### **'DONS & ENDS**

// A victory would put the 'Dons at 14-2, tying for the program record for best start over the first 16 games of the season. The 1992-93 team also started 14-2 and went on to a 17-2 start.

// The 'Dons have recorded double-digit steals in eight games. They have had more steals than their opponent in 11-of-15 games.

// Rasheed Bello had seven steals on Dec. 29 vs. Northern Kentucky, tying a program record in the NCAA Division I era. Some of the best individual steal performances in program history have come against Northern Kentucky. During the NCAA Division II era, Randy Spicer had eight steals against Northern Kentucky on Jan. 9, 1999.

// The 'Dons have made at least eight 3-pointers in 11-of-15 games and double digit treys in five games.

// Quinton Morton Robertson is 6th in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage at 46.7 percent (42-of-90). Maximus Nelson is shooting 42.7 percent (32-of-75) from three. Nelson doesn't appear on the national rankings as he is shy of the 2.5 made 3-pointers per game required to make the list.

// The Mastodons average 20.7 points off turnover this season, which is 24.8 percent of all points. Sparking points off turnovers, the 'Dons are 7th in the nation in turnovers forced per game at 18.13 and 7th in the nation in fastbreak points with 17.73.

// The 'Dons are ranked No. 12 in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major 25 Poll. They have been as high as No. 9 this season.

// The 'Dons are No. 88 in the latest NET rankings, the 'Dons reached a program-best No. 53 on Dec. 8, 2023.

### MORE 'DONS AND ENDS:

// Anthony Roberts has 37 steals, 8th in the nation and first in the league. His 2.47 steals ranks 19th in the nation.

// Rasheed Bello is 28th in the nation in total steals (30).

// Rasheed Bello went over the 1,000 point mark in his NCAA career on Dec. 31 vs. Detroit Mercy. His total combines his scoring at UW-Parkside and Purdue Fort Wayne.

// The 'Dons are 5-0 when Jalen Jackson leads the team in scoring.

// The 'Dons are 4-0 in league play for the first time since 2018-19 when the 'Dons opened 4-0 in Summit League play. A win on Saturday vs. Wright State would put the 'Dons at 5-0 for the first time in league play since 2010-11.

// Purdue Fort Wayne's scoring margin of 17.8 is first in the league.

// The 'Dons have had fewer turnovers than their opponent in all but two games this season (at Oakland, Dec. 2 and at Pitt, Dec. 20).

 $\ensuremath{\mathit{II}}$  The 'Dons have limited seven consecutive opponents to under 30 percent shooting from three.

// All five starters reached double-digits vs. SEMO (Dec. 9) and vs. Bethune-Cookman (Dec. 16). Additionally, six times this season four starters have reached double-digits.

// Rasheed Bello has reached double-digits in every game this season but one this season. Jalen Jackson and Anthony Roberts each have just two games without 10 points.

// The 'Dons are averaging 83.5 points per game, 31st in the nation and up from 73.9 last season.

// Purdue Fort Wayne's 10.5 steals per game this season are up from the 7.3 last year. The Division I era program high for steals per game was the 8.8 mark in 2021-22.

// Four Mastodons are averaging better than 12.0 points per game: Rasheed Bello (14.5), Anthony Roberts (14.0), Jalen Jackson (14.5) and Quinton Morton-Robertson (12.3).

// The Mastodons' 5-0 start was their longest undefeated stretch to start a season as a NCAA Division I program. It was their longest stretch to start a season since the 1992-93 team opened 9-0. That team earned a bid in the NCAA Division II Tournament, the only NCAA bid (Division I or II) in program history.

// Thanks to the 5-0 start to the season, the 'Dons now have now had a winning streak of at-least four games in every season since 2009-10 except for one (2017-18). That is 14-of-15 seasons.

// The 'Dons have won 20 straight home non-league games, a streak that started on Nov. 16, 2019 vs. Stetson.

// Thanks to wins over Northern Arizona (Nov. 17) and South Dakota (Nov. 18), the 'Dons won the Arizona Tip-Off. Quinton Morton-Robertson was named the MVP of the event and selected to the All-Tournament Team with Rasheed Bello.

// The 'Dons have partnered with Team IMPACT to add Bolton Richardson to the squad in 2023-24. Added to the team at a signing ceremony in July, Bolton will be at games, practices and other team activities.

### **HOW ABOUT THESE 'DONS?:**

// The new look 'Dons have 18.4 percent of scoring back from last year and 14.8 percent of minutes played from last season.

// Only two players (Quinton Morton-Robertson and Johnathan DeJurnett) were on the Mastodon roster two years ago in 2021-22.

// The 2023-24 roster features student-athletes from Indiana, Illinois, Virginia, Wisconsin, Tennessee, Georgia, Iowa and the Bahamas.

### JALEN JACKSON...:

// ... his field goal percentage (51.8 percent vs. 42.4 percent), 3-point field goal percentage (41.2 percent vs. 31.8 percent) and rebounds per game (4.0 per game vs. 1.5) are each up this season compared to his freshman campaign at UIC last year.

// ... has recorded nine or more points in every game this season.

### **QUINTON MORTON-ROBERTSON...:**

// ... is averaging 12.3 points per game, up from 7.3 last season.

// ... is averaging 2.6 assists per game, up from 1.5

// ... has made five 3-pointers in a game three times this season.

// ... was named the Arizona Tip-off MVP.

// ... was selected as the Horizon League Player of the Week (Nov. 20).

### **ANTHONY ROBERTS...:**

// ... has 37 steals this season, after 29 last year.

// ... is averaging 14.0 points per game, up from 7.3 last year.

// ... is recording 5.6 rebounds, up from 2.3 last year.

// ... has two double-doubles this season.

### // MAXIMUS NELSON...:

 ${\it II}$  ... 75-of-86 field goal attempts this season have been from beyond the arc.

// ... is averaging 7.4 points per game, up from 4.6 per game at Valparaiso last season.

// ... is shooting 42.7 percent from three, up from 34.2 percent last season.

### // RASHEED BELLO...:

// ... put together a line of 13 points, 8 assists, 7 steals, 3 rebounds and 2 blocks vs. Northern Kentucky (Dec. 29).

// ... has scored in double-digits in all but one game this season.

// ... was selected as the Horizon League Player of the Week (Nov. 13) after helping the 'Dons to a 3-0 start to the season including a win over DePaul.

// ... was named to the Arizona Tip-off All-Tournament Team.

// ... was the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Player of the Year at NCAA Division II UW-Parkside in 2022-23 and the Freshman of the Year in 2021-22. In 2022-23 he averaged 17.9 points, 5.1 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 2.5 steals per game to lead the Rangers to a NCAA Tournament appearance.

### // ERIC MULDER...:

// ... is scoring 6.7 points per game, up from 4.6 last season.

// ... is shooting 75.0 percent from the floor, up from 65.4 last year.

// ... is averaging 7.0 rebounds, up from 2.2 last season.

// ... has 11 blocks, after having nine last season.

### // COREY HADNOT II...:

// ... has earned four Horizon League Freshman of the Week honors this season.

// ... recorded a season-high five assists at Oakland (Dec. 2).

// ... had a career-high 15 points vs. Detroit Mercy (Dec. 31).

### // JONATHAN DEJURNETT...:

// ... is averaging a career-best 10.5 minutes per game.

## NOTES ON INDIVIDUAL GAMES: VS. DETROIT MERCY

// Purdue Fort Wayne led all scorers with 19 points and 10 rebounds, for a career high in scoring and his first career double-double.

// The 'Dons held the Titans to 17.6 percent from three (3-of-17), four points off turnovers and two fast break points.

// The 'Dons forced 24 turnovers while committing only seven.

### **VS. NORTHERN KENTUCKY**

// The 'Dons connected on 14 3-pointers.

// Purdue Fort Wayne erased an 11-point first half deficit.

### AT PITT

// The Panthers were held to 2-of-20 from three and as of that date a season-low 62 points.

// Rasheed Bello had 11 points, four assists and a block (not with a shoe).

### **VS. BETHUNE-COOKMAN**

// The 'Dons had a 15:8 assist/turnover ratio, aided by 13 steals.

// Anthony Roberts finished with five steals, along with 15 points, seven rebounds and five assists.

// The 'Dons held the Wildcats to just one 3-pointer in the second half (1-6) and 23.1 percent (3-13) from deep in the game.

// The 'Dons limited Bethune-Cookman to six field goals in the second half. The last time the 'Dons limited a team to six or fewer field goals came in February 2020 when they limited Denver to six in the first half Feb. 8 at Denver and Feb. 26 at home.

// Bethune-Cookman had only two fast break points.

### VS. SEMO

// Purdue Fort Wayne shot 53.8 percent (28-of-52) from the floor and 50 percent (7-of-14) from deep.

// The 'Dons shot 68.2 percent (15-of-22) from the floor and 80 percent (4-of-5) from deep in the second half

// Purdue Fort Wayne finished 26-of-41 from the free throw line. The last time the 'Dons took 40 free throws in a game was Nov. 11, 2016 at Arkansas.

// The 'Dons scored 26 points off of free throws. Both Anthony Roberts and Quinton Morton-Robertson had career-high seven free throws.

// Purdue Fort Wayne scored 47.2 percent of points (42-of-89) in the paint.

### AT SOUTHERN INDIANA

// The 'Dons scored 40 percent of points (28-of-70) in the paint.

// The 'Dons out-scored the Screaming Eagles 36-23 in the second half, after finishing the first half tied at 34.

// The 'Dons overcame their largest deficit this season, 12, in the win.

// Rasheed Bello blocked a shot with his shoe. The highlight made SportsCenter and was shared by the NCAA, CNN and Sports Illustrated.

// Quinton Morton-Robertson grabbed a career-high seven rebounds.

### AT OAKLAND:

// The 'Dons shot 66.7 percent (38-of-57) from the floor. It was the third-best shooting percentage in their DI era and the second-best against a DI opponent. Their 68.2 percent performance against Centenary on Feb. 18, 2003 is the only better performance against a DI foe in program history.

// The 'Dons shot 17-of-26 from range (65.4 percent) from three, the best ever percentage in Division I era program history when taking 20 or more attempts.

// The 'Dons had 24 assists, their most against a DI opponent since recording 24 at Eastern Illinois on Nov. 28, 2018.

// Eight Mastodons shot 50 percent or better in the game with Jalen Jackson making 7-of-7 from the floor.

// 13-of-21 field goals in the second half were either a 3-pointer or a dunk. The 'Dons shot 72.4 percent (21-of-29) in the second half and 7-of-10 from three.

// Quinton Morton-Robertson's five 3-pointers was a career-high against a Division I program.

### **VS. GREEN BAY:**

// The 'Dons limited the Phoenix to four second chance points, two fast break points and four points off turnovers.

// 40 percent of points (30-of-75) came in the paint.

// Maximus Nelson was one short of his career high in points with 17 points while making 5-of-8 from three.

### **VS. WITTENBERG:**

// The 'Dons shot 58.6 percent (38-of-65) from the floor.

### AT SAN FRANCISCO:

// The 'Dons scored 28 points in the paint for 46.7 percent (26-of-60) of their points.

// It was a five-point deficit for the 'Dons with less than 10 minutes left in the game.

### VS. SOUTH DAKOTA:

// The 'Dons shot 40 percent (14-of-35) from three, making 14 3-pointers.

// The 'Dons had a 16:6 assist/turnover ratio, aided by nine steals.

// The 'Dons trailed 41-36 at half.

### **VS. NORTHERN ARIZONA:**

// The 'Dons closed the game on a 20-5 run to rally back and earn the win.

// The 'Dons recorded 14 steals.

// Quinton Morton-Robertson finished with a career-high 27 points.

// Anthony Roberts picked up his second double-double of the season with 13 points and 10 rebounds.

### **VS. TEXAS A&M-COMMERCE:**

//The 'Dons forced 17 turnovers while committing only six. They turned these 17 turnovers into 26 points.

// Purdue Fort Wayne limited the Lions to 17.4 percent from three (4-of-23).

// The 'Dons had 44 points in the paint, for 51 percent of their scoring (44-of-86).

### **VS. ANDREWS:**

// Purdue Fort Wayne's 96-point win was the largest margin of victory in program history. It tops the 80-point margin the 'Dons won by on Nov. 14, 2022 against Manchester (111-31).

// The 'Dons set program records in points (130), field goals (53) and steals (23).

// Purdue Fort Wayne had a school-record eight finish in double-figures: Jalen Jackson (21), Bello (17), Roberts (17), Maximus Nelson (15), Hadnot II (12), Johnathan DeJurnett (12), Eric Mulder (10), and Khoi Thurmon (10).

// The 'Dons finished with 30 assists, the first time they had 30 assists in a game since 35 vs. Olivet on Jan. 9, 2017.

// With only four turnovers, held a 30-4 assist-turnover ratio.

// Quinton Morton-Robertson had nine assists and zero turnovers.

### AT DEPAUL:

// It was the Mastodons' first ever win over a Big East opponent.

// Four of five starters finished in double-digits: Quinton Morton-Robertson (24), Rasheed Bello (15), Jalen Jackson (13) and Anthony Roberts (13).

// The 'Dons shot 50 percent from three (9-of-18) and 44.4 percent from the field (28-of-63).

// Purdue Fort Wayne won the turnover battle 22-10 and held a 12-4 edge in steals.

// The 'Dons led for 29:51 minutes.

### **SHOE BLOCK**

His shoe came off when playing defense in the second half and as he carried around his shoe he defended a shot attempt and blocked the shot... with his shoe. 

### **WHY MASTODONS?**

It all started about 10,000 years ago ...

That's when mastodons roamed the southern Great Lakes region of North America. These stocky versions of modern elephants reached heights of about ten feet at the shoulder, with tusks that curved upward that were six feet or more in length. Mastodons were browsers who fed mostly on leaves and twigs from small trees and shrubs.

One such mastodon found its final resting place about two miles south of Angola, Indiana, on land that would eventually become part of Orsie Routsong's farm. In the fall of 1968, Routsong decided to expand a small pond on his property. An excavator was hired and instructed to pile the excavated material around the edge of the pond. Several days after the excavation was finished a heavy rain storm pounded the piles of dirt.

The next day, a young neighbor boy of Routsong's discovered a large bone in one of the dirt piles. Routsong knew it was something out of the ordinary, so he called Jack Sunderman, chair of the IPFW Geology Department, to identify the bone, and to ask for advice on what to do with it. Sunderman says his first question was, "How big is the bone," with Routsong's answer being "pretty big, maybe 3 or 4 feet long."

When Sunderman got to the farm, he identified the bone as a leg bone of a mastodon. He told Routsong a skeleton like this would have scientific and instructional value if a large portion of it could be located. Routsong agreed, and also agreed to have the IPFW Geology Department do the excavation. Sunderman got two more faculty members, Geoffrey Matthews and Bernd Erdtmann, and several geology students to help in the project.

After all the mastodon bones were collected, cleaned, and preserved, Routsong agreed to have the adult mastodon skeleton placed on permanent display at IPFW;

the skull of a nearby baby mastodon is now on loan to Science Central.

In the spring of 1970, The Communicator (IPFW's student newspaper) began a drive to come up with a mascot for IPFW. Some of the suggested choices included the Boiler-Hoosiers, Warhawks, Marauders, Frontiersmen, Pioneers, Elfs, and Hobbits. Those names and others came from student suggestions. Steve Pettyjohn, who served as the student body president in 1968-69, wrote a letter to the editor about the school mascot. In his letter, Pettyjohn extolled the virtues of choosing the mastodon as IPFW's mascot: "It sounds different, strange - that's exactly why. It's different and yes, even strange. For God's Sakes, let's have the courage to be a little different."

In the meantime, former Indiana Congressman Mark Souder, who served as student body president in 1969-70, recalls being lobbied by the Geology Club to choose the mastodon.

According to Nusbaumer, "Souder appointed a committee in student government to select a name although he was lobbying hard for the mastodon." After some discussion on the subject, Souder says a vote was taken by the committee and the mastodon came out the winner. Souder finished his recollection with these thoughts. "History shows that the advocacy of the geology club was correct. The fast, decisive action of the elected student government—though it did not please everyone and was not a precedent that the University desired to see—has also been upheld by history as Purdue Fort Wayne regularly scores high in any list of unique university nicknames; even in this era when everybody strives to be different. We did it decades ago."

John Konchar dominated these game notes from 2015-19. He is now a member of the Memphis Grizzlies. Let's look back on some of his collegiate accomplishments.
