After playing their final road games of the season this past weekend, the Indiana State softball team is set to wrap up their 2013 season with an eight-game home stand. The Sycamores will first turn their attention toward the Redbirds of Illinois State for a double header on Thursday at Price Field. The Sycamores enter the midweek games with a 14-31 overall record having last seen the field in a three-game series this past weekend inside the UNI Dome in Cedar Falls, Iowa. The Redbirds enter the doubleheader with a 24-18 overall record and are 9-6 in MVC play. With eight games remaining, the Sycamores need just 12 stolen bases to break the Missouri Valley Conference record for steals in a season while junior Morgan Allee needs just four steals to tie the MVC single season individual record of 37. Last Time Out

The Sycamores are coming off a three-game series on the road against Northern Iowa where the Sycamores were defeated by the Panthers in all three games. Junior Morgan Allee led off the first game of the series with an errorless inside the park home run, however, the Sycamores fell in the contest 9-4. The Panthers went on to defeat the Sycamores 4-1 and 8-1 in the final two games of the series. All three games were played inside the UNI Dome due to poor weather conditions in Cedar Falls.

A Little History—Illinois State

The Sycamores and Redbirds have previously met 86 times with the Redbirds holding the 72-14 all-time series advantage. The two teams first met during the 1981 season with the Redbirds winning a pair of games over the Sycamores. Most recently, the two teams played a single game in Normal, Ill. on April 17 with the Sycamores falling 12-4 before weather postponed the second game.

Scouting The Redbirds

The Redbirds enter the midweek doubleheader with a 24-18 overall record and 9-6 in MVC play having last seen the field this past weekend in a series win over Wichita State. The Redbirds have been led this season by Elizabeth Kay who is batting .438 with 56 hits, 10 home runs and 43 RBI's with a .556 on base percentage. Inside the circle for the Redbirds, Taylor Baxter leads the pitching staff with a 3.34 ERA with a 13-6 overall record over her 119.1 innings pitched and 55 strikeouts.

MVC Leaderboard

Many Sycamores are near the top of the MVC leaderboard in multiple statistical categories. Junior Morgan Allee leads the Valley with 33 stolen bases while freshman Alexa Cavin also leads all MVC players with 12 sacrifice bunts. As a team, the Sycamores lead the MVC in stolen bases with 88 and sacrifice bunts with 51 and are third in fielding percentage at .964. ISU is also third in the MVC in walks with 134 and third in hit by pitches with 30. Defensively the Sycamores lead the MVC in Fielding double plays with 19, with six more than second.

Making National Strides

At the seventh NCAA national softball statistical rankings release on Monday, April 22, the Sycamores had multiple players near the top of the national lists. Junior Morgan Allee was 11th in Division 1 in stolen bases per game and seventh overall in stolen bases with 33. Freshman Alexa Cavin also ranks 12th in Division 1 in sacrifice hits per game with 12. As a team, the Sycamores are ranked 13th nationally in stolen bases per game and have 88 total and are 25th in double plays turned per game and have 19 overall.

Turning Two

This past weekend against Northern Iowa, the Indiana State softball team broke its third school record of the season, this time in double plays turned. The Sycamores have now turned 19 double plays on the season which leads the MVC with six more than second place. The Sycamores are also 24th nationally in double plays.

Moving On Up

Just 42 games into her Sycamore career, junior Morgan Allee has already written her name into the ISU record book in stolen bases. Allee leads the Sycamores with 33 stolen bases on the season holds the record for most stolen bases in a single season at ISU breaking the previous record of 28, held by Amy Vaira, set in 1994. Despite it being her first season in a Sycamore uniform, Allee is now sixth all-time on the ISU career stolen bases list. Allee is also seventh in NCAA Div. 1 in stolen bases per game. Allee is also just four stolen bases away from breaking the MVC record of 37 with 11 games left to play.

Team Records About To Fall

Despite currently holding a record under .500, as a team, the Sycamores are writing themselves into ISU history. The team has already broken the ISU stolen bases record, hit by pitch record and total double plays turned record and are currently on pace to finish the season in the top 10 of eight other statistical categories in the ISU record book.

Stolen Base Record Falls

With five stolen bases as a team on Wednesday, April 3 against Illinois, the Indiana State softball team broke a 14 year old school record as they tallied a total of 67 stolen bases. The previous record was set in 1999 when they stole 64. The Sycamores still have eight games remaining on their schedule and lead the MVC with a current total of 88. Last season the Sycamores stole 53 bases in 53 games played. The Sycamores are also on pace to break the Missouri Valley Conference record of 100 stolen bases in a single season.

Walk This Way

The Sycamore batters have been extremely patient at the plate so far this season and as a team have received 134 walks, which ranks second all-time at ISU. Seven Sycamore batters have also received double digit walks in senior Halee Myers (14), sophomore Megan Stone (15), freshman Alexa Cavin (14), junior Shelby Wilson (16), sophomore Megan Bunting (12), sophomore Ashley Dickerson (13) and junior Morgan Allee (13). Last season as a team the Sycamores received 118 walks in 53 games.

First Career Home Runs

Just past the halfway point in the 2012-13 season, four different Sycamores have hit their first career home run's. Freshman Abbie Malchow hit her first home run during the finale of the series against Wichita State while junior Morgan Allee hit her first collegiate homer in the first game against Missouri State. Senior Halee Myers also hit her first home run of her collegiate career on Wednesday night in the Sycamores 6-5 win over Illinois. On April 9 against IUPUI, senior Alex Lucas also hit her first home run.

Using The Long Ball

So far this season, the Indiana State softball team has recorded 24 total home runs and is second on the ISU Team Records list, 10 away from first. The 24 home runs also is 10 more than the Sycamores season total from one year ago. Seven Sycamore players have accounted for ISU's home runs as sophomore Megan Stone leads and junior Shelby Wilson each have eight. Junior Morgan Allee has three home runs including an inside the park home run against UNI while freshman Abbie Malchow has two. Senior Halee Myers, senior Alex Lucas and senior Mackenzie Connelly each have one. Stone and Wilson's eight home runs also put them second on the single season records list, just three behind first and Stone's 10 career home runs rank her fifth all-time at ISU, just two away from fourth.

Wearing Pitches

Sycamore batters have been a target for opposing pitchers while in the batters box. As a team, the Sycamores rank third in the MVC in hit by pitches with 30. That number also ranks first on the all-time ISU record book. Individually, junior Shelby Wilson ranks fourth in the ISU career record book with 10 hit by pitches and junior Morgan Allee ranks 6th with eight. Sophomore Ashley Dickerson and Allee each have been hit eight times this season which ranks second on the ISU single season list, just two behind first. Dickerson is also fifth on the career hit by pitch list with nine.

Even Better In Valley Play

Sophomore Megan Stone is second for ISU with a .355 batting average but has been even better in the four Missouri Valley Conference series the Sycamores have played in. Through 19 MVC games, Stone holds a .380 batting average going 19-50 at the plate with five home runs. Stone also has a .436 on base percentage in Valley games and a .680 slugging percentage with 10 RBI's and 34 total bases.

Small Ball

The Sycamores have played small ball through the first part of the season and after 45 games, they lead the Missouri Valley Conference in total sacrifices with 57. Freshman Alexa Cavin leads the Sycamores and the Valley with 12 total sacrifices while senior Halee Myers also has eight. A total of 11 different Sycamore batters have also recorded a sacrifice so far this season.

Dickerson Gets The Save

In her first ever appearance as a collegiate pitcher, sophomore Ashley Dickerson entered the circle for the Sycamores Wednesday evening against Illinois in a one-run game in the bottom of the seventh. After a leadoff walk, Dickerson got a pop out and a grounded into a double play to secure the win for the Sycamores and earned the save.

Coach Bouman Reaches Milestone

During a 6-5 over over the Fighting Illini of the University of Illinois, head coach Shane bouman reached a coaching milestone as he scored his 200th career coaching victory. In his second season, Bouman has recorded 32 victories since taking over the reigns of the Sycamore program.

Stone Is MVC Player Of The Week

Sophomore Megan Stone was named MVC player of the week for the week of March 25, marking the first Sycamore player to receive a weekly award since Lindsey Beisser won MVC pitcher of the week, twice, last season. Stone is also the first Sycamore player to be named player of the week since the 2009 season when Katie Armour did it April 27, 2009.

Swinging Those Bats

The Indiana State softball team came out of the gates swinging to open the 2013 season and are averaging nearly seven hits a game. The Sycamores have out hit their opponents nine times and are 7-2 when doing so. The Sycamores also have three players batting over .300 on the season, including Shelby Wilson at .370, Megan Stone at .355 and Morgan Allee who is batting .343.

Wilson & Scott Are All-Tournament

After wrapping up play at the Blues City Classic this past weekend in Southaven, Miss., two Sycamore players were named to the All-Tournament team for their efforts. Sophomore Ashli Scott was named 1st Team All-Tournament after making one start and three appearances for ISU with a 0.58 ERA with a 1-0 record over her 12 innings pitched. Scott also recorded a season high in strikeouts with seven in her relief appearance against Nicholls State. Junior Shelby Wilson was also named 2nd Team All-Tournament after going 5-12 at the plate with two RBI's and a run scored with three stolen bases.

Returners Are Key

While they lost four letter winners and three starters to graduation, the Indiana State fielding alignment features much of the same as last year. The Sycamores return junior Shelby Wilson and sophomores Megan Stone and Ashley Dickerson to hold down the infield with newcomer Morgan Allee to fill the final spot. The Sycamores also return three key outfielders who spent significant time in the position during the 2012 campaign in: seniors Mackenzie Connelly and Hallee Myers as well as sophomore Megan Bunting.

Head coach Shane Bouman -- 2nd Season (South Dakota '92)



Head Coach Shane Bouman enters his second season as head softball coach at Indiana State.

In his first season at the helm of the Sycamore program, Bouman increased the Sycamores win total from the season before and led the team to the third longest win streak in the history of the program. Bouman also coached Lindsey Beisser to second team All-MVC honors.

Bouman comes to Indiana State from Iowa Lakes Community College where he spent one successful season. His team finished with a 27-12 overall record and advanced to the Region XI Tournament, winning its first contest.

Prior to his stint at Iowa Lakes Community College, Bouman served as the pitching coach at the University of Iowa for three seasons where the Hawkeyes went 109-59 and twice qualified for the NCAA Tournament.

Bouman's success at Iowa came early. In 2008, his first season as pitching coach, the Hawkeye pitchers garnered top-25 national rankings in four categories: seventh nationally in team earned run average (1.23) and Brittany Weil finished the season ranked 22nd in individual wins (28) and 23rd in earned run average (1.22). Weil was also a four-time Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honoree, first-team NFCA all-Mideast Region selection, and second team all-Big Ten pick. Current Indiana State assistant coach Amanda Zust finished the season ranked 14th in hits allowed per seven innings (3.87) and 24th in earned run average (1.24). In his second season at Iowa, Bouman once again guided the pitching staff to national recognition. Iowa's pitchers finished the 2009 season with a 1.38 ERA, which ranked seventh-nationally. In addition, Weil either broke or tied six school records during her senior campaign, and also tossed five no-hitters, including a perfect game. Bouman guided Weil to Iowa's first ever NFCA National Player of the Week honor, and she was also named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week four times and went on to earn NFCA second team all-America honors, first team NFCA all-Midwest Region and first team all-Big Ten honors.

Bouman previously served as head coach at South Dakota State University for six seasons and is the winningest coach in SDSU school history. Bouman guided nine players to Division I All-Independent teams, seven players to Division I All-Academic teams, and garnered an ESPN Academic All-American honoree. During Bouman's tenure, the Jackrabbits set school records for career home runs, stolen bases, RBI, and sacrifices.

Assistant coach Amanda Zust -- 2nd Season (Iowa '06)



Amanda Zust enters her second season as an assistant coach of the Indiana State softball team working primarily with the pitchers. In her first season with the Sycamores Zust coached Lindsey Beisser to second team All-MVC honors.

Before joining Coach Bouman's staff at Indiana State, Zust spent a season as a volunteer assistant coach at Drake University where she helped lead the Bulldogs to a 34-21 record and a second place finish in the MVC.

Zust, who graduated in 2010, was a standout pitcher at the University of Iowa where she compiled a 56-27 overall record with 597 strikeouts. The Des Moines native ranks in the school's top-10 in several categories, including career games, innings pitched, complete games, wins and strikeouts. In addition, Zust earned Iowa's Most Improved Player Award in 2007 and 2008, took home its Gold Glove Award in 2009 and threw two no-hitters - one in 2009 and another 364 days later in 2010. Zust also coached for five years at Des Moines East High School in Des Moines, Iowa.

Assistant coach Scott Miller -- 2nd Season

Miller has been around the professional fastpitch scene for over 20 years and has competed in seven ISC World Fastpitch Tournaments, earning All-American honors. Miller graduated from Emporia State University (KS) and has taught and coached high school athletics for over thirty years, winning multiple Nebraska State High School Championships.
