OUT OF THE BOX

ALL-TIME VS XAVIER

The two programs first met in 1985 with the last meeting in 2009. Indiana State leads the all-time series 18-6. The Sycamores have won six-straight meetings from 2000 to 2006 but have lost the last two matchups in the series.

KEEPING IT ROLLING

Indiana State is in the midst of a seven-game winning streak that includes victories over Austin Peay, Western Illinois, a three-game sweep of The Citadel and a midweek win at Eastern Illinois. Over that period the Sycamores have outscored opponents 50-23 and are hitting .309. The squad has also recorded 24 extra-base hits, including 16 doubles. Leadoff man Jarrod Watkins has six of the 15 doubles during the streak. The winning streak is tied for the fourth-longest in the nation behind St. Louis (11), South Florida (9) and VCU (9).

THE GUY CAN DEAL

Indiana State's Triston Polley has been the most dominant arm in the Sycamore rotation so far this year. In five starts, the Avon, Indiana product holds a 4-1 record to go along with a 2.16 ERA. Polley has pitched 33.1 innings and struck out 26 batters while holding opponents to a .186 average against. He allowed a season-low two hits Saturday at The Citadel in a 7-3 Sycamore win. On the year, the southpaw has allowed only eight earned runs and one or fewer earned runs in three starts.

FOUR OVER .300

Indiana State has four batters going over the .300 mark led by Jarrod Watkins who is batting .375 with a .514 slugging percentage. Luke Fegen is hitting .388 in 11 starts to go along with 12 runs scored and nine RBIs. Redshirt senior Dane Giesler sits at a .333 average, three home runs and a .583 slugging percentage. Right-fielder Roberto Enriquez is third on the team in RBIs with 12 and third in hitting with a .310 average.

MOVING UP THE LIST

Head coach Mitch Hannahs moved into third all-time in career wins at Indiana State with a pair of victories over Western Illinois, passing Rick Heller. Hannahs sits at 136 wins in five seasons at the helm of the program.

FAST STARTS

Indiana State has been dominant to open games this season, outscoring the opposition 18-5. The Sycamores have outscored opponents in all but one inning this season including a 25-8 advantage in the ninth.

WEAR IT

Roberto Enriquez ranks third in the nation in hit-by-pitches per game with a 0.59 average. On the season, Enriquez has been hit 10 times. Fellow teammate Romero Harris has been beamed six times.

GETTING ON BASE

Not only can redshirt senior Dane Giesler get on base via the base hit, but the infielder also has a way of reaching via base-on-balls. Giesler has drawn 16 walks through 15 games which ranks him 79th nationally and first in the MVC in the category. Giesler is averaging 1.07 walks per game which is 17th nationally.

WORK HORSE

Senior Ethan Larrison has seen action in eight games this season out of the bullpen, totaling 21.1 innings. Larrison enters the weekend with six saves this season. In total, Larrison holds a 1.27 ERA, 19 strikeouts and a 1-0 record after picking up the win at Belmont earlier this season.

SAME OLD TYLER WARD

Junior Tyler Ward has picked up where he left off a year ago in regards to strikeouts to walks. The right-hander was one of the top strikeouts to walk pitchers in the nation in 2017. This season Ward has 24 strikeouts and has allowed just four walks (6.00) good for third in the MVC.

BACK AFTER A CAREER DAY IN VEGAS

Chris Ayers has been cleared to return to action following an injury in the season opener. Ayers opened the 2018 season tying a career high with three base hits against UNLV. It marked the third time in his career that he had recorded three hits with the last time coming in 2017 at Utah Valley when he did it twice during a doubleheader.

Redshirt senior Dane Giesler was tabbed Preseason All-MVC following a breakout season a year ago. The Jasper, Indiana native led the way for the Trees in several offensive categories. He finished with a team high 17 home runs which was fourth-best in the conference and second all-time in school history for single-season homers. Giesler was also fifth in the league with a .593 slugging percentage and seventh in RBIs with 49.

SYCAMORES PICKED THIRD IN PRESEASON POLL

Indiana State was picked to finish third in the Missouri Valley Conference Preseason Poll. Dallas Baptist tallied 63 points and were named the favorites over second-place pick Missouri State (57). The Sycamores collected 42 votes overall followed by Southern Illinois (35), Illinois State (31), Bradley (30), Evansville (18) and MVC newcomer Valparaiso (12).

MISSOURI VALLEY CONFERENCE NOTES

IN RARE COMPANY

With Missouri State's 14-2 win over Seton Hall on Saturday, Bears head coach Keith Guttin moved into a tie with former San Diego State coach Jim Dietz for the No. 22 spot on the NCAA's Division I career coaching wins list. With a career record of 1,230-765 (.617), Guttin is the second-winningest coach in MVC history, while his win total ranked sixth among all active Division I head coaches entering the 2018 season. Barring any changes to the Bears' schedule, Guttin will coach his 2,000th game this Sunday when MSU hosts CSUN.

FIVE IN RPI'S TOP-100

Five league teams continue to rank in the top-100 of the RPI, led by Indiana State (No. 18), Illinois State (No. 26), Bradley (No. 66), Missouri State (No. 87) and DBU (No. 95). Another two teams, Valparaiso (No. 173) and Southern Illinois (No. 176), also rank in the RPI's top-200.

VALLEY RPI RANKS NO. 9

According to the latest RPI update from WarrenNolan.com (March 19), the Missouri Valley Conference ranks No. 9 amongst 31 leagues, down three positions from last week. Four of the Power-Five conferences (SEC, ACC, Big 12 and Pac-12) hold four of the top five positions, while the Sun Belt sits fifth.

WINS OVER POWER FIVE

Entering this week's action, the MVC has earned nine wins over members of Power Five conferences. The Valley sits 3-2 vs. the Pac-12, 3-4 vs. the Big 12, 2-5 vs. the Big Ten, 1-3 against the ACC and 0-5 vs. the SEC. Six of the eight MVC teams have earned wins against the Power Five. Bradley, Missouri State, Southern Illinois and Valparaiso each have one Power Five win, while DBU has two and Illinois State three. The league will have two more cracks at a Power Five win Tuesday as Illinois State hosts Illinois and DBU hosts Baylor.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Illinois State ranks second among Missouri Valley Conference teams at 26 in the RPI, as produced by WarrenNolan.com. The Redbirds have easily posted The Valley's best strength of schedule to date, checking in at 26 (Indiana State is second in SOS at 83). Illinois State will open the home schedule on Tuesday against Illinois after opening the season with 17-straight road contests. Illinois State's opponents to date have combined for an 155-95 (.620) Division I record through the weekend.

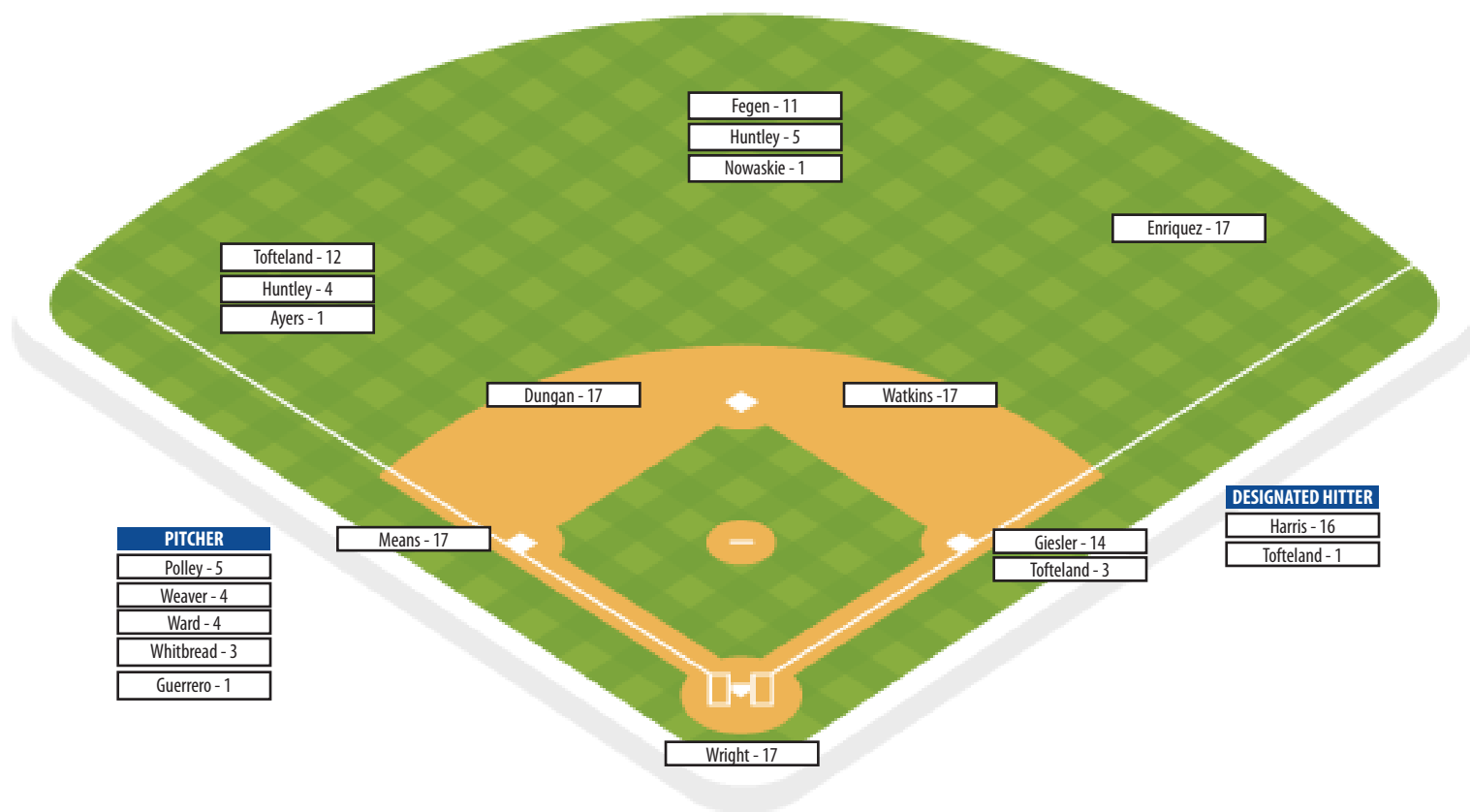
