Indiana State Begins December Road Journey At Morehead State On Saturday

SETTING THE STAGE

Indiana State continues year three of the Greg Lansing era on Saturday, December 8 when the Sycamores (4-2) travel to Morehead State (4-5) inside Ellis T. Johnson Arena for a return contest of the 2011 Bracketbusters Series. Tip-off is set for 2:00 p.m. (ET). The game will be broadcast live for free online at OVCDigitalNetwork.com. The game can also be heard on the radio via WIBQ 98.5 FM and along the Nelligan Sports Marketing Radio Network with Brian Fritz (pbp) and Matt Renn (analyst) on the call. GoSycamores.com will have an audio only production of the radio broadcast as well.

THE MOREHEAD STATE SERIES

Indiana State trails the all-time series against Morehead State by a 3-2 margin, and have dropped each of their last three meeting against the Eagles. The Sycamores own a pair of home court victories over Morehead State (1946 & 1972), but fell to Morehead State on the road in 1972 & 1982. MSU won the last meeting in the series by a 71-65 count on February 19, 2011 inside Hulman Center in a contest that was part of the Bracketbusters Series.

QUICK HITS

- Lucas Eitel is 15-of-24 from 3-point range this season (62.5 percent), which leads not only the Missouri Valley Conference, but also the nation. Eitel set a school record with his 7-of-7 performance from 3-point range on November 25 against High Point. He tied a school record by hitting seven consecutive triples, is also tied with Jay Tunnell for most consecutive treys made in succession (8) over multiple contests (at Ball State, vs. High Point).
- Indiana State is now 4-0 on the season when holding teams to 63 points or less and is to 30-1 when doing so under third-year head coach Greg Lansing.
- Indiana State has earned 38 close victories (five points or less) since 2005. Under Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 12-5 in close games.
- The Sycamores lead the Missouri Valley Conference and are 49th nationally in 3-point field goal percentage defense, allowing just 27.8 percent from long range this season. Additionally, Indiana State is averaging 11.3 turnovers per game, which is the 30th-fewest in the NCAA and third in the MVC.
- Manny Arop leads the team with two double-doubles, one of just 60 players in the NCAA to post more than one this season.
- The Sycamores are off to their sixth 4-2 start since 1996.
- Jake Odum scored 25 points against No. 23/25 New Mexico, which marked the eighth 20-point game of his career.

The Indiana State Head Coach

Indiana State head coach Greg Lansing (South Dakota, 1990) is 42-31 (.575) overall in his third season as a head coach. He is 20-16 all-time in MVC games, including a 13-5 mark at home and a 7-11 record on the road. During his career, he is 24-8 in all home games, 11-18 on the road, 7-5 in neutral court contests and 12-5 in games decided by five points or less. Lansing is 0-1 all-time against Morehead State, and is 0-0 versus the Eagles on the road. With the Trees, Lansing is 2-3 in overtime games and 30-1 when holding teams to 63 points or less. Saturday's game will be Greg Lansing's 74th as Indiana State head coach. Lansing is the second head coach to lead the Sycamores to the NCAA Tournament in their rookie campaign in the history of the program, with the other being Bill Hodges leading ISU to a 33-1 record and a Final Four appearance in the 1979 NCAA Tournament. Lansing was just the 14th rookie head coach in the history of the MVC to lead his team to 20 victories during their debut season.

A Little History

Indiana State is currently in its 117th season of college basketball at the school. The Sycamores are 1,389-1,198 all-time on the hardwood. Indiana State's game at Oral Roberts in 2010 was the historic 2,500th game in the history of the program.

Jake Odum Scores At Least 20 Points For The Eighth Time Of His Career With 25 Against New Mexico

Indiana State junior guard Jake Odum led the team with 25 points as the Sycamores dropped an overtime decision to No. 23/25 New Mexico at home on December 1. Odum hit 9-of-16 shots from the field and was 7-of-12 from the free throw line against the Lobos. Odum added seven rebounds and four assists with a steal in 33 minutes of action. He scored the 25 points despite playing most of his minutes in the first half with two fouls. He spearheaded a Sycamore effort that erased a 19-point deficit over the final 18 minutes of regulation to force overtime. Odum's final basket of the game came with 2.9 seconds remaining in regulation when he hit a tough lay-up to even the ledger at 64.

Manny Arop Records His Second Double-Double Of The Season Against Nationally-Ranked New Mexico

Indiana State junior guard Manny Arop posted a career-high 17 points to go with 10 rebounds as he recorded his second double-double in the last three contests against No. 23/25 New Mexico. Arop hit 6-of-11 shots from the field, his second 3-pointer of the season and was 4-of-6 from the charity stripe in 35 minutes of action. Arop posted 13 points and a season-high 11 rebounds in the road victory over Ball State on November 20. Arop is one of 60 players nationally to have recorded more than one double-double this season in the NCAA.

Lucas Eitel In The School Record For 3-Point Shooting Performance And Still Leads The Nation

Indiana State junior guard Lucas Eitel was named the Missouri Valley Conference Scholar-Athlete Of The Week following his career-high 25-point performance against High Point. Eitel hit 11-of-12 shots from the field, including 9-of-10 from three-point range, as the Sycamores won on the road at Ball State (68-48 on November 20) and at home versus High Point (76-62 on November 25). Against High Point, he earned his first career start and scored 25 points on the strength of 9-of-9 shooting, including an Indiana State record of 7-of-7 from behind the three-point arc. Eitel made eight consecutive 3-pointers at Ball State and against High Point to tie Jay Tunnell's school record set in 2009. He is currently the nation's leading 3-point shooter through four weeks of action as he

Sycamores Come From 19 Down Against New Mexico To Force Overtime; Do Not Commit A Turnover After Halftime

Indiana State found itself down 33-19 at the half against nationally-ranked New Mexico after hitting just 29.6 percent of their and committing 11 turnovers which allowed New Mexico to score 17 points. After the break, the Sycamores did not commit another turnover in either regulation or overtime and erased what ballooned into a 19-point deficit to force the extra period. ISU also hit 13-of-25 shots from the field (52 percent) and limited the high-powered Lobo offense to just 5-of-25 shooting (20 percent) in the second half.

Dawon Cummings Key In New Mexico Contest As Well!

Junior Dawon Cummings came off the bench to score 10 points against nationally-ranked New Mexico. Cummings hit 4-of-8 shots from the field, including one 3-pointer and a free throw. Cummings had a key steal in the first half which staked the Sycamores to an early 13-10 lead and then converted a conventional 3-point play during a second half comeback which got the Sycamores within two points of the Lobos.

Jake Odum In Top 10 At Indiana State For Steals, Moving Close In Assists

Indiana State junior Jake Odum has 130 career steals, which ranks him eighth all-time in the Sycamore basketball program, needing only three more to reach seventh place, currently held by David Moss (133 from 2002-06). The Sycamore career record is shared by Nate Green and Larry Bird with 240. Odum currently has 326 career assists, which currently ranks 11th all-time and needs five more to catch Greg Thomas (331 from 1989-93) to move into the Top 10.

Good Starter On The Battery

Indiana State improved to 4-0 this season when the Sycamore starters outscore their opponents with the 76-62 victory over High Point. Under third-year head coach Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 28-7 when the ISU starting five scores more than their opponent's counterparts.

63 Is The Magic Number

The Sycamores win by the score of 76-62 vs. High Point on November 20 was ISU's fourth this season in which they held an opponent to 63 points or less and earned the victory. ISU is currently 4-0 on the season when holding an opponent under that total. Under third-year head coach Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 30-1 when allowing less than 63 points to the opposition (including a 13-0 mark when holding teams to 53 or less).

Sycamore Success Inside Hulman Center Under Greg Lansing

The Sycamores are 24-8 (.750) inside Hulman Center under third-year head coach Greg Lansing. The Sycamores have won 15 of their last 20 home games. Additionally, the Sycamores have won 13 of their last 18 MVC games at home.

Sycamores Win At Ball State For The First Time Since 1986

Indiana State won 68-48 at Ball State on November 20 to end an 11-game road losing skid to the Cardinals. It was their first victory in Muncie since 1986 and their first at Worthen Arena (which opened in 1991) in nine tries. The Sycamores earned their largest margin of victory over Ball State since 1977 and their largest road win against the Cardinals since 1919.

Sycamores Improve To 3-0 In Home Openers Under Greg Lansing; Perfect At Home In November

With the 66-55 home court victory over Winthrop on Tuesday, November 13, Indiana State improved to 3-0 in home opening games under third-year head coach Greg Lansing and following the victory over High Point on November 25 are a perfect 6-0 in November home games in the last three seasons.

Sycamores Help UCLA Open New Pauley Pavilion While Gant Scores First Points In Building

It was a historic night for the Indiana State basketball program on November 9 as the Sycamores were the road team in the opening of New Pauley Pavilion against No. 13 UCLA. Legendary head coach John Wooden spent the 1946-47 and 1947-48 seasons as the head basketball coach at Indiana State before his 27-year run at the helm of the Bruin program. While both of coach Wooden's teams battled it out on the hardwood at New Pauley Pavilion, Sycamore sophomore Justin Gant scored the first points in the new building with a 3-pointer at the 17:11 mark of the first half.

Six Make Sycamore Debut At UCLA

The Sycamores game against UCLA marked the debut of six new Indiana State players on the roster for the 2012-13 campaign. Indiana State is returning just one starter from last season in junior guard Jake Odum. Freshman Khristian Smith led the newcomers with 11 points off the bench while starting forward Manny Arop tallied 10 points. Two Sycamores, Arop and Dawon Cummings made their Sycamore debuts in the starting lineup against UCLA while Devonte Brown, Rhett Smith, Brandon Burnett and Smith came off the bench in their first games in the Blue & White.

Sycamores In Postseason Play For Third Consecutive Season

With Indiana State's appearance in the 2012 CollegenInsider.com Postseason Tournament, the Sycamores have now made three consecutive trips to postseason play. ISU played in the 2010 College Basketball Invitational as well as the 2011 NCAA Tournament in addition to the CIT Tournament in 2012. The last time the Sycamores reached postseason play for three consecutive seasons came in 1977-79 when Indiana State played in the 1977 & 1978 NIT as well as the 1979 NCAA Tournament. The last time Indiana State hosted a postseason game came on March 10, 1978 when the Sycamores hosted Illinois State in the first round of the NIT.

Jake Odum Named To The Preseason All-Missouri Valley Team

Indiana State guard Jake Odum was one of five student-athletes named to the Preseason All-Missouri Valley Conference Team on October 29. Odum finished third in the Missouri Valley Conference with a 4.9 assists per game average. That mark was ranked 61st nationally. Odum recorded a career-high 12 assists against Fairfield as part of the Old Spice Classic, a number which ranked tied for fourth all-time at ISU in a single game. Odum is third in the MVC in steals per game with a 1.8 average, which ranks 81st nationally. Additionally, Odum's 4.5 assists per game average of his career is fifth-best in the history of the program while his 119 steals are ranked ninth-best in the Sycamore record books, while his 1.8 steals per game average ranks third.

Sycamores Picked To Finish 7th In Missouri Valley Conference Race

The Indiana State Sycamores were picked to finish seventh in the Missouri Valley Conference race according to a poll of league head coaches, sports information directors and a media panel. ISU finished eighth last season, with an 8-10 MVC record, just one game out of a large logjam for third place at 9-9.

Indiana State Posts Three Exhibition Victories In The Bahamas In August

Indiana State took advantage of the NCAA rule allowing teams to participate in a foreign tour of exhibition contests once every four years when they travelled to Nassau, Bahamas from August 12-14 and defeated the Giants 95-76, the Real Deal Shockers 116-75 and the PJ Stingers 76-55. Manny Arop scored 17 points to lead ISU against the Giants, while Dawon Cummings had 18 to pace the Sycamores against the Real Deal Shockers. The Sycamores were led in the final exhibition game of the tour by Lucas Eitel who scored 15 points versus the PJ Stingers.

Indiana State Reaches 17 Regular Season Victories For Third Consecutive Season; First Time Since Larry Bird Era

With its 59-46 victory over Missouri State on February 22, 2012, the Sycamores have now posted at least 17 regular season victories for the third consecutive season, which is the first time three Indiana State teams have reached that mark in succession since the 1976-77, 1977-78 & 1978-79 seasons. The Sycamores won 25 in 76-77, 19 in 77-78 and 26 in 78-79.

Triple-Double For Odum And Tournament Record To Boot

Jake Odum battled a foot injury while playing three games in four days at the 2011 Old Spice Classic. After two solid performances in the first two days of the event, Odum saved his best for last as he posted 10 points, 10 rebounds and 12 assists against Fairfield on November 27. That triple-double was the first by a Sycamore since Larry Bird posted one in 1979 versus Drake and the first by a member of the MVC in 14 seasons. Additionally, the 12 assists are an Old Spice Classic single-game record. His 12 assists is the first double digit assist total in his career and the first by a Sycamore since Michael Menser had 11 against Wichita State in 2001.

The Sycamores take a break for final exams but return to action on Saturday, December 15 when they travel to IUPUI for a 7:00 p.m. (ET) contest.

The Last Time Out ...

TERRE HAUTE, Ind. -- The Indiana State Sycamores erased a 19-point second half deficit and forced overtime before falling 77-68 to the visiting No. 23/25 New Mexico Lobos in front of a crowd of 6,080 inside Hulman Center.

ISU saw its four-game winning streak come to an end and dropped to 4-2 while New Mexico remained unbeaten on the year and moved to 8-0.

Jake Odum had another standout performance for the Sycamores as he engineered the Sycamore comeback during the course of the second half and posted 25 points for the game, hitting 9-of-16 shots from the field and seven free throws. He added seven rebounds and four assists despite spending most of the first half with two fouls.

Manny Arop posted a double-double for the second consecutive game as he tallied 17 points, hitting 6-of-11 from the field and added 10 rebounds. Dawon Cummings came off the bench to score 10 points.

ISU hit just 8-of-27 (29.6 percent) from the field in the first half, but converted 13-of-25 in the second half (52 percent). The Sycamores finished the game by hitting of 23-of-59 (39 percent) from the floor and limited the Lobos to just 22-of-57 shooting (38.6 percent). New Mexico hit just 5-of-25 (20 percent) from the field in the second half.

Chad Adams hit a 3-pointer for New Mexico with 18:33 remaining to stake the Lobos to a 40-21 lead, which was the largest of the contest. ISU got a 3-pointer from Lucas Eitel and two free throws from Arop to trim the lead down to 40-26.

Odum cut the led down to 44-31 with 14:47 remaining when he went to the free throw line in a bonus situation and grabbed his own rebound after the New Mexico players thought it was a two-shot foul and finished with a dunk to inch ISU closer at 44-31.

The Lobo lead shrunk to just 48-39 with 11:08 on the clock with a conventional 3-point play before Tony Snell countered with three free throws a few seconds later to stretch it back out to 51-39.

Indiana State would go on an 8-0 run with a lay-up and back-to-back jumpers from Arop and then a pair of charity tosses by Arop to make it 51-47 with 8:10 remaining. Kendall Williams converted a conventional 3-point play and then Odum hit a jumper with seven minutes to go and then found Dawon Cummings on a long pass which he turned into a 3-point play himself to cut into New Mexico advantage down to 54-52.

Williams tossed in a lay-up with 1:52 remaining to make it 62-57 and then Gant drained a long 3-pointer near the end of the shot clock to make it 62-60. After Williams hit two free throws, Odum converted a jump shot to make it 64-62 with 18 seconds on the clock.

Williams then missed both free throws with 14 seconds to go and Odum completed the regulation comeback with a lay-up with 2.9 seconds remaining to knot the contest at 64.

In overtime, New Mexico would hit 4-of-6 shots from the field, including the first five points to earn the 69-64 lead. Odum answered the first five points with a jumper to make it 69-6 and then Arop scored with 1:12 remaining to make it 71-68.

New Mexico scored the final six points of the extra period to earn the 77-68 victory.

ISU scored first on an Arop 3-pointer and led 7-2 when he hit a lay-up with 16:51 left before the half. Cummings converted a fastbreak dunk off a steal to stretch the lead out to 13-10 with 9:24 on the clock before the Lobos took a 14-13 lead on a Cameron Birstow jumper with 7:03 left before the break.

The Sycamores had 11 turnovers before the half and didn't turn it over again the rest of the contest.

Four New Mexico players reached double figures scoring, led by Kendall Williams with 24.

Indiana State Head Basketball Coach Third Season

Greg Lansing is in his third season as the head basketball coach at Indiana State. He previously spent eight seasons with the program as an assistant coach, including the previous three as associate head coach.

Lansing burst onto the scene as a rookie head coach with the Sycamore basketball program in 2010-11 as he became just the second-ever Indiana State head coach to lead the team to the NCAA Tournament in his first season. He led the team to a 20-14 record, becoming just the 14th head coach in the history of the Missouri Valley Conference to lead a team to 20 or more victories in their first year at the helm.

In 2011-12, the Sycamores finished the year with an 18-15 record and advanced to the CollegelInsiders.com Postseason Tournament. It marked the third consecutive year the team has reached postseason play -- its longest such stretch since the 1977, 1978 and 1979 seasons when Larry Bird donned the Indiana State uniform.

Jake Odum was one of just four players nationally to average at least 10 points, five rebounds and 4.5 assists per game during his sophomore season and was a Second Team All-Missouri Valley Conference selection as well as Second Team All-District selection as announced by the National Association of Basketball Coaches.

The Sycamores downed No. 25 nationally-ranked Vanderbilt on the road and finished third at the Old Spice Classic -- the best-ever finish by a MVC team in the event.

ISU reached the NCAA Tournament and took on Syracuse in Cleveland, Ohio based on the program's third-ever MVC Tournament Championship won at the Scottrade Center in St. Louis, Mo. ISU raced to the title with victories over No. 6 Evansville, No. 2 Wichita State and No. 1 Missouri State in the Championship Game as the Sycamores entered as the No. 3 seed in the tournament. Freshman Jake Odum was named to the MVC All-Tournament Team.

Odum was named a CollegelInsider.com Mid Major Freshman All-American and was named an All-MVC Honorable Mention selection as well as a member of the MVC All-Freshman, All-Newcomer and All-Defense Team. Carl Richard was also named to the All-MVC's Honorable Mention squad. ISU took two thrilling buzzer beating victories over league foes Missouri State and Creighton during the regular season at Hulman Center. The buzzer beater over Creighton by Richard was voted the No. 2 play of the weekend by ESPN's SportsCenter.

In 2009-10 the Sycamores overcame a ton of adversity to still put together its best season in nearly a decade under the professional leadership of the ISU coaching staff. Despite only having its full compliment of student-athletes for just 28 minutes of the rough and tumble Missouri Valley Conference slate, the Sycamores still recorded its first winning season since 2001 as they finished 17-15. ISU also finished the year with a 9-9 record in league play, bolstering the Sycamores out of the MVC Opening Round at the State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament by securing the league's No. 6 seed after

finishing in a tie for fifth in the standings.

Starting guard Jake Kelly suffered a season ending knee injury with 12 minutes left in the conference opener at Southern Illinois and subsequently also lost Dwayne Lathan and Harry Marshall for extended periods over the course of the year.

Marshall, who was the heart and sole of the team, led the MVC in scoring in league contests with a 16.0 ppg average. Marshall was tabbed Second Team All-MVC and was named to the MVC's All-Defensive Team after turning in shutdown performances against most of the league's all-conference opposition. Running a well-rounded program, the Sycamores also two representatives on the MVC's Scholar Athlete Team as both Jordan Printy and Aaron Carter took those plaudits.

The payoff for the Sycamores continued as ISU reached postseason play for the first since 2001 when they accepted a bid to the 2010 College Basketball Invitational, appearing in a road contest at Saint Louis.

With a keen attention to details that most coaches think of as an afterthought, the Sycamores concentrated on extreme efficiency on the court, finishing the year as the nation's second leading free throw shooting team. ISU's 76.9 percent mark at the line finished just behind NCAA qualifier BYU on the NCAA Division I list for the best free throw shooting teams in the country.

Additionally, the Sycamores overcame a 24-point deficit in the second half at Missouri State before falling in overtime. The 24-point comeback in front of a national television audience was the largest in the history of the MVC by a team that at least forced overtime.

During his second stint with the Sycamore basketball program, Lansing has been a key recruiting for many talented student-athletes. Lansing has also been a major part of the several all-conference accolades for several players, including Harry Marshall and Jay Tunnell, who took All-MVC honors following the 2008-09 campaign. Last season, the Sycamores concluded the regular season by winning six of their final games, including a trio of road contests.

Lansing returned to Indiana State after a seven year stint with the Iowa Hawkeyes. During Lansing's seven years as assistant coach at Iowa, the Hawkeyes went 135-92, received three NCAA Tournament invitations, three NIT appearances and won a pair of Big Ten tournament titles, the first of which came on four wins in four games making Iowa the first team in the Big Ten to ac-

complish such a feat. In 2005-06, Iowa earned a 25-9 record, the second-most wins in school history, the first undefeated (17-0) home record in the school's history and a No. 3 seed in the NCAA Tournament. Iowa earned seven All-Big Ten selections, 17 Academic All-Big Ten selections and four Academic All-Americans. Lansing coached four of the last five Big Ten rebounding champions, three straight conference leaders in blocked shots and, the league's 2005-06 defensive player of the year. Three of his student-athletes reached the NBA and two from the 2005-06 team were invited to NBA camps.

In Lansing's final two seasons of his first stint at Indiana State, the Sycamores posted back-to-back winning campaigns for the first time since 1979 and 1980. When the Sycamores posted a 16-11 record in 1998 it marked the first winning season for Indiana State since 1980. Indiana State advanced to the NCAA Tournament in both 2000 and 2001.

Prior to joining the staff at Indiana State, Lansing was the head basketball coach at Roosevelt High School in Des Moines, Iowa. Roosevelt had not had a winning season in 12 years before Lansing's initial season. The Roughriders went on to have back-to-back winning seasons under Greg's direction.

Lansing earned a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of South Dakota in 1990 and a master's degree in counseling from USD in 1992. As a member of the Coyote basketball team Lansing helped South Dakota reach the NCAA Division II Tournament during his junior and senior seasons, the first NCAA invitation for USD since 1954. He was twice named the South Dakota Defensive Player of the Year. Greg is currently ranked among the leaders in career assists at USD. Following his playing career, Lansing served as a graduate assistant coach at South Dakota for two seasons. In 1992-93 he was a full-time assistant.

Greg's father, Dave Lansing, coached high school basketball for 33 years in Iowa. Dave Lansing was inducted into the Iowa High School Athletic Association Coaches Hall of Fame during the 1999 Iowa boys state basketball tournament. Lansing's dad, his mother, Diane, his sister, Angela, and his nephew, Jordan, live in West Des Moines. His brother, Steve, is the head basketball coach at Faribault High School (Minn.), where he was named Regional Coach of the Year in 2004. Lansing is married to the former Angie Menser, who is an Indiana State graduate and a former track and cross country academic All-American for the Sycamores. She currently serves as ISU's senior women's administrator and athletics business manager.

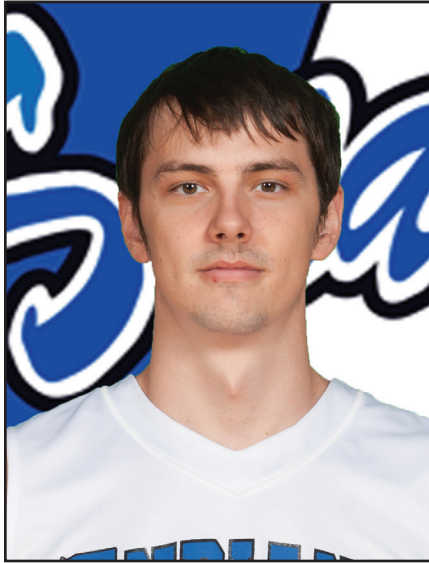
