**Sycamores Continue Road Swing With
First Meeting Of The Season Against Drake**

SETTING THE STAGE

Indiana State continues year three of the Greg Lansing era on Saturday, February 2 when the Sycamores (14-7, 7-3 MVC) conclude a week-long, two-game Valley road swing at Drake (10-11, 4-6 MVC) inside the Knapp Center. Tip-off is set for 7:30 p.m. (ET). The game will be broadcast live on the Missouri Valley Conference Television Network as well as ESPN3 with Scott Warmann (pbp) and Kevin Lehman (analyst) on the call. The game can also be heard on the radio via WIBQ 98.5 FM and along the Nelligan Sports Marketing Radio Network with Brian Fritz (pbp) and Matt Renn (analyst) on the call. GoSycamores.com will have an audio only production of the radio broadcast as well. Television clearances for the MVC TV Network as well as the ESPN3 broadcast are included on page two of this release.

THE DRAKE SERIES

Indiana State holds a 40-35 record in the all-time series against Drake, which dates back to 1945. The Sycamores have won seven of the last eight games against the Bulldogs, including two of the last three in Des Moines. Indiana State owns an 11-24 mark on the road against Drake.

QUICK HITS

- The Sycamores lead the MVC with victories against the RPI Top 25 with two, a number which is tied for seventh nationally.
- Indiana State leads the MVC in conference games only for field goal percentage defense with a 39.7 percent mark and are second in shooting with a 46.7 percent mark from the field through 10 MVC contests.
- Indiana State is 12-2 on the season when holding teams to 63 points or less and is 38-3 when doing so under third-year head coach Greg Lansing (and 14-0 when limiting teams to 53 or less).
- Indiana State has earned 43 close victories (five points or less) since 2005. Under Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 17-7 in close games.
- Manny Arop has reached double figures scoring in each of the last eight games.
- Jake Odum now has 388 career assists which ranks him eighth on the Indiana State Career List. He is one of eight Sycamores to be in ISU Top 10 for both assists and steals in a career.
- Jake Odum currently has 965 career points scored, needing only 35 more to become the 35th member of the Sycamores' 1,000 point club.
- Indiana State is 9-1 this season when hitting at least 36.4 percent of their 3-pointers.
- Indiana State has held two opponents this season without a 3-point field goal (Miami & Illinois State).
- The Sycamores defeated No. 14/15 Wichita State on January 29, its first victory over a nationally-ranked team in five attempts this season and first since at No. 25 Vanderbilt in December of 2011.
- Indiana State has outshot their opponents in field goal percentage in each of the past seven games.

The Indiana State Head Coach

Indiana State head coach Greg Lansing (South Dakota, 1990) is 52-36 (.591) overall in his third season as a head coach. He is 27-19 all-time in MVC games, including an 18-5 mark at home and a 9-14 record on the road. During his career, he is 29-8 in all home games, 14-22 on the road, 9-6 in neutral court contests and 17-7 in games decided by five points or less. Lansing is 3-1 all-time against Drake, and is 1-1 versus the Bulldogs on the road. With the Trees, Lansing is 4-3 in overtime games and 38-3 when holding teams to 63 points or less. Saturday's game will be Greg Lansing's 89th as Indiana State head coach. Lansing is the second head coach to lead the Sycamores to the NCAA Tournament in their rookie campaign in the history of the program, with the other being Bill Hodges leading ISU to a 33-1 record and a Final Four appearance in the 1979 NCAA Tournament. Lansing was just the 14th rookie head coach in the history of the MVC to lead his team to 20 victories during their debut season.

The Drake road contest is being televised regionally on the Missouri Valley Conference Television Network. The game will be cleared on Fox Sports Midwest, Fox Sports Indiana and Fox Sports Kansas City as well as Comcast SportsNet Chicago. The game can be found on DirecTV Channel 671, Dish Network Channel 418 and AT&T U-Verse Channel 748. The game will also be show on tape delay at 9:30 p.m. (ET) on Fox College Sports Atlantic. Additionally, the game will be carried live on ESPN3 (black out applies in the MVC footprint of Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Missouri and Nebraska).

A Little History

Indiana State is currently in its 117th season of college basketball at the school. The Sycamores are 1,399-1,203 all-time on the hardwood. Indiana State's game at Oral Roberts in 2010 was the historic 2,500th game in the history of the program.

Sycamores Use Stellar Defensive Effort To Stop Wichita State's 19-Game Home Court Winning Streak

Indiana State limited No. 14/15 Wichita State to just 27.1 percent shooting from the field to earn a 68-55 victory at Charles Koch Arena on January 29. ISU held the Shockers to a season-low 16-of-59 effort from the field, including a mar of 7-of-31 from inside the 3-point arc. The victory for the Sycamores was the first by a visiting team at Wichita State in the last 19 games, dating back to December of 2011 and was their worst home loss since 2009. The victory was also the first this season for the Sycamores this season against a nationally-ranked team in five attempts although ISU does own victories over now nationally-ranked Ole Miss and Miami.

Manny Arop Hits Double Figures Twice Last Week; Now At Seven In A Row

Manny Arop led the Sycamores with 17 points at No. 14/15 Wichita State on January 29 on the strength of a 7-of-11 shooting effort with six rebounds and two steals. Arop hit several big shots to keep the Shockers at bay in the second half, including a long rebound and full court dunk in the final two minutes to secure the victory. Arop has reached double digit scoring in each of the last eight games and leads the team with 17 double digit scoring performances for the year. In the last eight games that Arop has reached double figures, Arop is averaging 13.9 points and 4.0 rebounds per game to lead the team in scoring. He has hit 42-of-77 shots from the field (54.5 percent), including nine 3-pointers and is 18-of-25 from the free throw line (72 percent).

Indiana State One Of Just Five Teams Nationally To Own Multiple Victories Against Top 10 Conference Leaders

The Indiana State Sycamores are one of just five teams nationally to own a victory over a leader of a conference that ranks in the Top nationally according to the RPI and a third is just one game out of its league race. ISU downed Miami, leader of the ACC back on December 25 at the Diamond Head Classic and on January 29 won at MVC leading Wichita State. ISU also downed Ole Miss on December 22, which had led the SEC until its loss against Kentucky this week. Additionally, the Sycamores lead the MVC with two wins this season against the Top 25 of the RPI and are tied for seventh nationally for total Top 25 victories.

Jake Odum Hits Game Winning Free Throws Against Northern Iowa

Indiana State junior guard Jake Odum paced the Sycamores with a 12.5 point per game average as ISU earned a split against Illinois State and Northern Iowa. Odum added 5.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 1.5 steals per game over the two-game stretch. Odum was 8-of-9 at the free throw line over the two games, including two charity tosses with 0.3 seconds on the clock against Northern Iowa which gave the Sycamores a 59-58 victory over the Panthers. Odum paced the Sycamores with 16 points as he made 5-of-9 shots from the field, including a 3-pointer and was 6-of-7 from the free throw line. He added seven rebounds, five assists, a blocked shot and one steal. He had nine points with four rebounds, one assist and two steals at Illinois State. Odum nearly hit a game-winning 3-pointer at the buzzer against the Redbirds as his attempt

Looking At The Keys To A Sycamore Victory

Indiana State has several key statistical factors to track in each game that indicates that they are heading down the path a victory. The first is the halftime score. The Sycamores are 9-0 on the season when leading at the half. Additionally, ISU is 5-1 this season when putting at least four players in double figures scoring and are a perfect 7-0 when shooting at least 50 percent from the field. One other area to track is rebounding as the Sycamores are 9-1 this year when they outrebound the opposition. Additionally, the Sycamores are 12-2 when limiting a team to 63 points or less.

Sycamores Continue Their Recent Push Higher Up The NCAA RPI Rankings

As part of the Missouri Valley Conference's recent rise to No. 9 in the RPI ratings, is the explosive push upward by Indiana State, which has risen from a ranking of No. 188 in mid-December to now No. 38 in the NCAA RPI team rankings, as posted on RealTimeRPI.com. The Sycamores have played the second-toughest schedule of all 10 MVC teams, according to the RPI, as ISU owns a No. 43 Strength Of Schedule ranking. Nationally-ranked Wichita State owns a MVC-best No. 25 RPI while Creighton checks in at No. 30. The Sycamores have played seven Top 50 RPI teams this season and own quality victories against No. 3 Miami, at No. 25 Wichita State, No. 40 Ole Miss and No. 108 Northern Iowa (twice). Miami (No. 3) is the highest-highest ranked team the Sycamores have played this season, just ahead of No. 6 New Mexico, whom ISU dropped an overtime decision to at home on December 1.

Jake Odum Closing In On The 1,000 Point Mark

Indiana State junior guard Jake Odum is closing in on the 1,000-point mark for his career as he has 965 points after a 10-point outing at Wichita State on January 29. He needs just 35 more to become the 35th member of the Sycamore 1,000 point club. If Odum is able to reach that mark this season, he would become just the eighth Sycamore in the history of the program to reach the 1,000-point mark during his junior season. Other Sycamores to reach 1,000 points by the end of their junior campaign are Larry Bird (1,877 in two seasons), John Sherman Williams (1,787), Jerry Newsom (1,338), Butch Wade (1,135), David Moss (1,214), Eddie Bird (1,207) and Kelyn Block (1,018).

Greg Lansing Takes Suits and Sneakers For Cancer Awareness To The Indiana State Capital Building

Indiana State and Northern Iowa participated in the annual Coaches vs. Cancer Suits and Sneaks Challenge along with the rest of the nation's teams this weekend. All of the basketball coaches in the state of Indiana have issued a challenge to the state's lawmakers to wear sneakers with their suits on Monday, January 28 as part of the program to promote cancer awareness. Through an invitation from State Representative Bob Heaton, who played for ISU on the 1978-79 team which advanced to the NCAA Final Four, ISU head coach Greg Lansing will officially issue the day's challenge to Indiana Speaker Of The House Brian Bosma at the State House in Indianapolis on January 28.

Sycamores Hold Second Team This Season Without A Triple

Indiana State did not allow a made 3-pointer at Illinois State on January 23 as the Redbirds went 0-for-13 from long range on their home court and snapped a string of over 400 games with one which dated back to 1999. It marked the second time this season that the Sycamores have not allowed a trey in a game as nationally-ranked Miami went 0-of-15 back on December 25 in the consolation game of the Diamond Head Classic. For the season, the Sycamores are allowing teams to make just 30.4 percent of their threes attempted (96-of-316), which ranks third in the MVC behind Missouri State and Creighton.

Newcomers Are No Problem For Indiana State

With Jake Odum being the lone Sycamore starter to return in 2012-13, Indiana State has relied on a stable of five newcomers so far this season for a large chunk of its offensive production. Led by Manny Arop, who is a two-time MVC Newcomer Of The Week selection and is currently second on the team with a 13.2 ppg average ISU has seen just over four of every 10 points come from someone who was not on the active roster one year ago. For the season, 589 points have come from newcomers, of a total of 1,416 scored (41.6 percent).

Jake Odum Now One Of Eight Players At ISU To Reach The Career Top 10 Lists For Assists & Steals

Indiana State junior guard Jake Odum has 151 career steals, which ranks him sixth all-time in the Sycamore basketball record book, needing 14 more to reach fifth place, currently held by Matt Renn (165 from 1997-01). Odum also now has 388 assists for his career which is good enough for eighth place. He needs 38 more to catch Michael Menser (426 from 1997 to 2001) for seventh all-time. Odum is the eighth Sycamore in the history of the program to rank in the Indiana State Top 10 for both assists and steals in a career.

Greg Lansing Moves Into Sycamore Top 10 For All-Time Victories

With the 59-58 victory over Northern Iowa on January 26, Indiana State head coach Greg Lansing recorded his 51st career victory – which moves him into sole possession of 10th place on the ISU all-time wins list. Lansing is the fourth fastest coach to reach the 50 victory mark as he has accomplished the feat in only 85 games.

Sycamore Success Inside Hulman Center Under Greg Lansing

The Sycamores are 29-8 (.784) inside Hulman Center under third-year head coach Greg Lansing. The Sycamores have won 20 of their last 25 home games. Additionally, the Sycamores have won 18 of their last 23 MVC games at home.

63 Is The Magic Number

The Sycamores win by the score of 68-55 on January 29 at Wichita State was ISU's 12th this season in which they held an opponent to 63 points or less and earned the victory. ISU is currently 12-2 on the season when holding an opponent under that total. Under third-year head coach Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 38-3 when allowing less than 63 points to the opposition (including a 14-0 mark when holding teams to 53 or less).

Good Starter On The Battery

Indiana State is 8-1 this season when the Sycamore starters outscore their counterparts for the opposition. Under third-year head coach Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 32-8 when the ISU starting five scores more than their opponent's starters.

Jake Odum Named To Bob Cousy Award Watchlist

Jake Odum has been named to the 2013 Bob Cousy Award Watch List. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame has announced the watch list of candidates for the 2013 Bob Cousy Collegiate Point Guard of the Year Award. The annual honor, named for Hall of Famer and former Boston Celtic Bob Cousy, recognizes the top point guards in men's college basketball. Over 80 candidates have been nominated for the 2013 Bob Cousy Award. This watch list of candidates will be narrowed down to a final 20 around January 1st, final 10 near February 1st, and final five by approximately March 1st. A premier Selection Committee has been appointed by the Hall of Fame to review the final five candidates in contention for the nation's top collegiate point guard award. These Hall of Fame committees are made up of top college basketball personnel including media members, head coaches, Sports Information Directors and Hall of Famers. The winner of the 2013 Bob Cousy Award will be presented at the Hall of Fame's Class Announcement on Championship Monday in Atlanta as part of NCAA Final Four weekend.

Indiana State Has Won Two In A Row Over The Southeastern Conference

The Indiana State Sycamores downed Ole Miss by the score of 87-85 in overtime in the opener of the 2012 Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic. Indiana State has now won each of its last two meetings against the SEC, as they won on the road at No. 25 Vanderbilt in 2011. ISU also earned its first victory since 1986 in Hawaii with the victory over the Rebels. The Sycamores have now won their opener in both the 2011 Old Spice Classic as well as the 2012 Diamond Head Classic.

Sycamores Win At Ball State For The First Time Since 1986

Indiana State won 68-48 at Ball State on November 20 to end an 11-game road losing skid to the Cardinals. It was their first victory in Muncie since 1986 and their first at Worthen Arena (which opened in 1991) in nine tries. The Sycamores earned their largest margin of victory over Ball State since 1977 and their largest road win against the Cardinals since 1919.

Sycamores In Postseason Play For Third Consecutive Season

With Indiana State's appearance in the 2012 CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament, the Sycamores have now made three consecutive trips to postseason play. ISU played in the 2010 College Basketball Invitational as well as the 2011 NCAA Tournament in addition to the CIT Tournament in 2012. The last time the Sycamores reached postseason play for three consecutive seasons came in 1977-79 when Indiana State played in the 1977 & 1978 NIT as well as the 1979 NCAA Tournament. The last time Indiana State hosted a postseason game came on March 10, 1978 when the Sycamores hosted Illinois State in the first round of the NIT.

Jake Odum Named To The Preseason All-Missouri Valley Team

Indiana State guard Jake Odum was one of five student-athletes named to the Preseason All-Missouri Valley Conference Team on October 29. Odum finished third in the Missouri Valley Conference with a 4.9 assists per game average. That mark was ranked 61st nationally. Odum recorded a career-high 12 assists against Fairfield as part of the Old Spice Classic, a number which ranked tied for fourth all-time at ISU in a single game. Odum is third in the MVC in steals per game with a 1.8 average, which ranks 81st nationally. Additionally, Odum's 4.5 assists per game average of his career is fifth-best in the history of the program while his 119 steals are ranked ninth-best in the Sycamore record books, while his 1.8 steals per game average ranks third.

Sycamores Picked To Finish 7th In Missouri Valley Conference Race

The Indiana State Sycamores were picked to finish seventh in the Missouri Valley Conference race according to a poll of league head coaches, sports information directors and a media panel. ISU finished eighth last season, with an 8-10 MVC record, just one game out of a large logjam for third place at 9-9.

Indiana State Reaches 17 Regular Season Victories For Third Consecutive Season; First Time Since Larry Bird Era

With its 59-46 victory over Missouri State on February 22, 2012, the Sycamores have now posted at least 17 regular season victories for the third consecutive season, which is the first time three Indiana State teams have reached that mark in succession since the 1976-77, 1977-78 & 1978-79 seasons. The Sycamores won 25 in 76-77, 19 in 77-78 and 26 in 78-79.

The Sycamores return home to face off against nationally-ranked Creighton on Wednesday, February 6. Tip-off is set for 7:05 p.m. (ET).

The Last Time Out ...

WICHITA, Kan. -- For the first time in five tries, Indiana State has downed a nationally-ranked opponent this season as they downed MVC-leading No. 14/15 Wichita State 68-55 in front of a sold out crowd at Charles Koch Arena.

The Sycamores improved to 14-7, 7-3 MVC while Wichita State saw its 19-game home court winning streak end as they fell to 19-3, 8-2 MVC. ISU won at Wichita for the first time in eight tries (since 2004) and won on the road against a nationally-ranked opponent for the first time since at No. 25 Vanderbilt in December of 2011.

It marked the highest ranked opponent a Sycamore team has beaten since No. 14 Butler in 2006 and highest on the road since 1999 at No. 15 Indiana.

Arop led the team with 17 points, as he hit 7-of-11 shots from the field. He added six rebounds. Devonte Brown and Jake Odum each scored 10 points for the Sycamores.

The Sycamores hit 24-of-45 shots from the field to shoot 53.3 percent. Wichita State was limited to 27.1 percent from the field (16-of-59). ISU held a 35-34 lead in rebounding for the contest.

Leading 58-51 with 3:08 remaining, the Sycamores faced the Wichita State pressure and were forced the call their third timeout of the game. After an empty possession, the Sycamore got a coveted defensive stop as the clock ticked towards two minutes remaining. Odum was fouled away from the ball, and hit both free throws to run the lead out to 60-51.

After a Wichita State 3-pointer was long, Odum hit a pair of free throws with 1:28 left to stretch the lead out to 62-51. Arop then got a steal and was fouled where he hit both free throws to make it 64-51. The Sycamore scoring ended with a fastbreak dunk from Arop in the final two seconds for the 68-55 victory.

Wichita State hit a pair of 3-pointers to score on two of their first three trips down the floor and take a 6-0 advantage, but the Sycamores roared back to knot the contest with a trey from Manny Arop at the 18:09 mark and then a putback from RJ Mahurin as well as free throw by Devonte Brown.

The Sycamores used an 8-0 run to erase a 10-6 deficit, a spurt which was capped off a dunk by Justin Gant at the 12:08 mark to stake ISU to a 14-10 advantage. Each of the teams traded baskets as Arop hit a contested jumper at the 9:31 mark of the first half to give ISU the 18-15 cushion before Tekele Cotton hit a trey to knot the contest.

The Shockers ran their lead out to 25-22 on their fifth 3-pointer of the first half, but Khristian Smith answered with a pair of free throws to cut the Wichita State lead down to just a point with 4:12 remaining and then Brown converted the conventional 3-point play at the 3:47 mark to give ISU a 27-25 advantage.

Indiana State would score 17 of the final 20 point of the first half, including a key 11-0 run which was capped by a pair of free throws from Gant with 1:07 on the clock to stretch the lead out to 33-25. Fred Van Vleet hit the Shockers' sixth 3-pointer of the opening stanza to cut the Sycamore lead down to five points, but the Sycamores responded with the fourth four-point play of Mahurin's career with 32 seconds left to make it 37-28.

The first half ended with a steal and breakaway lay-up from Khristian Smith with three seconds left to give the Sycamores a 39-28 halftime lead. Devonte Brown paced the Sycamores with eight points before the half while Arop had seven. Indiana State hit 15-of-25 shots from the field in the first half (60 percent) to take the lead into the locker room.

Wichita State would cut into the Sycamore lead to open the second half by scoring the first five points after the break to cut the lead down to 39-33 with 18:25 on the clock.

The Shockers went on to score the first seven of the second half to whittle the ISU lead down to just four points but Dawon Cummings stopped the bleeding with a trey and then Arop hit a tough jumper in the paint to stretch the lead back out to 44-35 with 14:52 on the clock.

Malcolm Armstead hit the Shocks eighth 3-pointer of the game, but Cummings continued his hot shooting with a jumper in the paint at the 13:00 minute mark to stretch the cushion back out to 46-38. Arop went on to hit another jumper at the lead grew to 48-38 with 10:36 remaining.

Wichita State cranked up the full court press and scored eight of the next 10 points to trim the ISU lead down to 50-48 with just over seven minutes to go. Odum stopped the bleeding as he was fouled and hit both free throws with 6:30 remaining to run the lead back out to 52-48. Odum then hit running jumper at the 5:53 mark to make it 54-48.

Once again the Shockers cut the ISU lead down to four points, but Manny Arop got a long rebound and went coast-to-coast with 4:06 remaining to make it 56-50. Brown then got a steal and hit another fast break lay-up as the clock ticked under four minutes to go for the 58-50 lead.

Indiana State Head Basketball Coach Third Season

Greg Lansing is in his third season as the head basketball coach at Indiana State. He previously spent eight seasons with the program as an assistant coach, including the previous three as associate head coach.

Lansing burst onto the scene as a rookie head coach with the Sycamore basketball program in 2010-11 as he became just the second-ever Indiana State head coach to lead the team to the NCAA Tournament in his first season. He led the team to a 20-14 record, becoming just the 14th head coach in the history of the Missouri Valley Conference to lead a team to 20 or more victories in their first year at the helm.

In 2011-12, the Sycamores finished the year with an 18-15 record and advanced to the CollegelInsiders.com Postseason Tournament. It marked the third consecutive year the team has reached postseason play -- its longest such stretch since the 1977, 1978 and 1979 seasons when Larry Bird donned the Indiana State uniform.

Jake Odum was one of just four players nationally to average at least 10 points, five rebounds and 4.5 assists per game during his sophomore season and was a Second Team All-Missouri Valley Conference selection as well as Second Team All-District selection as announced by the National Association of Basketball Coaches.

The Sycamores downed No. 25 nationally-ranked Vanderbilt on the road and finished third at the Old Spice Classic -- the best-ever finish by a MVC team in the event.

ISU reached the NCAA Tournament and took on Syracuse in Cleveland, Ohio based on the program's third-ever MVC Tournament Championship won at the Scottrade Center in St. Louis, Mo. ISU raced to the title with victories over No. 6 Evansville, No. 2 Wichita State and No. 1 Missouri State in the Championship Game as the Sycamores entered as the No. 3 seed in the tournament. Freshman Jake Odum was named to the MVC All-Tournament Team.

Odum was named a CollegelInsider.com Mid Major Freshman All-American and was named an All-MVC Honorable Mention selection as well as a member of the MVC All-Freshman, All-Newcomer and All-Defense Team. Carl Richard was also named to the All-MVC's Honorable Mention squad. ISU took two thrilling buzzer beating victories over league foes Missouri State and Creighton during the regular season at Hulman Center. The buzzer beater over Creighton by Richard was voted the No. 2 play of the weekend by ESPN's SportsCenter.

In 2009-10 the Sycamores overcame a ton of adversity to still put together its best season in nearly a decade under the professional leadership of the ISU coaching staff. Despite only having its full compliment of student-athletes for just 28 minutes of the rough and tumble Missouri Valley Conference slate, the Sycamores still recorded its first winning season since 2001 as they finished 17-15. ISU also finished the year with a 9-9 record in league play, bolstering the Sycamores out of the MVC Opening Round at the State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament by securing the league's No. 6 seed after

finishing in a tie for fifth in the standings.

Starting guard Jake Kelly suffered a season ending knee injury with 12 minutes left in the conference opener at Southern Illinois and subsequently also lost Dwayne Lathan and Harry Marshall for extended periods over the course of the year.

Marshall, who was the heart and sole of the team, led the MVC in scoring in league contests with a 16.0 ppg average. Marshall was tabbed Second Team All-MVC and was named to the MVC's All-Defensive Team after turning in shutdown performances against most of the league's all-conference opposition. Running a well-rounded program, the Sycamores also two representatives on the MVC's Scholar Athlete Team as both Jordan Printy and Aaron Carter took those plaudits.

The payoff for the Sycamores continued as ISU reached postseason play for the first since 2001 when they accepted a bid to the 2010 College Basketball Invitational, appearing in a road contest at Saint Louis.

With a keen attention to details that most coaches think of as an afterthought, the Sycamores concentrated on extreme efficiency on the court, finishing the year as the nation's second leading free throw shooting team. ISU's 76.9 percent mark at the line finished just behind NCAA qualifier BYU on the NCAA Division I list for the best free throw shooting teams in the country.

Additionally, the Sycamores overcame a 24-point deficit in the second half at Missouri State before falling in overtime. The 24-point comeback in front of a national television audience was the largest in the history of the MVC by a team that at least forced overtime.

During his second stint with the Sycamore basketball program, Lansing has been a key recruiting for many talented student-athletes. Lansing has also been a major part of the several all-conference accolades for several players, including Harry Marshall and Jay Tunnell, who took All-MVC honors following the 2008-09 campaign. Last season, the Sycamores concluded the regular season by winning six of their final games, including a trio of road contests.

Lansing returned to Indiana State after a seven year stint with the Iowa Hawkeyes. During Lansing's seven years as assistant coach at Iowa, the Hawkeyes went 135-92, received three NCAA Tournament invitations, three NIT appearances and won a pair of Big Ten tournament titles, the first of which came on four wins in four games making Iowa the first team in the Big Ten to ac-

complish such a feat. In 2005-06, Iowa earned a 25-9 record, the second-most wins in school history, the first undefeated (17-0) home record in the school's history and a No. 3 seed in the NCAA Tournament. Iowa earned seven All-Big Ten selections, 17 Academic All-Big Ten selections and four Academic All-Americans. Lansing coached four of the last five Big Ten rebounding champions, three straight conference leaders in blocked shots and, the league's 2005-06 defensive player of the year. Three of his student-athletes reached the NBA and two from the 2005-06 team were invited to NBA camps.

In Lansing's final two seasons of his first stint at Indiana State, the Sycamores posted back-to-back winning campaigns for the first time since 1979 and 1980. When the Sycamores posted a 16-11 record in 1998 it marked the first winning season for Indiana State since 1980. Indiana State advanced to the NCAA Tournament in both 2000 and 2001.

Prior to joining the staff at Indiana State, Lansing was the head basketball coach at Roosevelt High School in Des Moines, Iowa. Roosevelt had not had a winning season in 12 years before Lansing's initial season. The Roughriders went on to have back-to-back winning seasons under Greg's direction.

Lansing earned a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of South Dakota in 1990 and a master's degree in counseling from USD in 1992. As a member of the Coyote basketball team Lansing helped South Dakota reach the NCAA Division II Tournament during his junior and senior seasons, the first NCAA invitation for USD since 1954. He was twice named the South Dakota Defensive Player of the Year. Greg is currently ranked among the leaders in career assists at USD. Following his playing career, Lansing served as a graduate assistant coach at South Dakota for two seasons. In 1992-93 he was a full-time assistant.

Greg's father, Dave Lansing, coached high school basketball for 33 years in Iowa. Dave Lansing was inducted into the Iowa High School Athletic Association Coaches Hall of Fame during the 1999 Iowa boys state basketball tournament. Lansing's dad, his mother, Diane, his sister, Angela, and his nephew, Jordan, live in West Des Moines. His brother, Steve, is the head basketball coach at Faribault High School (Minn.), where he was named Regional Coach of the Year in 2004. Lansing is married to the former Angie Menser, who is an Indiana State graduate and a former track and cross country academic All-American for the Sycamores. She currently serves as ISU's senior women's administrator and athletics business manager.
