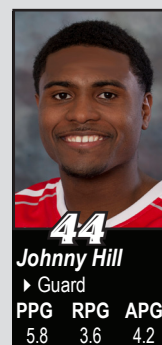

QUICK HITS ABOUT #REDBIRDHOOPS #DANSBACK #BACKTHEBIRDS

- Since joining the Missouri Valley Conference in 1981-82, the Redbirds are 15-16 in league openers.
- The Redbirds are 8-8 in Valley season openers that occur on the road. Illinois State's last Valley-opening road win came at Missouri State (72-69, ot) on Dec. 28, 2008.
- Illinois State has won four out of its last five Valley openers, including last year's 65-61 win over Northern Iowa on Doug Collins Court at Redbird Arena on Dec. 29, 2011.
- Illinois State has opened Valley play three times against Indiana State, once in Terre Haute, Ind., and twice at home in Normal, Ill. The Redbirds are 1-2 in Valley openers against the Sycamores (Jan. 3, 1996: W, 74-64, Normal, Ill.) (Jan. 6, 2001: L, 78-71, Normal, Ill.) (Dec. 22, 2005: L, 69-59, ot).
- Illinois State has not won in Terre Haute, Ind., since a 68-53 victory on Feb. 14, 2007
- The Redbirds feature the highest-scoring offense in the Valley, averaging a league-best 81.0 points per game.
- Illinois State's field goal percentage (50.8 percent) ranks second in the Valley and ninth in the nation.
- Illinois State's success this season has been based on 70 points. If the Redbirds reach 70, they win. If not, they lose. ISU is 9-0 when scoring 70 or more and 0-3 when scoring less than 70.
- The Redbirds have led at halftime in 11 out of 12 games this season. They only trailed at Drexel on Nov. 15.
- **Jackie Carmichael** is two blocks away from tying the career-blocked shots record. Carmichael has 158 career blocks, while the record holder, **Greg Dilligard**, had 160 blocks during his career from 2004-07.
- **Jackie Carmichael** ranks second in the Valley with 18.3 points averaged per game. Over the last four games, Carmichael has averaged 24.3 points per game.
- **Jackie Carmichael** ranks first in the Valley with 2.2 blocked shots averaged per game.
- **Kaza Keane** ranks second in the Valley with 5.3 assists averaged per game.
- First-year head coach **Dan Muller** became the 19th men's basketball coach in ISU history on May 8, 2012.

ABOUT INDIANA STATE

- Indiana State University is located in Terre Haute, Ind., and has an enrollment of 11,494. The Sycamores compete at the NCAA Division I level and are members of the Missouri Valley Conference.
- The Sycamores return one starter from last year's team which finished 18-15 with an 8-10 Valley record (8th). Indiana State is picked to finish seventh in the Valley this season.
- Illinois State leads the all-time series, 58-49. The Redbirds and Sycamores split their season series last year, with Illinois State winning at home, 67-54 (Jan. 18), and losing on the road, 83-77 (ot) (Feb. 14).

RED-HOT REDBIRDS

It might be cold outside, but Illinois State's offense has been red hot. The Redbirds rank ninth in the nation and second in the Missouri Valley Conference with a 50.8 field goal percentage. ISU's scoring offense also ranks among the nation's best, as Illinois State is 12th nationally and first in the Valley with 81.0 points averaged per contest.

SHARING THE ROCK

Illinois State's offensive success this year is a direct result of unselfish play. Along with boasting the top scoring offense in the Missouri Valley Conference (81.0), the Redbirds also lead the league in assists per game, with 18.1. That mark ranks seventh in the nation. ISU guard **Kaza Keane** ranks second in the league with 5.3 assists per game, while **Johnny Hill** is tied for fifth with 4.2.

BEATING THE BEST TO BE THE BEST

When Illinois State head coach **Dan Muller** was first hired in May of 2012, he vowed to improve the Redbirds' non-conference strength of schedule to better prepare ISU for the challenging Missouri Valley Conference. The Redbirds not only gained valuable experience, but also a winning record against added quality road opponents, Drexel, No. 5 Louisville and Dayton. The Redbirds went 2-1 against the three teams, with an 86-84 overtime win at Drexel (Nov. 15), a 69-66 loss at No. 5 Louisville (Dec. 1) and a 74-73 win at Dayton (Dec. 19).

THE MAGIC NUMBER IS 70

Illinois State's success this season has been based on 70 points. If the Redbirds reach 70, they win. If not, they lose. ISU is 9-0 when scoring 70 or more and 0-3 when scoring less than 70.

FIRST HALF FRENZY

Illinois State has dominated in the first half of nearly every game this season. The Redbirds have led at halftime in 11 out of their first 12 games, with the only exception being a 43-37 deficit at Drexel. ISU has outscored its opponents in the first half 534-to-392, which breaks down to a game average of 44.5 ISU first-half points compared to 32.7 opponent first-half points.

BLOCKING IN ON HISTORY

With two blocked shots in the win at Dayton and one in the win over Austin Peay, ISU senior forward **Jackie Carmichael** pulled within two blocks of the career-blocked shots record. Carmichael now has 158 blocks, which puts him just two blocks away from tying the Illinois State record of 160 set by **Greg Dilligard**, who played from 2003-07. Carmichael already has 26 blocks through the first 12 games (2.2 per contest).

TEAM SCORING

At least three Redbirds have netted double-figures in 10 of ISU's 12 games this season. Four reached double-figures in the opener versus UC Santa Barbara (Nov. 12), five scored double-figures at Drexel, (Nov. 15), three tallied double-figures against Delaware State, (Nov. 18), four reached double-figures versus Fairleigh Dickinson, (Nov. 20), three scored double-figures against UAB, (Nov. 23), three netted double-figures against Wyoming (Dec. 4), three reached double-figures versus Western Michigan (Dec. 8), three scored double-figures against Morgan State (Dec. 16), three netted double figures at Dayton (Dec. 19) and four scored double-figures against Austin Peay (Dec. 22). ISU is 9-1 when three or more players score in double-figures, and 0-2 when less than three net double-figures.

THEY SAY IT'S BETTER TO GIVE THAN TO RECEIVE

In the spirit of the holiday season, Illinois State is spreading the scoring cheer with a 217-to-181 (1.2) assist to turnover ratio through the first 12 games. ISU has teamed up for four 20-plus assists games this year, and sophomore **Johnny Hill** amassed a Redbird season-high 10 assists in the win over Western Michigan on Dec. 4.

KING OF THE HILL

Sophomore guard **Johnny Hill**, who averaged just 7.4 minutes per game last season, has been a vital part of ISU's success this year. After point guard **Kaza Keane** was sidelined with an ankle injury, Hill stepped up to make his first five career starts, and over the last six games, he has led ISU with 37 assists (6.2 per game), 12 steals (2.0 per game) and an average of 5.7 points and 4.8 rebounds per contest.

THREE-FOR-30

Senior forward **Jackie Carmichael's** career-high 30-point performance in Illinois State's win over Morgan State Sunday afternoon marked the third time a Redbird has scored 30 or more points in a single game so far this season. The other 30-plus point efforts were from **Bryant Allen** (30 points versus UAB on Nov. 23) and **Tyler Brown** (36 points versus Northwestern on Nov. 24). Illinois State is the only program in the country which has had three different players score 30 or more points this season.

FORCE TURNOVERS, WIN GAMES

The Redbirds are 8-0 this season when they force more turnovers than their opposition, and 1-3 when they commit more turnovers. The Redbirds won their first game with more turnovers than their opponent in the victory at Dayton on Dec. 19.

THE 700 CLUB

ISU forward **Jackie Carmichael** is one of just 11 Redbirds in program history to collect 700 or more rebounds. Carmichael grabbed his 700th board in the win against Western Michigan on Dec. 8. He now has 732 career rebounds and ranks 10th on the career rebounding list. He is also a 1,000-point club member.

THE FRENCH CONNECTION

Illinois State senior forward **John Wilkins** recorded his three best games of the season in ISU's matchups against Wyoming (Dec. 4), Western Michigan (Dec. 8) and Austin Peay (Dec. 22). The Antibes, France native netted 12 against Wyoming and 16 on a career-best seven field goals versus Western Michigan. He also scored 14 points in the win over Austin Peay, and Wilkins is averaging 6.1 points and 3.2 rebounds per game this season.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK AWARDED TO CARMICHAEL

Dec. 27

Jackie Carmichael received the honor for the second time this season and the fourth time in his career, after helping the Redbirds to wins against Dayton and Austin Peay last week. He averaged a double-double with 21.5 points and 11.5 rebounds per game during Illinois State's two wins last week, including the 74-73 victory at Dayton, followed by the 83-57 win over Austin Peay. Carmichael matched his season high with 12 rebounds Wednesday night at Dayton. He also netted 25 points to tally his sixth 20-plus-point game of the year and the 16th of his career. The Manhattan, Kan., native was 9-for-14 (64.3 percent) from the field and 7-for-9 (77.8 percent) at the free throw line. He also blocked two shots and collected one steal and one assist. In Illinois State's win over Austin Peay Saturday afternoon, Carmichael earned his 25th-career double-double, and fourth of the season, with 18 points and 11 rebounds.

Nov. 19

Carmichael set or tied a career high in four categories, including points (27), field goals (13), field goal attempts (20) and assists (3), in Illinois State's season-opening win against UC Santa Barbara Nov. 12, and he then led the Redbirds offensively with a 21-point performance during ISU's overtime win at Drexel Nov. 15. With Drexel leading, 75-73, Carmichael was fouled with 2.0 seconds remaining and proceeded to hit two pressure-packed free throws to send the game into overtime. The Valley Player of the Week award is the first for Illinois State since Carmichael won it Jan. 30, 2012. That was the lone player of the week honor awarded to the Redbirds last season.

A PERFECT STRETCH

With ISU and Wyoming tied, 21-21, in the first half of the Dec. 4 matchup, the Redbirds went on a 20-3 run to take a 41-24 lead with 3:49 remaining. During the scoring streak, ISU connected on seven-consecutive field goals without a miss, including six-straight three pointers. **Tyler Brown** netted three treys, **Jon Ekey** added two and **Nick Zeisloft** scored one during the run.

BACK-TO-BACK 30-POINT GAMES

Senior guard **Tyler Brown** and junior guard **Bryant Allen** each scored 30 or more points in back-to-back games at the South Padre Island Invitational in South Padre Island, Texas. Allen netted a career-high 30 points, on 9-for-15 shooting (60.0 percent), in Illinois State's win over UAB on Nov. 23. In doing so, he became the first Redbird since 2010 to score 30 points in a game. While it previously took two years between 30-point games, Brown accomplished the feat 24 hours after Allen, against Northwestern on Nov. 24. He netted a career-high 36 points on 12-for-20 shooting (60.0 percent), which was the fourth-highest scoring output in the nation this season, and the most points scored by a Redbird since **Tarise Bryson** tallied 41 against Central Michigan on Dec. 3, 2000.

THE ALLEN WRENCH

Junior **Bryant Allen** proved to be ISU's most useful tool Nov. 23, in the win over UAB. Allen netted a career-high 30 points and was credited with a career-best six steals. In doing so, he became the first Redbird since **Dinma Odiakosa** to score 30 points in a game. Odiakosa accomplished the feat Feb. 17, 2010, versus Missouri State. Allen also recorded the first five-plus steal effort since **Anthony Cousin** had five steals at Bradley, Feb. 26, 2011.

THE REDBIRD QUINTET

In a balanced scoring effort, five Redbirds tallied double figures during the win over Drexel (Nov. 15). **Jackie Carmichael** (21), **Tyler Brown** (20), **Johnny Hill** (13), **Bryant Allen** (11) and **Jon Ekey** (10) became the first quintet to accomplish that feat since Dec. 2011. The Dragons also had five players with 10 or more points.

THIS IS SPORTSCENTER

Two **Tyler Brown** dunks from ISU's win over Drexel made ESPN's Top Plays list Nov. 15-16. No. 5 was an alley-oop dunk from **Bryant Allen**, and No. 4 was an alley-oop dunk from **Kaza Keane**.

EXPERIENCED BIRDS

Illinois State features an experienced team, including four seniors, three juniors, four sophomores and just two freshmen - with only one true-freshman (**Kaza Keane**). ISU welcomes back four out of five starters from last year's team and returns 84.5 percent of offense (2,062/2,439), 92.4 percent of rebounding (1,135/1,229), 100 percent of shot blocking (118/118) and 69.1 percent of assists (317/459).

IT'S MULLER TIME

The last time the ISU men's basketball team participated in the NCAA Tournament, **Dan Muller** was the leader on the floor. He hopes to repeat that accomplishment, this time from the sideline, as the head coach. Muller was named the 19th men's basketball coach in school history May 8, 2012.
