OUT OF THE BOX

SYCAMORES AT A GLANCE

The Sycamores are coming off a midweek split in which the squad dropped its Tuesday matchup top Northern Illinois 5-4 before claiming a 10-6 victory at Ball State. Jarrod Watkins (.338, 11 2B, 13 RBI) and Dane Giesler (.306, 10 HR, 27 RBI) lead the Trees at the plate while CJ Huntley and Luke Fegen are hitting .302 and .265, respectively. As a team, the Sycamores are hitting .266 and have hit for 60 doubles, 10 triples and 34 home runs. The Indiana State pitching staff has struck out 254 batters and holds a combined 4.35 ERA which is third-best in the Missouri Valley Conference.

LOOKING AT LOUISVILLE

Louisville enters the weekend series 27-13 overall, 10-11 in the ACC and hold a No. 24 rank in college baseball. The Cardinals are hitting .274 on the season led by Logan Wyatt at .329 in 40 games. The Louisville pitching staff holds a 3.32 combined ERA.

ALL-TIME VS THE CARDS

Indiana State leads the all-time series with Louisville, 20-13, with the last meeting coming in 2007 when ISU fell to the Cardinals 7-3. ISU has dropped four-straight to Louisville with the last win coming in 1992 after the Trees won 10-0.

WARD EARNS MVC PITCHER OF THE WEEK AFTER DOMINANT OUTING AGAINST DBU

Tyler Ward put together a masterful performance Friday night as he pitched a complete game shutout against No. 23 Dallas Baptist. Ward allowed just six hits to the high-powered Patriots offense that entered the game with 251 runs scored in 34 games. The right-hander shut down much of the DBU lineup with just five Patriots recording base hits. Ward also ended DBU leadoff man Jameson Hannah's 46-game reached base streak and his school record 35-game hitting streak. Ward, a Santa Claus, Indiana native, improved to 6-3 on the season after striking out eight and walking just two Patriots. He also retired eight of the final nine batters he faced.

OUT OF THE BOX

HE CAN DEAL

Triston Polley has been the most dominant arm in the Sycamore rotation so far this year. In 10 starts, the Avon, Indiana product holds a 5-1 record to go along with a 3.22 ERA -- the best ERA in the MVC among starting pitchers. Polley has pitched 64.1 innings and struck out 41 batters while holding opponents to a .229 average against. On the year, the southpaw has allowed only 23 earned runs and one or fewer earned runs in five starts.

HE DOESN'T GO DOWN EASY

Jarrod Watkins leads the Sycamores at the plate this season with a .338 batting average over 37 starts. Another area the junior sits atop the team is in his strikeout numbers or lack thereof. Watkins is the toughest batter to strikeout in the Missouri Valley Conference at a 10.6 at bats per strikeout rating. In 149 total at bats, Watkins has struck out just 14 times. The mark is also 87th in the country.

SWINGING IT WELL

Redshirt senior Dane Giesler has been swinging the bat well as of late for the Sycamores. The first baseman leads the team with 10 home runs and RBI (27) and has connected on three bombs in the last two games, including two at Northern Illinois. His 10 home runs lead the MVC and rank 49th nationally.

AS A STAFF

Indiana States' pitching staff holds the third-lowest ERA in the conference at 4.34 behind Missouri State (4.03) and Bradley (4.13). Ethan Larrison holds the lowest ERA on the staff out of the bullpen with a 3.64 mark in 17 appearances. Among starting pitchers, southpaw Triston Polley has a 3.22 ERA which is the best in the MVC among qualified pitchers. The Sycamores have struck out 254 batters and walked 142 in 331 innings. RHP Tyler Ward leads the charge with 55 strikeouts. The Sycamores hold the second-lowest batting average against in the conference at a .259.

FAST STARTS

Indiana State has been dominant to open games this season, outscoring the opposition 23-9. The Sycamores have outscored opponents in all but two innings this season including a 33-14 advantage in the ninth.

WEAR IT

Sycamore outfielder Roberto Enriquez has been hit-by-pitch 20 times this season -- to rank 2nd in the nation in the category. With his 0.57 hit-by-pitches per game, he leads the country. Luke Fegen has been nine times. As a team, ISU has been hit 69 times to lead the Missouri Valley and rank 11th nationally.

SECOND IN PROGRAM HISTORY

Sycamore head coach Mitch Hannahs moved into sole possession of second place in program history Friday (4/13)

after securing his 141st career victory during a 5-2 win against Illinois State, passing former ISU head coach Paul Wolf.

RIVERS MAKES HIS RETURN TO THE MOUND

Sycamore redshirt senior Weston Rivers made his return the mound at No. 10 Indiana (4/10) for the first time since 2016. The southpaw was cleared following an injury in which he had been rehabbing for much of the season. A knuckleballer, Rivers went 2.1 innings in a scheduled staff start against the Hoosiers, allowing just a run to the third-best hitting team in the nation. Indiana State got all they could ask out of Weston Rivers at Purdue (4/18) who toed the mound for just the second time this season. He went five and two-third innings -- just one out shy of tying a career long outing that came back in 2016 against Illinois. Rivers allowed just one hit which came in the first inning on a one-out double. He went on to retire 16 of the next 17 batters he faced to finish his day, including nine-straight prior to his exit from the game. River continued his success during a midweek matchup with Ball State where he allowed just one base hit and an unearned run in five complete innings.

BACK TO THE NORM

After a tough start to the season fielding, Indiana State has slowly moved back to where they feel they belong on the defensive side of the ball. The Sycamores struggled with errors early, recorded multi-error games six times in the first 18 games of the season, including five in the series opener at Austin Peay. In the last 15 games, ISU has recorded just four errors with eight perfect fielding games during the stretch. The Sycamores' .945 fielding percent ranks third in the conference behind Illinois State and Dallas Baptist.

STRONG LAST WEEK

Junior outfielder CJ Huntley scored five runs and drove in four over the last week for the Sycamores. Huntley closed out his week with eight hits in 19 at bats for a .421 average. His .632 slugging percentage is tops on the team during the stretch. During Friday's series opening 6-0 win over No. 23 Dallas Baptist, Huntley finished a home run short of the cycle. He was perfect in the field in 15 fielding chances and finished with a .476 on-base percentage.

YOU MIGHT HAVE SEEN IT!

Former Sycamore and Oakland Athletics left-hander Sean Manaea no-hit the Boston Red Sox April 21. It marked the first ho-hitter of the 2018 MLB season and the seventh in Oakland Athletics history. Manaea is the first MVC pitcher to record a no-hitter in the MLB since Doug Stieb of SIU did so in 1990 against the Cleveland Indians as a member of the Toronto Blue Jays.

• Manaea's 10 strikeouts are the third most by an A's pitcher in a no-hitter in franchise history; Dave Stewart had 12 on June 29, 1990, and Catfish Hunter had 11 on May 8, 1968.

• Via Elias, the last two times one pitcher has no-hit the best team in baseball (by record) it was an Athletics pitcher: Dallas Braden's perfect game in 2010 against the Rays and Saturday.

• No team has been no-hit and then gone on to win the World Series that same season since the 1988 Dodgers (the Cincinnati Reds' Tom Browning threw perfect game against Los Angeles on Sept. 16, 1988).

PRESEASON ALL-MVC

Redshirt senior Dane Giesler was tabbed Preseason All-MVC following a breakout season a year ago. The Jasper, Indiana native led the way for the Trees in several offensive categories. He finished with a team high 17 home runs which was fourth-best in the conference and second all-time in school history for single-season homers. Giesler was also fifth in the league with a .593 slugging percentage and seventh in RBIs with 49.

OUT OF THE BOX

HE MIGHT LOOK FAMILIAR

Austin Conway led the Sycamores a year ago with 12 saves and the second-best ERA on the team out of the bullpen. After finishing his degree at Indiana State, Conway transferred to Louisville to begin his post-graduate degree with the Cardinals. With a year of athletic eligibility remaining Conway joined the Louisville baseball team and holds a 2-1 overall record and a 1.98 ERA in 13.2 innings this season.

SYCAMORES PICKED THIRD IN PRESEASON POLL

Indiana State was picked to finish third in the Missouri Valley Conference Preseason Poll. Dallas Baptist tallied 63 points and were named the favorites over second-place pick Missouri State (57). The Sycamores collected 42 votes overall followed by Southern Illinois (35), Illinois State (31), Bradley (30), Evansville (18) and MVC newcomer Valparaiso (12).

BROADCASTING INFORMATION

The Missouri Valley Conference announced April 9, 2018 that selected regular-season digital productions plus post-season championship coverage in May will be distributed on ESPN+ -- the first-ever multi-sport, direct-to-consumer subscription streaming service from The Walt Disney Company Direct-to-Consumer and International group in partnership with ESPN. Fans can subscribe to ESPN+ for just \$4.99 per month (or \$49.99 per year) and cancel at any time. MVC NOTES

Another Top 25 Win

Valparaiso earned its first win over a Top 25 opponent this season, beating #25 Illinois 11-7 Tuesday. The MVC has won eight games against top-25 opponents so far this season. DBU has five of those wins, beating #24 Oklahoma, #22 Sam Houston State (twice), #23 TCU and #4 Texas Tech. Missouri State and Southern Illinois also have wins over Top 25 teams, as the Bears beat #24 East Carolina and the Salukis beat #24 Illinois.

Wins Over Power Five

Entering this week's action, the MVC has earned 15 wins over members of Power Five conferences. The Valley has a winning record vs. the Big 12 (6-5), while going 3-4 vs. the Pac-12, 5-12 vs. the Big Ten, 1-3 against the ACC and 0-8 vs. the SEC.

Seven of the eight MVC teams have earned wins against the Power Five. Bradley, Indiana State and Southern Illinois each have one Power Five win, while Missouri State has two, Illinois State and Valparaiso has three and DBU four.

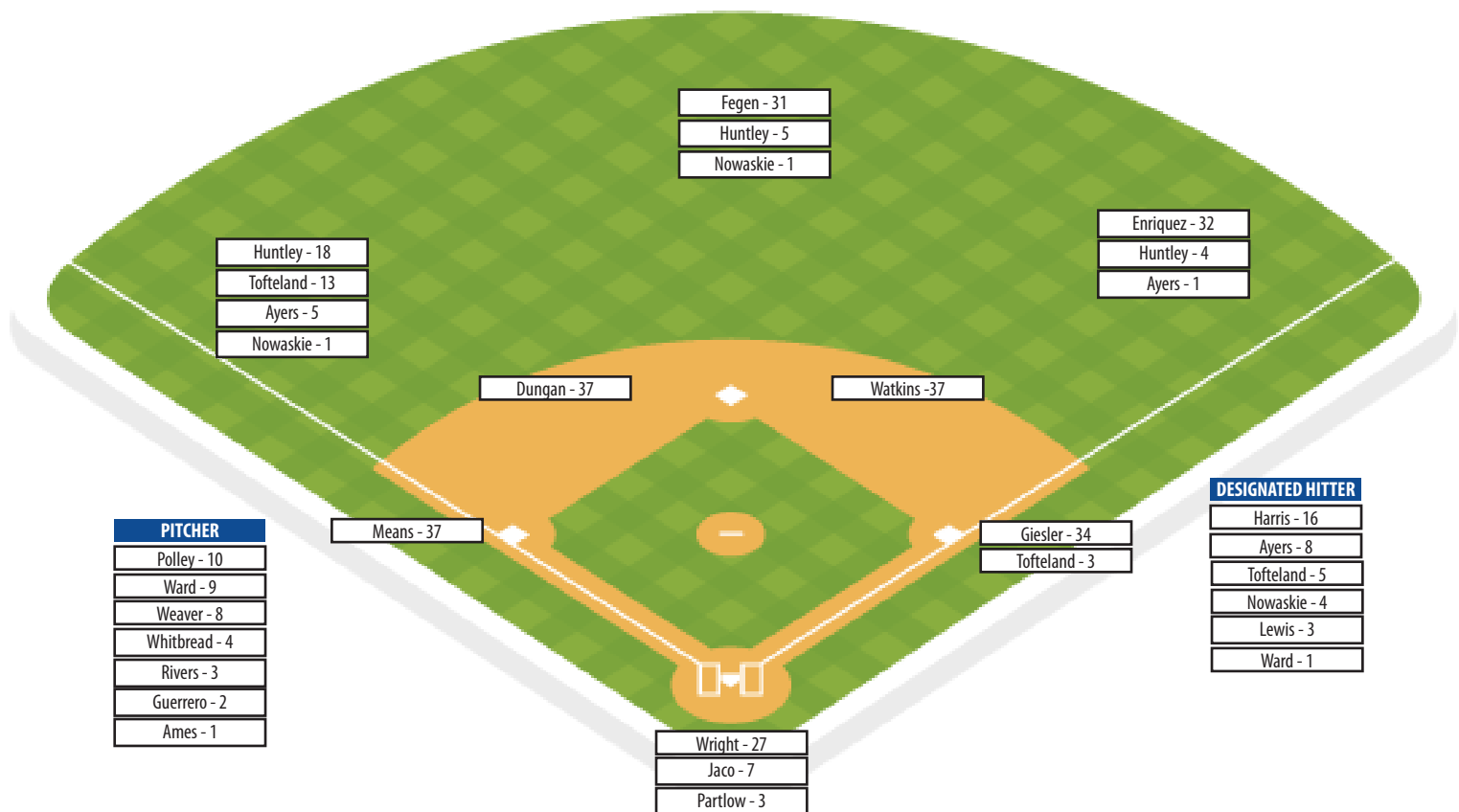
