SYCAMORES AT A GLANCE

Jarrod Watkins (.344, 10 2B, 8 RBI) and Dane Giesler (.333, 5 2B, 16 R, 19 BB, 12 RBI) lead the Trees at the plate while Luke Fegen and CJ Huntley are hitting .329 and .288, respectively. As a team, the Sycamores are hitting .273 and have hit for 43 doubles, 5 triples and 22 home runs. The Indiana State pitching staff has struck out 174 batters and holds a combined 4.12 ERA.

LOOKING AT THE BRAVES

Bradley enters the weekend 15-7 and winners of three of their last four games, including a 14-7 victory over Western Illinois Wednesday. The Braves are hitting .306 on the season led by Brendan Dougherty at .388 in 22 starts. The Bradley pitching staff holds a 4.61 combined ERA.

ALL-TIME VS BRADLEY

IRON MAN

Sophomore catcher Max Wright has been everything the Sycamores have asked this season, starting in all 23 games behind the plate, including the backend of two doubleheaders. Wright has played his role well in the batter's box with 22 hits this year for a .262 average. More than the average though has been his ability to cash in when there are runners on base. The Toronto, Ontario native has driven in 13 runs and has recorded the second-most multi-RBI games on the team with five. Wright's ability to control the run game has limited the oppositions opportunities on the base paths as well as he has thrown out six of the 12 runners trying to swipe a base.

THE FRIDAY GUY

Tyler Ward will make his fourth series-opening start of the season at Bradley. The right-hander enters the series with a 4-2 overall record and a 4.25 ERA. He has allowed just 11 extra-base hits in 42.1 innings of work while leading the Trees in strikeouts with 39. He recorded a career-high 10 strikeouts in his last outing against Missouri State,

HE CAN DEAL

Triston Polley has been the most dominant arm in the Sycamore rotation so far this year. In six starts, the Avon, Indiana product holds a 4-1 record to go along with a 2.60 ERA -- the third-best ERA in the MVC. Polley has pitched 45 innings and struck out 30 batters while holding opponents to a .217 average against. On the year, the southpaw has allowed only 13 earned runs and one or fewer earned runs in three starts.

STRONG WEEK

Jake Means led the Sycamores over the last four games with a .357 batting average and a .714 slugging percentage. Means, a Gardner, Kansas product, recorded multiple hits in two of the four games the week, including a 2-for-4 day against Missouri State when he smashed his fourth home run of the season to tie the ballgame. The junior reached base eight times, including twice on walks and hit-bypitches for a .471 on-base percentage. Means was also perfect at third base on 18 fielding chances.

Indiana State right-hander Donnie Ames was strong in relief for the Sycamores over the last week, tallying 8.2 innings out of the bullpen while notching his second win of the

season. The Terre Haute, Indiana native allowed just five base hits and two earned runs against No. 11 Indiana and Missouri State over the span, while holding the opposition to a .167 average against. Ames went 3.2 innings against the Hoosiers, allowing just one hit in the appearance before going a career long five innings against Missouri State during ISU's 6-4 victory over the Bears.

WORK HORSE

Senior Ethan Larrison has seen action in 11 games this season out of the bullpen, totaling 29 innings. Larrison enters the week with seven saves this season. In total, Larrison holds a 2.17 ERA, 30 strikeouts and a 1-0 record. His seven saves rank 13th nationally while his ERA is second in The Valley among qualified pitchers.

FAST STARTS

Indiana State has been dominant to open games this season, outscoring the opposition 19-5. The Sycamores have outscored opponents in all but one inning this season including a 29-11 advantage in the ninth.

PRESEASON ALL-MVC

Redshirt senior Dane Giesler was tabbed Preseason All-MVC following a breakout season a year ago. The Jasper, Indiana native led the way for the Trees in several offensive categories. He finished with a team high 17 home runs which was fourth-best in the conference and second all-time in school history for single-season homers. Giesler was also fifth in the league with a .593 slugging percentage and seventh in RBIs with 49.

SYCAMORES PICKED THIRD IN PRESEASON POLL

Indiana State was picked to finish third in the Missouri Valley Conference Preseason Poll. Dallas Baptist tallied 63 points and were named the favorites over second-place pick Missouri State (57). The Sycamores collected 42 votes overall followed by Southern Illinois (35), Illinois State (31), Bradley (30), Evansville (18) and MVC newcomer Valparaiso (12).

MISSOURI VALLEY CONFERENCE NOTES

FIVE IN RPI'S TOP-75

Five league teams continue to rank in the top-75 of the RPI, led by Missouri State (No. 28), Indiana State (No. 37), DBU (No. 62), Illinois State (No. 64) and Bradley (No. 71).

Another two teams, Southern Illinois (No. 125) and Valparaiso (No. 163), also rank in the RPI's top-175.

VALLEY RPI RANKS NO. 8

According to the latest RPI update from WarrenNolan.com (April 2), the Missouri Valley Conference ranks No. 8 amongst 31 leagues, moving up one position from last week. Four of the Power-Five conferences (SEC, Big 12, ACC and Pac-12) hold four of the top five positions, while the American sits fifth, the Mountain West sixth and Sun Belt seventh.

WINS OVER POWER FIVE

Entering this week's action, the MVC has earned 10 wins over members of Power Five conferences. The Valley sits 3-2 vs. the Pac-12, 4-5 vs. the Big 12, 2-8 vs. the Big Ten, 1-3 against the ACC and 0-5 vs. the SEC.

Six of the eight MVC teams have earned wins against the Power Five. Bradley, Southern Illinois and Valparaiso each have one Power Five win, while DBU and Missouri State have two and Illinois State three.

This week's schedule features two games against Power Five teams as TCU visits DBU and Missouri State battles Missouri at Busch Stadium in St. Louis on Tuesday.

CLOSE CALLS

The MVC has an 18-28 record in one run contests this season, including a 6-10 mark in extra inning contests. The MVC has fared better in two run games, boasting a 13-12 overall record. The conference sits 31-40 in games decided by two runs or fewer.

Starting Strong

With their MVC series win at Indiana State over the weekend, the Bears have now won 12 of their last 13 Valley openers and have won or split 11 of their last 13 MVC-opening series. Additionally, MSU is a combined 26-10 in its opening conference series since 2006.

TONS OF RUNS

DBU has scored 10 or more runs in four consecutive games. Starting with a season-high 21 runs on March 25 at Sam Houston State, the Patriots followed with 10 runs versus Southern University on Thursday, and totaled 12 runs and 14 runs in their two games against Xavier. It marks the most consecutive double-digit games by a Patriot offense since DBU scored 10 or more runs in six straight from April 12-20, 2012.


