WINTHROP GAME PREVIEW

The Pat Kelsey era opened up with a bang as he joined every coach in Winthrop by winning the very first game they coached as an Eagle.

The Eagles travel to Terre Haute to take on a Sycamores team that suffered an 86-59 victory at UCLA in their opener. This will be the first meeting ever with Indiana State as well as the Eagles first trip to play in the state of Indiana since 1999 when they faced Auburn in their first ever NCAA Tournament appearance in Indianapolis.

Sophomore Derrick Henry shined offensively in the first game for the Eagles as he scored a career-high 26 points on 8-for-14 shooting as he also nabbed a personal-best six boards. Henry led four players in double-figures.

Senior Gideon Gamble added 12 points and scored in double-figures for the first time in his career without knocking down a tree. Newcomer Christian Farmer, a junior college transfer, added 11 points on 4-for-10 shooting while sophomore Andre Smith had 10 points.

Kelsey was able to get a lot of players several minutes in the opener as the team shot the ball well from the

field, finishing at 50 percent against a Knights defense that played 40 minutes of zone.

Sophomore Larry Brown had a solid game in just his second career start as he finished with five points while setting career-highs with nine rebounds and three assists.

Indiana State is led by preseason All-MVC selection Jake Odum, a junior guard that scored six points with five assists and four steals against the Bruins.

Similar to the Eagles, Indiana State returns just one starter this season from a team that finished the season with an 18-15 record last year.

Odum is the only returning starter and he averaged 10.8 points, 4.8 assists and 5.9 rebounds in 2011-12.

Sophomore center Justin Gant and freshman guard Khristian Smith led the Sycamores against UCLA with 11 points each. Junior forward Manny Arop also scored in double-figures with 10.

Indiana State fired up 26 threes in the loss to UCLA, connecting on just 19 percent. The Sycamores did take advantage of 16 Bruin miscues, turning them into 24 points.

In 2011-12, Indiana State was strong at home with an 11-4 mark at Hulman Center while the Eagles were just 4-11 on the road.

# EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

## WINTHROP AS A TEAM

- In the last five seasons in their first road game, Winthrop is 2-3
- Derrick Henry's 26 points are the most in a season-opener since Michael Jenkins had 40 against North Greenville on Nov. 10, 2006
- Winthrop is coming off back-to-back losing seasons for the first time since 1996-97/1997-98
- The Eagles opened up the 2011-12 season with 0-5 and didn't score 80 points in a game until the sixth game (107-68 win over Central Penn)
- This is the first meeting against Indiana State
- Of all the returning players, not one had more than three games scoring in double-figures in 2011-12 (Joab Jerome had three)
- For the first time since 2009-10, Winthrop will not participate in a regular season tournament (just the 2nd time in last 12 seasons)
- Coach Pat Kelsey joined all five previous head coaches at Winthrop who won in their debut (Nield Gordon, Won 91-81 at Wingate), (Steve Vacendak, Won 74-64 at UMES), (Dan Kenney, Won 92-84 vs. Queens), (Gregg Marshall, Won 71-50 vs. Clinch Valley), (Randy Peele, Won 68-61 vs. Queens)
- Winthrop has just one freshman on the 2012-13 roster
- Derrick Henry's 26 points were the fourth most by any other Big South player in their opener and fifth best performance over the first three days of the season in league play

## #2 Gideon Gamble

- Scored 12 points in the opener on 5-for-10 shooting but did not knock down a three and also pulled down career-best
- Against St. Andrews was the first time he had scored in double-figures without hitting a three-point basket
- Has 11 career double-figure games with a career-high 20 points vs. VCU on Nov. 15, 2010
- Has 16 career games with multiple three-pointers made
- This is the first season since 2003-04 that Winthrop will play three of its first four games at home

## #3 Andre Smith

- Despite foul trouble in the opener, he finished with 10 points, and three rebounds
- Scored a career-high 13 points against Central Penn on Nov. 26, 2011
- Had 11 games with at least two assists last season

## #4 Joab Jerome

- Missed Season Opener
- Averaged 4.6 points, 3.6 rebounds, 1.9 assists and 0.8 steals per game as a sophomore
- Has three career games with double-figures and scored a career-high 14 points vs. Presbyterian College on Feb. 14, 2012
- Finished with eight points, four rebounds, a career-best nine assists and two steals to help Winthrop upset Campbell in opening round of 2011-12 Big South Conference Tourney
- Shot free throws in 22-of-29 games played in 2011-12

## #11 Reggie King

- Is injured to start the season and will play the point if he can return
- Has 44 games played in his career

## #12 James Bourne

- Made 13th career start in opener and had six points on 3-for-3 shooting
- Scored a career-high 10 points at Liberty on Jan. 14, 2012 (his only double-figure game)
- Pulled down at least one rebound in 31-of-32 games played in 2011-12

# EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

## • **#14 Shola Diop**

- Made both shots attempted in season opener
- Battled injuries in 2011-12 but is healthy for 2012-1
- When he did play in 2011-12, shot the ball well finishing the season 10-for-15 (67 percent)
- Scored career-high 12 points

## **#15 Derrick Henry**

- Scored career-high 26 points in season opener, scoring double-figures in both the first and second half (14/12)
- Leads the Big South in free throws attempted (14) and is only player in double-figures
- One of only two players to see 30 or more minutes against St. Andrews
- Scored 15 points against Central Penn on Nov. 26, 2011 going 5-for-5 from the field and 3-for-3 behind the arc

## **#20 Donovan Carter**

- Walk-on has seen action in six games in three seasons (four minutes in season opener against St. Andrews)

## **#21 Torrell Priest**

- Earned a spot on the team as a walk-on
- Previously played at Clinton Junior College and Rockingham C.C.
- Averaged 21 points per game and was named First Team All-Conference At Rockingham C.C.
- All-Region First Team selection and member of the State Championship team at Fort Mill H.S.

## **#22 Steve Johnson**

- Came off the bench for three points, three rebounds in first game with Eagles (vs. St. Andrews)
- Transfer from Brunswick C.C. where he averaged 13.3 points and 10.5 rebounds as a sophomore

## **#23 Larry Brown**

- Started against St. Andrews and pulled down career-high nine rebounds and dished out career-best three assists
- Had one start in 25 games played in 2011-12 and mainly contributed on the boards
- Had a career-high seven rebounds against Marquette on Nov. 18, 2011 and had 10 games of three or more boards
- Was only 1-for-11 from the foul line as a freshman

## **#31 Tevin Prescott**

- Saw seven minutes of action against St. Andrews knocking down his only field goal (about a six-foot jumper)
- Earned a spot on the team as a walk-on
- All-Region Selection in 2011-12 and was a member of the State Championship Team at Hartsville
- Named the MVP of the Bojangles Classic

## **#34 Christian Farmer**

- Scored 11 points and dished out four assists in first game with Eagles (vs. St. Andrews)
- Transferred from Tallahassee C.C. where he averaged 14 points per game
- Shot 43 percent behind the arc as a sophomore at Tallahassee C.C.
