'DONS & ENDS

// Rasheed Bello was named to the CollegeInsider.com Lou Henson Award Mid-Season Watch List on Jan. 10. The award at the end of the season recognizes the best mid-major player in the nation.

// The 'Dons have recorded double-digit steals in 11 games. They have had more steals than their opponent in 17-of-22 games and each of the last five games.

// The 'Dons have made at least eight 3-pointers in 17-of-22 games and double digit treys in seven games.

// The 'Dons have double-digit offensive rebounds in nine games.

// Quinton Morton-Robertson is 30th in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage at 41.3 percent (64-of-155).

// Three times this season the 'Dons have committed six or fewer turnovers in a game.

// Anthony Roberts has 46 steals, 25th in the nation and first in the league. His 2.09 steals per game ranks 39th in the nation.

// Rasheed Bello is 34th in the nation in total steals (44). His 2.00 steals per game is 50th.

// Rasheed Bello went over the 1,000 point mark in his NCAA career on Dec. 31 vs. Detroit Mercy. His 1,000 plus total combines his scoring at UW-Parkside and Purdue Fort Wayne. He has 1,131 total points with 791 coming at UW-Parkside.

// Purdue Fort Wayne's scoring margin of 10.8 is first in the league and 41st in the nation.

// The 'Dons have had fewer turnovers than their opponent in all but three games this season.

// All five starters reached double-digits vs. SEMO (Dec. 9) and vs. Bethune-Cookman (Dec. 16). Additionally, the 'Dons are 8-2 when four or all five starters reach double-digits.

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MORE 'DONS AND ENDS:

// Rasheed Bello has reached double-digits in every game this season but two this season.

// The 'Dons are averaging 81.8 points per game, 29th in the nation and up from 73.9 last season.

// Purdue Fort Wayne's 10.0 steals per game this season, 9th in the nation, are up from the 7.3 last year. The Division I era program high for steals per game was the 8.8 mark in 2021-22.

// Four Mastodons are averaging better than 13.0 points per game: Rasheed Bello (15.5), Anthony Roberts (13.1), Jalen Jackson (15.3) and Quinton Morton-Robertson (13.6).

// The Mastodons' 5-0 start was their longest undefeated stretch to start a season as a NCAA Division I program. It was their longest stretch to start a season since the 1992-93 team opened 9-0. That team earned a bid in the NCAA Division II Tournament, the only NCAA bid (Division I or II) in program history.

// Thanks to the 5-0 start to the season, the 'Dons now have now had a winning streak of at-least four games in every season since 2009-10 except for one (2017-18). That is 14-of-15 seasons.

// The 'Dons have won 20 straight home non-league games, a streak that started on Nov. 16, 2019 vs. Stetson.

// The 'Dons have partnered with Team IMPACT to add Bolton Richardson to the squad in 2023-24. Added to the team at a signing ceremony in July, Bolton will be at games, practices and other team activities.

HOW ABOUT THESE 'DONS?:

// The new look 'Dons have 18.4 percent of scoring back from last year and 14.8 percent of minutes played from last season.

// Only two players (Quinton Morton-Robertson and Johnathan DeJurnett) were on the Mastodon roster two years ago in 2021-22.

// The 2023-24 roster features student-athletes from Indiana, Illinois, Virginia, Wisconsin, Tennessee, Georgia, Iowa and the Bahamas.

IN LEAGUE PLAY ONLY THE 'DONS ARE...:

// ... making 10.0 3-pointers per game, one of two teams in the league making 10 or more. Behind Green Bay, with 10.9.

// ... shooting 36.9 percent from three, 3rd in the league.

// ... 1st in turnover margin (5.82).

// ... 4th in the league in scoring at 80.3 points per game.

IN LEAGUE PLAY ONLY, INDIVIDUALLY...:

// ... Quinton Morton-Robertson is 2nd in the league in 3-pointers per game (3.4) and 4th in 3-point field goal percentage (40.5 percent).

// ... Rasheed Bello is 1st (2.3) in steals per game.

// ... Eric Mulder is 3rd in rebounds per game (8.0).

// ... Rasheed Bello is 3rd in assists (4.7).

JALEN JACKSON...:

// ... his field goal percentage (50.5 percent vs. 42.4 percent), 3-point field goal percentage (44.6 percent vs. 31.8 percent) and rebounds per game (4.5 per game vs. 1.5) are each up this season compared to his freshman campaign at UIC last year.

// ... 20-point games this season: 3.

QUINTON MORTON-ROBERTSON...:

// ... owns 689 career points, 501 in a Purdue Fort Wayne uniform.

// ... has 64 3-pointers on the season. He will reach top 10 in program history for a single-season if he gets to 74.

// ... 20-point games this season: 5.

// ... is averaging 13.6 points per game, up from 7.3 last season.

// ... is averaging 2.27 assists per game, up from 1.5

// ... has made five 3-pointers in a game four times this season.

// ... was named the Arizona Tip-off MVP.

// ... was selected as the Horizon League Player of the Week (Nov. 20).

ANTHONY ROBERTS...:

// ... is sneaking up on 2,000 career points. He owns 1,833 NCAA career points with 521 as a Mastodon.

// ... 20-point games this season: 1.

// ... has 46 steals this season, after 29 last year.

// ... is averaging 13.1 points per game, up from 7.3 last year.

// ... is recording 5.7 rebounds, up from 2.3 last year.

// ... has two double-doubles this season.

// MAXIMUS NELSON...:

// ... 114-of-128 field goal attempts this season have been 3-point attempts.

// ... is averaging 7.0 points per game, up from 4.6 per game at Valparaiso last season.

// ... is shooting 39.5 percent from three, up from 34.2 percent last season.

// RASHEED BELLO...:

// ... 20-point games this season: 4.

// ... put together a line of 13 points, 8 assists, 7 steals, 3 rebounds and 2 blocks vs. Northern Kentucky (Dec. 29). His steal total tied the program Division I era record for steals in a game. Some of the best individual steal performances in program history have come against Northern Kentucky. During the NCAA Division II era, Randy Spicer had eight steals against Northern Kentucky on Jan. 9, 1999.

// ... has scored in double-digits in all but two games this season.

// ... was selected as the Horizon League Player of the Week (Nov. 13) after helping the 'Dons to a 3-0 start to the season including a win over DePaul.

// ... was named to the Arizona Tip-off All-Tournament Team.

// ... was the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Player of the Year at NCAA Division II UW-Parkside in 2022-23 and the Freshman of the Year in 2021-22. In 2022-23 he averaged 17.9 points, 5.1 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 2.5 steals per game to lead the Rangers to a NCAA Tournament appearance.

// ERIC MULDER...:

// ... is scoring 6.0 points per game, up from 4.6 last season.

// ... is shooting 74.7 percent from the floor, up from 65.4 last year.

// ... is averaging 7.1 rebounds, up from 2.2 last season.

// ... has 19 blocks, after having nine last season.

// COREY HADNOT II...:

// ... has earned five Horizon League Freshman of the Week honors this season.

// ... recorded a season-high five assists at Oakland (Dec. 2).

// ... had a career-high 15 points vs. Detroit Mercy (Dec. 31).

// JONATHAN DEJURNETT...:

// ... is averaging a career-best 9.4 minutes per game.

// Tied a season high with 14 offensive rebounds.

// Eric Mulder had a career-high four blocks.

// Broke a streak of eight straight games shooting 40 percent or better.

AT NORTHERN KENTUCKY

// Jalen Jackson led the 'Dons with 17 points with nine rebounds, shooting 70 percent from the floor (7-of-10) and 75 percent from deep (3-of-4).

// The 'Dons held the Norse to 16.7 percent from deep (3-of-18).

AT CLEVELAND STATE

// Rasheed Bello totaled 20 points, six assists and four rebounds.

// Anthony Roberts had 16 points and six rebounds.

// Rasheed Bello and Anthony Roberts scored 52.9 percent of points for the 'Dons.

VS. IUPUI

// The 'Dons scored 42 of their 79 points from the paint, 53 percent.

// Eric Mulder had a career-high 12 rebounds.

AT ROBERT MORRIS

// Quinton Morton-Robertson tied a program record with 15 3-point attempts, he finished 6-of-15.

// The 'Dons forced 25 turnovers, and lost for just the second time under Jon Coffman with forcing 20 or more turnovers.

AT YOUNGSTOWN STATE

// Fell behind by 27 points in the second half only to cut it to a three-point deficit with just over two minutes left in the game.

// Rasheed Bello finished 11-of-14 from the free throw line and finished with 25 points.

VS. WRIGHT STATE

// The 'Dons had three players score 20+ points, Quinton Morton-Robertson (26), Jalen Jackson (24) and Rasheed Bello (23). The last time the 'Dons had three players score 20 plus was Jan. 3, 2019 vs. South Dakota State (Kason Harrell (23), John Konchar (23), Matt Holba (20)).

// The Mastodons scored 44 of their 98 points in the paint, 44.9 percent.

// The 'Dons shot 54.0 percent from the floor. The 'Dons are now 45-4 under Coffman when shooting 54.0 percent or better in a game.

VS. DETROIT MERCY

// Eric Mulder led all scorers with 19 points and 10 rebounds, for a career high in scoring and his first career double-double.

// The 'Dons held the Titans to 17.6 percent from three (3-of-17), four points off turnovers and two fast break points.

// The 'Dons forced 24 turnovers while committing only seven.

VS. NORTHERN KENTUCKY

// The 'Dons connected on 14 3-pointers.

// Purdue Fort Wayne erased an 11-point first half deficit.

AT PITT

// The Panthers were held to 2-of-20 from three and as of that date a season-low 62 points.

// Rasheed Bello had 11 points, four assists and a block (not with a shoe).

VS. BETHUNE-COOKMAN

// The 'Dons had a 15:8 assist/turnover ratio, aided by 13 steals.

// The 'Dons held the Wildcats to just one 3-pointer in the second half (1-6) and 23.1 percent (3-13) from deep in the game.

// The 'Dons limited Bethune-Cookman to six field goals in the second half. The last time the 'Dons limited a team to six or fewer field goals came in February 2020 when they limited Denver to six in the first half Feb. 8 at Denver and Feb. 26 at home.

// Bethune-Cookman had only two fast break points.

VS. SEMO

// Purdue Fort Wayne shot 53.8 percent (28-of-52) from the floor and 50 percent (7-of-14) from deep.

// The 'Dons shot 68.2 percent (15-of-22) from the floor and 80 percent (4-of-5) from deep in the second half

// Purdue Fort Wayne finished 26-of-41 from the free throw line. The last time the 'Dons took 40 free throws in a game was Nov. 11, 2016 at Arkansas.

AT SOUTHERN INDIANA

// The 'Dons scored 40 percent of points (28-of-70) in the paint.

// The 'Dons out-scored the Screaming Eagles 36-23 in the second half, after finishing the first half tied at 34.

// The 'Dons overcame their largest deficit this season, 12, in the win.

// Rasheed Bello blocked a shot with his shoe. The highlight made SportsCenter and was shared by the NCAA, CNN and Sports Illustrated.

AT OAKLAND:

// The 'Dons shot 66.7 percent (38-of-57) from the floor. It was the third-best shooting percentage in their DI era and the second-best against a DI opponent. Their 68.2 percent performance against Centenary on Feb. 18, 2003 is the only better performance against a DI foe in program history.

// The 'Dons shot 17-of-26 from range (65.4 percent) from three, the best ever percentage in Division I era program history when taking 20 or more attempts.

// The 'Dons had 24 assists, their most against a DI opponent since recording 24 at Eastern Illinois on Nov. 28, 2018.

// Eight Mastodons shot 50 percent or better in the game with Jalen Jackson making 7-of-7 from the floor.

// 13-of-21 field goals in the second half were either a 3-pointer or a dunk. The 'Dons shot 72.4 percent (21-of-29) in the second half and 7-of-10 from three.

VS. GREEN BAY:

// The 'Dons limited the Phoenix to four second chance points, two fast break points and four points off turnovers.

// Maximus Nelson was one short of his career high in points with 17 points while making 5-of-8 from three.

VS. WITTENBERG:

// The 'Dons shot 58.6 percent (38-of-65) from the floor.

AT SAN FRANCISCO:

// The 'Dons scored 28 points in the paint for 46.7 percent (26-of-60) of their points.

// It was a five-point deficit for the 'Dons with less than 10 minutes left in the game.

VS. SOUTH DAKOTA:

// The 'Dons shot 40 percent (14-of-35) from three, making 14 3-pointers.

// The 'Dons had a 16:6 assist/turnover ratio, aided by nine steals.

// The 'Dons trailed 41-36 at half.

VS. NORTHERN ARIZONA:

// The 'Dons closed the game on a 20-5 run to rally back and earn the win.

// The 'Dons recorded 14 steals.

// Quinton Morton-Robertson finished with a career-high 27 points.

// Anthony Roberts picked up his second double-double of the season with 13 points and 10 rebounds.

VS. TEXAS A&M-COMMERCE:

// The 'Dons forced 17 turnovers while committing only six. They turned these 17 turnovers into 26 points.

// Purdue Fort Wayne limited the Lions to 17.4 percent from three (4-of-23).

// The 'Dons had 44 points in the paint, for 51 percent of their scoring (44-of-86).

VS. ANDREWS:

// Purdue Fort Wayne's 96-point win was the largest margin of victory in program history. It tops the 80-point margin the 'Dons won by on Nov. 14, 2022 against Manchester (111-31).

// The 'Dons set program records in points (130), field goals (53) and steals (23).

// Purdue Fort Wayne had a school-record eight finish in double-figures: Jalen Jackson (21), Bello (17), Roberts (17), Maximus Nelson (15), Hadnot II (12), Johnathan DeJurnett (12), Eric Mulder (10), and Khoi Thurmon (10).

// The 'Dons finished with 30 assists, the first time they had 30 assists in a game since 35 vs. Olivet on Jan. 9, 2017.

// With only four turnovers, held a 30-4 assist-turnover ratio.

AT DEPAUL:

// It was the Mastodons' first ever win over a Big East opponent.

// Four of five starters finished in double-digits: Quinton Morton-Robertson (24), Rasheed Bello (15), Jalen Jackson (13) and Anthony Roberts (13).

// The 'Dons shot 50 percent from three (9-of-18) and 44.4 percent from the field (28-of-63).

// Purdue Fort Wayne won the turnover battle 22-10 and held a 12-4 edge in steals.

// The 'Dons led for 29:51 minutes.

// Freshman Corey Hadnot II recorded nine points and three assists in 29 minutes off the bench in his first collegiate game. He became the first Mastodon true freshman to score nine or more points in their first career game against a Division I opponent since Mo Evans scored 12 points against Dayton (2013).

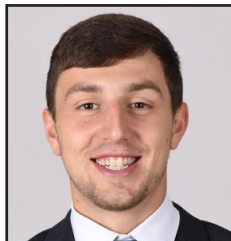

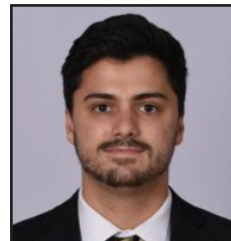

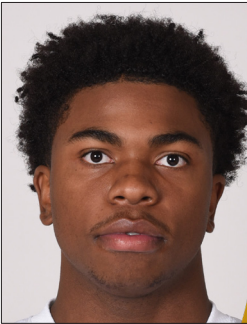

WHY MASTODONS?

It all started about 10,000 years ago ...

That's when mastodons roamed the southern Great Lakes region of North America. These stocky versions of modern elephants reached heights of about ten feet at the shoulder, with tusks that curved upward that were six feet or more in length. Mastodons were browsers who fed mostly on leaves and twigs from small trees and shrubs.

One such mastodon found its final resting place about two miles south of Angola, Indiana, on land that would eventually become part of Orsie Routsong's farm. In the fall of 1968, Routsong decided to expand a small pond on his property. An excavator was hired and instructed to pile the excavated material around the edge of the pond. Several days after the excavation was finished a heavy rain storm pounded the piles of dirt.

The next day, a young neighbor boy of Routsong's discovered a large bone in one of the dirt piles. Routsong knew it was something out of the ordinary, so he called Jack Sunderman, chair of the IPFW Geology Department, to identify the bone, and to ask for advice on what to do with it. Sunderman says his first question was, "How big is the bone?" with Routsong's answer being "pretty big, maybe 3 or 4 feet long."

When Sunderman got to the farm, he identified the bone as a leg bone of a mastodon. He told Routsong a skeleton like this would have scientific and instructional value if a large portion of it could be located. Routsong agreed, and also agreed to have the IPFW Geology Department do the excavation. Sunderman got two more faculty members, Geoffrey Matthews and Bernd Erdtmann, and several geology students to help in the project.

After all the mastodon bones were collected, cleaned, and preserved, Routsong agreed to have the adult mastodon skeleton placed on permanent display at IPFW;

the skull of a nearby baby mastodon is now on loan to Science Central.

In the spring of 1970, The Communicator (IPFW's student newspaper) began a drive to come up with a mascot for IPFW. **Some of the suggested choices included the Boiler-Hoosiers, Warhawks, Marauders, Frontiersmen, Pioneers, Elfs, and Hobbits.** Those names and others came from student suggestions. Steve Pettyjohn, who served as the student body president in 1968-69, wrote a letter to the editor about the school mascot. In his letter, Pettyjohn extolled the virtues of choosing the mastodon as IPFW's mascot: **"It sounds different, strange - that's exactly why. It's different and yes, even strange. For God's Sakes, let's have the courage to be a little different."**

In the meantime, former Indiana Congressman Mark Souder, who served as student body president in 1969-70, recalls being lobbied by the Geology Club to choose the mastodon.

According to Nusbaumer, "Souder appointed a committee in student government to select a name although he was lobbying hard for the mastodon." After some discussion on the subject, Souder says a vote was taken by the committee and the mastodon came out the winner. Souder finished his recollection with these thoughts. "History shows that the advocacy of the geology club was correct. The fast, decisive action of the elected student government—though it did not please everyone and was not a precedent that the University desired to see—has also been upheld by history as Purdue Fort Wayne regularly scores high in any list of unique university nicknames; **even in this era when everybody strives to be different. We did it decades ago.**"

John Konchar dominated these game notes from 2015-19. He is now a member of the Memphis Grizzlies. Let's look back on some of his collegiate accomplishments.

- Finished his collegiate career as the first student-athlete in NCAA Division I men's basketball history to record 2,000 points, 1,000 rebounds, 500 assists and 200 steals.

- Since 1992-93, he was the only player in NCAA Division I with two seasons of 450 points, 200 rebounds, 150 assists and 60 steals.

- Konchar owns the program record for points, (2,065), field goals (759) and rebounds (1,150) in addition to holding the DI era records for steals (272) and assists (554).

- He was the first player in Summit League history to record a triple-double in the Summit League Tournament, thanks to 18 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists vs. South Dakota last season.
