Game Preview

The Indiana State women's basketball team opens up their 2012-13 season on Friday, Nov. 9, when the Sycamores host the Eastern Illinois Panthers inside Hulman Center at 7:05 p.m.

The game can be heard live on WIBQ 98.5 FM and on the Nelligan Sports Marketing Radio Network as Brent Holl and Jimmy Kendall cover all the action on the court. Fans can watch the game live online at GoSycamores.com through SycamoreVision with a premium subscription.

Indiana State will look to continue their recent success at home against Eastern Illinois and in home openers, as the Sycamores carry impressive streaks in both categories into the game on Friday. ISU has won 10 consecutive games against EIU inside Hulman Center, a streak that dates back to the 1992-93 season. In home openers, the Sycamores have won nine of their last 10 matchups, including a string of three-straight victories.

Four Sycamores went into double-figures against the Panthers last season, including junior Anna Munn and sophomore Natasha Zurek both posting 13 points in EIU's 75-60 victory.

A Little History -- Eastern Illinois

Friday's game will be the 57th meeting between Indiana State and Eastern Illinois, two schools separated by just 50 miles. Indiana State leads the all-time series by a 33-23 margin, as the Panthers are the most common opponent for the Sycamores outside of the MVC. Dating back to the 1992-93 season, Indiana State has won 17 of the last 19 matchups, including 10 consecutive games inside Hulman Center.

Scouting The Panthers

Eastern Illinois went 22-9 during the 2011-12 season, finishing in second place in the Ohio Valley Conference with a 13-3 league record. The Panthers earned a spot in the Postseason WNIT, falling on the road at Texas Tech in the opening game of the tournament. Heading into this season, EIU was picked to finish in second place in the West Division of the OVC, while seniors Ta'Kenya Nixon, Mariah King and Sydney Mitchell earned Preseason All-OVC honors. Eastern Illinois carried one of the best scoring offenses in the country last season, as the Panthers ranked 27th nationally by averaging 71.7 points per game.

Under 61

Indiana State is 24-2 when holding their opposition under 61 points in their two seasons with head coach Teri Moren, including a 12-2 mark last season. During MVC games, ISU is 12-1 under head coach Moren when teams score 60 points or fewer. When teams go over 60 points against ISU in the last two seasons, the Sycamores are 7-30.

Nonconference Winners

Indiana State will be looking for their fourth straight season of finishing nonconference play at the .500 mark or above, after accomplishing the feat in 2009-10, 2010-11 and 2011-12. The Sycamores have 11 nonconference games on their schedule this season, with six inside Hulman Center and five on the road.

Top 40

Indiana State ranked 37th nationally in three-point field-goal percentage last season, knocking down 34.2% (194-for-568) of their shots from beyond the arc in 2011-12. Deja Mattox (.438, 49-for-112) and junior Anna Munn (.381, 53-for-139) led the charge for ISU, as Mattox led the league and Munn placed fifth in the conference, respectively.

Dishing It Out

Senior Taylor Whitley has racked up 277 assists in her three seasons at Indiana State, ranking 11th in ISU history. The ISU senior has a chance to move up the ISU ranks quickly, needing just two more assists to break into the Top 10. JoDee Rigel (278 -- 1977-81) is 10th at ISU in career assists, with ninth place being held by Barbara Graves (280 -- 1979-83) and eighth place going to Tracy Johnson (282 -- 1978-82).

On A Good Pace: Part I

Senior Taylor Whitley enters the 2012-13 season with 775 career points, needing to average 7.5 points per game in her senior season to become the 26th member of the 1,000 Point Club at Indiana State. The Geneva, Ill., product averaged 7.6 points per game as a freshman and 12.1 points per game as a sophomore before totaling a 7.5 points per game average as a junior following an early-season knee injury.

On A Good Pace: Part II

Junior Anna Munn has knocked down 97 three-pointers in her two seasons at Indiana State, a pace that puts the junior guard on her way to enter the Top 10 in the career rankings. Munn is just 26 threes away from 10th place, held by Georgia Bottoms (123 -- 1993-98). The Indianapolis native knocked 53 three-pointers last season, ranking second on the team.

Stepping Up In Valley Play

After scoring just 11 points in nine games during the nonconference season, sophomore Racheal Mahan stepped up her game during MVC play. In ISU's 18 league games last season, the Mansfield, Ohio, native averaged 5.1 points and 3.8 rebounds per game.

Replacing A Big Three

Indiana State will look to replace the scoring of Deja Mattox, Brittany Schoen and Shannon Thomas this season, three Sycamores that finished their careers in 2011-12 as members of the 1,000 Point Club. ISU also replaced three 1,000-point scorers following the 2005-06 season, going 19-11 overall and 12-6 in the MVC that season.

Tough Competition

Last season, the Sycamores hold the second-best strength of schedule ranking among teams in the MVC, playing the 90th toughest schedule in the country. Of Indiana State's 12 nonconference opponents, six entered their league tournament as one of the top three seeds.

Money At The Line

Junior Anna Munn hit 22 consecutive free-throws to start the MVC season last year, going without a miss at the charity stripe from Dec. 22 through Feb. 24. Munn led the team last season by shooting 91.4% (53-for-58) at the line and has missed just 21 free-throws in her first two seasons at Indiana State (103-for-124, 83.1%).

Mahan, Munn Pace Sycamores Over Knights

Junior Anna Munn scored a game-high 14 points and sophomore Rachael Mahan added a double-double with 13 points and 13 rebounds as the Sycamores scored a 51-39 exhibition victory over Bellarmine in front of 2,055 fans inside Hulman Center on Friday, Nov. 2.

Munn connected on four three-pointers in the game to score her 14 points and added five rebounds, three assists and two steals in 33 minutes of action. Mahan made the most of her 32 minutes by scoring 13 points and pulling down 13 rebounds while adding six blocked shots and five steals.

Head coach Teri Moren -- 3rd Season (Purdue '92)

Head coach Teri Moren is in her third season at the helm of the Indiana State women's basketball program in 2012-13, leading the Sycamores to a fifth place finish in the conference last season and their first time outside of Thursday night at the conference tournament since 2008-09. ISU finished 15-16 in 2011-12 under Moren, tying for fifth place in the league with an even 9-9 record. Moren's career record moved to 161-105 over nine seasons as a head coach and 31-32 in two seasons in Terre Haute.

In Moren's first season, the Sycamores finished the year at 16-16 overall, including a trip to the State Farm MVC Tournament semifinals. ISU entered the 2011 conference tournament as the seventh seed after finishing the conference season with an 8-10 record, but picked up a pair of wins in the tournament over #10 Southern Illinois (83-68) and #2 Illinois State (80-51) before falling in a hard-fought game with #3 Missouri State in the semifinals (84-79).

Also in Moren's first season, Indiana State set program records for wins under a first-year head coach with 16, for assists in the game when they dished out 31 against USC Upstate on Dec. 12 and for free-throw attempts in a game when they took 52 shots at the charity stripe against Southern Illinois on Feb. 25.

Moren, a Seymour, Ind., native, came to ISU in 2010 after serving for three seasons as the associate head coach at Georgia Tech, where the Yellow Jackets had made three NCAA Tournament appearances and enjoyed three consecutive 20-win seasons.

Moren previously served as the head coach at the University of Indianapolis for seven seasons, where she compiled a 130-73 record. The 2003 WBCA Region 4 Coach of the Year, her teams made appearances in three consecutive NCAA Division II Tournaments and earned the Great Lakes Valley Conference regular-season and tournament titles in 2002-03. Moren was also an assistant coach at Northwestern in 1999-2000 and has additional assistant coaching experience for six years at Butler.

A 1992 graduate of Purdue University with a bachelor's degree in therapeutic recreation, Moren lettered four years in basketball and was a two-year starter for the Boilermakers. Her Purdue squad also earned the 1991 Big Ten Championship in Moren's junior season.

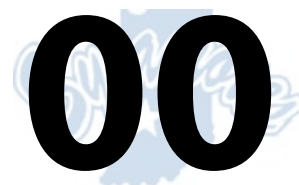

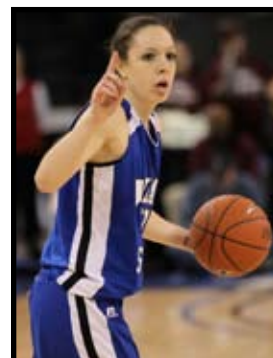
