OUT OF THE BOX

SETTING THE STAGE

Indiana State wraps up an eight-game road swing to start the 2019 season with a trip to Cullowhee, North Carolina for a pair of midweek games against Western Carolina Tuesday and Wednesday. Both games are slated for a 4 p.m. ET first pitch and are set to air live on ESPN+.

ALL-TIME VS WESTERN CAROLINA

Indiana State is 1-0 all time against Western Carolina with the lone meeting in the series coming in the Starkville Regional of the 1989 NCAA Tournament. The Sycamores defeated WCU 10-3 in an elimination game.

TREES OFF TO A HOT START

Indiana State closed out the second weekend of 2019 with another weekend sweep -- this time at the Hughes Brothers Challenge in which the team defeated host UNC Wilmington, Marshall and Iona. The 6-0 start to the year is the fourth-best record to open a season in program history. ISU opened the 1924 season with 11 wins, the 1958 season winning eight-straight and most recently the 1990 campaign with seven-straight wins.

18-UNDEFEATED TEAMS REMAIN

After two weeks of action, there are 18 undefeated teams in college baseball. They are: Indiana State, LSU, North Carolina, Oregon State, Arizona State, Tennessee, Virginia Tech, Illinois, Richmond, California Baptist, Georgia, Gardner-Webb, Michigan, Penn State, NC State, New Jersey Tech, Baylor and Florida State.

PITCHING STRONG FOR THE SYCAMORES

The pitching staff for the Sycamores has been outstanding through six games this season, allowing just 11 earned runs in 54 innings of work while a 1.83 team ERA ranks 10th best in the nation. Over the last three games, Indiana State recorded a pair of shutouts and has allowed just one earned run. Sophomore Jake Ridgway has not allowed a run in three appearances (7.1 innings) out of the bullpen.

SEASONED RETURNERS

Indiana State will be one of the most seasoned and veteran units in the Missouri Valley Conference in 2019, returning eight starters from the field and all three starting pitchers from a year ago. In total, the Sycamores return 22 letterwinners from a third-place team. Eight of the nine returning fielders are seniors and two of the three returning starting pitchers are four-year players. In total, the Sycamore roster bolsters 14 seniors, 16 juniors, two sophomores and a trio of freshmen.

THE OPEN ROAD

Opening weekend of the 2019 season featured an 850-mile (1,700 round trip) bus trip for the Sycamores as they

made their way to Jacksonville, Florida. It didn't get any easier for the team as week two was a trip to Wilmington, North Carolina, an 835-mile journey from Terre Haute. The Sycamores are currently on the tail end of the eight-game road swing to open the season as they take on Western Carolina for two games in the midweek, a 373-mile trip before making their way back to Terre Haute (1,756 round trip).

STRONG UP THE MIDDLE

Two of the strongest players in the lineup for Indiana State come from the middle infield in seniors Clay Dungan and Jarrod Watkins. The duo combined for 135 base hits and 21 stolen bases. Dungan started all 55 games for the Sycamores, hitting .283 to go with a .369 slugging percentage and a .355 on-base percent. He also finished as the team leader in doubles with 14. Watkins was one of four Sycamores to finish over .300 in the box with a .304 average as the leadoff man. In total, Watkins finished with 12 doubles, a pair of triples and 18 RBIs. He was named to the All-MVC Defensive team after finishing the season with a .974 fielding percentage.

BACK ON THE MOUND

On the mound, Indiana State brings back left-handers Triston Polley and Tristan Weaver to go along with right-hander Tyler Ward. The trio started 37 games a year ago and combined for 224.2 innings of action. Polley finished 2018 with a 7-2 overall record to go along with a 3.53 earned run average while Ward went 6-3 with a 3.66 ERA, striking out 55 and walking just 13 batters. Weaver struck out 41 in 66.1 innings and finished 3-5 on the year.

SYCAMORES WITH TWO ON PRESEASON ALL-MVC LIST

Two Sycamores were tabbed to the Preseason All-MVC list in seniors Triston Polley (LHP) and Jarrod Watkins (2B). Polley started a team-high 15 games for the Sycamores on the mound in 2018. He finished with a 7-2 record and a 3.53 ERA while pitching a team high 94.1 innings. The southpaw allowed just 37 earned runs and held opponents to a .233 average against. Watkins started all 55 games for the Sycamores his first year in the program in 2018. He was an immediate impact player in the middle infield, earning an MVC All-Defensive nod. He finished second on the team with a .305 batting average going for 69 hits in 226 at bats. Watkins doubled 12 times to go along with two triples while driving in 18 RBIs and scoring 35 runs.

WHITBREAD GOES CAREER LONG IN SHUTOUT VICTORY

Right-hander Tyler Whitbread made his second start of 2019 during a 10-0 shutout win over Iona during the Hughes Brothers Challenge in Wilmington, N.C. He tossed a career high eight innings while allowing just one base hit to the Gaels. Whitbread was efficient on the mound, needing just 76 pitches to retire 23 of the 25 Iona batters he faced. The Camlachie, Ontario native struck out one Iona batter

and walked one as he garnered his first win of the season. On the season, he has pitched 12 innings and allowed just seven hits while holding a 1.50 ERA.

STARTING WITH A SWEEP

Indiana State opened the 2019 season with a road sweep over Jacksonville, a 40-win team in 2018 and the No. 2 seed at the Gainesville Regional. It marked the first season-opening sweep for the Sycamores since 2010 when ISU swept Texas Southern to kick off the season. The sweep of Jacksonville also marked the first time that the Dolphins have been swept at home since 2014.

OFFENSE NO ISSUE IN FLORIDA

Indiana State bats were live to kick off the season against Jacksonville. In a three-game series, ISU collected 35 total base hits, including 10 extra-base hits. The Sycamores notched five doubles as well as five home runs against the Dolphins en route to 28 runs while holding JU to just 11. Five Sycamores wrapped up the weekend with five or more hits led by Max Wright and Roberto Enriquez who tallied six hits apiece. The duo also connected on a home run each against JU.

BEST PERFORMANCES OF OPENING WEEKEND

Max Wright led the Sycamores at the plate over opening weekend as the Sycamores picked up a series sweep at Jacksonville. The junior finished the three games with six hits and a .500 batting average (6-of-12). In total, Wright tallied five RBIs, three runs scored, a double and a home run while slugging .833. The Toronto, Ontario native also picked up a walk and a hit-by-pitch to finish with a .571 on-base percentage. Wright tallied a hit in all three games with three hits and four RBI coming Saturday against JU. Wright iced the series finale with a solo home run in the seventh inning.

One of just two sophomores on the 35-man roster, Jake Ridgway looked like a veteran over the weekend against Jacksonville. The New Lenox, Illinois product saw action twice out of the bullpen for the Sycamores, tossing 5.2 innings and allowing just one base hit while holding opponents to a .063 batting average against. Ridgway struck out four batters on the weekend. The right-hander tossed three scoreless innings in the finale en route to a save.

GRAUER NAMED TO STOPPER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

Indiana State baseball junior pitcher Tyler Grauer was one of 75 players named to the 2019 National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association's initial watch list for the Stopper of the Year award. The award is given to the top relief pitcher in NCAA Division I baseball with this being the 15th year of the award. Grauer was a standout reliever during his sophomore season, making 21 appearances for the Sycamores. He pitched 25.1 innings and finished with a 3.76 ERA. The left-

hander struck out 20 and allowed just seven walks en route to a 3-0 record. Grauer also closed out all three save situations he faced. In total, 26 conferences have representation on the list with at least two players coming from 17 different leagues. Grauer is one of three relief pitchers to be on this list representing the Missouri Valley Conference.

HE DOESN'T GO DOWN EASY

Jarrod Watkins finished 2018 with a .305 batting average over 55 starts. Another area he excelled at was his strikeout numbers or lack thereof. Watkins was the toughest to strikeout in the Missouri Valley Conference at a 12.6 at bats per strikeout rating. In 226 at bats, Watkins has struck out just 18 times. Watkins ranked 28th nationally in the category.

WEAR IT

Senior Roby Enriquez was hit-by-pitch 27 times in 2018, finishing second in the nation in the category. Enriquez averaged 0.51 HBP's per game which was tops in the country. As a team, Indiana State finished sixth nationally in hit-by-pitches with 105 total. Third baseman Jake Means was hit 14 times while Dane Giesler and Luke Fegen were hit 10 times apiece.

YOU CAN RUN -- BUT I WOULDN'T

Sycamore catcher Max Wright is one of the best behind the plate in the MVC. The sophomore has had just 22 opponents look to swipe a base with 12 of those runners being thrown out. He is the top defensive catcher in the MVC with the next best starting catcher being challenged is Matt Duce of DBU with 31 steal attempts against.

LARRISON SELECTED IN 2018 MLB DRAFT

Right-hander Ethan Larrison was selected in the 16th round (Pick: 489) of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Arizona Diamondbacks. From a walk-on to the Sycamore baseball program to a four-year letterwinner, Larrison marks the 10th Indiana State baseball player selected in the draft under head coach Mitch Hannahs. A Shelbyville, Indiana native, Larrison led the Missouri Valley Conference in saves with nine on the year. His 10 career saves, places him tied for eighth in program history. Larrison made 25 appearances out of the bullpen for ISU this season recording three wins and striking out 50 opponents. Larrison closed out the year with a 3.76 ERA over 55 innings pitched while holding opponents to a .231 batting average against.

YOU MIGHT HAVE SEEN IT!

Former Sycamore and Oakland Athletics left-hander Sean Manaea no-hit the Boston Red Sox April 21, 2018. It marked the first ho-hitter of the 2018 MLB season and the seventh in Oakland Athletics history. Manaea was the first MVC pitcher to record a no-hitter in the MLB since Doug Stieb of SIU did so in 1990 against the Cleveland Indians as a member of the Toronto Blue Jays. Manaea's 10 strikeouts are the third most by an A's pitcher in a no-hitter in franchise history; Dave Stewart had 12 on June 29, 1990, and Catfish Hunter had 11 on May 8, 1968.

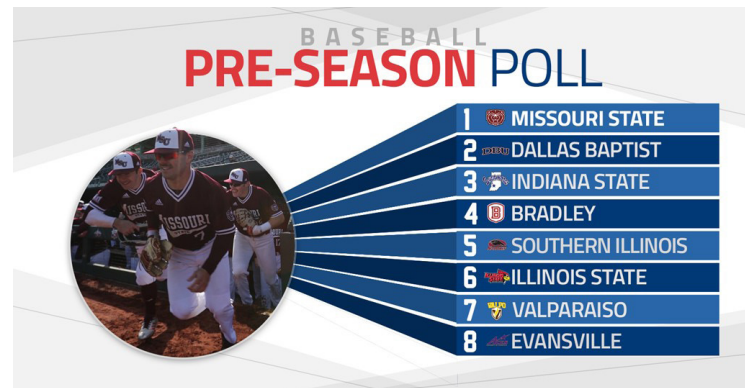

• Indiana State baseball was picked to finish third in the Missouri Valley Conference Preseason Poll. Missouri State tallied 59 points and were narrowly named the favorite over second-place pick Dallas Baptist (58 points), as the Patriots tallied two first-place votes. Indiana State (49 points) finished third with the final first place vote, while Bradley finished fourth with 39 points. Southern Illinois was selected in fifth place with 31 points, followed by Illinois State (28 points) in the sixth slot, Valparaiso (13 points) in the seventh slot and Evansville eighth (11 points).

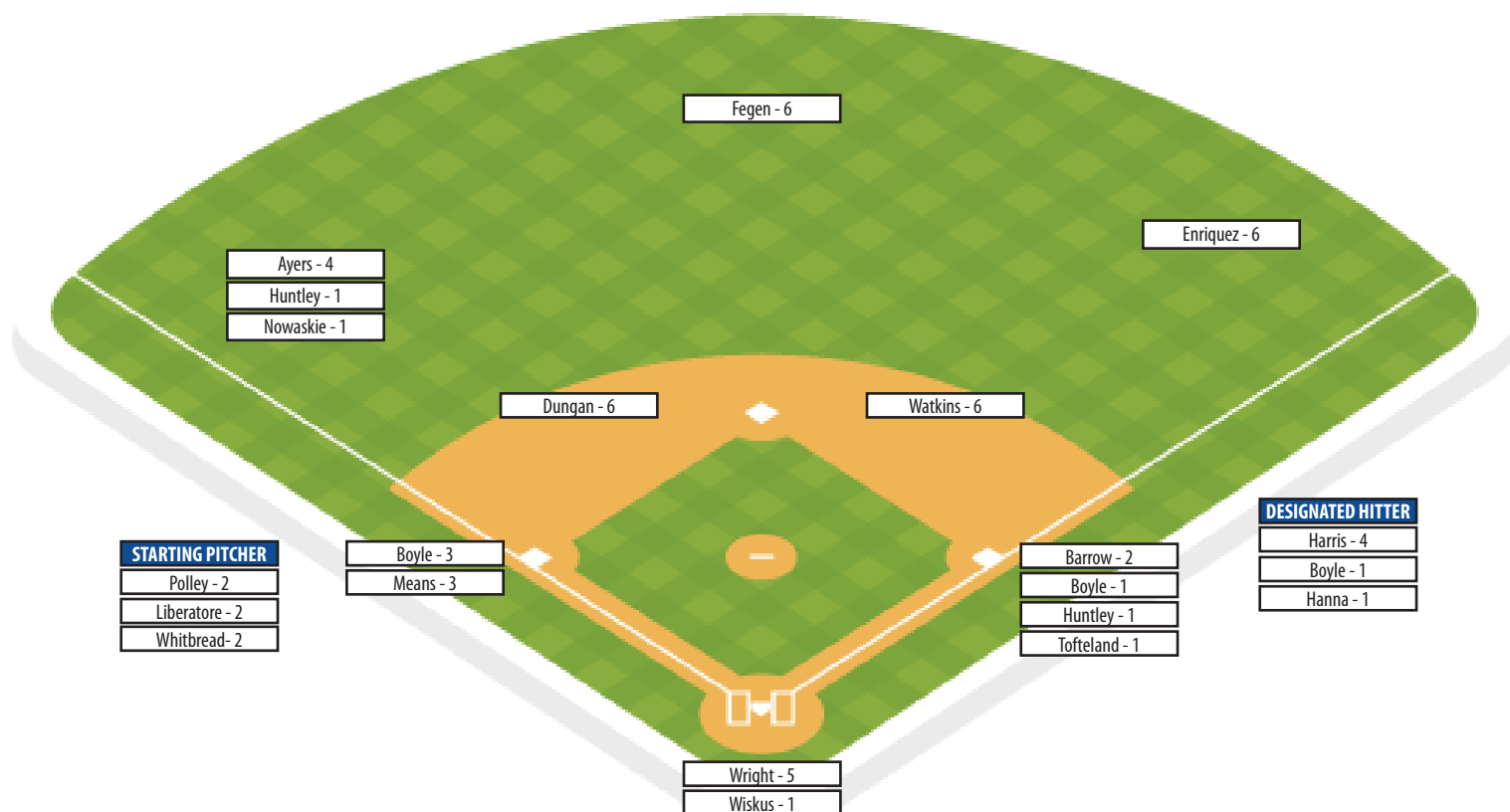
