## Indiana State Hosts Iona On ESPNU In Ramada Worldwide Bracketbusters Contest

### SETTING THE STAGE

Indiana State continues year three of the Greg Lansing era on Saturday, February 23 when the Sycamores (16-11, 9-7 MVC) continue a three-game home stand against Iona (15-12, 9-7 MAAC) inside Hulman Center. Tip-off is set for 11:02 a.m. (ET). The game will be broadcast live nationally on ESPNU with Doug Sherman (pbp) and Sean Harrington (analyst) on the call. The game can also be heard on the radio via WIBQ 98.5 FM and along the Nelligan Sports Marketing Radio Network with Brian Fritz (pbp) and Matt Renn (analyst) on the call. GoSycamores.com will have an audio only production of the radio broadcast as well. The game will be simulcast on ESPN3 and a guide to access the ESPN broadcasts can be found on page 2 of this release.

### QUICK HITS

- The Sycamores are one of the best in the MVC against the RPI Top 50 with four victories, including a neutral court victory over No. 2 Miami as well as No. 50 Ole Miss, a home win over No. 45 Creighton and a road victory over No. 32 Wichita State. Indiana State has the third-best RPI in the MVC with a No. 63 mark.

- The victory over Creighton on Feb. 6 was the 1,400th victory in the history of the program and its best victory over a ranked team inside Hulman Center since joining the MVC against the Top 25 as the Bluejays were ranked No. 13.

- No. 13 Creighton is the highest ranked opponent to fall to the Sycamores since No. 13 Oklahoma was defeated by the 2001 Sycamores in the NCAA Tournament.

- Indiana State is 13-2 on the season when holding teams to 63 points or less and is 39-3 when doing so under third-year head coach Greg Lansing (and 14-0 when limiting teams to 53 or less).

- Indiana State has earned 44 close victories (five points or less) since 2005. Under Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 18-10 in close games.

- Jake Odum now has 421 career assists which ranks him eighth on the Indiana State Career List. He is one of eight Sycamores to be in ISU Top 10 for both assists and steals in a career.

- Jake Odum now has 1,061 career points scored as he tossed in 15 against Wichita State on February 19. Odum is the 35th member of the ISU 1,000-point club and is just the eighth Sycamore to reach that mark during his junior season.

- The Sycamores have recorded more blocked shots than their opponents in 10 of the last 11 games.

- Indiana State is 11-3 this season when hitting at least 36.4 percent of their 3-pointers.

- Indiana State has held two opponents this season without a 3-point field goal (Miami & Illinois State).

- The Sycamores have defeated a pair of nationally-ranked teams this season — a road win over No. 14 Wichita State on January 29 as well as a home court win over No. 13 Creighton on February 6.

- Jake Odum has made 161 free throws this season and moved into the ISU Top 10 for most charity tosses made in a single-season at Bradley (now in sixth place) while his 208 free throw attempts are 10th all-time. He made 19 in a row prior to a first half miss against Wichita State on Tuesday.

### The Indiana State Head Coach

Indiana State head coach Greg Lansing (South Dakota, 1990) is 54-40 (.574) overall in his third season as a head coach. He is 29-23 all-time in MVC games, including a 20-6 mark at home and a 9-17 record on the road. During his career, he is 31-9 in all home games, 14-25 on the road, 9-6 in neutral court contests and 18-10 in games decided by five points or less. Lansing has never faced Iona. With the Trees, Lansing is 4-4 in overtime games and 39-3 when holding teams to 63 points or less. Saturday's game will be Greg Lansing's 95th as Indiana State head coach. Lansing is the second head coach to lead the Sycamores to the NCAA Tournament in their rookie campaign in the history of the program, with the other being Bill Hodges leading ISU to a 33-1 record and a Final Four appearance in the 1979 NCAA Tournament. Lansing was just the 14th rookie head coach in the history of the MVC to lead his team to 20 victories during their debut season.

### A Little History

Indiana State is currently in its 117th season of college basketball at the school. The Sycamores are 1,401-1,207 all-time on the hardwood. Indiana State's 76-57 home court victory over No. 13/16 Creighton was the 1,400th victory in the history of the program on February 6.

### Sycamores In Ramada Worldwide Bracketbusters For Ninth Time

Indiana State's game on February 23 is part of the Ramada Worldwide Bracketbusters, which marks the Sycamores ninth year of participating in the scheduling concept and this is the first year ISU is making an appearance on the ESPN Television package. ISU is 3-5 in Bracketbuster games, including a mark of 1-3 at home. The MVC has had a national-best 43 appearances on the ESPN Family Of Networks over the 11-year history of the event. Indiana State has lost three consecutive Bracketbusters games, dating back to a victory at home over Toledo in 2009.

### Jake Odum With A Pair Of Road Double Digit Performances For Indiana State

Indiana State junior guard Jake Odum entered the Bradley game with 149 free throws on the year and with his 10 made in the game at Bradley on February 16, he entered the Sycamore single-season Top 10 list, passing Larry Bird, Jerry Newsom and Wayne Allison and now has 161 on the year (through Wichita State), which ranks sixth. Bird's 221 made free throws in 1978-79, is the school record. Throughout the course of the Bradley game, Odum passed both Bird and Duane Klueh, the only two Sycamores to have their jerseys retired. His 10-of-10 free throw performance is the best by an Indiana State player since Dwayne Lathan made 10-of-10 against Southern Illinois on February 11, 2012. Additionally, Odum made 19 free throws in a row dating back to the Southern Illinois contest on February 9 and extending to the first half of the Wichita State game on Feb. 19. Odum is seven made free throws away from tying Bird again (168 in 76-77) for fifth on the ISU single-season list. Additionally, Odum has attempted 208 free throws this season, which is tied with Matt Renn for eighth on the ISU single-season free throws attempted list and needs five more to tie Butch Wade for seventh.

### Jake Odum Goes Over 1,000 Point Mark In Victory Over No. 13/16 Creighton

Indiana State junior guard Jake Odum reached the 1,000-point mark for his career as he posted a team-best 22 points in the victory over No. 13/16 Creighton on February 6 inside Hulman Center. Odum became the 35th member of the Indiana State 1,000 Point Club with a free throw late in the second half against the Bluejays. Odum is just the eighth Sycamore in the history of the program to reach the 1,000-point mark during his junior season. With his 15 points against Wichita State, Odum now has 1,064 career points, which ties him with Harry Morgan for 31st on the ISU scoring list and needs 10 more to tie Howard Dardeen for 30th on ISU's all-time scoring list. Other Sycamores to reach 1,000 points by the end of their junior campaign are Larry Bird (1,877 in two seasons), John Sherman Williams (1,787), Jerry Newsom (1,338), Butch Wade (1,135), David Moss (1,214), Eddie Bird (1,207) and Kelyn Block (1,018).

### An Indiana State Win Over Iona Would ...

- Improve the Sycamores to 4-5 in Ramada Worldwide Bracketbusters games and stop a three-game losing skid in the scheduling concept dating back to a 2009 victory over Toledo.
- Extend the Sycamores' string of consecutive seasons with 17 or more regular season victories to four, its longest since 1960-64.
- Give the Sycamores their first victory over a member of the MAAC since a 72-66 victory over Fairfield in the consolation final of the 2011 Old Spice Classic in Orlando, Fla.
- Improve the Sycamores to 3-0 against the current membership of the MAAC (also 1-0 vs. Fairfield & 1-0 vs. Loyola (Md.)).

#### Jake Odum Now One Of Eight Players At ISU To Reach The Career Top 10 Lists For Assists & Steals

Indiana State junior guard Jake Odum has 161 career steals, which ranks him sixth all-time in the Sycamore basketball record book, needing four more to reach fifth place, currently held by Matt Renn (165 from 1997-01). Odum also now has 421 assists for his career which is good enough for eighth place. He needs three more to catch Michael Menser (426 from 1997 to 2001) for seventh all-time. Odum is the eighth Sycamore in the history of the program to rank in the Indiana State Top 10 for both assists and steals in a career.

#### Indiana State Looking To Reach 17 Regular Season Victories For Fourth Consecutive Season; First Time Since Larry Bird Era

With its 59-46 victory over Missouri State on February 22, 2012, the Sycamores posted at least 17 regular season victories for the third consecutive season, which is the first time three Indiana State teams have reached that mark in succession since the 1976-77, 1977-78 & 1978-79 seasons. The Sycamores won 25 in 76-77, 19 in 77-78 and 26 in 78-79. With one more victory in its final five regular games this season, Indiana State will have reached that 17-victory milestone for four consecutive seasons, which hasn't happened in Terre Haute since 1960-64.

#### Newcomers Are No Problem For Indiana State

With Jake Odum being the lone Sycamore starter to return in 2012-13, Indiana State has relied on a stable of five newcomers so far this season for a large chunk of its offensive production. Led by Manny Arop, who is a two-time MVC Newcomer Of The Week selection and is currently second on the team with a 12.6 ppg average ISU has seen over four of every 10 points come from someone who was not on the active roster one year ago. For the season, 754 points have come from newcomers, of a total of 1,824 scored (41.3 percent).

#### Sycamore Success Inside Hulman Center Under Greg Lansing

The Sycamores are 31-9 (.775) inside Hulman Center under third-year head coach Greg Lansing. The Sycamores have won 22 of their last 28 home games. Additionally, the Sycamores have won 20 of their last 26 MVC games at home. This season, the Sycamores have lost just twice at home, in overtime to nationally-ranked New Mexico on December 1 and on Tuesday to league-leading Wichita State.

#### 63 Is The Magic Number

The Sycamores win by the score of 76-57 on February 6 against Creighton was ISU's 13th this season in which they held an opponent to 63 points or less and earned the victory. ISU is currently 13-2 on the season when holding an opponent under that total. Under third-year head coach Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 39-3 when allowing less than 63 points to the opposition (including a 14-0 mark when holding teams to 53 or less).

#### Good Starter On The Battery

Indiana State is 10-4 this season when the Sycamore starters outscore their counterparts for the opposition. Under third-year head coach Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 34-11 when the ISU starting five scores more than their opponent's starters.

#### Looking At The Keys To A Sycamore Victory

Indiana State has several key statistical factors to track in each game that indicates that they are heading down the path a victory. The first is the halftime score. The Sycamores are 10-2 on the season when leading at the half. Additionally, ISU is a perfect 7-0 when shooting at least 50 percent from the field. One other area to track is rebounding as the Sycamores are 10-3 this year when they outrebound the opposition. Additionally, the Sycamores are 13-2 when limiting a team to 63 points or less.

#### No. 13/16 Creighton Is The Highest Nationally Ranked Opponent To Fall At Hulman Center In MVC Era

The No. 13/16 Creighton Bluejays rolled into Hulman Center on February 2 as the highest ranked team to take on the Sycamores at home since No. 12 Tulsa visited on Feb. 2, 1985. With the 76-57 victory against the Bluejays, the Sycamores are now 11-18 all-time against nationally-ranked opponents and earned their first victory inside Hulman Center against a ranked foe since downing No. 14 Butler in December of 2006. It was the highest ranked opponent that ISU has beaten anywhere since a victory over No. 13 Oklahoma in the 2001 NCAA Tournament. No. 13/16 Creighton is the highest ranked opponent to fall to

the Sycamores inside Hulman Center in the MVC era.

### Sycamores Use Stellar Defensive Effort To Stop Wichita State's 19-Game Home Court Winning Streak

Indiana State limited No. 14/15 Wichita State to just 27.1 percent shooting from the field to earn a 68-55 victory at Charles Koch Arena on January 29. ISU held the Shockers to a season-low 16-of-59 effort from the field, including a mar of 7-of-31 from inside the 3-point arc. The victory for the Sycamores was the first by a visiting team at Wichita State in the last 19 games, dating back to December of 2011 and was their worst home loss since 2009. The victory was also the first this season for the Sycamores this season against a nationally-ranked team in five attempts although ISU does own victories over now nationally-ranked Ole Miss and Miami.

### Greg Lansing Takes Suits and Sneakers For Cancer Awareness To The Indiana State Capital Building

Indiana State and Northern Iowa participated in the annual Coaches vs. Cancer Suits and Sneaks Challenge along with the rest of the nation's teams this weekend. All of the basketball coaches in the state of Indiana have issued a challenge to the state's lawmakers to wear sneakers with their suits on Monday, January 28 as part of the program to promote cancer awareness. Through an invitation from State Representative Bob Heaton, who played for ISU on the 1978-79 team which advanced to the NCAA Final Four, ISU head coach Greg Lansing will officially issue the day's challenge to Indiana Speaker Of The House Brian Bosma at the State House in Indianapolis on January 28.

### Sycamores Have Held Two Teams This Season Without A Triple

Indiana State did not allow a made 3-pointer at Illinois State on January 23 as the Redbirds went 0-for-13 from long range on their home court and snapped a string of over 400 games with one which dated back to 1999. It marked the second time this season that the Sycamores have not allowed a trey in a game as nationally-ranked Miami went 0-of-15 back on December 25 in the consolation game of the Diamond Head Classic. For the season, the Sycamores are allowing teams to make just 30.4 percent of their threes attempted (96-of-316), which ranks third in the MVC behind Missouri State and Creighton.

### Jake Odum Named To Bob Cousy Award Watchlist

Jake Odum has been named to the 2013 Bob Cousy Award Watch List. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame announced the watch list of candidates for the 2013 Bob Cousy Collegiate Point Guard of the Year Award. The annual honor, named for Hall of Famer and former Boston Celtic Bob Cousy, recognizes the top point guards in men's college basketball. Over 80 candidates have been nominated for the 2013 Bob Cousy Award. This watch list of candidates will be narrowed down to a final 20 around January 1st, final 10 near February 1st, and final five by approximately March 1st. A premier Selection Committee has been appointed by the Hall of Fame to review the final five candidates in contention for the nation's top collegiate point guard award. These Hall of Fame committees are made up of top college basketball personnel including media members, head coaches, Sports Information Directors and Hall of Famers. The winner of the 2013 Bob Cousy Award will be presented at the Hall of Fame's Class Announcement on Championship Monday in Atlanta as part of NCAA Final Four weekend.

### Indiana State Has Won Two In A Row Over The Southeastern Conference

The Indiana State Sycamores downed Ole Miss by the score of 87-85 in overtime in the opener of the 2012 Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic. Indiana State has now won each of its last two meetings against the SEC, as they won on the road at No. 25 Vanderbilt in 2011. ISU also earned its first victory since 1986 in Hawaii with the victory over the Rebels. The Sycamores have now won their opener in both the 2011 Old Spice Classic as well as the 2012 Diamond Head Classic.

### Sycamores In Postseason Play For Third Consecutive Season

With Indiana State's appearance in the 2012 CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament, the Sycamores have now made three consecutive trips to postseason play. ISU played in the 2010 College Basketball Invitational as well as the 2011 NCAA Tournament in addition to the CIT Tournament in 2012. The last time the Sycamores reached postseason play for three consecutive seasons came in 1977-79 when Indiana State played in the 1977 & 1978 NIT as well as the 1979 NCAA Tournament. The last time Indiana State hosted a postseason game came on March 10, 1978 when the Sycamores hosted Illinois State in the first round of the NIT.

### Jake Odum Named To The Preseason All-Missouri Valley Team

Indiana State guard Jake Odum was one of five student-athletes named to the Preseason All-Missouri Valley Conference Team on October 29. Odum finished third in the Missouri Valley Conference with a 4.9 assists per game average. That mark was ranked 61st nationally. Odum recorded a career-high 12 assists against Fairfield as part of the Old Spice Classic, a number which ranked tied for fourth all-time at ISU in a single game. Odum is third in the MVC in steals per game with a 1.8 average, which ranks 81st nationally. Additionally, Odum's 4.5 assists per game average of his career is fifth-best in the history of the program while his 119 steals are ranked ninth-best in the Sycamore record books, while his 1.8 steals per game average ranks third.

### Sycamores Picked To Finish 7th In Missouri Valley Conference Race

The Indiana State Sycamores were picked to finish seventh in the Missouri Valley Conference race according to a poll of league head coaches, sports information directors and a media panel. ISU finished eighth last season, with an 8-10 MVC record, just one game out of a large logjam for third place at 9-9.

### Up Next

The Sycamores embark on their final week of the regular season on Wednesday, February 27 when they host Drake inside Hulman Center to conclude a three-game home stand. Indiana State and Drake will tip-off at 7:05 p.m. (ET).

The Last Time Out ...

**TERRE HAUTE, Ind.** — The Indiana State men's basketball team (16-11, 9-7 MVC) rallied late behind junior RJ Mahurin's seventh career four-point play but the Indiana State basketball team fell to the Shockers of Wichita State (23-5, 12-4 MVC) 66-62 Tuesday inside Hulman Center.

Sophomore forward Justin Gant got the Sycamores on the board first with try to give Indiana State a 3-0 lead after forcing a Shocker shot clock violation on the Shockers first possession.

The Shockers responded with a 5-0 run but after a steal junior Dawon Cummings tied the game back up for the Sycamores with a fast break dunk to bring the crowd to its feet.

Neither team was able to get a their offense going early on in the first half with neither team leading by more than three points in the opening 13 minutes but the Sycamores were aggressive on the boards gaining a 15-8 advantage over the Shockers.

With just under four minutes remaining in the half the Shockers knocked down a three-pointer to take a 19-18 lead and then hits a pair of free throws to jump out to their largest lead of the game at 21-18 over the Sycamores.

The Sycamores answered with a three-pointer by junior Manny Arop to cut the lead 22-21 with just under two minutes to play in the half and after a Shocker basket, junior RJ Mahurin tied the game up at 24 with try from the corner.

Both teams then traded free throws and at half time the score was all knotted up at 25-25.

Defense controled the opening eight minutes of the second half with both teams trading baskets and misses. With just over 12 minutes remaining, the Shockers jumped out to the largest lead of the game by either team at four at 38-34. Arop responded with a pair of free throws on the other end to cut it 38-36 with just under 12 minutes remaining in regulation.

After a Wichita State layup, a pair of Mahurin free throws and Arop and Jake Odum layups the Sycamores stored back to retake the lead at 42-40 and re-energize the crowd. The Shockers responded, however, with a 6-0 run of their own to take the lead back at 46-42, forcing a Sycamore timeout.

Coming out of the timeout, Odum answered the Shocker run with three-pointer from the top of the key to cut the lead to one. Wichita State hit a three of their own on the other end but Odum was fouled on a quick layup in transition and hit one of two free throws to once again make it a one possession game.

With just under five minutes remaining to play the Shockers converted on a traditional three-point play to jump out to a five point lead, the largest of the game by either team. Odum answered back on the other end with a layup but could not covert the three point play.

The Shockers jumped out to their largest lead of the game at eight with 2:20 remaining in the game off a layup but Odum hit a layup and was fouled to cut the Shocker lead to 59-53 with 1:36 showing on the clock.

The Sycamores continued to battle and with 34 seconds remaining, Mahurin recorded his seventh career four-point play to cut the Shocker lead to 62-59. The Shockers hit a pair of free throws on the other end and Cummings hit a quick troy for the Sycamores cut the Wichita State lead to two at 64-62 with 24 seconds remaining.

On the ensuing in-bound the Sycamores nearly had the Shockers trapped in the corner but Odum was called for a foul and Wichita State hit both free throws. The Sycamores could get no closer as they fell to the Shockers 66-62 for their first loss at home in Missouri Valley Conference play this season.

Arop led three Sycamores to reach double figures with 17 and nine rebounds while Odum recorded 15 points, six rebounds and five assists and Mahurin added 13 points. Cleanthony Early led all scorers with 19 points for the Shockers.

# Greg Lansing

## Indiana State Head Basketball Coach Third Season

Greg Lansing is in his third season as the head basketball coach at Indiana State. He previously spent eight seasons with the program as an assistant coach, including the previous three as associate head coach.

Lansing burst onto the scene as a rookie head coach with the Sycamore basketball program in 2010-11 as he became just the second-ever Indiana State head coach to lead the team to the NCAA Tournament in his first season. He led the team to a 20-14 record, becoming just the 14th head coach in the history of the Missouri Valley Conference to lead a team to 20 or more victories in their first year at the helm.

In 2011-12, the Sycamores finished the year with an 18-15 record and advanced to the CollegelInsiders.com Postseason Tournament. It marked the third consecutive year the team has reached postseason play -- its longest such stretch since the 1977, 1978 and 1979 seasons when Larry Bird donned the Indiana State uniform.

Jake Odum was one of just four players nationally to average at least 10 points, five rebounds and 4.5 assists per game during his sophomore season and was a Second Team All-Missouri Valley Conference selection as well as Second Team All-District selection as announced by the National Association of Basketball Coaches.

The Sycamores downed No. 25 nationally-ranked Vanderbilt on the road and finished third at the Old Spice Classic -- the best-ever finish by a MVC team in the event.

ISU reached the NCAA Tournament and took on Syracuse in Cleveland, Ohio based on the program's third-ever MVC Tournament Championship won at the Scottrade Center in St. Louis, Mo. ISU raced to the title with victories over No. 6 Evansville, No. 2 Wichita State and No. 1 Missouri State in the Championship Game as the Sycamores entered as the No. 3 seed in the tournament. Freshman Jake Odum was named to the MVC All-Tournament Team.

Odum was named a CollegelInsider.com Mid Major Freshman All-American and was named an All-MVC Honorable Mention selection as well as a member of the MVC All-Freshman, All-Newcomer and All-Defense Team. Carl Richard was also named to the All-MVC's Honorable Mention squad. ISU took two thrilling buzzer beating victories over league foes Missouri State and Creighton during the regular season at Hulman Center. The buzzer beater over Creighton by Richard was voted the No. 2 play of the weekend by ESPN's SportsCenter.

In 2009-10 the Sycamores overcame a ton of adversity to still put together its best season in nearly a decade under the professional leadership of the ISU coaching staff. Despite only having its full compliment of student-athletes for just 28 minutes of the rough and tumble Missouri Valley Conference slate, the Sycamores still recorded its first winning season since 2001 as they finished 17-15. ISU also finished the year with a 9-9 record in league play, bolstering the Sycamores out of the MVC Opening Round at the State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament by securing the league's No. 6 seed after

finishing in a tie for fifth in the standings.

Starting guard Jake Kelly suffered a season ending knee injury with 12 minutes left in the conference opener at Southern Illinois and subsequently also lost Dwayne Lathan and Harry Marshall for extended periods over the course of the year.

Marshall, who was the heart and sole of the team, led the MVC in scoring in league contests with a 16.0 ppg average. Marshall was tabbed Second Team All-MVC and was named to the MVC's All-Defensive Team after turning in shutdown performances against most of the league's all-conference opposition. Running a well-rounded program, the Sycamores also two representatives on the MVC's Scholar Athlete Team as both Jordan Printy and Aaron Carter took those plaudits.

The payoff for the Sycamores continued as ISU reached postseason play for the first since 2001 when they accepted a bid to the 2010 College Basketball Invitational, appearing in a road contest at Saint Louis.

With a keen attention to details that most coaches think of as an afterthought, the Sycamores concentrated on extreme efficiency on the court, finishing the year as the nation's second leading free throw shooting team. ISU's 76.9 percent mark at the line finished just behind NCAA qualifier BYU on the NCAA Division I list for the best free throw shooting teams in the country.

Additionally, the Sycamores overcame a 24-point deficit in the second half at Missouri State before falling in overtime. The 24-point comeback in front of a national television audience was the largest in the history of the MVC by a team that at least forced overtime.

During his second stint with the Sycamore basketball program, Lansing has been a key recruiting for many talented student-athletes. Lansing has also been a major part of the several all-conference accolades for several players, including Harry Marshall and Jay Tunnell, who took All-MVC honors following the 2008-09 campaign. Last season, the Sycamores concluded the regular season by winning six of their final games, including a trio of road contests.

Lansing returned to Indiana State after a seven year stint with the Iowa Hawkeyes. During Lansing's seven years as assistant coach at Iowa, the Hawkeyes went 135-92, received three NCAA Tournament invitations, three NIT appearances and won a pair of Big Ten tournament titles, the first of which came on four wins in four games making Iowa the first team in the Big Ten to ac-

complish such a feat. In 2005-06, Iowa earned a 25-9 record, the second-most wins in school history, the first undefeated (17-0) home record in the school's history and a No. 3 seed in the NCAA Tournament. Iowa earned seven All-Big Ten selections, 17 Academic All-Big Ten selections and four Academic All-Americans. Lansing coached four of the last five Big Ten rebounding champions, three straight conference leaders in blocked shots and, the league's 2005-06 defensive player of the year. Three of his student-athletes reached the NBA and two from the 2005-06 team were invited to NBA camps.

In Lansing's final two seasons of his first stint at Indiana State, the Sycamores posted back-to-back winning campaigns for the first time since 1979 and 1980. When the Sycamores posted a 16-11 record in 1998 it marked the first winning season for Indiana State since 1980. Indiana State advanced to the NCAA Tournament in both 2000 and 2001.

Prior to joining the staff at Indiana State, Lansing was the head basketball coach at Roosevelt High School in Des Moines, Iowa. Roosevelt had not had a winning season in 12 years before Lansing's initial season. The Roughriders went on to have back-to-back winning seasons under Greg's direction.

Lansing earned a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of South Dakota in 1990 and a master's degree in counseling from USD in 1992. As a member of the Coyote basketball team Lansing helped South Dakota reach the NCAA Division II Tournament during his junior and senior seasons, the first NCAA invitation for USD since 1954. He was twice named the South Dakota Defensive Player of the Year. Greg is currently ranked among the leaders in career assists at USD. Following his playing career, Lansing served as a graduate assistant coach at South Dakota for two seasons. In 1992-93 he was a full-time assistant.

Greg's father, Dave Lansing, coached high school basketball for 33 years in Iowa. Dave Lansing was inducted into the Iowa High School Athletic Association Coaches Hall of Fame during the 1999 Iowa boys state basketball tournament. Lansing's dad, his mother, Diane, his sister, Angela, and his nephew, Jordan, live in West Des Moines. His brother, Steve, is the head basketball coach at Faribault High School (Minn.), where he was named Regional Coach of the Year in 2004. Lansing is married to the former Angie Menser, who is an Indiana State graduate and a former track and cross country academic All-American for the Sycamores. She currently serves as ISU's senior women's administrator and athletics business manager.
