Indiana State Returns Home To Face Bradley Wednesday Evening

SETTING THE STAGE

Indiana State continues year three of the Greg Lansing era on Saturday, January 12 when the Sycamores (10-5, 3-1 MVC) hit the road for the third time in their first five league contests to take on Southern Illinois (7-8, 0-4 MVC) inside SIU Arena. Tip-off is set for 8:00 p.m. (ET). The game will be broadcast locally on WTWO-TV with Jason Pensky (pbp) and Jim Waugh (analyst) on the call. The game can also be heard on the radio via WIBQ 98.5 FM and along the Nelligan Sports Marketing Radio Network with Brian Fritz (pbp) and Matt Renn (analyst) on the call. GoSycamores.com will have an audio only production of the radio broadcast as well.

THE SOUTHERN ILLINOIS SERIES

In a series which began in 1916, Southern Illinois holds a 77-43 lead in the all-time series against Indiana State. The Sycamores have won five of the last six meetings in the series, including the each of the last two. Southern Illinois leads the series in Carbondale by a 47-11 margin with the Sycamores last victory on the road over the Salukis coming on February 16, 2011 in the form of a 77-72 victory.

QUICK HITS

- Indiana State is 8-1 on the season when holding teams to 63 points or less and is 34-2 when doing so under third-year head coach Greg Lansing (and 14-0 when limiting teams to 53 or less).
- Indiana State has earned 42 close victories (five points or less) since 2005. Under Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 16-5 in close games.
- Both Jake Odum and Justin Gant have reached double figures scoring in each of the last four games.
- Jake Odum now has 361 career assists which ranks him ninth on the Indiana State Career List. He is one of eight Sycamores to be in ISU Top 10 for both assists and steals in a career.
- Jake Odum is nationally-ranked in five different statistical categories (194th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.56), 113th in assists per game (4.4), 242nd in free throw percentage (76.8), 178th in steals per game (1.71) and 247th in points per game (14.6).
- Indiana State is 7-1 this season when hitting at least 36.4 percent of their 3-pointers.
- The Sycamores have recorded more free throws than their opponents in each of the past four games.
- Jake Odum tied a career-high with five steals against Northern Iowa on January 2.
- ISU set a NCAA record by hitting a perfect 12-of-12 from 3-point range on Feb. 12, 2012 at home against Southern Illinois.
- Indiana State has made more free throws in MVC play (80) than all league teams have attempted except Missouri State (83) through four games of conference action.

The Indiana State Head Coach

Indiana State head coach Greg Lansing (South Dakota, 1990) is 48-34 (.585) overall in his third season as a head coach. He is 23-17 all-time in MVC games, including a 15-5 mark at home and an 8-12 record on the road. During his career, he is 26-8 in all home games, 13-20 on the road, 9-6 in neutral court contests and 16-5 in games decided by five points or less. Lansing is 4-1 all-time against Southern Illinois, and is 1-1 versus the Salukis on the road. With the Trees, Lansing is 4-3 in overtime games and 34-2 when holding teams to 63 points or less. Saturday's game will be Greg Lansing's 83rd as Indiana State head coach. Lansing is the second head coach to lead the Sycamores to the NCAA Tournament in their rookie campaign in the history of the program, with the other being Bill Hodges leading ISU to a 33-1 record and a Final Four appearance in the 1979 NCAA Tournament. Lansing was just the 14th rookie head coach in the history of the MVC to lead his team to 20 victories during their debut season.

A Little History

Indiana State is currently in its 117th season of college basketball at the school. The Sycamores are 1,395-1,201 all-time on the hardwood. Indiana State's game at Oral Roberts in 2010 was the historic 2,500th game in the history of the program.

Sycamores Start 3-1 In Missouri Valley Play For The First Time Since 2010-11

Indiana State began Missouri Valley Conference play with a perfect 2-0 record for the first time since the 2007-08 campaign when the Sycamores achieved a 3-0 burst out of the gate. The Sycamores downed Illinois State at home in the league opener and earned a road victory over Northern Iowa on January 2. Now in its 36th season of MVC play, the Sycamores have started 2-0 just six times, including this season. It marked just the sixth time in 36 seasons of MVC play that the Sycamores won each of their first two league games. So far, the Sycamores are 3-1 in the MVC for the first time since the 2010-11 campaign.

Looking At The Keys To A Sycamore Victory

Indiana State has several key statistical factors to track in each game that indicates that they are heading down the path a victory. The first is the halftime score. The Sycamores are 8-0 on the season when leading at the half. Additionally, ISU is 4-0 this season when putting at least four players in double figures scoring and hold the same record when shooting at least 50 percent from the field. One other area to track is rebounding as the Sycamores are a perfect 6-0 this year when they rebound the opposition.

Indiana State Stuffs The Paint Against Bradley

The Sycamores tallied a season-best nine blocked shots against Bradley on January 9 as they earned a 68-53 home court victory -- their fourth in a row at home against the Braves. It was the most for the Sycamores since they had 10 against Bradley back in December of 2010 in the MVC opener that season.

Justin Gant With A Second Solid Week To Start MVC Play

Justin Gant continued his strong start to Missouri Valley Conference play as he paced the team with 18 points in a road victory over Northern Iowa and came back with 12 points in a narrow defeat in Omaha against nationally-ranked Creighton. For the week, Gant averaged 15.0 ppg and 3.5 rebounds per contest. He hit 13-of-25 shots from the field (52.0 percent), hit a 3-pointer to start the Indiana State scoring in each game and finished with three trifectas in all. He added seven rebounds, one assist, one blocked shot and one steal while averaging 28.5 minutes per game. Gant was 8-of-12 from the field at UNI to tie his career-high of 18 points and pull down six rebounds. He led the charge with six consecutive points in the first half as part of an 11-0 run which staked the Sycamores to an early lead. At Creighton, he hit a pair of 3-pointers to score 12 points with a rebound, assist, blocked shot and steal in a team-high 31

Manny Arop Continues Strong Play Heading Into Third Week Of MVC Play

Manny Arop averaged 11.0 points and 3.0 rebounds per game as the Sycamores split a pair of road games against Northern Iowa and nationally-ranked Creighton during the first full week of Missouri Valley Conference play. Arop began the week by scoring nine points and pulling down four rebounds at UNI and then paced the team with 13 points on a 4-of-8 shooting performance with a pair of 3-pointers and a trio of free throws with two rebounds and a steal at Creighton. Arop sealed the game by with a bankshot jumper with 44 seconds left in the second half at UNI which put the Sycamores ahead by seven points. He kick started a 10-0 run early in the second half which put the Sycamores ahead 39-32 with 17:31 left as he hit a 3-pointer to tie the game and stretched the ISU advantage with a pair of free throws a minute later.

Sycamores Continue Their Recent Push Higher Up The NCAA RPI Rankings

As part of the Missouri Valley Conference's recent rise to No. 9 in the RPI ratings, is the explosive push upward by Indiana State, which has risen from a ranking of No. 188 in mid-December to now No. 25 in the NCAA RPI team rankings, as posted on RealTimeRPI.com. The Sycamores have played the toughest schedule of all 10 MVC teams, according to the RPI, as ISU leads the league with a No. 11 Strength Of Schedule ranking. Nationally-ranked Creighton owns a MVC-best No. 17 RPI while Wichita State checks in at No. 18. The Sycamores have played six Top 50 RPI teams this season and own quality victories against No. 7 Miami, No. 48 Ole Miss and No 114 Northern Iowa. Miami (No. 7) is the highest-highest ranked team the Sycamores have played this season, just ahead of No. 10 New Mexico, whom ISU dropped an overtime decision to at home on December 1.

Jake Odum Named To Bob Cousy Award Watchlist

Jake Odum has been named to the 2013 Bob Cousy Award Watch List. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame announced the watch list of candidates for the 2013 Bob Cousy Collegiate Point Guard of the Year Award. The annual honor, named for Hall of Famer and former Boston Celtic Bob Cousy, recognizes the top point guards in men's college basketball. Over 80 candidates have been nominated for the 2013 Bob Cousy Award. This watch list of candidates will be narrowed down to a final 20 around January 1st, final 10 near February 1st, and final five by approximately March 1st. A premier Selection Committee has been appointed by the Hall of Fame to review the final five candidates in contention for the nation's top collegiate point guard award. These Hall of Fame committees are made up of top college basketball personnel including media members, head coaches, Sports Information Directors and Hall of Famers. The winner of the 2013 Bob Cousy Award will be presented at the Hall of Fame's Class Announcement on Championship Monday in Atlanta as part of NCAA Final Four weekend.

Newcomers Are No Problem For Indiana State

With Jake Odum being the lone Sycamore starter to return in 2012-13, Indiana State has relied on a stable of five newcomers so far this season for a large chunk of its offensive production. Led by Manny Arop, who is a two-time MVC Newcomer Of The Week selection and is currently second on the team with a 12.8 ppg average ISU has seen just over four of every 10 points come from someone who was not on the active roster one year ago. For the season, 410 points have come from newcomers, of a total of 1,020 scored (40.2 percent).

Jake Odum Now One Of Eight Players At ISU To Reach The Career Top 10 Lists For Assists & Steals

Indiana State junior guard Jake Odum has 146 career steals, which ranks him seventh all-time in the Sycamore basketball record book, needing three more to reach sixth place, currently held by Rick Fields (149 from 1981-85). Odum also now has 361 assists for his career which is good enough for ninth place. He needs eight more to catch Nick Hargrove (369 from 1993 to 1997) for eighth all-time. Odum is the eighth Sycamore in the history of the program to rank in the Indiana State Top 10 for both assists and steals in a career.

Good Starter On The Battery

Indiana State is 7-1 this season when the Sycamore starters outscore their counterparts for the opposition. Under third-year head coach Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 31-8 when the ISU starting five scores more than their opponent's starters.

63 Is The Magic Number

The Sycamores win by the score of 68-53 on January 9 against Bradley was ISU's eighth this season in which they held an opponent to 63 points or less and earned the victory. ISU is currently 8-1 on the season when holding an opponent under that total. Under third-year head coach Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 34-2 when allowing less than 63 points to the opposition (including a 14-0 mark when holding teams to 53 or less).

Indiana State Has Won Two In A Row Over The Southeastern Conference

The Indiana State Sycamores downed Ole Miss by the score of 87-85 in overtime in the opener of the 2012 Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic. Indiana State has now won each of its last two meetings against the SEC, as they won on the road at No. 25 Vanderbilt in 2011. ISU also earned its first victory since 1986 in Hawaii with the victory over the Rebels. The Sycamores have now won their opener in both the 2011 Old Spice Classic as well as the 2012 Diamond Head Classic.

Sycamore Success Inside Hulman Center Under Greg Lansing

The Sycamores are 26-8 (.765) inside Hulman Center under third-year head coach Greg Lansing. The Sycamores have won 17 of their last 22 home games. Additionally, the Sycamores have won 15 of their last 20 MVC games at home.

Sycamores Win At Ball State For The First Time Since 1986

Indiana State won 68-48 at Ball State on November 20 to end an 11-game road losing skid to the Cardinals. It was their first victory in Muncie since 1986 and their first at Worthen Arena (which opened in 1991) in nine tries. The Sycamores earned their largest margin of victory over Ball State since 1977 and their largest road win against the Cardinals since 1919.

Sycamores In Postseason Play For Third Consecutive Season

With Indiana State's appearance in the 2012 CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament, the Sycamores have now made three consecutive trips to postseason play. ISU played in the 2010 College Basketball Invitational as well as the 2011 NCAA Tournament in addition to the CIT Tournament in 2012. The last time the Sycamores reached postseason play for three consecutive seasons came in 1977-79 when Indiana State played in the 1977 & 1978 NIT as well as the 1979 NCAA Tournament. The last time Indiana State hosted a postseason game came on March 10, 1978 when the Sycamores hosted Illinois State in the first round of the NIT.

Jake Odum Named To The Preseason All-Missouri Valley Team

Indiana State guard Jake Odum was one of five student-athletes named to the Preseason All-Missouri Valley Conference Team on October 29. Odum finished third in the Missouri Valley Conference with a 4.9 assists per game average. That mark was ranked 61st nationally. Odum recorded a career-high 12 assists against Fairfield as part of the Old Spice Classic, a number which ranked tied for fourth all-time at ISU in a single game. Odum is third in the MVC in steals per game with a 1.8 average, which ranks 81st nationally. Additionally, Odum's 4.5 assists per game average of his career is fifth-best in the history of the program while his 119 steals are ranked ninth-best in the Sycamore record books, while his 1.8 steals per game average ranks third.

Sycamores Picked To Finish 7th In Missouri Valley Conference Race

The Indiana State Sycamores were picked to finish seventh in the Missouri Valley Conference race according to a poll of league head coaches, sports information directors and a media panel. ISU finished eighth last season, with an 8-10 MVC record, just one game out of a large logjam for third place at 9-9.

Indiana State Reaches 17 Regular Season Victories For Third Consecutive Season; First Time Since Larry Bird Era

With its 59-46 victory over Missouri State on February 22, 2012, the Sycamores have now posted at least 17 regular season victories for the third consecutive season, which is the first time three Indiana State teams have reached that mark in succession since the 1976-77, 1977-78 & 1978-79 seasons. The Sycamores won 25 in 76-77, 19 in 77-78 and 26 in 78-79.

Triple-Double For Odum And Tournament Record To Boot

Jake Odum battled a foot injury while playing three games in four days at the 2011 Old Spice Classic. After two solid performances in the first two days of the event, Odum saved his best for last as he posted 10 points, 10 rebounds and 12 assists against Fairfield on November 27. That triple-double was the first by a Sycamore since Larry Bird posted one in 1979 versus Drake and the first by a member of the MVC in 14 seasons. Additionally, the 12 assists are an Old Spice Classic single-game record. His 12 assists is the first double digit assist total in his career and the first by a Sycamore since Michael Menser had 11 against Wichita State in 2001.

Up Next

Indiana State begins a two-game MVC homestand on Wednesday, January 16 when they host Missouri State, who is also off to a 3-1 start to conference play. The game will tip-off at 7:05 p.m. (ET) and will be televised on WTWO-TV.

The Last Time Out ...

TERRE HAUTE, Ind. -- Led by a balanced scoring attack and lock down defense, the Indiana State men's basketball team (10-5, 3-1 MVC) improved to 3-1 in Missouri Valley Conference play with a 68-53 win over the visiting Braves of Bradley (10-6, 2-2 MVC) Wednesday inside Hulman Center.

The Sycamores improved to 34-2 when holding opponents to 63 points or less and 13-0 when holding opponents to 53 points or less under head coach Greg Lansing. ISU is 3-1 to start MVC play for the first time since a similar start in 2007-08. The Sycamores are 10-5 to begin the season for the second consecutive year.

With the win the Sycamores have now won four straight home contests against Bradley and five in its last six attempts against the Braves.

Justin Gant and Manny Arop led the Sycamores with 13 points each while Jake Odum added 11. Nine different Sycamores scored in the contest and as a team Indiana State shot 50% from the floor. Junior RJ Mahurin and Dawon Cummings led the Sycamores rebounding effort with six boards each.

Defensively, the Sycamores held the Braves to 21-66 shooting for 32% while out rebounding the Braves by a 38-34 margin. Indiana State is a perfect 6-0 on the season when outrebounding the opposition. The Sycamores recorded a season-best nine blocked shots, including a season-best three from Gant.

The Sycamore offense struck first, taking a 4-0 lead over the Braves off baskets by juniors Manny Arop and Jake Odum. The Braves answered with two buckets in the lane before junior Justin Gant hit a triple and long jumper to give the Sycamores a 9-4 lead just four minutes into the opening frame.

Throughout the opening minutes, the Sycamores used a balance scoring attack with five different Sycamores recording points in the first 11 minutes of action and shooting 50% as a team from the floor

With just over eight minutes remaining in the first half, the Sycamores extended their lead to six at 20-14 following an Arop layup and free throw by junior Dawon Cummings. The Braves battled back over the next three minutes before using back-to-back baskets off turnovers to take their first lead of the game at 23-22.

The Bradley lead was short lived thanks to a pair of Gant free throws and a jumper by freshman Khristian Smith to give the Sycamores a 26-23 lead. The Sycamores held onto a three-point lead for the remainder of the half, holding a 28-25 advantage at the break.

Smith led six Sycamore scorers with eight halftime points coming off 3-4 shooting from the floor and 2-2 from the charity stripe. Gant also added seven points while the Sycamores held the Braves to just 34% shooting as a team.

Coming out of the locker room the Sycamores began to heat up on offense hitting four of their first five shots of the second frame. Arop got the Sycamores going with a mid-range jumper followed by a Mahurin bucket to give the Sycamores a seven-point advantage at 32-25.

Following the first media timeout of the second half, freshman Devonte Brown hit a pair of free throws and sophomore Jake Kitchell recorded a layup to give the Sycamores a 10-point advantage at 41-31.

The Braves battled back with a five point run with just over 10 minutes left to play to cut the Sycamores lead to five at 45-40 before making it a one possession game with 7:30 left to play.

Kitchell ended a four-minute Sycamore scoring drought with a layup to followed by an Arop jumper to move the Sycamores back in front of the Braves by seven and force a Bradley timeout.

Odum extended the Sycamore lead even further with just over four minutes to play as he banked in a triple with the shot clock running down to give ISU a 55-46 advantage.

Gant became the first Sycamore to reach double figures off a pair of free throws following the under four minute media timeout to give the Sycamores their largest lead of the game at 57-46.

The Sycamores grew their lead to 15 over the final minutes and went on to defeat the Braves by a final score of 68-53.

Bradley was led by a 15-point effort from Walt Lemon, Jr. The Braves recorded 12 steals in the contest, paced by five from Dyrucus Simms-Edwards and four from Lemon, Jr.

Indiana State Head Basketball Coach Third Season

Greg Lansing is in his third season as the head basketball coach at Indiana State. He previously spent eight seasons with the program as an assistant coach, including the previous three as associate head coach.

Lansing burst onto the scene as a rookie head coach with the Sycamore basketball program in 2010-11 as he became just the second-ever Indiana State head coach to lead the team to the NCAA Tournament in his first season. He led the team to a 20-14 record, becoming just the 14th head coach in the history of the Missouri Valley Conference to lead a team to 20 or more victories in their first year at the helm.

In 2011-12, the Sycamores finished the year with an 18-15 record and advanced to the CollegenInsiders.com Postseason Tournament. It marked the third consecutive year the team has reached postseason play -- its longest such stretch since the 1977, 1978 and 1979 seasons when Larry Bird donned the Indiana State uniform.

Jake Odum was one of just four players nationally to average at least 10 points, five rebounds and 4.5 assists per game during his sophomore season and was a Second Team All-Missouri Valley Conference selection as well as Second Team All-District selection as announced by the National Association of Basketball Coaches.

The Sycamores downed No. 25 nationally-ranked Vanderbilt on the road and finished third at the Old Spice Classic -- the best-ever finish by a MVC team in the event.

ISU reached the NCAA Tournament and took on Syracuse in Cleveland, Ohio based on the program's third-ever MVC Tournament Championship won at the Scottrade Center in St. Louis, Mo. ISU raced to the title with victories over No. 6 Evansville, No. 2 Wichita State and No. 1 Missouri State in the Championship Game as the Sycamores entered as the No. 3 seed in the tournament. Freshman Jake Odum was named to the MVC All-Tournament Team.

Odum was named a CollegenInsider.com Mid Major Freshman All-American and was named an All-MVC Honorable Mention selection as well as a member of the MVC All-Freshman, All-Newcomer and All-Defense Team. Carl Richard was also named to the All-MVC's Honorable Mention squad. ISU took two thrilling buzzer beating victories over league foes Missouri State and Creighton during the regular season at Hulman Center. The buzzer beater over Creighton by Richard was voted the No. 2 play of the weekend by ESPN's SportsCenter.

In 2009-10 the Sycamores overcame a ton of adversity to still put together its best season in nearly a decade under the professional leadership of the ISU coaching staff. Despite only having its full compliment of student-athletes for just 28 minutes of the rough and tumble Missouri Valley Conference slate, the Sycamores still recorded its first winning season since 2001 as they finished 17-15. ISU also finished the year with a 9-9 record in league play, bolstering the Sycamores out of the MVC Opening Round at the State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament by securing the league's No. 6 seed after

finishing in a tie for fifth in the standings.

Starting guard Jake Kelly suffered a season ending knee injury with 12 minutes left in the conference opener at Southern Illinois and subsequently also lost Dwayne Lathan and Harry Marshall for extended periods over the course of the year.

Marshall, who was the heart and sole of the team, led the MVC in scoring in league contests with a 16.0 ppg average. Marshall was tabbed Second Team All-MVC and was named to the MVC's All-Defensive Team after turning in shutdown performances against most of the league's all-conference opposition. Running a well-rounded program, the Sycamores also two representatives on the MVC's Scholar Athlete Team as both Jordan Printy and Aaron Carter took those plaudits.

The payoff for the Sycamores continued as ISU reached postseason play for the first since 2001 when they accepted a bid to the 2010 College Basketball Invitational, appearing in a road contest at Saint Louis.

With a keen attention to details that most coaches think of as an afterthought, the Sycamores concentrated on extreme efficiency on the court, finishing the year as the nation's second leading free throw shooting team. ISU's 76.9 percent mark at the line finished just behind NCAA qualifier BYU on the NCAA Division I list for the best free throw shooting teams in the country.

Additionally, the Sycamores overcame a 24-point deficit in the second half at Missouri State before falling in overtime. The 24-point comeback in front of a national television audience was the largest in the history of the MVC by a team that at least forced overtime.

During his second stint with the Sycamore basketball program, Lansing has been a key recruiting for many talented student-athletes. Lansing has also been a major part of the several all-conference accolades for several players, including Harry Marshall and Jay Tunnell, who took All-MVC honors following the 2008-09 campaign. Last season, the Sycamores concluded the regular season by winning six of their final games, including a trio of road contests.

Lansing returned to Indiana State after a seven year stint with the Iowa Hawkeyes. During Lansing's seven years as assistant coach at Iowa, the Hawkeyes went 135-92, received three NCAA Tournament invitations, three NIT appearances and won a pair of Big Ten tournament titles, the first of which came on four wins in four games making Iowa the first team in the Big Ten to ac-

complish such a feat. In 2005-06, Iowa earned a 25-9 record, the second-most wins in school history, the first undefeated (17-0) home record in the school's history and a No. 3 seed in the NCAA Tournament. Iowa earned seven All-Big Ten selections, 17 Academic All-Big Ten selections and four Academic All-Americans. Lansing coached four of the last five Big Ten rebounding champions, three straight conference leaders in blocked shots and, the league's 2005-06 defensive player of the year. Three of his student-athletes reached the NBA and two from the 2005-06 team were invited to NBA camps.

In Lansing's final two seasons of his first stint at Indiana State, the Sycamores posted back-to-back winning campaigns for the first time since 1979 and 1980. When the Sycamores posted a 16-11 record in 1998 it marked the first winning season for Indiana State since 1980. Indiana State advanced to the NCAA Tournament in both 2000 and 2001.

Prior to joining the staff at Indiana State, Lansing was the head basketball coach at Roosevelt High School in Des Moines, Iowa. Roosevelt had not had a winning season in 12 years before Lansing's initial season. The Roughriders went on to have back-to-back winning seasons under Greg's direction.

Lansing earned a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of South Dakota in 1990 and a master's degree in counseling from USD in 1992. As a member of the Coyote basketball team Lansing helped South Dakota reach the NCAA Division II Tournament during his junior and senior seasons, the first NCAA invitation for USD since 1954. He was twice named the South Dakota Defensive Player of the Year. Greg is currently ranked among the leaders in career assists at USD. Following his playing career, Lansing served as a graduate assistant coach at South Dakota for two seasons. In 1992-93 he was a full-time assistant.

Greg's father, Dave Lansing, coached high school basketball for 33 years in Iowa. Dave Lansing was inducted into the Iowa High School Athletic Association Coaches Hall of Fame during the 1999 Iowa boys state basketball tournament. Lansing's dad, his mother, Diane, his sister, Angela, and his nephew, Jordan, live in West Des Moines. His brother, Steve, is the head basketball coach at Faribault High School (Minn.), where he was named Regional Coach of the Year in 2004. Lansing is married to the former Angie Menser, who is an Indiana State graduate and a former track and cross country academic All-American for the Sycamores. She currently serves as ISU's senior women's administrator and athletics business manager.
