Sycamores Begin Missouri Valley Play With Home Contest Against Illinois State

SETTING THE STAGE

Indiana State continues year three of the Greg Lansing era on Sunday, December 30 when the Sycamores (7-4, 0-0 MVC) open Missouri Valley Conference play against Illinois State (9-3, 0-0 MVC) inside Hulman Center. Tip-off is set for 1:05 p.m. (ET). The game will be broadcast live locally on WAWV-TV as well as worldwide on the internet on a pay-per-view basis on Sycamore Vision, which is a web stream service provided by GoSycamores.com with Jason Pensky (pbp) and Jim Waugh (analyst) on the call. The game can also be heard on the radio via WIBQ 98.5 FM and along the Nelligan Sports Marketing Radio Network with Brian Fritz (pbp) and Matt Renn (analyst) on the call. GoSycamores.com will have an audio only production of the radio broadcast as well.

THE ILLINOIS STATE SERIES

Illinois State holds a 58-49 margin in the all-time series, while Indiana State is 33-17 against the Redbirds in Terre Haute. The Sycamores have won each of the last five meetings against Illinois State at Hulman Center, dating back to Illinois State's last victory in Terre Haute which came on February 14, 2007.

QUICK HITS

- Indiana State is now 6-1 on the season when holding teams to 63 points or less and is to 32-2 when doing so under third-year head coach Greg Lansing.

- Indiana State has earned 40 close victories (five points or less) since 2005. Under Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 14-5 in close games.

- Manny Arop posted a career-high 27 points as part of the Sycamores' 87-85 overtime victory over Ole Miss in the opener of the 2012 Diamond Head Classic. He was named the MVC Newcomer Of The Week for the second consecutive time after leading the Sycamores in scoring during the tournament.

- Jake Odum now has 349 career assists which ranks him 10th on the Indiana State Career List. He is one of eight Sycamores to be in ISU Top 10 for both assists and steals in a career.

- Jake Odum is nationally-ranked in three different statistical categories (139th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.84), 93rd in assists per game (4.6) and 217th in points per game (15.0).

- Indiana State has now won each of its last two meetings against members of the Southeastern Conference (at Vanderbilt in 2011 & vs. Ole Miss in 2012).

- With the victory over Miami on December 25, Indiana State head coach Greg Lansing owns 45 for the Sycamores, which is one ahead of legendary head coach John Wooden and is 12th all-time at the school.

The Indiana State Head Coach

Indiana State head coach Greg Lansing (South Dakota, 1990) is 45-33 (.577) overall in his third season as a head coach. He is 20-16 all-time in MVC games, including a 13-5 mark at home and a 7-11 record on the road. During his career, he is 24-8 in all home games, 12-19 on the road, 9-6 in neutral court contests and 14-5 in games decided by five points or less. Lansing is 3-1 all-time against Illinois State, and is 2-0 versus the Redbirds inside Hulman Center. With the Trees, Lansing is 4-3 in overtime games and 32-2 when holding teams to 63 points or less. Sunday's game will be Greg Lansing's 79th as Indiana State head coach. Lansing is the second head coach to lead the Sycamores to the NCAA Tournament in their rookie campaign in the history of the program, with the other being Bill Hodges leading ISU to a 33-1 record and a Final Four appearance in the 1979 NCAA Tournament. Lansing was just the 14th rookie head coach in the history of the MVC to lead his team to 20 victories during their debut season.

The Illinois State contest will be televised locally on WAWV-TV as part of the Sycamores' institutional broadcast package. The game can also be seen live on Sycamore Vision, which is a pay-per-view web stream service provided by GoSycamores.com. A Little History

Indiana State is currently in its 117th season of college basketball at the school. The Sycamores are 1,392-1,200 all-time on the hardwood. Indiana State's game at Oral Roberts in 2010 was the historic 2,500th game in the history of the program.

For Valley Openers

Indiana State is beginning its 36th season as a member of the Missouri Valley Conference on Sunday afternoon against Illinois State inside Hulman Center. ISU is 14-21 all-time in Valley openers, including a 12-6 mark when opening the league slate at home. ISU won its first-ever MVC opener against Southern Illinois on January 4, 1977 at Hulman Center (66-58). ISU last won its league opener on December 29, 2010 with a 80-66 victory over Bradley. The Sycamores last opened the league schedule against Illinois State on December 22, 2005 with a 69-59 overtime home court victory. ISU also opened the MVC slate at Illinois State on January 3, 1996 with a 74-64 defeat at the hands of the Redbirds. ISU is 2-2 (2-0 at home) when beginning conference play against Illinois State.

Manny Arop Earns Second Consecutive MVC Newcomer Of The Week Honor

Indiana State junior Manny Arop has earned his second consecutive MVC Newcomer Of The Week honor after leading the team in scoring over three games at the Diamond Head Classic team with a 17.7 ppg average as the Sycamores won against Ole Miss and Miami to finish third in the eight-team field. Arop hit 18-of-44 shots for the week (40.9 percent), including seven 3-pointers and hit 10-of-11 free throws (90.9 percent). He averaged 4.7 rebounds per game and posted two assists with two steals while averaging 33.7 minutes per game. He was one of two Sycamores to reach double figures scoring in all three games of the tournament. Arop began the tournament by scoring a career-high 27 points in the overtime victory over Ole Miss. He added seven rebounds against the Rebels and hit 9-of-15 shots from the field, including four 3-pointers and was 5-of-6 from the free throw line. He added 13 points against nationally-ranked San Diego State with five rebounds, an assist and steal and concluded the week with 13 points and two rebounds against Miami in the Consolation Championship Game. Arop hit a pair of late free throws to get the Sycamores within a possession of the Hurricanes in regulation in the final game of the tournament. Arop earned the same honor on December 17 following the road victory over IUPUI.

Sycamores Put All Five Starters In Double Figures To Down Ole Miss In Diamond Head Classic Opener

Paced by a career-high 27 points from Manny Arop, the Indiana State Sycamores placed all five of their starters in double figures scoring as they downed Ole Miss 87-85 in overtime in the opener of the 2012 Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic on December 22. Justin Gant recorded his first career double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds while Dawon Cummings had 10 and RJ Mahurin scored 14. Jake Odum tallied 16 points to go with eight rebounds and eight assists to just miss his second career triple-double.

Indiana State Has Won Two In A Row Over The Southeastern Conference

The Indiana State Sycamores downed Ole Miss by the score of 87-85 in overtime in the opener of the 2012 Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic. Indiana State has now won each of its last two meetings against the SEC, as they won on the road at No. 25 Vanderbilt in 2011. ISU also earned its first victory since 1986 in Hawaii with the victory over the Rebels. The Sycamores have now won their opener in both the 2011 Old Spice Classic as well as the 2012 Diamond Head Classic.

Jake Odum Named To Bob Cousy Award Watchlist

Jake Odum has been named to the 2013 Bob Cousy Award Watch List. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame announced the watch list of candidates for the 2013 Bob Cousy Collegiate Point Guard of the Year Award. The annual honor, named for Hall of Famer and former Boston Celtic Bob Cousy, recognizes the top point guards in men's college basketball. Over 80 candidates have been nominated for the 2013 Bob Cousy Award. This watch list of candidates will be narrowed down to a final 20 around January 1st, final 10 near February 1st, and final five by approximately March 1st. A premier Selection Committee has been appointed by the Hall of Fame to review the final five candidates in contention for the nation's top collegiate point guard award. These Hall of Fame committees are made up of top college basketball personnel including media members, head coaches, Sports Information Directors and Hall of Famers. The winner of the 2013 Bob Cousy Award will be presented at the Hall of Fame's Class Announcement on Championship Monday in Atlanta as part of NCAA Final Four weekend.

Newcomers Are No Problem For Indiana State

A pair of Sycamore newcomers finished 1-2 in scoring for the Sycamores at Morehead State. Making his first career start, freshman Christian Smith led the team with 20 points, hitting 6-of-9 shots from the field and was 8-of-11 from the free throw line with an assist and a steal. Manny Arop continued his hot start to the season by scoring 19 points as well. Of the Sycamores' 63 points at Morehead State, a total of 45 (71.4 percent) was scored by newcomers. For the season, 311 points have come from newcomers, of a total of 744 scored (41.8 percent).

Jake Odum Now One Of Eight Players At ISU To Reach The Career Top 10 Lists For Assists & Steals

Indiana State junior guard Jake Odum has 136 career steals, which ranks him seventh all-time in the Sycamore basketball record book, needing 13 more to reach sixth place, currently held by Rick Fields (149 from 1981-85). Odum also now has 349 assists for his career which is good enough for 10th place. He needs one more to catch David Moss (350 from 2002 to 2006) for ninth all-time. Odum is the eighth Sycamore in the history of the program to rank in the Indiana State Top 10 for both assists and steals in a career.

Good Starter On The Battery

Indiana State is 6-1 this season when the Sycamore starters outscore their counterparts for the opposition. Under third-year head coach Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 30-8 when the ISU starting five scores more than their opponent's starters.

63 Is The Magic Number

The Sycamores win by the score of 57-55 in overtime against Miami on December 25 was ISU's sixth this season in which they held an opponent to 63 points or less and earned the victory. ISU is currently 6-1 on the season when holding an opponent under that total. Under third-year head coach Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 32-2 when allowing less than 63 points to the opposition (including a 13-0 mark when holding teams to 53 or less).

Sycamore Success Inside Hulman Center Under Greg Lansing

The Sycamores are 24-8 (.750) inside Hulman Center under third-year head coach Greg Lansing. The Sycamores have won 15 of their last 20 home games. Additionally, the Sycamores have won 13 of their last 18 MVC games at home.

Sycamores Win At Ball State For The First Time Since 1986

Indiana State won 68-48 at Ball State on November 20 to end an 11-game road losing skid to the Cardinals. It was their first victory in Muncie since 1986 and their first at Worthen Arena (which opened in 1991) in nine tries. The Sycamores earned their largest margin of victory over Ball State since 1977 and their largest road win against the Cardinals since 1919.

Sycamores In Postseason Play For Third Consecutive Season

With Indiana State's appearance in the 2012 CollegenInsider.com Postseason Tournament, the Sycamores have now made three consecutive trips to postseason play. ISU played in the 2010 College Basketball Invitational as well as the 2011 NCAA Tournament in addition to the CIT Tournament in 2012. The last time the Sycamores reached postseason play for three consecutive seasons came in 1977-79 when Indiana State played in the 1977 & 1978 NIT as well as the 1979 NCAA Tournament. The last time Indiana State hosted a postseason game came on March 10, 1978 when the Sycamores hosted Illinois State in the first round of the NIT.

Jake Odum Named To The Preseason All-Missouri Valley Team

Indiana State guard Jake Odum was one of five student-athletes named to the Preseason All-Missouri Valley Conference Team on October 29. Odum finished third in the Missouri Valley Conference with a 4.9 assists per game average. That mark was ranked 61st nationally. Odum recorded a career-high 12 assists against Fairfield as part of the Old Spice Classic, a number which ranked tied for fourth all-time at ISU in a single game. Odum is third in the MVC in steals per game with a 1.8 average, which ranks 81st nationally. Additionally, Odum's 4.5 assists per game average of his career is fifth-best in the history of the program while his 119 steals are ranked ninth-best in the Sycamore record books, while his 1.8 steals per game average ranks third.

Sycamores Picked To Finish 7th In Missouri Valley Conference Race

The Indiana State Sycamores were picked to finish seventh in the Missouri Valley Conference race according to a poll of league head coaches, sports information directors and a media panel. ISU finished eighth last season, with an 8-10 MVC record, just one game out of a large logjam for third place at 9-9.

Indiana State Posts Three Exhibition Victories In The Bahamas In August

Indiana State took advantage of the NCAA rule allowing teams to participate in a foreign tour of exhibition contests once every four years when they travelled to Nassau, Bahamas from August 12-14 and defeated the Giants 95-76, the Real Deal Shockers 116-75 and the PJ Stingers 76-55. Manny Arop scored 17 points to lead ISU against the Giants, while Dawon Cummings had 18 to pace the Sycamores against the Real Deal Shockers. The Sycamores were led in the final exhibition game of the tour by Lucas Eitel who scored 15 points versus the PJ Stingers.

Indiana State Reaches 17 Regular Season Victories For Third Consecutive Season; First Time Since Larry Bird Era

With its 59-46 victory over Missouri State on February 22, 2012, the Sycamores have now posted at least 17 regular season victories for the third consecutive season, which is the first time three Indiana State teams have reached that mark in succession since the 1976-77, 1977-78 & 1978-79 seasons. The Sycamores won 25 in 76-77, 19 in 77-78 and 26 in 78-79.

Triple-Double For Odum And Tournament Record To Boot

Jake Odum battled a foot injury while playing three games in four days at the 2011 Old Spice Classic. After two solid performances in the first two days of the event, Odum saved his best for last as he posted 10 points, 10 rebounds and 12 assists against Fairfield on November 27. That triple-double was the first by a Sycamore since Larry Bird posted one in 1979 versus Drake and the first by a member of the MVC in 14 seasons. Additionally, the 12 assists are an Old Spice Classic single-game record. His 12 assists is the first double digit assist total in his career and the first by a Sycamore since Michael Menser had 11 against Wichita State in 2001.

Up Next

Indiana State returns to road to take on Northern Iowa on January 2, 2013 in its first road contest of the MVC campaign. The game will tipoff at 8:00 p.m. (ET) and will be televised live on ESPN3.

The Last Time Out ...

HONOLULU -- Jake Odum hit a running jumper in the lane with 0.8 seconds left as the Sycamores overcame a late seven-point Miami lead to down the Hurricanes 57-55 in overtime to secure third place in the Diamond Head Classic.

The Sycamores went 2-1 in the tournament and improved to 7-4 on the season while Miami fell to 8-3. ISU won both of its games in the Diamond Head Classic in overtime as well as against the Power 6 (also winning 87-85 in overtime against Ole Miss on December 22).

Indiana State was limited to just 17-of-63 shooting from the field (27 percent). That is the lowest shooting percentage by a winning team in NCAA Division I Basketball so far this season. ISU did finish 17-of-18 from the free throw line (94.4 percent), including a pair by RJ Mahurin on the Sycamores' final offensive possession of regulation which tied the game.

Mahurin and Arop each tied for game high scoring honors with 13 points each. Jake Odum, who hit the game winning shot with 0.8 seconds left in overtime, had nine points, six rebounds and six assists in the contest.

Khrastian Smith secured his career-best 11th rebound of the game with just over 35 seconds left which set up a Sycamore timeout. Indiana State ran the clock all the way down to six seconds, spread the floor and Odum provided the heroics with a bankshot before the buzzer for the 57-55 victory.

The win over Miami was the first for the Sycamores since the 1979 NCAA Tournament against a current member of the Atlantic Coast Conference when they downed Virginia Tech. ISU also improved to 4-3 in overtime games under Greg Lansing and are 32-2 when holding teams under 63 points or less.

The Sycamores got a defensive stop to begin the overtime period and scored first on a field goal by Khrastian Smith as ISU took a 51-49 lead. After Miami was able to knot the game at 51 just over a minute into the extra period, Arop hit a driving lay-up with 3:21 left to stake ISU to a 53-51 advantage.

Miami would score four points in a row until Arop hit a pair of free throws with just over a minute remaining to even the game again at 55.

Miami would score eight of the first 10 points in the second half after holding a two point lead over the Sycamores and found themselves up 31-23 with 17:17 remaining in the game. The Sycamores would counter with five points in a row to trim the Hurricane lead down to just 31-28 on a pair of free throws by Odum as well an Arop try as he reached double figures scoring in each game of the Diamond Head Classic.

Miami ran the lead back out to 33-28, but Arop countered with a lay-up to cut the Hurricane advantage down to three points with just over 12 minutes remaining. The Sycamores would not score again until the 8:15 mark when Lucas Eitel hit 1-of-2 free throws to cut the lead down to 39-31. Devonte Brown hit a pair of free throws and converted the conventional 3-point play with 4:27 remaining to cut the Miami advantage down to 43-40.

The Hurricanes would go on to score the game's next four points until Mahurin hit a pair of free throws at the 2:25 mark to cut the Miami cushion down to just 47-42. Lucas Eitel then stepped up after a defensive stop and buried a 3-pointer with just under two minutes on the clock to make it a two point game. After Larkin scored for Miami to move the lead out to 49-45, Odum was fouled driving to the basket and hit both free throws to make it 49-47 with 1:02 remaining.

Miami would go to miss a pair of free throws with 32 seconds left and Mahurin was fouled after grabbing an offensive rebound at the 16.9 second mark. He hit both ensuing free throws to knot the game at 49. The Sycamores got a defensive stop and had a last second heave fall short to send the Sycamores to their second overtime game of the Diamond Head Classic.

Justin Gant scored first for Indiana State with an open lay-up off the feed for Odum to stake the Sycamores to a quick 2-0 lead less than a minute in. The Hurricanes would go on to score the next nine points of the game until Devonte Brown banked one in to cut the Miami lead down to 9-4 with 14:19 remaining in the opening stanza.

Dawon Cummings and Manny Arop drilled 3-pointers around the nine minute mark but Miami continued to pound the ball inside to own a 15-10 edge with 8:30 left in the first half. Odum connected on a 3-pointer with 4:25 left to inch the Sycamores within 17-15.

Arop converted a conventional 3-point play with 1:23 left in the first half to make it 23-21 in favor of Miami and the Sycamores missed a pair of second chance opportunities with less than 10 seconds left that would have knotted the game at the break.

Arop led the Sycamores with six points at the half, and Indiana State owned a 24-23 edge on the glass despite giving up 12 second chance points and 20 points in the paint.

Kenny Kadji led Miami with 11 points.

Indiana State Head Basketball Coach Third Season

Greg Lansing is in his third season as the head basketball coach at Indiana State. He previously spent eight seasons with the program as an assistant coach, including the previous three as associate head coach.

Lansing burst onto the scene as a rookie head coach with the Sycamore basketball program in 2010-11 as he became just the second-ever Indiana State head coach to lead the team to the NCAA Tournament in his first season. He led the team to a 20-14 record, becoming just the 14th head coach in the history of the Missouri Valley Conference to lead a team to 20 or more victories in their first year at the helm.

In 2011-12, the Sycamores finished the year with an 18-15 record and advanced to the CollegelInsiders.com Postseason Tournament. It marked the third consecutive year the team has reached postseason play -- its longest such stretch since the 1977, 1978 and 1979 seasons when Larry Bird donned the Indiana State uniform.

Jake Odum was one of just four players nationally to average at least 10 points, five rebounds and 4.5 assists per game during his sophomore season and was a Second Team All-Missouri Valley Conference selection as well as Second Team All-District selection as announced by the National Association of Basketball Coaches.

The Sycamores downed No. 25 nationally-ranked Vanderbilt on the road and finished third at the Old Spice Classic -- the best-ever finish by a MVC team in the event.

ISU reached the NCAA Tournament and took on Syracuse in Cleveland, Ohio based on the program's third-ever MVC Tournament Championship won at the Scottrade Center in St. Louis, Mo. ISU raced to the title with victories over No. 6 Evansville, No. 2 Wichita State and No. 1 Missouri State in the Championship Game as the Sycamores entered as the No. 3 seed in the tournament. Freshman Jake Odum was named to the MVC All-Tournament Team.

Odum was named a CollegelInsider.com Mid Major Freshman All-American and was named an All-MVC Honorable Mention selection as well as a member of the MVC All-Freshman, All-Newcomer and All-Defense Team. Carl Richard was also named to the All-MVC's Honorable Mention squad. ISU took two thrilling buzzer beating victories over league foes Missouri State and Creighton during the regular season at Hulman Center. The buzzer beater over Creighton by Richard was voted the No. 2 play of the weekend by ESPN's SportsCenter.

In 2009-10 the Sycamores overcame a ton of adversity to still put together its best season in nearly a decade under the professional leadership of the ISU coaching staff. Despite only having its full compliment of student-athletes for just 28 minutes of the rough and tumble Missouri Valley Conference slate, the Sycamores still recorded its first winning season since 2001 as they finished 17-15. ISU also finished the year with a 9-9 record in league play, bolstering the Sycamores out of the MVC Opening Round at the State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament by securing the league's No. 6 seed after

finishing in a tie for fifth in the standings.

Starting guard Jake Kelly suffered a season ending knee injury with 12 minutes left in the conference opener at Southern Illinois and subsequently also lost Dwayne Lathan and Harry Marshall for extended periods over the course of the year.

Marshall, who was the heart and sole of the team, led the MVC in scoring in league contests with a 16.0 ppg average. Marshall was tabbed Second Team All-MVC and was named to the MVC's All-Defensive Team after turning in shutdown performances against most of the league's all-conference opposition. Running a well-rounded program, the Sycamores also two representatives on the MVC's Scholar Athlete Team as both Jordan Printy and Aaron Carter took those plaudits.

The payoff for the Sycamores continued as ISU reached postseason play for the first since 2001 when they accepted a bid to the 2010 College Basketball Invitational, appearing in a road contest at Saint Louis.

With a keen attention to details that most coaches think of as an afterthought, the Sycamores concentrated on extreme efficiency on the court, finishing the year as the nation's second leading free throw shooting team. ISU's 76.9 percent mark at the line finished just behind NCAA qualifier BYU on the NCAA Division I list for the best free throw shooting teams in the country.

Additionally, the Sycamores overcame a 24-point deficit in the second half at Missouri State before falling in overtime. The 24-point comeback in front of a national television audience was the largest in the history of the MVC by a team that at least forced overtime.

During his second stint with the Sycamore basketball program, Lansing has been a key recruiting for many talented student-athletes. Lansing has also been a major part of the several all-conference accolades for several players, including Harry Marshall and Jay Tunnell, who took All-MVC honors following the 2008-09 campaign. Last season, the Sycamores concluded the regular season by winning six of their final games, including a trio of road contests.

Lansing returned to Indiana State after a seven year stint with the Iowa Hawkeyes. During Lansing's seven years as assistant coach at Iowa, the Hawkeyes went 135-92, received three NCAA Tournament invitations, three NIT appearances and won a pair of Big Ten tournament titles, the first of which came on four wins in four games making Iowa the first team in the Big Ten to ac-

complish such a feat. In 2005-06, Iowa earned a 25-9 record, the second-most wins in school history, the first undefeated (17-0) home record in the school's history and a No. 3 seed in the NCAA Tournament. Iowa earned seven All-Big Ten selections, 17 Academic All-Big Ten selections and four Academic All-Americans. Lansing coached four of the last five Big Ten rebounding champions, three straight conference leaders in blocked shots and, the league's 2005-06 defensive player of the year. Three of his student-athletes reached the NBA and two from the 2005-06 team were invited to NBA camps.

In Lansing's final two seasons of his first stint at Indiana State, the Sycamores posted back-to-back winning campaigns for the first time since 1979 and 1980. When the Sycamores posted a 16-11 record in 1998 it marked the first winning season for Indiana State since 1980. Indiana State advanced to the NCAA Tournament in both 2000 and 2001.

Prior to joining the staff at Indiana State, Lansing was the head basketball coach at Roosevelt High School in Des Moines, Iowa. Roosevelt had not had a winning season in 12 years before Lansing's initial season. The Roughriders went on to have back-to-back winning seasons under Greg's direction.

Lansing earned a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of South Dakota in 1990 and a master's degree in counseling from USD in 1992. As a member of the Coyote basketball team Lansing helped South Dakota reach the NCAA Division II Tournament during his junior and senior seasons, the first NCAA invitation for USD since 1954. He was twice named the South Dakota Defensive Player of the Year. Greg is currently ranked among the leaders in career assists at USD. Following his playing career, Lansing served as a graduate assistant coach at South Dakota for two seasons. In 1992-93 he was a full-time assistant.

Greg's father, Dave Lansing, coached high school basketball for 33 years in Iowa. Dave Lansing was inducted into the Iowa High School Athletic Association Coaches Hall of Fame during the 1999 Iowa boys state basketball tournament. Lansing's dad, his mother, Diane, his sister, Angela, and his nephew, Jordan, live in West Des Moines. His brother, Steve, is the head basketball coach at Faribault High School (Minn.), where he was named Regional Coach of the Year in 2004. Lansing is married to the former Angie Menser, who is an Indiana State graduate and a former track and cross country academic All-American for the Sycamores. She currently serves as ISU's senior women's administrator and athletics business manager.

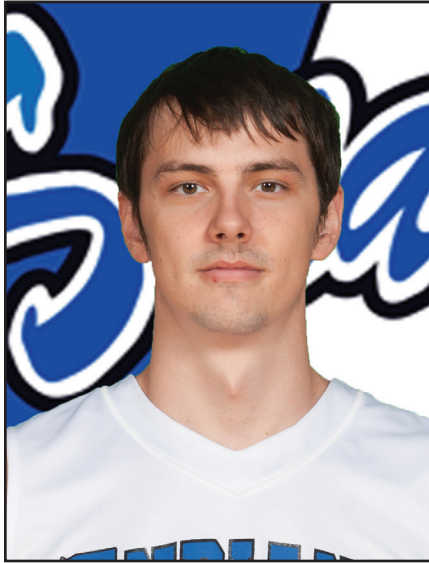
