#### SYCAMORES AT A GLANCE

Jarrod Watkins (.317, 10 2B, 10 RBI) and Luke Fegen (.311, 5 2B, 14 RBI) lead the Trees at the plate while Dane Giesler and Chris Ayers are hitting .286, respectively. As a team, the Sycamores are hitting .270 and have hit for 53 doubles, 8 triples and 28 home runs. The Indiana State pitching staff has struck out 216 batters and holds a combined 4.41 ERA.

#### LOOKING AT THE BOILERMAKERS

Purdue enters the week 15-15 overall and losers of their last five games. The Boilermakers are hitting .267 on the season led by Skyler Hunter at .336 in 30 starts. The Purdue pitching staff holds a 4.73 combined ERA.

#### ALL-TIME VS PURDUE

The Sycamores lead the all-time series with Purdue 39-30-2. Indiana State has won seven of the last 10 meetings. The two squads split midweek matchups a year ago with each team winning on the road.

#### MISSOURI VALLEY PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Triston Polley earned his first MVC Pitcher of the Week honor after a dominant start 4.41 against Illinois State, going seven and a third innings, allowing just one run on three hits.

The Avon, Indiana product struck out five and walked just one in the outing. The southpaw retired 13-straight batter before a walk in the seventh inning. Illinois State got the offense going late though, scoring eight runs in the final two innings of play.

#### LOOKING FORWARD

Indiana State will play four of its next five games at home, including a weekend series with league-leading Dallas Baptist. The Trees will have back-to-back midweek games with Purdue with the first coming at home on Tuesday before heading to Purdue Wednesday. Following this weekend's homestand with DBU, the Sycamores will play nine-straight contests on the road, including a weekend series at Louisville before wrapping up with Southern Illinois.

#### **OUT OF THE BOX**

#### IN CASE YOU DIDN'T KNOW

Indiana State Athletic Director Sherard Clinkscales is one of just five Purdue pitchers to toss a no-hitter. Clinkscales did so May 9, 1992 against Indiana.

#### HE CAN DEAL

Triston Polley has been the most dominant arm in the Sycamore rotation so far this year. In nine starts, the Avon, Indiana product holds a 5-1 record to go along with a 2.44 ERA -- the second-best ERA in the MVC. Polley has pitched 59 innings and struck out 39 batters while holding opponents to a .201 average against. On the year, the southpaw has allowed only 16 earned runs and one or fewer earned runs in five starts.

#### MASHING

Indiana State sent four balls over the wall this weekend, including three in one game against Illinois State. Two of the home runs came off the bat of junior Chris Ayers which were the first and second home runs of the season for the outfielder coming in back-to-back games. Dane Giesler and Jake Means lead the team with six home runs each while ROmero Harris has five in 16 games for the Trees. As a team, ISU has 28 total home runs in 30 games.

#### AS A STAFF

Indiana States' pitching staff holds the third-lowest ERA in the conference at 4.41 behind Missouri State (3.88) and Dallas Baptist (4.26). Ethan Larrison holds the lowest ERA on the staff out of the bullpen with a 2.70 mark in 14 appearances. Among starting pitchers, southpaw Triston Polley has a 2.44 ERA which is also second-best in the MVC among qualified pitchers. The Sycamores have struck out 216 batters and walked 113 in 267.1 innings. RHP Tyler Ward leads the charge with 47 strikeouts.

#### SPEED TREES

Indiana State entered the Bradley with just 15 stolen bases in 23 games. In the last eight outings, ISU has recorded 10 stolen bases. Catcher Max Wright led the way with three stolen bases while Clay Dungan finished with two.

#### **WORK HORSE**

Senior Ethan Larrison has seen action in 14 games this season out of the bullpen, totaling 36.2 innings. Larrison enters the week with eight saves this season. In total, Larrison holds a 2.70 ERA and 34 strikeouts. His eight saves rank 20th nationally.

#### **WEAR IT**

Sycamore outfielder Roberto Enriquez has been hit-bypitch 14 times this season -- to rank 9th in the nation in the category. With his 0.48 hit-by-pitches per game, he ranks second in the nation. Fellow Sycamore Romero Harris has been six times. As a team, ISU has been hit 52 times to lead the Missouri Valley and rank 31st nationally.

#### SECOND IN PROGRAM HISTORY

Sycamore head coach Mitch Hannahs moved into sole possession of second place in program history Friday (4/13) after securing his 141st career victory during a 5-2 win against Illinois State, passing former ISU head coach Paul Wolf.

#### RIVERS MAKES HIS RETURN

Sycamore redshirt senior Weston Rivers made his return the mound at No. 10 Indiana (4/10) for the first time since 2016. The southpaw was cleared following an injury in which he had been rehabbing for much of the season. A knuckleballer, Rivers went 2.1 innings in a scheduled staff start against the Hoosiers, allowing just a run to the third-best hitting team in the nation.

#### GET THE LEAD, AND KEEP IT

Indiana State holds a 15-1 record when leading after eight innings this season thanks in part to the arm of closer Ethan Larrison who leads the team with eight saves. Also, filling in middle relief, Larrison has 36.2 innings on the season, striking out 34 batters in that time while holding opponents to a .221 average against. Fellow bullpen arms Donnie Ames and Tyler Grauer account for a save each. The Sycamores hold a 13-2 record when leading after six and a 14-3 record when leading after seven innings.

#### BACK TO THE NORM

After a tough start to the season fielding, Indiana State has slowly moved back to where they feel they belong on the defensive side of the ball. The Sycamores struggled with errors early, recorded multi-error games six times in the first 18 games of the season, including five in the series opener at Austin Peay. In the last 12 games, ISU has recorded just four errors with six perfect fielding games during the stretch. The Sycamores' .977 fielding percent ranks second in the conference behind Illinois State.

#### STRONG WEEK

Hayden Jaco is making the most of his time behind the plate following the absence of starting catcher Max Wright. Jaco started four games over the last week, finishing with a .533 batting average on eight hits in 15 at bats. Jaco has driven in four runs, including two runs in the series opener against Illinois State. The junior is sporting a .600 slugging percentage and a .563 on-base percentage during the stretch.

#### **FAST STARTS**

Indiana State has been dominant to open games this season, outscoring the opposition 19-8. The Sycamores have outscored opponents in all but two innings this season including a 33-14 advantage in the ninth.

#### PRESEASON ALL-MVC

Redshirt senior Dane Giesler was tabbed Preseason All-MVC following a breakout season a year ago. The Jasper, Indiana native led the way for the Trees in several offensive categories. He finished with a team high 17 home runs which was fourth-best in the conference and second all-time in school history for single-season homers. Giesler was also fifth in the league with a .593 slugging percentage and seventh in RBIs with 49.

#### SYCAMORES PICKED THIRD IN PRESEASON POLL

Indiana State was picked to finish third in the Missouri Valley Conference Preseason Poll. Dallas Baptist tallied 63 points and were named the favorites over second-place pick Missouri State (57). The Sycamores collected 42 votes overall followed by Southern Illinois (35), Illinois State (31), Bradley (30), Evansville (18) and MVC newcomer Valparaiso (12).

#### **MVC NOTES**

#### FIVE IN RPI'S TOP-75

Five league teams continue to rank in the top-75 of the RPI, led by DBU (No. 43), Illinois State (No. 61), Missouri State (No. 64), Indiana State (No. 70) and Bradley (No. 73). Another two teams, Southern Illinois (No. 132) and Valparaiso (No. 165), also rank in the RPI's top-175.

#### VALLEY RPI RANK S NO. 9

According to the latest RPI update from WarrenNolan.com (April 16), the Missouri Valley Conference ranks No. 9 amongst 31 leagues, moving down two positions from last week. Four of the Power-Five conferences (SEC, Big 12, ACC and Pac-12) hold four of the top five positions, while the American sits fifth and Big Ten sixth.

#### WINS OVER POWER FIVE

Entering this week's action, the MVC has earned 13 wins over members of Power Five conferences. The Valley has a winning record vs. the Big 12 (6-5), while going 3-4 vs. the Pac-12, 3-11 vs. the Big Ten, 1-3 against the ACC and 0-6 vs. the SEC. Six of the eight MVC teams have earned wins against the Power Five. Bradley and Southern Illinois each have one Power Five win, while Missouri State and Valparaiso have two, Illinois State three and DBU four. This week's midweek schedule features five games against Power Five teams. On Tuesday, Indiana State will play host to Purdue, Valparaiso will face #25 Illinois, Evansville will head to #6 Vanderbilt and Missouri State will travel to #4 Arkansas. Indiana State will also travel to Purdue on Wednesday.


