Following an offseason filled with commitment, desire and change, the 2013 edition of the Indiana State softball team is set to hit the field for the first time this weekend under second year head coach Shane Bouman at the Cyclone Invitational in Ames, Iowa. The Sycamores enter the opening weekend with six starters returning from last year's squad and eight returning letter winners; they are joined by 10 new faces. Despite returning eight players from last year's team, the Sycamores are a young team with 12 of the 18 players on the roster being in their first or second year of collegiate softball. Indiana State kicks off the 2013 season at 10 a.m. Friday against the Mastodons of IPFW. The Sycamores will also face off against Northern Colorado twice as well as North Dakota and host Iowa State as part of a five game opening weekend. All five games will be played inside the Bergstrom Football Complex on the campus of Iowa State University. Live stats for all games along with full box scores and recaps will be available online at GoSycamores.com and a live audio stream will be available free of charge for the game against Iowa State at GoSycamores.com.

## Scouting The Mastodons

The Sycamores and Mastodons have previously met nine times with the Sycamores holding a 6-3 all-time series advantage. The two teams last met during the 2001 season when the Sycamores defeated the Mastodons, 1-0 in Fort Wayne. The first ever meeting between the two teams came during the 2001 season when the Sycamores won both games of a double header 5-2, 1-0 in Terre Haute.

IPFW returns its top four offensive players from a year ago, all four hit over .300 on the season for the Mastodons. Now sophomore Larissa Franklin led the way at .364, junior Alex Bousquet (.361), junior Brittany Kachur (.347), junior Ashleigh Bousquet (.344). On the mound, the Mastodons top returner is sophomore Miranda Kramer who finished 2012 with a 1.87 ERA over her 131.0 innings pitched.

## Scouting The Bears

This will be the first ever meeting between Indiana State and Northern Colorado when they play two games against each other in the Cyclone Invitational. The Bears return their top two hitters from last season's team that finished 25-28 overall. Northern Colorado is led by now senior Lindsey Smith who led the team with a .382 average last season and sophomore Melissa Marcovecchio with a .374 average. On the mound, the Bears return all four pitchers from last year's squad.

## Scouting Fighting Sioux

The Fighting Sioux are coming off a 2012 season in which they finished 18-29 overall. UND returns their top five hitters from last year's squad, four who batted over .300, led by now senior Kenna Olsen who finished 2012 with a .403 average. On the mound, UND returns all four pitchers who saw significant action in 2012, led by now senior Michelle Frank who finished the season with a 4.65 ERA over her 139.1 innings pitched.

## Scouting The Cyclones

This will be the fifth all-time meeting between the Sycamores and Cyclones with the Cyclones holding a 3-1 series advantage. The two teams first met during the 1988 season when the Sycamores defeated the Cyclones 6-5 in the Spring Cyclone Classic. The last meeting between the two teams came during the 2004 season when the Sycamores fell 4-3 to the Cyclones in eight innings.

The Cyclones finished 2012 with an overall record of 14-39 and 2-22 in Big 12 play. Returning for the Cyclones this season is senior infielder Erica Miller who was the lone Cyclone player to record a batting average over .300 at .364. Senior pitcher Tori Torrescano who finished with an 8-27 record and 6.11 ERA over her 173.0 innings pitched.

## Sycamores vs. Current Big 12

The Sycamores have played 18 previous games against the current Big 12 membership, recording a 3-15 overall record. The Sycamores last win against a Big 12 opponent came during the 2008 season when Indiana State defeated Oklahoma State 5-2. ISU's other two wins over Big 12 foes came during the 1988 season when they defeated Kansas by a score of 1-0 and Iowa State 6-5.

## Trying To Break The Trend

When the Indiana State softball takes the field at Iowa State, they will be looking to break an opening weekend trend of starting 1-3. The Sycamores have opened the season 1-3 the past three seasons and six times in the last nine seasons. The Sycamores will also be looking to get a win in the season opener for the first time since 2009 when they defeated Creighton 4-3. Overall, the Sycamores have recorded a 15-20 record in season openers in the program's 35 year history.

## Bring 'Em On

The Indiana State softball team will have an opportunity to test themselves throughout the early part of the 2013 season as they will take on a number of teams being nationally recognized. Going into the first weekend of the season, they are set to play the #9 team in the country in the USA Today/NFCA poll in Georgia as well as Tulsa and Illinois State who are receiving votes. The Sycamores will also play Auburn who is ranked #40 in the College Sports Madness Pre Season Top 44.

## Returners Are Key

While they lost four letter winners and three starters to graduation, the Indiana State fielding alignment features much of the same as last year. The Sycamores return junior Shelby Wilson and sophomores Megan Stone and Ashley Dickerson to hold down the infield with newcomer Morgan Allee to fill the final spot. The Sycamores also return three key outfielders who spent significant time in the position during the 2012 campaign in: seniors Mackenzie Connelly and Halee Myers as well as sophomore Megan Bunting. Sophomore pitcher Ashli Scott will return to help fill the void left by Lindsey Beisser due to graduation and freshman Meredith Henriksen will look to help fill the spot left open by the graduation of Olivia Andres behind the plate.

## Moving On Up

Despite a disappointing end to the 2012 regular season, the Sycamores found themselves in the ISU record book with their ability to steal bases. As a team, the Sycamores recorded the sixth highest total on the season stolen bases list with 53, just one away from fifth place.

Sophomore Megan Stone put herself in the ISU record book during her freshman campaign with her speed on the base pads. Stone finished her freshman season in a tie for seventh place on the single season list with 15, just one away from a tie for sixth place.

## New Faces, New Team

While eight players return from the 2012 roster, the 2013 addition of the Indiana State softball team will feature 10 new faces. Junior Morgan Allee and sophomore Stephanie Fougousse join freshmen Alexa Cavin, Meredith Henriksen, Halle Humphrey, Sarah Lawrence, Abbie Malchow, Kelsey Montgomery, Paige Schreiner and Mikayla Grindle.

## Head coach Shane Bouman -- 2nd Season (South Dakota '92)



Head Coach Shane Bouman enters his second season as head softball coach at Indiana State.

In his first season at the helm of the Sycamore program, Bouman increased the Sycamores win total from the season before and led the team to the third longest win streak in the history of the program. Bouman also coached Lindsey Beisser to second team All-MVC honors.

Bouman comes to Indiana State from Iowa Lakes Community College where he spent one successful season. His team finished with a 27-12 overall record and advanced to the Region XI Tournament, winning its first contest.

Prior to his stint at Iowa Lakes Community College, Bouman served as the pitching coach at the University of Iowa for three seasons where the Hawkeyes went 109-59 and twice qualified for the NCAA Tournament.

Bouman's success at Iowa came early. In 2008, his first season as pitching coach, the Hawkeye pitchers garnered top-25 national rankings in four categories: seventh nationally in team earned run average (1.23) and Brittany Weil finished the season ranked 22nd in individual wins (28) and 23rd in earned run average (1.22). Weil was also a four-time Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honoree, first-team NFCA all-Mideast Region selection, and second team all-Big Ten pick. Current Indiana State assistant coach Amanda Zust finished the season ranked 14th in hits allowed per seven innings (3.87) and 24th in earned run average (1.24). In his second season at Iowa, Bouman once again guided the pitching staff to national recognition. Iowa's pitchers finished the 2009 season with a 1.38 ERA, which ranked seventh-nationally. In addition, Weil either broke or tied six school records during her senior campaign, and also tossed five no-hitters, including a perfect game. Bouman guided Weil to Iowa's first ever NFCA National Player of the Week honor, and she was also named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week four times and went on to earn NFCA second team all-America honors, first team NFCA all-Midwest Region and first team all-Big Ten honors.

Bouman previously served as head coach at South Dakota State University for six seasons and is the winningest coach in SDSU school history. Bouman guided nine players to Division I All-Independent teams, seven players to Division I All-Academic teams, and garnered an ESPN Academic All-American honoree. During Bouman's tenure, the Jackrabbits set school records for career home runs, stolen bases, RBI, and sacrifices.

## Assistant coach Amanda Zust -- 2nd Season (Iowa '06)



Amanda Zust enters her second season as an assistant coach of the Indiana State softball team working primarily with the pitchers. In her first season with the Sycamores Zust coached Lindsey Beisser to second team All-MVC honors.

Before joining Coach Bouman's staff at Indiana State, Zust spent a season as a volunteer assistant coach at Drake University where she helped lead the Bulldogs to a 34-21 record and a second place finish in the MVC.

Zust, who graduated in 2010, was a standout pitcher at the University of Iowa where she compiled a 56-27 overall record with 597 strikeouts. The Des Moines native ranks in the school's top-10 in several categories, including career games, innings pitched, complete games, wins and strikeouts. In addition, Zust earned Iowa's Most Improved Player Award in 2007 and 2008, took home its Gold Glove Award in 2009 and threw two no-hitters - one in 2009 and another 364 days later in 2010. Zust also coached for five years at Des Moines East High School in Des Moines, Iowa.

## Assistant coach Scott Miller -- 2nd Season



Returning for his second season on staff as assistant coach of the Indiana State softball program is Scott Miller. Miller serves primarily as a hitting coach for the Sycamores and coached two players, Megan Stone and Shelby Wilson to season batting averages over .325.

Coach Scott Miller is no stranger to Bouman's coaching staffs as he has previously served as an assistant coach at both South Dakota State and Iowa Lakes CC working primarily with outfielders and hitting. Miller has been around the professional fastpitch scene for over 20 years and has competed in seven ISC World Fastpitch Tournaments, earning All-American honors. Miller graduated from Emporia State University (KS) and has taught and coached high school athletics for over thirty years, winning multiple Nebraska State High School Championships.
