### THE INDIANA STATE GAME

- San Diego State and Indiana State are meeting in the semifinals of the Diamond Head Classic. The Sycamores defeated Ole Miss, 87-85 in overtime, before the Aztecs dismissed the Dons, 80-58.
- The two teams are meeting for only the fourth time in the history of the series and first time since 1967. Indiana State has won all three meetings, including the first-ever get-to-

- gether, which was at a neutral site, 65-57, in 1950.
- San Diego State is meeting a member of the Missouri Valley Conference for the second time this year. Earlier this season, the Aztecs traveled to Missouri State and claimed a 60-44 victory.
- The winner of this game will advance to the Christmas day championship game.

### No. 18/15 San Diego State Will Put Its 10-Game Winning Streak On the Line Sunday vs. Indiana State at the Diamond Head Classic

No. 18/15 San Diego State will meet Indiana State in the semifinals of the 2012 Diamond Head Classic on Sunday at Stan Sheriff Center.

Game time is set for noon HT/2 p.m. PT and the contest will be broadcast nationally by ESPNU. Kanoa Leahy and Sean Farnham will have the call on television. The non-conference tilt can also be heard on radio on AM 600 KOGO and 101 KGB with Ted Leitner providing the description.

The Aztecs are looking to extend several significant winning streaks, including an 10-game overall win streak (7th-longest active win streak nationally), a 23-game December win streak (second-longest nationally) and an 11-game win streak at multi-team in-season events.

SDSU finds itself in the semifinals vs. Indiana State after a career afternoon for senior guard Chase Tapley. The Sacramento, Calif., native went off for a career-high 33 points, which was three shy of the tournament record, on the strength of a personal-record 13 field goals, including a season-high-tying six three-pointers. What is more impressive is that he scored his 33 points in 26 minutes, 33 seconds, after not scoring in the first 7 minutes, 20 seconds of the game and the final 6 minutes, 7 seconds. Tapley led a foursome of Aztecs who scored in double figures in Jamaal Franklin (11 points), DeShawn Stephens (10 points) and Xavier Thames (10 points).

### Storylines

- At 10-1, the Aztecs are off to their second-best start in Division I history (1970-71). The 2010-11 team opened the year with a 20-0 mark.
- With a victory over Indiana State, the Aztecs' 11-game winning streak would tie for the third-longest in school history.

■ SDSU has limited all 11 opponents to less than 48-percent field-goal shooting. The Aztecs have won 15 straight games when owning a better field-goal percentage than their opponents and 43-2 in its last 45 games when holding the opposition to less than 40-percent field-goal shooting.

■ Jamaal Franklin has scored in double figures in 31 consecutive games, which is the third-longest streak nationally.

■ Senior guard **Chase Tapley**, is one of two active NCAA players with 1,000 points, 300 rebounds, 200 assists, 150 steals and 40 blocks. He has made a three-point field goal in nine straight games and 15 consecutive games if you only count games played indoors (excludes Syracuse game on USS Midway). He has connected on 26 of his last 43 three-point field goal attempts, including a season-high six vs. UC Santa Barbara and vs. San Francisco.

### Streiking

■ San Diego State has won 10 consecutive games, which is the seventh-longest win streak in the country. The 10-game streak is the fourth-longest in program history.

■ San Diego State has won 10 straight non-conference games (tied second-longest in school history). A win on Sunday would be the school's second-longest streak.

■ San Diego State has won 33 straight regular-season games against unranked non-conference opponents.

■ San Diego State has won 23 straight December games (second-longest active streak nationally).

■ San Diego State has won 80 straight when leading with five minutes to play and 22 straight when leading at the half.

### Island Fever

■ The Aztecs have been dominant in multi-team in-season events/tournaments having won 11 straight and 23 of their last 24. The lone misstep was a 71-63 loss at Pacific in the 2009 West Coast Classic. Oddly enough, that was SDSU's last loss to a school from California.

■ This is Steve Fisher's fifth trip to Hawaii in his coaching career and is 9-2 lifetime.

■ While at Michigan, Fisher won the 1992 Rainbow Classic, defeating No. 20 Nebraska, No. 5 North Carolina and No. 2 Kansas. In 1994, Fisher led the Wolverines to a 2-1 record at the Maui Classic. Then in 2001, Fisher guided SDSU to its aforementioned win at Hawaii.

■ JJ O'Brien is the lone Aztec to have played in Hawaii. White at Utah, O'Brien played in all three games at the 2010 Diamond Head Classic and totaled five points, six rebounds and two assists, while starting the final two games of the tournament.

### SDSU vs. the Missouri Valley

■ San Diego State is 10-29 all-time vs. the Missouri Valley Conference.

■ The Aztecs have won five of their last six vs. the league and all five victories have come during Steve Fisher's 14-year career at San Diego State.

■ SDSU vs. current Missouri Valley members: 0-4 vs. Bradley, 1-4 vs. Creighton, 3-4 vs. Drake, 1-4 vs. Evansville, 1-2 vs.

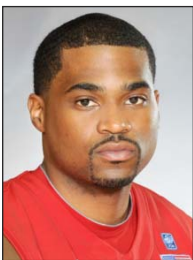
