OUT OF THE BOX

SYCAMORES AT A GLANCE

Indiana State enters play 26-21 on the year with an 8-10 record in Missouri Valley Conference play and winners of six of their last eight games. The Sycamores have won consecutive weekend series over Southern Illinois and Evansville with just four games remaining in the regular season — a midweek at Mizzou and a weekend series at MVC newcomer Valpo — before heading to Dallas for the MVC Championship. Dane Giesler (.303, 11 HR, 34 RBI) and Romero Harris (.319, 7 2B, 8 HR 31 RBI) anchor the lineup at the plate for the Sycamores while Jarrod Watkins (.298, 11 2B, 12 RBI) and CJ Huntley (.287, 46 H, 27 RBI) add to the middle of the batting order. As a team, Indiana State is hitting .269 and have hit for 76 doubles, 11 triples and 44 home runs. The Indiana State pitching staff has struck out 311 batters and holds a combined 4.26 ERA.

LOOKING AT MIZZOU

Missouri enter play with a 31-20 overall record and a 10-17 record in SEC action after dropping two of three games over the weekend to South Carolina. The Tigers are hitting .268 on the season led by Kameron Minser at .360 in 34 games. The MU pitching staff holds a 3.82 combined ERA.

MOVING UP THE TOP-10 HOME RUN LIST

Sycamore cleanup man Dane Giesler leads the Sycamores as well as the Missouri Valley Conference with 12 home runs this season and now has 30 in his four-year career in blue and white. With a home run over the weekend Evansville, Giesler moved into a tie for fifth place in program history. The redshirt senior needs just two more home runs to reach fourth place. The Jasper, Indiana native nearly broke the single season record a season ago with 17 home runs — good enough for second in program history.

HE DOESN'T GO DOWN EASY

Jarrod Watkins holds a .298 batting average over 47 starts. Another area the junior sits atop the team is in his strikeout numbers or lack thereof. Watkins is the toughest batter to strikeout in the Missouri Valley Conference at a 10.6 at bats per strikeout rating. In 191 at bats, Watkins has struck out just 18 times. Watkins ranks 68th nationally in the category.

WEAR IT

Junior right fielder Roberto Enriquez finished his week just 1-for-5 at the plate for a .200 batting average but he reached base six other times thanks in part to being beaned five times from Aces pitchers while also drawing a walk for a .636 on-base percentage. He took advantage of his seven base running opportunities, scoring three runs during the weekend. Currently, Enriquez has 11 more HBP's than the next Missouri Valley Conference player ahead of Matt Brown of Missouri State who has been hit 14 times. He leads the country in HBP's and HBP's per game at 0.56. As a team Indiana State ranks eighth in the nation with 87 HBP's.

WELCOME BACK TO THE LINEUP

Designated hitter Romero Harris has been a welcomed sight to the Sycamore lineup following an injury. Harris finished the week with a team-high .462 batting average, going 6-of-13 at the plate. The junior also led the squad in slugging percentage, collecting three extra-base hits in a weekend series with Evansville. Harris notched his eighth home run of the year in game one of the series. He went on to add a pair of doubles in the 14-9 series finale win for the Trees. In total, the Navarre, Ohio native scored three times and drove in three.

SOLID OUT OF THE PEN

Junior Tyler Whitbread made two appearances out of the bullpen for the Sycamores during a weekend series win against Evansville. The right-hander finished with four innings pitched, allowing just two hits and striking out a pair of Evansville batters. Whitbread held UE scoreless while on the mound and held the Aces to a .154 batting average against over the two outings. The Camlachie, Ontario product went two and two-third innings in Friday's game, allowing just one baserunner and striking out two.

YOU CAN RUN -- BUT I WOULDN'T

Sycamore catcher Max Wright is one of the best behind the plate in the MVC. The sophomore has had just 17 opponents look to swipe a base with 11 of those runners being thrown out for a .609 caught stealing percent. He is the top defensive catcher in the MVC with the next best starting catcher being challenged is Matt Duce of DBU with 22 steal attempts against.

LET IT FLY

As a squad, Indiana State has 44 total home runs which is second-best in the league. ISU has three players in the top-

10 in the Missouri Valley Conference in total home runs this season led by redshirt senior Dane Giesler leads The Valley with 12 homers while Jake Means sits third with 10 bombs. In just 22 starts this year Romero Harris is 10th with eight home runs. Giesler ranked 68th in the country in home runs.

LARRISON BACK ON TRACK

After struggling the past three weeks on the mound, senior Ethan Larrison returned to his normal self at SIU. Larrison entered in the seventh inning of game two with the bases loaded and two outs but induced the groundout to third to end the Saluki threat before sitting down Southern in order in the eighth, including two strikeouts. In total, the right-hander went 5.2 innings over the last week and allowed no runs, no hits and struck out seven batters while issuing no walks. Larrison tossed two scoreless innings in a weekend series against Evansville, striking out two Aces batters.

FAST STARTS

Indiana State has been dominant to open games this season, outscoring the opposition 25-14. The Sycamores have outscored opponents in all but two innings this season including a 45-22 advantage in the ninth. ISU is also 22-1 when leading after the eighth inning.

SECOND IN PROGRAM HISTORY

Sycamore head coach Mitch Hannahs moved into sole possession of second place in program history Friday (4/13) after securing his 141st career victory during a 5-2 win against Illinois State, passing former ISU head coach Paul Wolf.

WINNING IN TOUGH PLACES

Indiana State became just the second team in the last three season to go to Louisville and win a non-conference game against the Cardinals. Only Texas Tech and Indiana State have won games inside Jim Patterson Stadium over the last three seasons as the Cardinals are 90-16 overall and 70-2 against non-conference foes during the stretch.

YOU MIGHT HAVE SEEN IT!

Former Sycamore and Oakland Athletics left-hander Sean Manaea no-hit the Boston Red Sox April 21. It marked the first ho-hitter of the 2018 MLB season and the seventh in Oakland Athletics history. Manaea is the first MVC pitcher to record a no-hitter in the MLB since Doug Stieb of SIU did so in 1990 against the Cleveland Indians as a member of the Toronto Blue Jays.

- Manaea's 10 strikeouts are the third most by an A's pitcher in a no-hitter in franchise history; Dave Stewart had 12 on June 29, 1990, and Catfish Hunter had 11 on May 8, 1968.
- Via Elias, the last two times one pitcher has no-hit the best team in baseball (by record) it was an Athletics pitcher: Dallas Braden's perfect game in 2010 against the Rays and

Saturday.

PRESEASON ALL-MVC

Redshirt senior Dane Giesler was tabbed Preseason All-MVC following a breakout season a year ago. The Jasper, Indiana native led the way for the Trees in several offensive categories. He finished with a team high 17 home runs which was fourth-best in the conference and second all-time in school history for single-season homers. Giesler was also fifth in the league with a .593 slugging percentage and

The Sycamores collected 42 votes overall followed by Southern Illinois (35), Illinois State (31), Bradley (30), Evansville (18) and MVC newcomer Valparaiso (12).

BROADCASTING INFORMATION

The Missouri Valley Conference announced April 9, 2018 that selected regular-season digital productions plus post-season championship coverage in May will be distributed on ESPN+ -- the first-ever multi-sport, direct-to-consumer subscription streaming service from The Walt Disney Company Direct-to-Consumer and International group in partnership with ESPN. MVC NOTES

VALLEY RPI RANKS NO. 10

According to the latest RPI update from WarrenNolan.com (May 14), the Missouri Valley Conference ranks No. 10 amongst 31 leagues. Four of the Power-Five conferences (SEC, Big 12, ACC and Pac-12) hold four of the top five positions, while the American sits fourth. The Big Ten, Atlantic Sun, Sun Belt, Mountain West and MVC round out the top 10.

WINS OVER POWER FIVE

Entering this week's action, the MVC has earned 18 wins over members of Power Five conferences. The Valley has a 7-8 mark against the Big 12, while going 3-4 vs. the Pac-12, 6-13 vs. the Big Ten, 2-6 against the ACC and 0-9 vs. the SEC.

Seven of the eight MVC teams have earned wins against the Power Five. Southern Illinois has one Power Five win, while Bradley, Indiana State and Missouri State have two, Illinois State and Valparaiso three and DBU has five (Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, TCU, Texas Tech, twice).


