#### SYCAMORES AT A GLANCE

Jarrod Watkins (.372, 10 2B, 8 RBI) and Luke Fegen (.333, 5 2B, 19 R, 11 BB, 8 RBI) lead the Trees at the plate while Dane Giesler and CJ Huntley are hitting .322 and .292, respectively. Romero Harris is tops on the squad with five home runs and 22 RBIs. As a team, the Sycamores are hitting .285 and have hit for 40 doubles, 4 triples and 20 home runs. The Indiana State pitching staff has struck out 150 batters and holds a combined 4.14 ERA.

#### LOOKING AT THE BEARS

Missouri State comes into play with a 17-6 overall record and are riding a six-game winning streak. The Bears are coming off a midweek win against Kansas. The team is led offensively by Jeremy Eirman (.333, 5 HR, 21 RBI) and Drew Millas (.317, 2 HR, 29 RBI). As a club, the Bears are hitting at a clip of .250 while the pitching staff holds a 3.07 ERA.

### ALL-TIME VS MISSOURI STATE

The Sycamores trail in the all-time series with Missouri State, 69-44. The Sycamores dropped a weekend series to the Bears in Springfield a year ago. In the last two series, each team has secured three-game sweeps as ISU swept the Bears in Terre Haute in 2016.

#### LAST TIME OUT

Indiana State's nine-game winning streak came to an end Wednesday afternoon at Bob Warn Field, falling to No. 11 Indiana, 5-3. The Sycamores brought the tying run to the plate in the ninth but the Trees were unable to finish the comeback after CJ Huntley hit his second home run of the season with two outs. The Sycamores left 11 runners on base, including two runners in each in the first three innings. Sophomore reliever Donnie Ames went 3.2 innings in the contest, retiring 10-straight Hoosiers at one point while allowing just one hit in his outing. Jarrod Watkins, CJ Huntley and Jake Means each tallied two hits to lead the Sycamores.

### **OUT OF THE BOX (CONT.)**

#### THE FRIDAY GUY

Tyler Ward will make his third series-opening start of the season against Missouri State. The right-hander enters the series with a 4-1 overall record and a 4.32 ERA. He has allowed just nine extra-base hits in 33.1 innings of work while holding the MVC's fifth-best strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.89) with 29 strikeouts and just six walks. The junior has won three-straight decisions with his lone loss coming at the hands of No. 12 Vanderbilt.

#### HE CAN DEAL

Triston Polley has been the most dominant arm in the Sycamore rotation so far this year. In five starts, the Avon, Indiana product holds a 4-1 record to go along with a 2.33 ERA -- the third-best ERA in the MVC. Polley has pitched 38.2 innings and struck out 27 batters while holding opponents to a .222 average against. On the year, the southpaw has allowed only 10 earned runs and one or fewer earned runs in three starts.

#### WEAR IT

Sycamore outfielder Roberto Enriquez has been hit-by-pitch 12 times this season -- to rank third in the nation in the category. With his 0.63 hit-by-pitches per game, he ranks first in the nation. Fellow Sycamore Romero Harris has been six times. As a team, ISU has been hit 36 times to lead the MVC.

#### **REACHING BASE**

Indiana State junior Jarrod Watkins has reached base in all 20 games in a Sycamore uniform. He has put together 10 multi-hit games, including three three-hit games. Watkins also held the longest hitting streak on the team at 14 games this season — currently at five games.

### MOVING UP THE LIST

Head coach Mitch Hannahs moved into third all-time in career wins at Indiana State with a pair of victories over Western Illinois, passing Rick Heller. Hannahs sits at 138 wins in five seasons at the helm of the program.

#### **GETTING ON BASE**

Not only can redshirt senior Dane Giesler get on base via the base hit, but the infielder also has a way of reaching via base-on-balls. Giesler has drawn 18 walks through 18 games played which ranks him 113th nationally and second in the MVC in the category. Giesler is averaging 1.00 walks per game which is 15th nationally.

#### **WORK HORSE**

Senior Ethan Larrison has seen action in nine games this season out of the bullpen, totaling 24.1 innings. Larrison enters the weekend with seven saves this season. In total, Larrison holds a 1.85 ERA, 23 strikeouts and a 1-0 record after picking up the win at Belmont earlier this season. His seven saves rank eighth nationally while his ERA is first in The Valley among qualified pitchers.

#### FAST STARTS

Indiana State has been dominant to open games this season, outscoring the opposition 19-5. The Sycamores have outscored opponents in all but one inning this season including a 29-11 advantage in the ninth.

#### **BACK AFTER A CAREER DAY IN VEGAS**

Chris Ayers has been cleared to return to action following an injury in the se ason opener. Ayers opened the 2018 season tying a career high with three base hits against UNLV. It marked the third time in his career that he had recorded three hits with the last time coming in 2017 at Utah Valley when he did it twice during a doubleheader.

#### PRESEASON ALL-MVC

Redshirt senior Dane Giesler was tabbed Preseason All-MVC following a breakout season a year ago. The Jasper, Indiana native led the way for the Trees in several offensive categories. He finished with a team high 17 home runs which was fourth-best in the conference and second all-time in school history for single-season homers. Giesler was also fifth in the league with a .593 slugging percentage and seventh in RBIs with 49.

#### SYCAMORES PICKED THIRD IN PRESEASON POLL

Indiana State was picked to finish third in the Missouri Valley Conference Preseason Poll. Dallas Baptist tallied 63 points and were named the favorites over second-place pick Missouri State (57). The Sycamores collected 42 votes overall followed by Southern Illinois (35), Illinois State (31), Bradley (30), Evansville (18) and MVC newcomer Valparaiso (12).

#### **MISSOURI VALLEY CONFERENCE NOTES**

#### QUICK STARTS CRUCIAL

If your team has plans on sitting atop the MVC standings heading into the league's postseason tournament, you might want to get off to a good start as all but one team that has won the MVC regular season has won at least 15 games since 2010, the first year of a 21-game conference schedule. In the last eight seasons, Indiana State is the only league team to win the MVC regular season title with fewer than 15 league victories, as the Sycamores won the Valley with a 14-7 record in 2012.

#### MILESTONE FOR HEEFNER

DBU Head Coach Dan Heefner won his 400th career game with a 9-7 win over No. 22 Sam Houston State on Friday. At just the young age of 40, Heefner is now 401-217 and his .649 win percentage ranks 19th best among active NCAA Division I coaches.

#### 1-2 PUNCH

Jameson Hannah and Devlin Granberg have been a dynamic 1-2 punch at the top of DBU's batting order. Both are hitting over .400, as Granberg leads the Patriots with a .407 batting average, while Hannah boasts the team's second highest average at .402. Over the last 12 games, Hannah and Granberg have accounted for 52 hits, eight home runs, 11 doubles, 31 RBI, and are hitting a combined .473.

#### **NEW SAVES RECORD**

SIU closer Ryan Netemeyer tied SIU's career saves record with his 30th career save in SIU's 10-8 win over UC Irvine on Sunday. Netemeyer, a two-time All-MVC closer, pitched a scoreless ninth in a game that featured 32 hits. He tied Bryant George (2007-10) for the school record, which is also tied for fourth in MVC history.

#### STREAKING AT HAMMONS

With five home victories last week, the Bears ran their 2018 home mark to 8-2 and extended their current Hammons Field win streak to six straight games. That streak represents the sixth different home win streak of at least six games since the start of the 2015 season. The Bears have logged their top two single-season home win totals over the last two years, going 21-7 at home last spring, following a Hammons Field record 22 victories in 2016. In 2015, MSU posted its best-ever showing at Hammons with a 19-3 (.864) mark, giving the Bears a combined 70-21 (.769) home record since the start of the 2015 season.

#### VALLEY RPI RANKS NO. 8

According to the latest RPI update from WarrenNolan.com (March 29), the Missouri Valley Conference ranks No. 8 amongst 31 leagues, moving up one spot from Monday. Four of the Power-Five conferences (SEC, Big 12, ACC and Pac-12) hold four of the top five positions, while the Sun Belt sits fifth.


