# Ethical Conduct - Bylaw 10.1

- Refusing to cooperate in investigation
- Academic fraud
- Intentional extra benefits/inducements
- False information during investigation or forcing others to do same
- Kick-backs for arranging agents to meet with student athletes
- Providing banned substances to student athletes or other illicit drugs or prescription drugs;
- Misleading NCAA, the NCAA Eligibility Center or admissions office about academic records
- Competition under an assumed name or knowingly allowing same to occur;
- Failure to provide NCAA information regarding person's amateur status or change therein.
- Sports wagering by athletic department staff, coaches, student athletes; any person on campus who "oversees" athletic department (FAR, President).

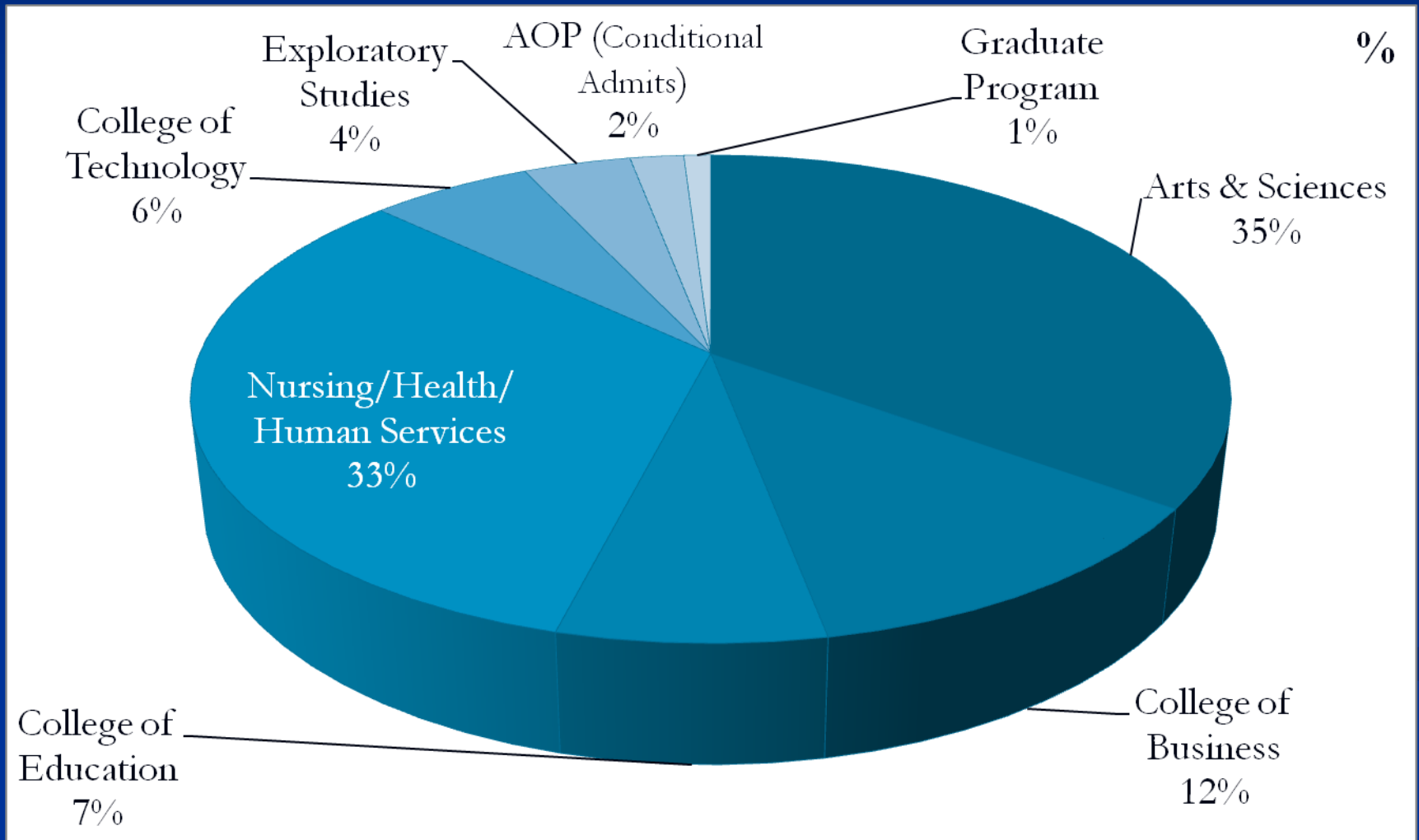

# Eligibility Certification

- *Freshman* – NCAA Eligibility Center
- *Transfers* – 2-4, 4-4, 4-2-4's
  - Year in Residence (MBB, WBB, Baseball, FB → ↑ )
  - Qualifiers vs Non-Qualifiers
- *Continuing:*
  - 6/18/24 hour rules; 9 hour rule for football
  - Full time enrollment
  - Percentage Towards Degree
    - 40%/60%/80%
    - GPA 90/95/100%
    - 5 Year Clock
    - Athletic Holds

# Financial Aid

- Head Count vs Equivalency Sports
- Athletic scholarships
  - Permissible awards – Tuition, fees, room, board, books
  - Term of award
  - Maximum amount (COA/GIA)
  - 5<sup>th</sup> year aid
  - Summer school aid

# Benefits

- Extra benefits (boosters, staff, coaches)
- Travel restrictions-missed class time
- Academic support services required
