OUT OF THE BOX

SYCAMORES AT A GLANCE

Indiana State enters the weekend hitting .281 as a club with 39 extra-base hits, including 15 home runs. The Indiana State pitching staff holds a 4.60 ERA and has struck out 97 batters in 115.1 innings. Jarrod Watkins leads ISU at the plate with a .375 average and a team-best 21 base hits. Luke Fegen (.353) and Roberto Enriquez (.333) are also hitting over .300 for the Trees. Triston Polley has a 3-1 record and a 2.42 ERA in four starts for the Sycamores. Polley has 21 strikeouts in 26.0 innings.

LOOKING AT THE BULLDOGS


The Citadel enters the weekend 8-8 on the year and winners of three of their last four contests. The Bulldogs are led by William Kinney who holds a .385 batting average in 16 starts. Taylor Cothron (.333) and Jonathan Sabo (.328) are also hitting over .300 for The Citadel. The Bulldogs pitching staff is anchored by Alex Bialakis with a 1.89 ERA in six appearances, including three starts.

MOVING UP THE LIST

Head coach Mitch Hannahs moved into third all-time in career wins at Indiana State with a pair of victories over Western Illinois, passing Rick Heller. Hannahs sits at 132 wins in five seasons at the helm of the program.

2018 MVC STANDINGS

ALL-TIME VS THE CITADEL

The Sycamores hold a 6-2 advantage with The Citadel in the all-time series. The teams last met in 2010 when Indiana State took 2-of-3 from the Bulldogs in Charleston.

DOMINANT ON THE MOUND

Triston Polley notched his third win of the season Sunday afternoon in a combined shutout of Western Illinois. Polley nearly went the distance, finishing with a career best eight and a third innings while striking out four Leathernecks on the day. Ethan Larrison closed out the final two innings of the game for his fourth save of the season.

THE STREAK CONTINUES

Jarrod Watkins holds the teams longest hitting streak at 13 games. The junior has 21 hits, including four doubles and a triple for a .375 average. So far this season, Watkins has strung together six multi-hit performances, including a pair of three-hit outings.

FAST STARTS

Indiana State has been dominant to open games this season, outscoring the opposition 16-5. The Sycamores have outscored opponents in all but two innings this season including a 21-3 advantage in the ninth.

WEAR IT

Romero Harris and Roberto Enriquez rank in the top-30 nationally in hit-by-pitches per game. Harris ranks 17th with .50 per game while Enriquez is just behind him 26th nationally with .46 per game. As a team, ISU has been hit by a pitch 25 times to just nine times for opponents.

INFIELD STEADY

One of the most consistent areas for the Sycamores has been the infield defensively. Every infield spot has been manned by the same player all 13 games. The only changes defensively in the field have been in left field and center field.

GET ON AND SCORE

Luke Fegen has been one of the top run-scorers for the Trees in 13 games. Fegen has 12 base hits for a .355 batting average. He has reached base 16 times (12 H, 2 BB, 2 HBP) and has scored 11 runs for the Sycamores. Fegen is also sporting a .500 slugging percentage with a pair of doubles and a home run to his credit.

WORK HORSE

Senior Ethan Larrison has seen action in six games this season out of the bullpen, totaling 16. 2 innings. The righthander picked up saves three and four of the season last weekend against Western Illinois. In total, Larrison holds a 1.62 ERA, 14 strikeouts and a 1-0 record after picking up the win at Belmont earlier this season.

SAME OLD TYLER WARD

Junior Tyler Ward has picked up where he left off a year ago in regards to strikeouts to walks. The right-hander was one of the top strikeouts to walk pitchers in the nation in 2017. This season Ward has 17 strikeouts and has allowed just three walks (5.56) good for sixth in the MVC.

IS HE GETTING HOT?

It hasn't been the start to the season that junior Jake Means might have wanted but there may be light at the end of the tunnel. Entering the last weekend Means sat at just a .133 average on the season in eight games, collecting hits in just two games. Means blasted two home runs in the series finale at Austin Peay to help the Sycamores salvage a game in the series, the first multi-hit game of the season for the Gardner, Kansas native. Means now sits at .205 on the season after three hits in two games against Western Illinois.

BACK AFTER A CAREER DAY IN VEGAS

Chris Ayers has been cleared to return to action following an injury in the season opener. Avers opened the 2018 season tying a career high with three base hits against UNLV. It marked the third time in his career that he had recorded three hits with the last time coming in 2017 at Utah Valley when he did it twice during a doubleheader.

PRESEASON ALL-MVC

Redshirt senior Dane Giesler was tabbed Preseason All-MVC following a breakout season a year ago. The Jasper, Indiana native led the way for the Trees in several offensive categories. He finished with a team high 17 home runs which was fourth-best in the conference and second alltime in school history for single-season homers. Giesler was also fifth in the league with a .593 slugging percentage and seventh in RBIs with 49.

WHAT RETURNS FOR THE TREES

Indiana State returns six position starters and three key pitchers from last season's 29-26 team. Infielder Clay Dungan returns for ISU after starting in 55 games last season hitting .275 with 60 base hits and nine home runs. The Sycamores will also welcome back Dane Tofteland and Chris Ayers to the batting order. The duo combined for 57

base hits and 45 runs a year ago.

Indiana State will look to fill a void in the starting rotation this season after its top arm was taken in the 11th round of the MLB Draft. Junior RHP Tyler Ward will look to fill the spot after a solid year on the mound. Ward finished at 4-5 with a 4.16 ERA in 84.1 innings.

Two bullpen arms in right-hander Ethan Larrison and southpaw Triston Polley return for the Sycamores this season as well. Larrison appeared in 19 games last season and struck out 32 batters while walking only 13. Polley struck out 35 batters and walked 14 in 26.2 innings.

SYCAMORES PICKED THIRD IN PRESEASON POLL

Indiana State was picked to finish third in the Missouri Valley Conference Preseason Poll. Dallas Baptist tallied 63 points and were named the favorites over second-place pick Missouri State (57). The Sycamores collected 42 votes overall followed by Southern Illinois (35), Illinois State (31), Bradley (30), Evansville (18) and MVC newcomer Valparaiso (12).

MISSOURI VALLEY CONFERENCE NOTES

TOUGH AT HORNER

With DBU's series win over Oral Roberts, the Patriots won their 17th consecutive weekend series at Horner Ballpark. Dating back to the start of the 2015 season, DBU is 24-1 in weekend series at home, with their lone series loss coming to Oral Roberts in February of 2016. The Patriots will host Brown at Horner Ballpark this weekend.

5-0 WEEK FOR SALUKIS

After SIU started the season 3-8, the Salukis went 5-0 this past week. The winning streak started with a combined 1-hit shutout at SEMO. The next day, the offense exploded for 23 runs in a win at Murray State, the eighth-most runs in program history. SIU capped the winning streak with a weekend sweep over Northern Illinois. Southern Illinois outscored its opponents 49-11. As a team, SIU hit .302 while the pitching staff limited opponents to a .197 average.

HIGH POWERED OFFENSE

Illinois State is off to one of the best starts nationally offensively. The Redbirds currently rank third in scoring, averaging 10.0 runs per game (behind Tennessee Tech and New Mexico State). ISU also sits sixth in slugging (.521) and 14th nationally with 21 home runs. The 21 home runs is just three short of last season's entire total of 24.

WINNING OUT WEST

The four-game series at Washington was the start of a west coast swing for the Redbirds that will also take them to Hawaii over spring break for a four-game set. The beginning of the trip has gone well for the Redbirds out west, as ISU took two of the first three games of its series at Pac-12 opponent Washington with the final game of the series set for Monday.

KING KOPACH

Southern Illinois' Connor Kopach ranks top five nationally in three different categories. The senior infielder leads the nation with 13 steals this season and ranks fifth in both runs (23) and hits (29). Kopach ranks second in The Valley with a .433 batting average.

BOUNCEBACK BEARS

With its 5-4 walk off victory over Arkansas State on Sunday, Missouri State not only logged its fifth come-from-behind victory of the season, but also improved to 5-0 follow a loss. The Bears have hit .294 with seven of their 11 home runs on the season in those five victories.

AGAINST THE FIELD

The MVC holds a winning record against 10 leagues in non-conference play (American, Conference USA, Metro, MAC, Mountain West, Ohio Valley, Patriot, SWAC, Summit and WAC), and at least a .500 record against another two leagues (Pac-12 and Southland).

RPI REPORT

The first NCAA RPI Report has four teams ranked in the RPI's top-65, led by Illinois State (No. 24), while Bradley (No. 38), Indiana State (No. 42) and DBU (No. 63) are also in the top-65. The MVC currently sits No. 8 as a conference, sitting behind the SEC, ACC, Big 12, Pac-12, Mountain West, Big Ten and Sun Belt.


