ABOUT THE COACHES

Kevin McKenna (Creighton '93) is in his third season as the head coach at Indiana State (36-41 at ISU & 126-74 overall). In his first season with the Sycamores, McKenna led the team to its highest win total since the 2000-01 season and an impressive 12-2 record at home in the Hulman Center. Last season, he led the Sycamores to six victories in their final seven regular season games, including three consecutive league road wins in the span of 10 days. McKenna came to Indiana State after spending nine seasons as an assistant coach at Creighton, where he helped the Bluejays advance to four NCAA tournament appearances. From 2001-05, McKenna spent four years as the head coach (89-33) at NCAA Division II Nebraska-Omaha, where he guided the Mavericks to four consecutive 20-win seasons and three appearances in the NCAA Division II Tournament. McKenna is one of just two NCAA Division I head men's basketball coaches who have won an NBA World Championship (with the Los Angeles Lakers in 1982). Florida International's Isiah Thomas is the other. He is the only NCAA Division I men's basketball head coach to earn both an NBA and CBA Championship and is the only person in the history of the Missouri Valley Conference to win a MVC Regular Season Title, MVC Tournament Championship, NBA Championship and CBA title. McKenna is 3-2 against Evansville, including a mark of 1-1 at Roberts Stadium.

Marty Simmons (Evansville '88) As a player and as a coach, Marty Simmons has turned programs into winners. Last season was his latest example, transforming a 9-21 team into a 17-game winner and leading the Purple Aces to the CollegeInsider.com Post-Season Tournament. The 2008-09 Aces achieved their best winning percentage since 2000, and their first postseason appearance since 1999, when Simmons was an assistant coach with the Aces. Simmons' work last season was reflected in voting for the 2009 Rawlings Missouri Valley Conference Coach of the Year award. He finished third in the balloting, trailing only the two coaches who led their teams to the MVC co-championship. Simmons is 2-3 against Indiana State, including a mark of 1-1 at Roberts Stadium.

SERIES HISTORY

Indiana State holds a slim 76-74 advantage in the all-time series which saw its historic 150th meeting earlier this month inside Hulman Center — a 69-55 Sycamore victory. The Purple Aces hold a 47-28 lead in the series in games played in Evansville.

TELEVISION PARTICULARS

Sunday's game will be televised locally in the Wabash Valley live on WTWO-TV. The broadcast will begin at 3 p.m. (ET).

A WIN OVER EVANSVILLE WOULD ...

- Give Indiana State a season series sweep of the Purple Aces; marking the fifth consecutive season in which the season series has netted a sweep for either the Sycamores or Purple Aces. The last split came in 2004-05.
- Improve Indiana State to 2-1 on the road against Evansville
- Give Indiana State consecutive victories for the first time since downing Creighton (Jan. 1) & Drake (Jan. 3)
- Give the Sycamores at least one MVC season series sweep in each of the three seasons under coach McKenna.

A Little History:

Indiana State is currently in its 114th season of college basketball at the school. The Sycamores are 1,343-1,141 all-time on the hardwood. The Sycamores are 16 contests away from playing their historic 2,500th game in the history of the program.

Coaches Vs. Cancer Weekend:

Coaches vs. Cancer Suits and Sneakers awareness weekend is Friday, Jan. 29 through Sunday, Jan. 31, in which college basketball coaches nationwide will wear sneakers with their sideline attire to raise cancer awareness and remind fans that by making healthy lifestyle choices, such as regular exercise and a healthy diet, they can reduce their own cancer risk. Coaches vs. Cancer is a collaboration of the American Cancer Society and the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC).

Over The Century Mark Against Six Opponents:

Indiana State has faced off against Evansville more than another opponent in the history of the program as Sunday's matchup will be the 151st all-time. is one of just six schools that Indiana State has faced at least 100 times in the 114-year history of the program. Below are the schools that Indiana State has faced at least 100 times throughout the years.

They're Free! Take Em!:

Indiana State has been hitting the freebies so far this season, as the Sycamores are ahead of Wichita State for top honors in the Missouri Valley Conference with a 76.5 percentage from the charity stripe. ISU has hit 319-of-417 while the Shockers are 329-of-435. ISU currently ranks fifth nationally in free throw percentage.

Marshall's March To 1,000 Career Points & Milestone Game Against Wichita State:

Indiana State senior Harry Marshall currently has 974 career points, needing 26 to become the 32nd member of the Indiana State 1,000-point club. Marshall played his 100th career game against Wichita State and celebrated the milestone by scoring a career-high 29 points to become ISU's first 20-plus point scorer this season.

Close Call To Biggest Valley Rally EVER!:

Down 52-28 with 16:20 left at Missouri State, the Indiana State Sycamores faced their biggest deficit of the game and nearly completed the largest comeback in the history of the Missouri Valley Conference. No MVC team has ever come from down by as many as 24 points in a game to earn a victory. ISU fell in overtime, but a 3-pointer by senior Harry Marshall with one second left knotted the score at 83 and completed the 24-point comeback. MSU grabbed the victory in overtime by a 99-92 margin. ISU did complete the third largest comeback in the history of the league on Feb. 19, 2008 by coming back from 21 down to defeat Wichita State 83-73 in overtime.

Three Or More In Double Figures Equals Sycamore Success:

Indiana State has had a least three players reach double digit scoring in 11 contests this season. When the Sycamores are able to accomplish that feat they have been nearly unbeatable, as ISU is 9-3 in such situations. ISU is averaging an 7.8 point margin of victory when the Sycamores post at least three double digit scorers.

Impressive Second Half At Missouri State:

In roaring back from the 24-point deficit at Missouri State, ISU put together a 60 point second half against Missouri State. The Sycamores were 20-of-28 from the field in the second half versus the Bears (71.4 percent), including a mark of 11-of-14 from 3-point range (78.6 percent). Jordan Printy set a career-high with six 3-pointers in the game, hitting five of them in the second half alone. The 60 points are the most in a half in the two-year history of the JQH Arena.

Air Marshall:

Indiana State senior guard Harry Marshall leads the Sycamores with 17 double digit scoring contests this season. He has currently scored 10 or more points in 10 consecutive contests which is his longest string of double digit scoring performances since he put together 11 in a row at the end of last season. With a double digit performance against Evansville, Marshall will tie that previous career best for consecutive double digit scoring performances.

Martin Nearing Century Mark For Blocked Shots:

Indiana State junior Isiah Martin needs just one blocked shot to reach 100 for his career. His current total of 99 blocks ranks fourth all-time in the history of the program and he needs 11 more to overtake Nate Green for third (109). The Indiana State school record is 168, set by DeCarsta Webster from 1975-78.

Winnin' By A Whisker:

Indiana State has recorded five victories in close games this season, defined as a game decided by five or fewer points. Winning the close ones has been a staple of third-year head coach Kevin McKenna's career as he has already has 14 "close" wins while at Indiana State. In addition to the four already posted this season, his Sycamores' recorded five in 2008-09 and four more during his first season at the helm, 2007-08. In fact of McKenna's 84 games as head coach of the Sycamores, 21 have been decided by five points or less and ISU is 14-7 in those games, for a .667 winning percentage.

The Chairmen Of The Boards:

After falling against Wichita State despite holding a 31-28 lead in rebounding, ISU is 9-1 on the season when posting more rebounds than an opponent. Indiana State is virtually even for the season in rebounds as the Sycamores have hauled in 663 rebounds while opponents have gathered 691.

Ability To Bounce Back:

ISU is 20-26 under third-year head coach Kevin McKenna in games following a loss. This season, ISU is 6-3 in games which following a loss and bounced back from a four-game skid with its recent 68-65 victory over Southern Illinois.

Long Range Success Against Bradley & Evansville:

Indiana State made 10 field goals from 3-point range against Evansville as that performance came on the heels of a 16-trey performance at Bradley which marks the first time the Sycamores have connected on 10 or more 3-pointers in consecutive contests since draining 14 at Illinois State (02/08) and 11 versus Drake (02/11) last season.

Carl Richard Posts First Double-Double of the Year:

Carl Richard scored 11 points and pulled down 10 rebounds in the 91-85 overtime road loss at Bradley to post Indiana State's first double-double of the season. Richard was 5-of-8 from the field, including a 3-pointer. It marked Indiana State's first double-double since Richard posted one himself at Missouri State last season. In that contest, Richard had 20 points and 10 rebounds.

Best Defensive Performance In A Year At Drake:

The Indiana State defense clamped down in the final 10 minutes at Drake and held the Bulldogs to just 46 points, which is Drake's lowest offensive production at home this season. The 46-point defensive gym turned in by the Sycamores marks the first time that the Sycamores have held an opponent to less than 50 points since Jan. 23, 2008 when ISU held Evansville to just 42 points.

Lathan Named Valley Newcomer of the Week Twice:

Indiana State sophomore Dwayne Lathan was named the Missouri Valley Conference's Newcomer of the Week for the second time this season following his performance before the Holiday Break against IUPUI. Lathan led ISU with a career-best tying effort in leading ISU with 18 points. Lathan hit 6-of-11 shots from the floor and was 6-of-10 from the free throw line as he led ISU with 18 points and 7 rebounds. He added one assist and a steal in 29 minutes of action. Lathan leads ISU with nine double digit scoring performances in his 10 games played (missed season opener against Nebraska-Kearney). Lathan also leads ISU with a 14.3 ppg scoring average which is the fifth-best mark in the Missouri Valley Conference and is the top by any league newcomer. Lathan also leads ISU with his 5.8 rebounds per game average, which is seventh in the league. Lathan also took the league's top newcomer honor following the second week of play at LSU, on a neutral floor against Milwaukee and at home versus Colorado State.

Jake Kelly Suffers Season Ending Knee Injury Against Salukis:

Jake Kelly has been lost for the season following a knee injury that will require season ending surgery. The team learned of the severity of Kelly's injury following an evaluation conducted by team physician Dr. Tom Klootwyk at Methodist Sports Medicine in Indianapolis. Kelly was third on the team this season with a 9.0 ppg scoring average with 18 assists and six steals. He drained the game winning jumper in a 55-54 road victory over Toledo on December 19. Kelly was playing this season following his transfer from the University of Iowa as the NCAA waived the year in residence requirement and allowed him to compete this season.

Triple Trouble On The Road:

Indiana State has defeated Western Kentucky, Arkansas State and Toledo in back-to-back-to-back road non-conference games. It marks the first time ISU has won three consecutive road non-conference games since the 2005-06 campaign when the Sycamores downed Butler, Western Michigan and Eastern Illinois. ISU was 8-1 in non-league games that season.

Stepping Up To The Challenge:

Indiana State did its part for its league in the inaugural Mountain West/Missouri Valley Conference Challenge as the Sycamores downed Colorado State 65-60 at Hulman Center. All nine of the Mountain West Conference schools will face off against a pre-determined member of the MVC with the exception of Evansville. The MVC won the inaugural Challenge this year by a 5-4 margin, capped by a win by Northern Iowa over Wyoming last week.

Best Shooting Performance In Five Seasons:

Indiana State connected on 30-of-52 field goals in the 76-63 victory against Milwaukee. That performance equates to a 57.7 percent mark. The 57.7 percent showing is the best by an Indiana State state team since they hit 59.6 percent from the field in January of 2004 against Drake.

Local Flavor Of Team To Get Some Seasoning:

All four of Indiana State's incoming freshmen are expected to redshirt this season. Jake Odum, a native of Terre Haute, along with RJ Mahurin (Rockville, Ind.) and Logan & Lucas Eitel (nearby Marshall, Ill.) will all sit out their initial seasons in the program and take a redshirt season. Subject to change as the season progresses, the four local student-athletes will push the total to six freshmen to ++++redshirt in head coach Kevin McKenna's three seasons. Jordan Printy redshirted during the 2007-08 campaign while Koang Doluony took a redshirt season last year and made his Sycamore debut on Friday against Nebraska-Kearney.

Sycamore Signees:

Indiana State inked three student-athletes to national letters of intent as part of the NCAA Early Signing Period. Steve McWhorter, Myles Walker and Jake Kitchell comprised the Sycamores' 2009 Signing Class.

McWhorter, a 6-2, 185, point guard from Racine, Wis., won a Division 3 state championship last season at Saint Catherines High School as he averaged 10.0 points, 5.0 assists and shot 57.6 percent from the field for coach Bob Letsch. McWhorter took over as the starter at point guard when he was a sophomore. As a junior, he was on a team with nine seniors, and his talent shined in the state tournament. He had 12 points, seven assists and five rebounds in a 48-34 state championship victory against La Crosse Aquinas. In the state semifinals, McWhorter had nine points and nine assists.

Walker is a 6-8, 250, junior college post player from South Plains Junior College who averaged 7.4 points and 4.8 rebounds, while shooting 46.7 percent from the floor and 38.6 percent (32 for 83) from the free-throw line as a freshman last season for coach Steve Green. Walker's best game was a 24-point, 13-rebound performance on Jan. 1. He averaged 1.0 blocks per game with a season-high of five, and he twice had three steals in a game.

At Antonian College Prep in San Antonio, Texas he played for head coach Andre Walker. Myles was named to the all-state team three times and all-district four times. He was once named to the North-South All-Star tournament. As a middle linebacker for the football team Myles earned all-state recognition three times and played in the Army All-American Bowl. He also ran track, boasting a time of 48.07 seconds in the 400 meter dash.

Kitchell is a 6-9, 225, power forward from Union Mills, Ind., and played for coach John Steinhilber at South Central High School. Kitchell averaged 20 points, 14 rebounds, six assists and six blocks per game for a team that finished the 2008-09 season with a record of 17-5. He is expected to be a first team all-state selection later this month in the upcoming edition of the annual Hoosier Basketball Magazine. He was a member of the Indiana Junior All-Stars last spring.

The Last Time Out...

TERRE HAUTE, Ind. - Indiana State's Harry Marshall secured a steal with less than three seconds left to go along with his team-best 13 points as the Sycamores notched a 68-65 victory over Southern Illinois in front of 4,179 fans at Hulman Center.

ISU broke a four-game skid to improve to 12-9, 4-6 MVC while SIU fell to 12-8, 4-6 MVC. With the victory, ISU improved to 5-1 on the season in games decided by five points or less.

Marshall led ISU with 13 points, hitting 7-of-8 from the free throw line. Reed also scored 12 points and Richard added 11. Dwayne Lathan returned to action after an injury forced him to the sidelines earlier this month to score nine. Aaron Carter added nine points as well off the bench.

With 18.6 seconds left SIU's Kevin Dillard found himself at the free throw line with the Sycamores ahead 66-63. Dillard missed both free throws attempts and Isiah Martin came down with a key rebound and was fouled immediately. In the double bonus, Martin missed both attempts setting up with Salukis for another attempt. Bogut hit a running lay-up with 3.5 seconds left which cut the ISU lead down to 66-65.

Out of a timeout, Aaron Carter was fouled and he converted the first free throw to make it 67-65 and then hit another to make it 68-65. Marshall's steal on the Saluki inbound pass secured the win.

ISU was held to just 38.9 percent shooting (21-of-54) but converted 20-of-27 attempts from the free throw line.

The Sycamores were able to grow their six-point half-time lead up to 35-28 with 17:23 left in the second half on a jumper by Carl Richard and then the lead reached eight when Jordan Printy drilled a 3-pointer with 13:32 to go which gave the Sycamores a 42-32 advantage and helped cap a 7-2 ISU spurt.

SIU was able to put together the game's next seven points to cut into the ISU lead at 42-41 before Lathan extended the Sycamore lead back out to 45-41 on a triple by Dwayne Lathan, who returned to action for the first time since being injured at Bradley on January 6.

Kevin Dillard answered with a 3-pointer on the Salukis' end of the floor to make it 45-44 and Richard struck back with a conventional 3-point play on a second chance opportunity as ISU kept SIU at arm's length by retaking a 48-44 advantage with 8:42 on the clock.

Rashad Reed kept ISU on a hot streak with a deep 3-pointer with seven and a half remaining to make it 51-45. Dillard drained a 3-pointer for ISU but Printy had the answer with a triple of his own as the Sycamores took a 54-48 lead over a possession for possession exchange with seven minutes left.

Leading 55-50 the Sycamores' had Reed on a fast break and he was fouled. Reed converted both free throws with six minutes on the clock as the Sycamores gained a 57-50 cushion. After another Sycamore steal on the Salukis' next offensive possession, Aaron Carter made it 60-50 with a 3-pointer which forced SIU to take a timeout.

SIU scored three points to make it 60-53 before Carter

added a free throw with four minutes left to make it 61-53. SIU cut the game down to a two possession margin on a bucket by Tony Freeman just before the final media timeout as the score became 61-55. Freeman added a free throw on SIU's next possession to make it 61-56 as the clock ticked towards three minutes left.

Carter continued his tough play inside as he fouled hard on tough drive inside. He hit 1-of-2 charity tosses with 2:52 to go to give the Sycamores a 62-56 advantage. Gene Teague countered with a lay-up inside on the next possession and ISU got its six-point lead right back with a jumper by Richard for the 64-58 cushion.

Jordan Printy created a steal on the defensive end with two minutes to go and Reed went to the free throw line after behind fouled from behind. Reed gave the Sycamores a 66-58 advantage with his two charity tosses following the steal.

SIU scored the game's next five points after creating a steal in the press to make it 66-63 with just under a minute left. Reed was whistled for a traveling violation with 30 seconds left before Dillard was fouled on the drive with 18.6 seconds on the clock.

Indiana State fell behind 6-0 before roaring back with four consecutive points as they closed the gap to 6-4 with 17:23 left in the opening stanza. After SIU countered with a pair of free throws by Gene Teague to build back its four point cushion.

Another charity toss by Teague gave SIU a 10-3 lead and led ISU to embark on a nine point spurt for a 19-13 lead with 9:26 to go before half. Marshall and Crawford hit back-to-back lay-ups to make it 14-13 and then Reed got things cooking with his first 3-pointer of the game for a 17-13 lead. The run was capped on a jumper by Carl Richard.

With 5:23 to go in the first half, Aaron Carter's lay-up on a second chance opportunity reestablished the Sycamores' 23-17 lead. The game swayed between a three and five point game for the remainder of the first half until Marshall connected on a pair of free throws with 22 seconds left and ISU was able to hold on one final SIU possession for a 32-26 cushion.

Marshall led ISU at the half with 11 points.
