The game: High Point University (3-1) plays Indiana State (3-1) for the first time ever on Sunday at the Hulman Center in Terre Haute, Ind. The Panthers played in the state of Indiana last season, traveling to Purdue and leading the Boilermakers, 62-60, with under three minutes to go, before taking a 67-65 loss. Then-senior Nick Barbour had a three-point attempt that rimmed out in the final seconds. Both the Panthers and Sycamores are off to 3-1 starts. It's HPU's best start since getting off to a 3-1 start in 2004-05. The Panthers' last 4-1 start was in 1999-2000. ISU has gotten off to good starts under coach Greg Lansing, going 5-0 to start the 2011-12 season.

The opponent: Indiana State has won three games in a row, most recently getting a 68-48 road win over Ball State last Tuesday. The Sycamores lost the season opener, 86-59, to current No. 11 UCLA on the road. Since then, they have gone on to beat Winthrop (66-55), Truman State (70-57) and Ball State (68-48). Jake Odum leads the team with averages of 14.8 points and 4.8 assists. He scored 21 in the win over Ball State. Manny Arop is the team's top rebounder at 6.3 per game and he is contributing 8.5 ppg. The team is coached by Greg Lansing, who has a 41-30 record in two-plus seasons at ISU.

Last time out: High Point bounced back with a 93-62 win over St. Andrews University last Wednesday at the Millis Center. Redshirt-freshman John Brown led all scorers with 24 points and totaled seven rebounds and three blocks. Graduate student Allan Chaney posted his second double-double in a row with 14 points and 10 rebounds. Senior point guard Jairus Simms had a career-high nine assists and freshman Adam Weary scored 13 points with five assists. St. Andrews had four double-digit scorers led by Orlando Edwards, who scored 14 points and hit four three-pointers. The Knights kept the game close as it was 57-47 with under 13 minutes to go before the Panthers pulled away. High Point is 16-7 all-time against St. Andrews.

Assist highs: Senior Jairus Simms had a career-high nine assists and freshman Adam Weary had five, contributing to 22 total assists against St. Andrews on Wednesday. Simms's total was most by an HPU player since David Singleton had 11 at VMI

on Jan. 24, 2009. The last time two HPU players had at least five assists in the same game was Dec. 21, 2011 when Xavier Martin had six and Simms had five. That was also the last time HPU totaled 20 assists in a game. The last time High Point had 22 or more assists was 22 vs. Averett on Dec. 10, 2011.

47 Rebounds: High Point's 47 rebounds against St. Andrews on Nov. 21 were the team's most since getting 50 in a loss to VMI on Jan. 15, 2011.

Brown posts third 20+ game: Redshirt-freshman John Brown scored 24 points against St. Andrews on Wednesday, the third time in four games he scored at least 20 points. He scored a career-high 28 points against UNC Greensboro in the season opener on Nov. 9. Brown followed that up with 22 in a road win over Appalachian State on Nov. 13. After scoring just seven points in a loss to William & Mary, Brown came back to score 24 points with seven rebounds and three blocks in just 22 minutes of play. In four games, Brown is averaging 20.3 points, 6.3 rebounds and 2.8 blocks. He is averaging 0.8 points per minute and shooting 55.2 percent from the field this season.

•SportsCenter No. 1 play: In his collegiate debut against UNC Greensboro, John Brown slammed home a one-handed alley-oop on a pass from Allan Chaney in the second half. The video was featured as ESPN SportsCenter's No. 1 play on Nov. 10 and was listed the No. 5 play of the weekend on Nov. 12. It was the first time High Point University was recognized in the top 10 plays since Shay Shine's dunk over Presbyterian's Walt Allen on Feb. 1, 2011 was the No. 2 play.

•@SportsCenter tweet: The YouTube clip of John Brown's reverse dunk at Appalachian State was tweeted to over 4 million followers by ESPN's @SportsCenter handle. The video has over 10,000 views.

•Brown collects freshman honor: John Brown was named Big South Freshman of the Week after posting game-highs of 28 points, eight rebounds, five steals and three blocks in the Panthers' win over UNC Greensboro. He was High Point's first Freshman of the Week since Du'Vaughn Maxwell in January of 2011. HPU has earned just four Freshman of the Week honors since the beginning of the 2007-08 season.

Chaney's consecutive double-doubles: Graduate student Allan Chaney notched his second double-double in a row with 14 points and 10 rebounds in the win over St. Andrews last Wednesday. That followed his career-best 22-point, 10-rebound performance against William & Mary on Nov. 17. That was the first double-double of his collegiate career. After missing three seasons of basketball, Chaney is providing an immediate impact for the Panthers. He is averaging 17.3 points and 8.3 rebounds while shooting 62.5 percent from the field through four games.

•Chaney ties free-throw record: Allan Chaney went 8-for-8 from the free-throw line against William & Mary on Nov. 17, becoming the 12th player in HPU's Div. I era to shoot 100 percent when attempting at least eight free throws. The most recent was Nick Barbour, who went 8-for-8 at Stephen F. Austin State on Feb. 18, 2012. The best free-throw shooting performance was when Shay Shine went 10-for-10 in a win over NC Central on Feb. 7, 2011.

Law returns: Redshirt-senior forward Corey Law rejoined the lineup and scored eight points with six rebounds in 12 minutes of play against St. Andrews on Nov. 21. He has led HPU in rebounding three times in a row and averaged 9.5 points and 7.2 rebounds last year. In 82 career games, Law has averaged 8.9 points and 7.1 rebounds. He has 581 career rebounds and is closing in on HPU's all-time top 10 in that category. Steve Tatgenhorst ranks 10th all-time with 724 rebounds from 1964-69.

Weary joins double-figure scorers: Freshman guard Adam Weary scored 13 points in the win over St. Andrews last Wednesday, raising his season average to 10.3 ppg. It was his third double-digit scoring performance and he has hit a three-pointer in all four games. He's also averaging 2.3 rebounds and 2.3 assists. With John Brown and Allan Chaney also averaging double-figures, it's the first time since last February that the team had three players averaging at least 10 points (Nick Barbour, Shay Shine and Corey Law).

Starting 3-1: High Point's 3-1 start is its best since starting 3-1 in 2005-06. The Panthers' last 4-1 start was in 1999-2000. That team went on to start 5-1 but ended up 11-17 on the season. Of the first five wins that year, three came against non-Div. I opponents.

Back on the block: Through four games, HPU is averaging 5.8 blocks. Last season HPU averaged 2.8 blocks. The Panthers averaged over four blocks twice in the Div. I era: 4.4 in 2008-09 and 4.2 in 2009-10. Both of those seasons were led by HPU's all-time blocks leader, Cruz Daniels, who averaged 2.5 blocks per game in his career. Redshirt-freshman forward John Brown leads HPU with 2.8 blocks per game so far this year.

Panthers topped by William & Mary: High Point got off to a tough start, shooting under 30 percent in the first half, and never recovered in an 83-61 loss to William & Mary on Nov. 17 at the Millis Center. The Tribe hit 50.0 percent of its shots in the first half and 63.2 percent in the second half en route to the win. A 21-3 scoring run left William & Mary with a 17-point lead at halftime. HPU graduate student Allan

Chaney picked up a double-double with 22 points and 10 rebounds in the loss. William & Mary's Tim Rusthoven scored 23 points with nine rebounds and guard Marcus Thornton scored 21 points with five assists.

Defensive board battle: William & Mary had 33 defensive rebounds compared to HPU's 19 on Saturday. The -14 defensive rebounding margin is HPU's worst since a -15 (29-16) margin in a 66-60 loss to Liberty on Jan. 13, 2011. The Panthers were beaten on the defensive boards by 11 once last season – an 85-66 loss to Radford on Jan. 17, 2012. By contrast, the Panthers outrebounded opponents by 11 on the defensive side in three games last season, all wins.

Newcomer contributions: With just six healthy returners to begin the season, High Point has gotten most of its production from its newcomers. In the first four games, newcomers scored 273 of HPU's 321 points (85 percent) and grabbed 105 of High Point's 160 rebounds (66 percent). Redshirt-freshman John Brown leads HPU with 20.3 points per game and ranks second with 6.3 rebounds. Graduate transfer Allan Chaney ranks second in scoring at 17.3 ppg and leads the team with 8.3 rpg.

Panthers smoke Mountaineers: High Point cruised to a 22-point win over Appalachian State on Nov. 13 in Boone, N.C., getting 22 points, seven rebounds and four blocks from John Brown in the 86-64 victory. The Panthers used a 28-6 run to take a 46-19 run with 2:37 remaining in the first half and the game was never close after that. HPU graduate student Allan Chaney scored 18 points with six rebounds. Junior guards Dejuan McGaughy and Derrell Edwards scored 15 points and 13 points, respectively. Jay Canty led Appalachian State with 23 points.

Biggest road win: High Point's 22-point road win over Appalachian State on Nov. 13 was the team's largest margin of victory on the road since it moved up to NCAA Div. I in 1999-2000. The previous high was 21 points, a 70-49 win at Savannah State on Feb. 6, 2007. HPU beat James Madison by 19 points (82-63) on Dec. 29, 2005.

Cherry vs. UNC grads: HPU head coach Scott Cherry – a 1993 North Carolina graduate – faced three fellow UNC graduates to begin the season. He came out victorious over former HPU assistant coach and current UNC Greensboro head coach Wes Miller (North Carolina '07) as well as Appalachian State's Jason Capel (UNC '02). William & Mary's Tony Shaver (North Carolina '76) came out on top on Nov. 17.

Edwards' perfect night: Junior guard Derrell Edwards made every shot he took at Appalachian State on Nov. 13, going 5-for-5 from the floor and 3-for-3 from beyond the arc, to score 13 points. He also chipped in a pair of steals. Through four games, Edwards is averaging 6.0 points, 2.5 rebounds and 1.5 assists in 27.5 minutes.

McGaughy in double-digits: Junior guard Dejuan McGaughy hit double-digits for the first time at HPU, scoring 15 points to go along with four rebounds and three steals at Appalachian State on Nov. 13. He is averaging 8.8

points, 2.8 rebounds and 2.3 assists through four games.

Chaney hits threes: Graduate student Allan Chaney hit two three-pointers against Appalachian State on Nov. 13, his first three-pointers since his collegiate debut against Toledo on Nov. 14, 2008, when he was playing at the University of Florida. He went 1-for-5 from three-point range in 23 games that season.

Season opening win: High Point opened the season with an 81-73 win over UNC Greensboro on Nov. 9 at the Millis Center. HPU led all but 50 seconds of the contest, which was the first between the local rivals since 2003. HPU redshirt-freshman John Brown posted game highs of 28 points, eight rebounds, five steals and three blocks. Graduate student Allan Chaney scored 15 points with seven rebounds in 16 minutes and freshman Adam Weary chipped in 10 points. Trevis Simpson led three double-digit scorers for UNCG with 18 points.

Chaney's comeback complete: More than three years since his previous game, HPU graduate student Allan Chaney completed his comeback with 15 points and seven rebounds in 16 minutes in the Panthers' win over UNC Greensboro on Nov. 9. Before that, Chaney's last official game was March 4, 2009, when he was a freshman at the University of Florida. He transferred to Virginia Tech, sitting out the 2009-10 season due to transfer rules, before a heart ailment sidelined him for the 2010-11 and 2011-12 seasons. Chaney earned his bachelor's degree from Virginia Tech and joined HPU as a graduate student this season.

Cherry's openers: HPU is 4-0 in season openers under head coach Scott Cherry. The win over UNC Greensboro was the first against a Div. I team.

Exhibition win: High Point topped Mars Hill, 96-62, in an exhibition game on Nov. 3 at the Millis Center. Newcomers Allan Chaney and Derrell Edwards scored 16 points a piece to lead HPU while newcomer Dejuan McGaughy posted game highs of seven rebounds and five assists. The Lions' Daron Guyton led all scorers with 18 points. After Mars Hill made it close midway through the first half, High Point ended the half on a 27-8 run and it was never in doubt thereafter. It was the first time the teams faced each other since 1988.

Cherry begins fourth season: Head coach Scott Cherry begins his fourth season after posting a 40-52 record in his first three years at HPU. Cherry led HPU to a 15-15 overall (10-8 Big South) record in his first season of 2009-10, marking a six-win improvement from the season before. High Point went 12-19 (7-11) in 2010-11 and 13-18 (8-10) last season. The Panthers finished the 2011-12 season with a 5-3 record in their last eight games, beating Gardner-Webb in the first round of the Big South Tournament before losing to UNC Asheville in the quarterfinals.

Radio broadcast change: Evan Lepler is High Point's new play-by-play broadcaster for all games on ESPN Radio, 1230 AM-WFMR, and highpointpanthers.com. He joins color commentator Stafford Stephenson, who is now in his 11th season.
