The Indiana State Head Coach

Indiana State head coach Greg Lansing (South Dakota, 1990) is 3-3 (.500) overall in his first season as a head coach, all with the Sycamores. He is 0-0 all-time in MVC games, including a 0-0 mark at home, a 0-0 mark on the road and a 0-0 record in neutral court contests. During his career, he is 1-0 in all home games, 1-2 on the road, 1-1 in neutral court contests and 2-1 in games decided by five points or less. Lansing is 0-0 all-time against Notre Dame, including a 0-0 record at the Joyce Center. With the Trees, Lansing is 0-1 in overtime games, and 2-0 when holding teams to 60 points or less. Tuesday's game is Greg Lansing's seventh game as Indiana State head coach.

A Little History

Indiana State is currently in its 115th season of college basketball at the school. The Sycamores are 1,351-1,150 all-time on the hardwood. Indiana State's game at Oral Roberts this season was the historic 2,500th game in the history of the program.

For Home Openers

Indiana State won for the ninth time in its last 11 home opening contests with its 58-54 victory over Buffalo. The only setbacks in lidlifters at Hulman Center during that time span came against North Texas in 2008 and against Valparaiso in 2001. ISU won two home openers in a row.

Jake & Jake Plus Nine

Jake Kelly and Jake Odum paced the Sycamores with 10 points each during the 58-54 home opener victory against Buffalo. Kelly was 3-of-7 from the field, hit a key 3-pointer and was 3-of-4 at the free throw line. He added a pair of rebounds and assists as well as two blocked shots despite battling foul trouble. Redshirt freshman Odum was a perfect 4-of-4 from the field and was 2-of-4 at the free throw line with three assists and two blocked shots plus three steals in 35 minutes of action against the Bulls. While the two Jakes scored a combined 20 points the other nine players who saw action for the Trees, tallied 34 points in the victory.

An Indiana State Win Over Notre Dame Would ...

- Be Indiana State's first victory over Notre Dame in just two all-time meetings.
- Break a nine-game losing streak against current members of the BIG EAST Conference, dating back to a 84-63 home court victory over Cincinnati on December 16, 1983.
- Be Indiana State's first road non-conference victory over an Indiana school since taking downing Butler 59-58 on

December 17, 2005 inside Hinkle Fieldhouse.

Getting To The Glass

Indiana State has been extremely strong on the boards this season as ISU has pulled down a total of 220 rebounds while the opposition has just 197. ISU is averaging 36.7 caroms per game while the five opponents are averaging 32.8. Leading the way for ISU has been the performance on the boards of Carl Richard, who is averaging 9.7 rebounds per game, including a total of 18 offensive rebounds. Indiana State has outrebounded four of its six opponents this season. The Sycamores are one of eight Valley teams to hold a positive rebounding margin so far this season. Richard's 9.7 rebounds per game is currently tops in the Missouri Valley Conference.

Printy Moving Up Indiana State 3-Point List

Indiana State junior Jordan Printy currently has 113 career 3-pointers and needs just two more to tie David Moss' 115 which is 10th on the ISU all-time list. Printy is one of just 14 Sycamores in the history of the program to hit at least 100 3-point field goals in a career.

Isiah Martin Ranks Highly For Career Blocked Shots

Indiana State junior Isiah Martin now has 117 blocked shots in his career following his posting of one against Buffalo. His current total of 117 blocks ranks third all-time in the history of the program as he recently passed Nate Green for third (109). The Indiana State school record is 168, set by DeCarsta Webster from 1975-78. Martin needs 10 more to catch Djibril Kante who for second place with 127. For the season, Martin is averaging 1.6 blocked shots per game and is one of two Sycamores to rank in the Valley's Top 5. Myles Walker's 1.7 blocks per game average is second while Martin's 1.3 is fifth. As a team, Indiana State is averaging 5.5 blocked shots per game which is the best in the league. ISU had seven rejections in their last outing against Buffalo.

Kelly One Of The Top Scorers In The Missouri Valley

Indiana State senior Jake Kelly leads the Sycamores with his 11.7 ppg average, which ranks in 15th in the Missouri Valley Conference rankings.

King Of The Four-Point Play

Indiana State senior Aaron Carter has become known as the "King of the 4-Point Play" in the Sycamores circles. For the most part, converting a 4-point play is extremely rare, but for Carter it is becoming old hat. Carter converted a 4-point play, defined as being fouled in the act of shooting a successful 3-point field goal and then converting the free throw, six times in his Sycamore career. Carter posted a pair as a sophomore and had four last year, including one with 3:42 to play in the first half against Drake this past week. Carter converted two in one game earlier this season at Missouri State as part of a 24-point second half comeback for Indiana State.

Notching An Oklahoma Road Victory

Indiana State kept up its winning ways against Oral Roberts with a 74-69 road victory versus the Golden Eagles. ISU has now won each of the last three meetings in the series, including their first on the road. ISU also won its first game in the state of Oklahoma since February 14, 1980 when the Sycamores took down then Valley-member Tulsa, 70-66. The win at Oral Roberts was also the first road victory for first-year head coach Greg Lansing.

Preseason Missouri Valley Conference Predictions

The Indiana State basketball team has received a seventh place predicted finish as announced today (Oct. 26) by the league office. The annual preseason poll was conducted earlier this

month by the conference's head coaches, media panel and sports information directors. The Sycamores finished in a tie for fifth place last year in the league standings and received the No. 6 seed at the State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament in St. Louis. ISU finished the 2008-09 campaign with a 17-15 overall record and a 9-9 mark in league play.

Wichita State garnered 33 first place votes and are picked to win the league with 382 points. Missouri State took home one first place vote and is slated to finish second (313 points) while 2010 NCAA Sweet Sixteen qualifier Northern lowa received three first place votes and is picked third (289 points). In fourth is Creighton with 282 points while Bradley received the final two first place votes and tallied 264 points. Illinois State was sixth with 165 points while the Sycamores had 136 in seventh. Drake was eighth with 121 points, Southern Illinois was ninth with 120 and Evansville rounded out the poll with 73 points.

The MVC preseason team included Kwadzo Ahelegbe (Northern Iowa), Kenny Lawson, Jr. (Creighton), Sam Maniscalco (Bradley), Toure Murry (Wichita State) and Kyle Weems (Missouri State). The honorable mention squad included Taylor Brown (Bradley), J.T. Durley (Wichita State), Adam Leonard (Missouri State), Colt Ryan (Evansville), Seth VanDeest (Drake) and Andrew Warren (Bradley).

Sycamores Sign Devonte Brown & Justin Gant

Indiana State basketball head coach Greg Lansing landed two in his first official recruiting class during the Early Signing Period as Devonte Brown & Justin Gant inked a national letters of intent and will join the Sycamore program next season as incoming freshmen.

Brown is a native of Killeen, Texas where he is a senior guard for Killeen Ellison High School. He is 6-3, 185 and averaged 15 points, seven rebounds, four steals and three assists per game at Ellison during his junior season, one year after he earned a starting role for the Screaming Eagles. Brown played shooting guard for 22-11 Ellison last season, leading it to the Texas 5-A playoffs as Killeen's best team in that class. Brown will switch and play point guard during his senior season at Ellison.

Gant is a 6-8, 210 power forward who has been a three-year starter for head coach Todd Woelfle at Terre Haute North Vigo High School. Gant was third in the Metropolitan Interscholastic Conference in scoring, averaging 17 points per game for the 17-7 Patriots. Gant averaged 17 on a team that scored 50 points per game, one of the best percentages among MIC leaders as far as percentage of points he provided for his team. He also averaged 8 rebounds per game. He played AAU basketball for the Spiece Select 2011 team. Gant averaged 16 points and 10 rebounds per game for Spiece. He also played for the Indiana Elite team between his sophomore and junior seasons at North.

Sycamores Return To Postseason In 2010

Indiana State made its first appearance in the postseason by accepting an invitation last year to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI) by traveling to Saint Louis since participating in the 2001 NCAA Tournament when the Sycamores downed No. 4 seeded Oklahoma in the first round by the score of 70-68 (OT). ISU is 38-20 all-time in postseason play. The Sycamores won the 1950 NAIB National Championship, downing Delta State, Arkansas State, Baldwin-Wallace, Tampa and East Central Oklahoma. The Sycamores have appeared in the 1942 & 1943 National Intercollegiate Tournament, the 1946, 1948, 1949 & 1950 NAIB National Tournament, the 1952, 1953, 1954, 1959, 1962 & 1963 NAIA National Tournament; the 1966, 1967 & 1968 NCAA College Division Tournament; the 1977 & 1978 National Invitation Tournament; and the 1979 & 2001 NCAA Division I Basketball Championship. ISU made a run to the 1979 NCAA Final Four behind the star power of Sycamore legend Larry Bird, falling in the national championship contest to Michigan State, 75-64 in a game that is still the highest rated television basketball broadcast of all-time.

Up Next

Indiana State stays on the road to take on Wyoming on December 4 in Laramie as part of the MVC/Mountain West Challenge Series. Tipoff is slated for 7:00 p.m. (ET). The game can be heard live on ESPN Radio 92.7 FM as well as 1300 AM.

The Last Time Out ...

TERRE HAUTE, Ind. -- Indiana State forced 20 Buffalo turnovers and scored 26 points off those miscues en route to a 58-54 victory over Buffalo in front of 3,927 fans at Hulman Center.

ISU won its second consecutive contest to improve to 3-3 on the season while the Bulls fell to 3-2.

ISU was paced by Jake Odum's and Jake Kelly's 10 points each while Dwayne Lathan and Myles Walker tallied nine. Aaron Carter had seven while Carl Richard added seven as well.

Richard went into double figures rebounding for the third time this season with 10 rebounds.

ISU led 23-21 at the half and led by as many as seven points late in the contest before earning the 58-54 decision.

The Sycamore defense was stingy in the contest, holding Buffalo to just 36 percent shooting, as they hit 18-of-50 shots from the field and turned the ball over 20 times. ISU tallied 26 points off turnovers while the Bulls could only score eight points off of 15 Sycamore turnovers.

With the score tied at 14 with 7:41 left in the opening half, ISU scored six consecutive points on a bucket by McWhorter, a stop and score by Odum and then a driving lay-up by Lathan. The lead got cut to 20-19 with just under three minutes left, before Aaron Carter connected on a 3-pointer to make it 23-19 with two minutes to go.

The score was tied at 42 -- the 10th tie of the contest -- with 8:43 to go, before Richard and Odum hit back-to-back buckets to make it 46-42. A free throw by McWhorter made it 47-42 before the lead was hittled down to 49-48 and then 52-50 with 1:36 to go.

ISU got another layup by Lathan with 1:13 to make it 54-50 and then Odum added a turnaround jumper in the paint with 28 seconds on the clock for a 56-50 advantage. A free throw by Odum

with 14.1 seconds left made it 57-50. Carter added one more free throw with seven seconds let for the 58-54 victory.

ISU broke a twogame losing streak to Buffalo and evened the all-time series at 2 each. The game was head coach Greg Lansing's home debut and he became the fourth consecutive head coach to win his first game at home.

Greg Lansing

Indiana State Head Basketball Coach First Season

Greg Lansing is in his first season as the head basketball coach at Indiana State. He previously spent eight seasons with the program as an assistant coach, including the last three as associate head coach.

In 2009-10 the Sycamores overcame a ton of adversity to still put together its best season in nearly a decade under the professional leadership of the ISU coaching staff. Despite having its full compliment of student-athletes for just 28 minutes of the rough and tumble Missouri Valley Conference slate, the Sycamores still recorded its first winning season since 2001 as they finished 17-15. ISU also finished the year with a 9-9 record in league play, bolstering the Sycamores to the league's No. 6 seed at the State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament after finishing in a tie for fifth in the standings.

Starting guard Jake Kelly suffered a season ending knee injury with 12 minutes left in the conference opener at Southern Illinois and subsequently also lost Dwayne Lathan and Harry Marshall for extended periods over the course of the year.

Marshall led the MVC in scoring in league contests with a 16.0 ppg average. He was tabbed Second Team All-MVC and was named to the MVC's All-Defensive Team after turning in shutdown performances against most of the league's all-conference opposition. Running a well-rounded program, the Sycamores also had two representatives on the MVC's Scholar Athlete Team as both Jordan Printy and Aaron Carter took those plaudits.

The payoff for the Sycamores continued as ISU reached postseason play for the first since 2001 when they accepted a bid to the 2010 College Basketball Invitational, appearing in a road contest at Saint Louis.

With a keen attention to details that most coaches think of as an afterthought, the Sycamores concentrated on extreme efficiency on the court, finishing the year as the nation's second leading free throw shooting team. ISU's 76.9 percent mark at the line finished just behind NCAA qualifier BYU on the NCAA Division I list for the best free throw shooting teams in the country.

During this most recent stint with the Sycamore basketball program, Lansing has also been a key recruiter for many talented student-athletes. He helped bring a

local flavor to the club with the additions of Jake Kelly, Logan & Lucas Eitel, RJ Mahurin and Jake Odum.

Lansing has also been a major reason for several all-conference accolades for numerous players, including Harry Marshall and Jay Tunnell, who took All-MVC honors following the 2008-09 campaign and Marshall again in 2009-10. In 2008-09, the Sycamores concluded the regular season by winning six of their final games, including a trio of road contests.

Lansing returned to Indiana State after a seven-year stint with the lowa Hawkeyes. During Lansing's seven years as assistant coach at Iowa, the Hawkeye's went 135-92, received three NCAA Tournament invitations, three NIT appearances and won a pair of Big Ten tournament titles, the first of which came on four wins in four games making lowa the first team in the Big Ten to accomplish such a feat. In 2005-06, Iowa earned a 25-9 record, the second-most wins in school history, the first undefeated (17-0) home record in the school's history and a No. 3 seed in the NCAA Tournament. Iowa earned seven All-Big Ten selections, 17 Academic All-Big Ten selections and four Academic All-Americans. Lansing coached four of the last five Big Ten rebounding champions, three straight conference leaders in blocked shots and, the league's 2005-06 defensive player of the year. Three of his student-athletes reached the NBA and two from the 2005-06 team were invited to NBA camps.

In Lansing's final two seasons of his first stint at Indiana State, the Sycamores posted back-to-back winning campaigns for the first time since 1979 and 1980. When the Sycamores posted a 16-11 record in 1998 it marked the first winning season for Indiana State since 1980. Indiana State advanced to the NCAA Tournament in both 2000 and 2001.

Prior to joining the staff at Indiana State, Lansing was the head basket-ball coach at Roosevelt High School in Des Moines, Iowa. Roosevelt had not had a winning season in 12 years before Lansing's initial season. The Roughriders went on to have back-to-back winning seasons under his direction.

Lansing earned a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of South

Dakota in 1990 and a master's degree in counseling from USD in 1992. As a member of the Coyote basketball team Lansing helped South Dakota reach the NCAA Division II Tournament during his junior and senior seasons, the first NCAA invitation for USD since 1954. He was twice named the South Dakota Defensive Player of the Year. Greg is currently ranked among the leaders in career assists at USD. Following his playing career, Lansing served as a graduate assistant coach at South Dakota for two seasons. In 1992-93 he was a full-time assistant.

Lansing earned all-state honors in three different sports at Harlan Community High School, graduating in 1986.

Greg's father, Dave Lansing, coached high school basketball for 33 years in Iowa. Dave Lansing was inducted into the Iowa High School Athletic Association Coaches Hall of Fame during the 1999 Iowa boys state basketball tournament.

Lansing's dad, his mother, Diane, his sister, Angela, and his nephew, Jordan, live in West Des Moines. His brother, Steve, is the head basketball coach at Faribault High School (Minn.), where he was named Regional Coach of the Year in 2004.

Lansing is married to the former Angie Menser, who is an Indiana State graduate and a former track and cross country academic All-American for the Sycamores. She currently serves as ISU's senior women's administrator and athletics business manager.
