Game Preview

The Indiana State women's basketball team closes out the month of November on the road this Thursday, Nov. 29, traveling to St. Louis, Mo., for a matchup with the Saint Louis Billikens. Tipoff is set for 8:00 p.m. (ET), 7:00 p.m. locally in Missouri from Chaifetz Arena.

The game can be heard live on WIBQ 98.5 FM and on the Nelligan Sports Marketing Radio Network as Brent Holl covers all the action on the court.

Indiana State will look for their first road win of the season on Thursday, as the Sycamores have dropped games at Indiana (L, 48-60) and IUPUI (L, 67-71) earlier this month. Thursday's game is also the first time this season that Indiana State has traveled outside the state of Indiana.

The Sycamores improved to a perfect 3-0 at home in 2012-13 last Sunday, topping Belmont in a defensive battle, 48-34. Junior Anna Munn knocked down a career-high six three-pointers in the contest and led the team with a season-high 19 points, while freshman Marina Laramie added 13 points and seven rebounds in 24 minutes off the bench.

A Little History -- Saint Louis

Thursday's game will be the fifth meeting between Indiana State and Saint Louis, with the Sycamores holding a 3-1 edge in the series. The Sycamores swept a three-game series with the Billikens from 1986-89 before SLU earned their first win in the series at home on Dec. 21, 2002. Outside of their games with Missouri State and during the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament, Thursday's game will be the first for Indiana State in the state of Missouri since defeating Southeast Missouri in Cape Girardeau, 75-72, on Nov. 28, 2008.

Scouting The Billikens

Saint Louis enters Thursday's game with a 2-3 record, coming off a 55-44 win in their home opener over Western Illinois last Saturday. The Billikens went 1-3 in their four-game road swing to start the season, falling at Missouri (51-67), UMKC (53-56) and Oklahoma (33-68) before topping Nebraska Omaha (51-42). Junior Lorreal Jones leads the team in scoring (11.8 points per game) and rebounding (7.6 rebounds per game) this season, while also shooting 25-for-45 (55.6%) from the field. Senior Courtney Webb is also averaging in double figures (11.4 points per game), knocking down a team-leading 10 three-pointers this season. Turnovers have been a problem for the Billikens this season, as the team is averaging 20.6 miscues per game.

Under 61

Indiana State is 27-3 when holding their opposition under 61 points in their three seasons with head coach Teri Moren, including a 3-1 mark this season. During MVC games, ISU is 12-1 under head coach Moren when teams score 60 points or fewer. When teams go over 60 points against ISU in the last three seasons, the Sycamores are 7-31.

Off To A Good Start

Junior Anna Munn has posted double-figure scoring efforts in all five games this season, totaling 18 points against Eastern Illinois, 14 points against Marshall, 16 points at Indiana, 12 points at IUPUI and 19 points against Belmont. Munn is the first Sycamore to start a season with five straight double-digit scoring games since Kelsey Luna at the beginning of the 2008-09 season. The last member of the team to post six straight double-figure scoring efforts to start a season was Melanie Boeglin, who scored at least 10 points in the first 16 games of the 2005-06 season.

League-Leading Defense

Indiana State leads the MVC in points allowed per game this season, as ISU's opponents have averaged 50.6 points per game through five contests. ISU allowed 60.0 points per game in head coach Teri Moren's first season (2010-11) and 58.6 points per game last season.

Dishing It Out

Senior Taylor Whitley stands in seventh place in Indiana State history for career assists, entering Thursday's game with 293 for her career. The Geneva, Ill., native, has passed JoDee Rigel (278 -- 1977-81), Barbara Graves (280 -- 1979-83), Tracy Johnson (282 -- 1978-82) and Kim Darner (286 -- 1988-92) this season to break into the Top 10. Whitley needs 87 more assists to pass Amy Walker (379 -- 1991-95) for sixth place.

Among The Best

Junior Anna Munn leads the MVC and ranks in a tie for 14th in the nation with an average of 3.4 three-point field goals made per game. The ISU junior has knocked down at least one trey in all five games this season and has made at least four in three separate contests.

Team Assists

Indiana State is tied for the conference lead with an average of 14.2 assists per game as a team. The Sycamores have posted double-digit assists in all five games this season, including 21 in their season-opening victory over Eastern Illinois.

On A Good Pace: Part I

Senior Taylor Whitley enters Thursday's game with 826 career points, needing to average 7.5 points per game in her senior season to become the 26th member of the 1,000 Point Club at Indiana State. The Geneva, Ill., product averaged 7.6 points per game as a freshman and 12.1 points per game as a sophomore before totaling a 7.5 points per game average as a junior following an early-season knee injury.

On A Good Pace: Part II

Junior Anna Munn has knocked down 110 three-pointers in her time at Indiana State, a pace that puts the junior guard on her way to enter the Top 10 in the career rankings. Munn is just 13 threes away from 10th place, held by Georgia Bottoms (123 -- 1993-98). The Indianapolis native is tied for the MVC lead with 17 treys this season.

Second-Chance Points

ISU ranks second in the conference by averaging 15.2 offensive rebounds per game. The Sycamores are averaging 3.4 more offensive rebounds per game than their opponents and have outscored their opposition by 21 points (55-34) on second-chance points this season.

D-Up

ISU allowed 34 points in a 48-34 victory over Belmont last Sunday, their fewest allowed since limiting Evansville to 31 points in a 55-31 victory against the Purple Aces on Jan. 21, 2010.

Off The Bench

Freshman Marina Laramie has appeared in all five games off the bench for the Sycamores, averaging 7.0 points (fourth on the team) and 4.0 rebounds (third on the team) per game. The newcomer from O'Fallon, Mo., had the best game of her young career last Sunday, totaling 13 points and seven rebounds in a season-high 24 minutes off the bench.

Half-by-Half

The Sycamores have outscored their opponents by a margin of 151-102 (+49) in the opening 20 minutes of their five games this season, while trailing by a 151-136 (-15) edge in the second half. This season, Indiana State has led at the half in four of their five games.

Sophomore Jump

After averaging 3.8 points and 2.9 rebounds per game as a freshman, Racheal Mahan has more than doubled her production early in her second season at Indiana State. Mahan is tied for second on the team by averaging 10.2 points per game, while leading the way at 8.6 rebounds per game. The sophomore from Mansfield, Ohio, posted back-to-back double-doubles to begin the season, going for 10-and-10 against Eastern Illinois before posting career-highs with 18 points and 12 rebounds against Marshall.

30-Point Win

Indiana State posted a 30-point win over Eastern Illinois to open the season, topping the Panthers 69-39 inside Hulman Center. ISU's win by 30 points was their largest margin of victory since defeating Southern Illinois by 36 points (93-57) on Feb. 25, 2011 and their largest in nonconference play since topping Southeast Missouri by 44 points (72-28) on Nov. 24, 2009.

First-Half Defense

The Sycamores allowed just nine points in the first half to Eastern Illinois on Friday, Nov. 9, inside Hulman Center, taking a 36-9 advantage into the locker room. The last time that ISU allowed nine points or less to an opponent in a half came back on Dec. 28, 2002, when ISU took a 59-9 lead after 20 minutes over IPFW en route to a 96-28 victory inside Hulman Center.

Indiana State Adds Four On Signing Day

Third-year head coach Teri Moren announced the addition of four student-athletes to the 2013-14 roster, as Jasmine Grier, Ricquia Jones, Rhagen Smith and Stephanie Wittman all inked National Letters of Intent to join the Sycamores during the early signing period.

Head coach Teri Moren -- 3rd Season (Purdue '92)

Head coach Teri Moren is in her third season at the helm of the Indiana State women's basketball program in 2012-13, leading the Sycamores to a fifth place finish in the conference last season and their first time outside of Thursday night at the conference tournament since 2008-09. ISU finished 15-16 in 2011-12 under Moren, tying for fifth place in the league with an even 9-9 record. Moren's career record sits at 164-107 over 10 seasons as a head coach and 34-34 in three seasons in Terre Haute.

In Moren's first season, the Sycamores finished the year at 16-16 overall, including a trip to the State Farm MVC Tournament semifinals. ISU entered the 2011 conference tournament as the seventh seed after finishing the conference season with an 8-10 record, but picked up a pair of wins in the tournament over #10 Southern Illinois (83-68) and #2 Illinois State (80-51) before falling in a hard-fought game with #3 Missouri State in the semifinals (84-79).

Also in Moren's first season, Indiana State set program records for wins under a first-year head coach with 16, for assists in the game when they dished out 31 against USC Upstate on Dec. 12 and for free-throw attempts in a game when they took 52 shots at the charity stripe against Southern Illinois on Feb. 25.

Moren, a Seymour, Ind., native, came to ISU in 2010 after serving for three seasons as the associate head coach at Georgia Tech, where the Yellow Jackets had made three NCAA Tournament appearances and enjoyed three consecutive 20-win seasons.

Moren previously served as the head coach at the University of Indianapolis for seven seasons, where she compiled a 130-73 record. The 2003 WBCA Region 4 Coach of the Year, her teams made appearances in three consecutive NCAA Division II Tournaments and earned the Great Lakes Valley Conference regular-season and tournament titles in 2002-03. Moren was also an assistant coach at Northwestern in 1999-2000 and has additional assistant coaching experience for six years at Butler.

A 1992 graduate of Purdue University with a bachelor's degree in therapeutic recreation, Moren lettered four years in basketball and was a two-year starter for the Boilermakers. Her Purdue squad also earned the 1991 Big Ten Championship in Moren's junior season.

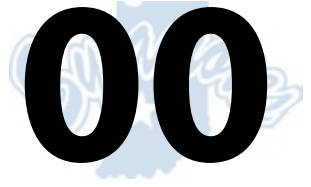

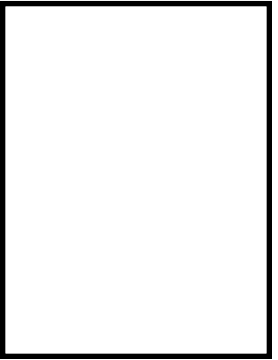

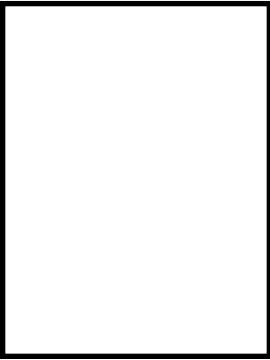
