OUT OF THE BOX

SYCAMORES AT A GLANCE

Indiana State enters the Missouri Valley Conference Championship winners of three-straight MVC weekend series after taking two of three games against Southern Illinois and Evansville before sweeping Valpo to close out the regular season. Romero Harris (.339, 8 2B, 8 HR, 37 RBI) and Jarrod Watkins (.314, 12 2B, 18 RBI) anchor the lineup at the plate for the Sycamores. Dane Giesler leads the MVC with 14 home runs and sits ninth in The Valley with 43 RBI. As a team, Indiana State is hitting .275 and have hit for 82 doubles, 11 triples and 46 home runs. The Indiana State pitching staff has struck out 330 batters and holds a combined 4.19 ERA.

MOVING UP THE TOP-10 HOME RUN LIST

Sycamore cleanup man Dane Giesler leads the Sycamores as well as the Missouri Valley Conference with 14 home runs this season and now has 32 in his four-year career in blue and white. With a pair of home runs over the weekend at Valpo, Giesler moved into a tie for fourth place in program history. The Jasper, Indiana native nearly broke the single season record a season ago with 17 home runs — good enough for second in program history.

OPENER DAY STARTER

Junior Triston Polley will toe the rubber in game one of the MVC Championship for the Sycamores. The southpaw holds a team-best 7-2 overall record, including 3-0 record in MVC action. Polley enters play with a 3.47 ERA in 88.1 innings on the mound while striking out 54 batters. The Avon, Indiana native went six and two-third innings against Southern Illinois May 5 as Indiana State took game two of the series, 8-2. He allowed six hits and just two runs while striking out four Salukis. He has not allowed more than two runs in his last three starts and has allowed three or fewer runs in 12 of his 14 starts this season.

HE DOESN'T GO DOWN EASY

Jarrod Watkins is second on the team with a .314 batting average over 50 starts. Another area the junior sits atop the team is in his strikeout numbers or lack thereof. Watkins is the toughest batter to strikeout in the Missouri Valley Conference at a 11.1 at bats per strikeout rating. In 207 at bats, Watkins has struck out just 18 times. He sits 51st nationally in the category.

OUT OF THE BOX

STRONG CONFERENCE SLATE

Jake Means has shown his glove work all season but early struggles at the plate did not last. The junior leads the team with a .315 batting average during MVC action with 23 hits. Means has also homered six times while slugging .630 in 21 games of Valley action.

NOT TO BE OVERLOOKED

A mainstay in the lineup for the Sycamores and recently moved to the two-hole, CJ Huntley has embraced his role in the lineup. Hitting just .167 on March 16, he has seen his average climb to .305 since then. The junior has collected 53 base hits, including 11 doubles for the Sycamores and is currently tied for third on the squad with 30 RBI.

WEAR IT

Roberto Enriquez holds just a .224 batting average but the junior outfielder finds a way to reach base with 19 walks and 25 hit-by-pitches this season for a .286 on-base percentage. Enriquez ranks second in the nation in hit-by-pitches and first in HBP's per game with a 0.53 mark. He leads the MVC by nine HBP's. In a weekend series against Evansville, Enriquez was hit five times over three games. He is currently tied for third in MVC history in single season HBP's. As a team, Indiana State ranks 5th nationally with 98 HBP's.

GREAT WEEK ON THE DIAMOND

Jarrod Watkins put together one of his most complete weeks on the diamond this season over the last four games for the Sycamores. Watkins finished the week with a team-high .500 batting average, going 8-of-16 at the plate. The junior accounted for nine of the teams 37 runs on the week with six RBI and three runs scored. He also collected his team high 12th double at Mizzou. One of the best fielders on the team, Watkins assisted in all eight of the team's double plays in four games. Watkins collected multiple hits in each game at Valpo, going 3-of-3 with three RBI in game two.

WELCOME BACK TO THE LINEUP

The missing link for the Sycamores a month and a half during the regular season was Romero Harris. Harris missed time due to an injury and saw action in 27 games, but still ranks 11th in the MVC with eight home runs. The junior has reached base in all 27 games he has played and currently holds a 15-game hitting streak. He has 11 multi-hit games, including six three-hit games and has averaged more than an RBI per start with 37 so far this season in the cleanup spot.

YOU CAN RUN -- BUT I WOULDN'T

Sycamore catcher Max Wright is one of the best behind the plate in the MVC. The sophomore has had just 19 opponents look to swipe a base with 11 of those runners being thrown out. He is the top defensive catcher in the MVC with the next best starting catcher being challenged is Matt Duce of DBU

with 27 steal attempts against.

I FT IT FIY

As a squad, Indiana State has 46 total home runs which is second-best in the league. ISU has three players in the top-11 in the Missouri Valley Conference in total home runs this season led by redshirt senior Dane Giesler leads The Valley with 14 homers while Jake Means sits third with 10 bombs. In just 25 starts this year Romero Harris is 11th with eight home runs. Giesler ranked 47th in the country in home runs.

SOFT-TOSSING LEFTY

After battling injury for most of the 2018 campaign, redshirt senior Weston Rivers has been a major contributor to the Sycamore rotation in the absence of Tyler Ward. Rivers holds a team-best 2.15 ERA and a 4-0 record in seven starts. A knuckleballer on the mound, he has relied on his defense behind him and has held the opposition to a .189 average against. He has wins against Purdue, Ball State, Southern Illinois and Valpo.

CLOSING IT OUT

Junior right-hander Ethan Larrison is tied for the MVC lead with nine saves this season. Larrison has struck out 46 batters and walked just 21 in 51.2 innings while holding opponents to a .218 average against.

FAST STARTS

Indiana State has been dominant to open games this season, outscoring the opposition 30-14. The Sycamores have outscored opponents in all but two innings this season including a 46-22 advantage in the ninth. ISU is also 24-1 when leading after the eighth inning.

SECOND IN PROGRAM HISTORY

Sycamore head coach Mitch Hannahs moved into sole possession of second place in program history Friday (4/13) after securing his 141st career victory during a 5-2 win against Illinois State, passing former ISU head coach Paul Wolf.

OUT OF THE BOX

WINNING IN TOUGH PLACES

Indiana State became just the second team in the last three season to go to Louisville and win a non-conference game against the Cardinals. Only Texas Tech and Indiana State have won games inside Jim Patterson Stadium over the last three seasons as the Cardinals are 90-16 overall and 70-2 against non-conference foes during the stretch.

YOU MIGHT HAVE SEEN IT!

Former Sycamore and Oakland Athletics left-hander Sean Manaea no-hit the Boston Red Sox April 21. It marked the first ho-hitter of the 2018 MLB season and the seventh in Oakland Athletics history. Manaea is the first MVC pitcher to record a no-hitter in the MLB since Doug Stieb of SIU did so in 1990 against the Cleveland Indians as a member of the Toronto Blue Jays.

- Manaea's 10 strikeouts are the third most by an A's pitcher in a no-hitter in franchise history; Dave Stewart had 12 on June 29, 1990, and Catfish Hunter had 11 on May 8, 1968.
- Via Elias, the last two times one pitcher has no-hit the best team in baseball (by record) it was an Athletics pitcher: Dallas Braden's perfect game in 2010 against the Rays and Saturday.

PRESEASON ALL-MVC

Redshirt senior Dane Giesler was tabbed Preseason All-MVC following a breakout season a year ago. The Jasper, Indiana native led the way for the Trees in several offensive categories. He finished with a team high 17 home runs which was fourth-best in the conference and second all-time in school history for single-season homers. Giesler was also fifth in the league with a .593 slugging percentage and seventh in RBIs with 49.

SYCAMORES PICKED THIRD IN PRESEASON POLL

Indiana State was picked to finish third in the Missouri Valley Conference Preseason Poll. Dallas Baptist tallied 63 points and were named the favorites over second-place pick Missouri State (57). The Sycamores collected 42 votes overall followed by Southern Illinois (35), Illinois State (31), Bradley (30), Evansville (18) and MVC newcomer Valparaiso (12).


