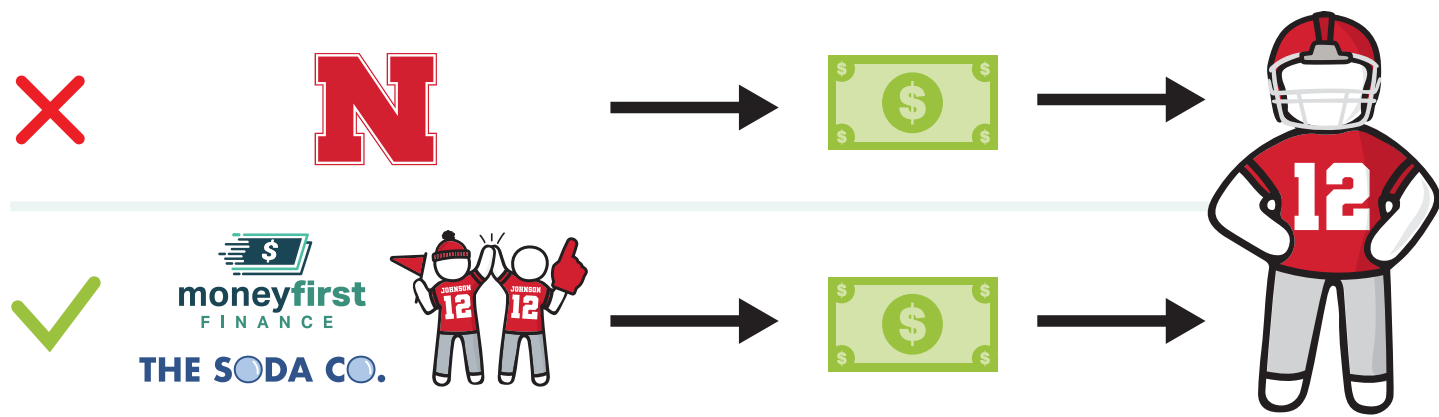


NIL POLICIES

WHAT ARE NIL ACTIVITIES?

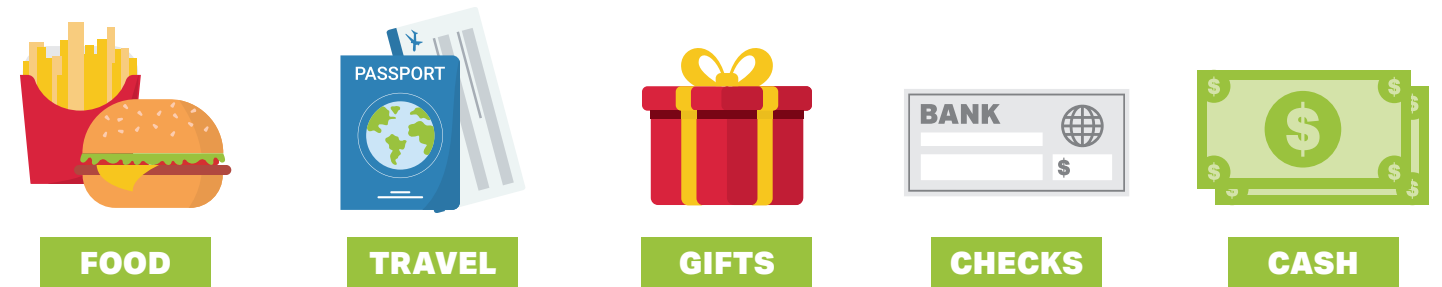
When student-athletes receive compensation for providing services, selling products, hosting events, accepting donations, monetizing media, or licensing rights to/for others tied to their name, image, or likeness, that is an NIL activity.

MAY I COMPENSATE A STUDENT-ATHLETE FOR AN NIL ACTIVITY?



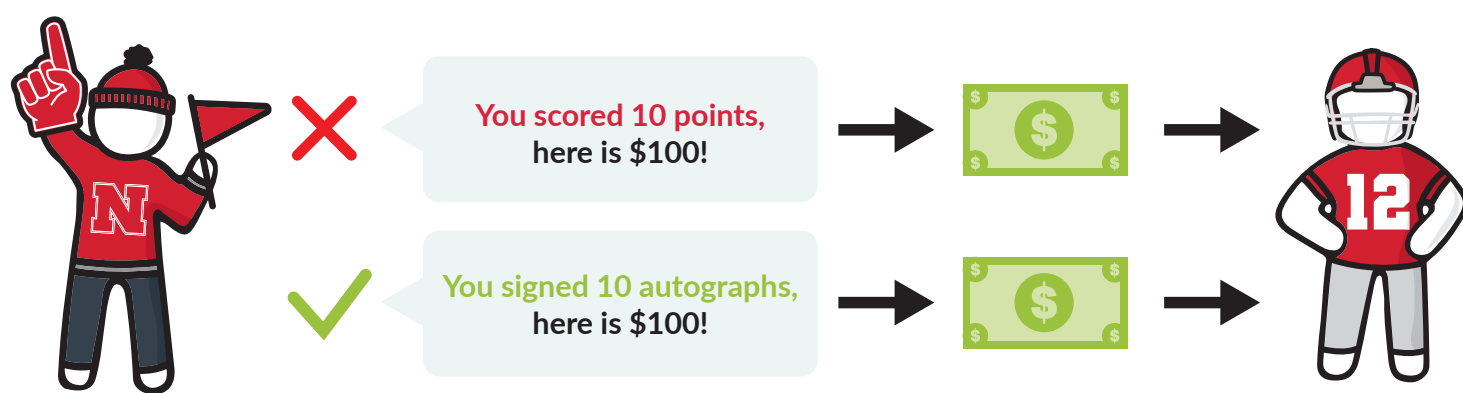
Payment Source Policy. Yes, boosters may compensate student-athletes for NIL activities.

HOW MAY I COMPENSATE A STUDENT-ATHLETE FOR AN NIL ACTIVITY?



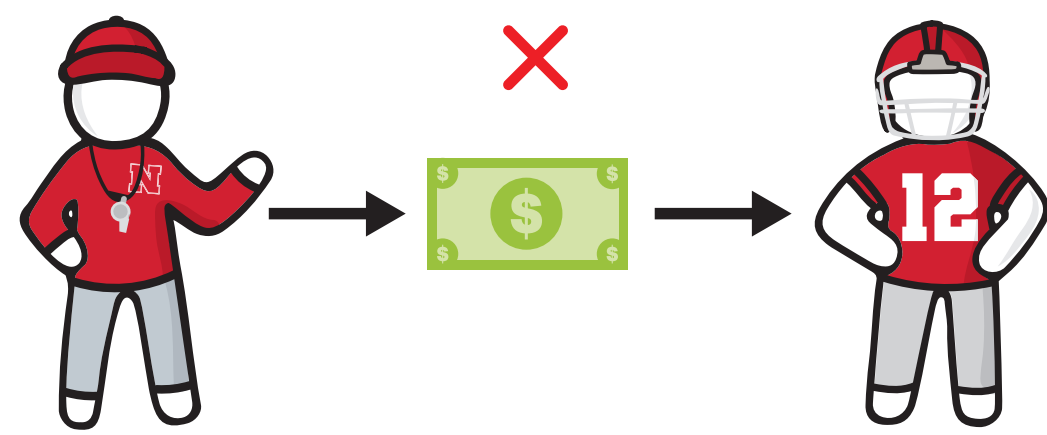
Payment Method Policy. You may compensate a student-athlete for NIL activities many different ways: cash, checks, digital credits, gift cards, free products or services, paid travel, complimentary meals and more.

WHAT CAN I COMPENSATE A STUDENT-ATHLETE FOR?



Payment Purpose Policy. You cannot pay or provide any sort of remuneration to a student-athlete for their athletic performance (i.e. compensation cannot be contingent on amount of touchdowns, points scored, or sacks).

MAY STAFF CONNECT ME WITH STUDENT-ATHLETES?



Institutional Education Policy. UNL staff members cannot facilitate meetings between student-athletes and boosters.

MAY A CURRENT OR PROSPECTIVE STUDENT-ATHLETE BE COMPENSATED FOR ENROLLMENT?



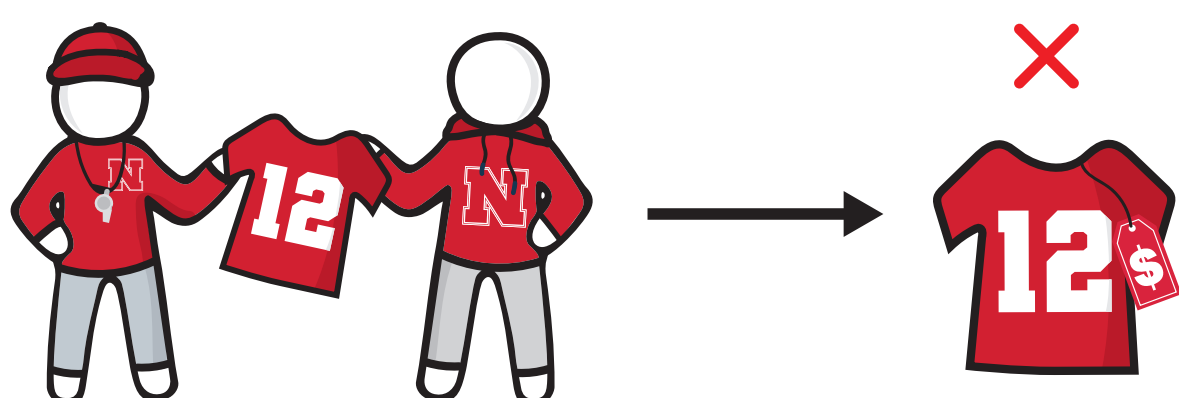
Recruiting Inducement Policy. No, NIL activities cannot be used for recruiting purposes. You cannot use NIL as an inducement for a prospective student-athlete to enroll at our institution. You cannot use NIL as an inducement for a current student-athlete to remain enrolled at our institution.

DO NIL ACTIVITIES NEED TO BE DISCLOSED TO THE INSTITUTION?



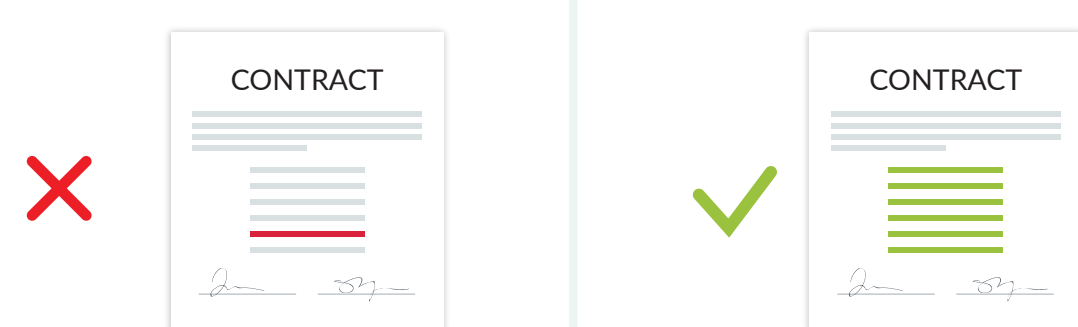
Disclosure Policy. Yes. All NIL deals must be disclosed by the student-athlete via Opendorse. Student-athletes are encouraged to disclose deals at least five days prior to the execution of the activity, but in any event, disclosure shall be made within five days after execution.

CAN STUDENT-ATHLETES SELL MEMORABILIA DURING NIL ACTIVITIES?



Memorabilia Sales Policy. Student-athletes can not participate in NIL activities that involve the sale or exchange of awards or any other item received for athletics participation, including, but not limited to, apparel, equipment, shoes, or uniform.

WHICH ACTIVITIES ARE PROHIBITED FOR STUDENT-ATHLETES?



Prohibited Activities Policy. You can not participate in NIL activities that conflict with school values or agreements or extend beyond your participation in an athletic program at the University. Refer to the full NIL Policy for a complete list of activities to avoid.
