The Idaho State football team returns to the road for a contest at Montana on November 5 at 5 p.m. in Missoula. The game will be televised live on Root Sports and Jerry Miller and Mitch Beckstead will call the game on 102.5 KMGI. Live stats and audio will be available at isubengals.com. Because the game is televised on Root Sports the game will not be available on Big Sky TV.

SERIES VS. MONTANA

Montana leads the series 43-13. The Bengals lost 33-27 in overtime in Pocatello to Montana last year. Montana has won 10 straight meetings, with the Bengals last win being 43-40 in two overtimes in 2003 at Holt Arena. Idaho State's last win in Missoula was 31-17 in 1983.

Montana is 5-3 and 2-3 in Big Sky Conference play. Quarterback Brady Gustafson has thrown for 2,593 yards, 24 touchdowns and only seven interceptions. Jerry Louie-Mc-Gee leads the receiving attack with 51 receptions for 428 yards and two touchdowns. Jeremy Calhoun has carried the ball 69 times for 504 yards and is averaging a team-best 63 yards a game. John Buss leads the defense with 57 tackles and 16.5 tackles for loss. Connor Strahm has 48 tackles.

MIKE KRAMER FILE

Career Record: 95-122 overall Career Big Sky Record: 63-80

One of the most successful coaches in Big Sky football history is now an Idaho State Bengal. Mike Kramer was hired to be the Bengal's 25th head coach in program history on Nov. 22, 2010. Since being given the charge to rebuild the Bengal football program, ISU has made great strides on the field, in the classroom and in the community.

Kramer led the Bengals to their first winning season since 2003 in 2014. Idaho State finished with an 8-4 record and a 6-2 mark in Big Sky Conference play. The offense rewrote the record books as it finished with 6,744 total yards and 64 touchdowns. ISU tallied 2,567 rushing yards, breaking a school record that stood since 1957. Senior quarterback Justin Arias was a finalist for the Walter Payton Award and he was a third-team All-American and first-team all-conference. With the success of the 2014 season, Kramer finished seventh in the voting for the Eddie Robinson Award and he was awarded the Big Sky Conference Coach of the Year. Kramer is the second coach in Division I history to earn conference Coach of the Year honors at three different schools in the same league.

The football program recorded a perfect single-year APR score of 1,000 for the 2011-12 academic year and it reached an all-time high four-year score of 962 following the 2013-14 academic year. In the fall of 2012 and 2013 a record 20 players were named to the Big Sky All-Academic team, breaking the record of 17 that was set by Kramer's 2011 team. In five of the last six semesters the football program has boasted a 3.0 or higher.

In the fall of 2011, the team had a GPA of 3.04 and 51 out of the 80 student-athletes had a 3.0 or higher. Those numbers were topped in the spring when the football team had a team GPA of 3.16 and had 53 of 79 student-athletes earn a 3.0 or higher. Since Kramer took over as head coach he has had 58 players graduate as of December of 2013.

In Kramer's first three seasons, the Bengal offense has set numerous Big Sky and Idaho State single-season record.

The Colton, Wash., native began his coaching career at his prep alma mater as a student teacher and assistant coach in 1976, helping the team to an undefeated season and the state B-11 Championship. The next year, Kramer became teacher and assistant football coach at Helena High under eventual University of Montana head coach Mick Dennehy. In 1980, upon his mentor's departure to join the MSU staff, he was elevated to the head coaching position. His highly successful tenure - he led the Bengals to their first winning season since 1958 - was capped with a stint as the winning head coach in the East-West Shrine Game in '82.

Kramer's education credentials include a bachelor of science degree from the University of Idaho, a master's degree in physical education from Eastern Washington, and graduate studies in educational administration at Washington State University. He is an avid mountaineer with conquests of most of the tallest peaks in the Pacific Northwest including several different routes on Mt Rainier.

- Michael Dean's five receptions for 50 yards was a career-high.
- KW Williams six receptions gives him 172 for his career and moves him into a tie with Ed Bell, who played for ISU from 1967-69.
- KW Williams two touchdowns ties his career-high and gives him 25 for his career, tied for fourth with Brett Fowler, who played from 2000-03.
- KW Williams moved into six place for career receiving yards. His 91 yards today moves him into sixth place with 2,224. He passed Shawn Beals (2,208), Madison Mangum (2,204) and Brett Fowler (2,179).
- Lonell Woodhouse's 62-yard run in the fourth quarter tied for the 15th longest offensive play in the Mike Kramer era.

Zak Johnson is 18-27 kicking field goals in his career. Rene Weitmann is currently in 10th place with 21 (21-33) from 1985-86.

DEPTH AT RUNNING BACK

Idaho State has shown depth at running back early into the 2016 season as six different backs have had carries. Jakori Ford leads the attack with 88 carries on 418 yards and five touchdowns. Freshman Michael Dean has carried the ball 16 times for 208 yards and four touchdowns. The Bengals are averaging 4.3 yards a carry on 221 attempts. Other running backs to carry the ball are redshirt freshman Ty Flanagan, sophomore James Madison, sophomore Lonell Woodhouse and senior Braeden Mitchell.

SPREADING THE BALL AROUND

Early into the 2016 season, 12 different players have caught passes from the Bengal quarterbacks. KW Williams leads the attacked with 48 receptions. Josh Cook has 33 receptions, Jakori Ford 23, Hagen Graves 33 and Mitch Gueller 18. Pat Carter, Ty Flanagan, Austin Campbell, Michael Dean, James Madison, Tucker Louie-McGee and Trae Pilster have also caught passes this year.

WELCOME TO BENGAL FOOTBALL

In the opening win 26 Bengals saw action for the first time at their respective positions. Seeing the field for the first time at their respective positions were, Pat Carter, Dallen Collins, Chris Miedema, Nikko Taylor, Lorenzo Terry III, Caleb Brown, Robert Kvinsland, Michael Dean, Brandon Monroe, James Madison, Adkin Aguirre, Ty Flanagan, Luke Holloway, Christian Holland, Austin Campbell, Ryan Shields, Braiden Beckman, Mason Jackson, Nate Tavernier, Garrett Smith, Jake Hoggan, Jacob Molenaar, Dakota Wilson, Chance Salutregui, Clark Jeppesen and Daniel Heck.

RETURN OF MANU AND JENKINS

After suffering preseason season ending injuries in 2015, Mario Jenkins and Taison Manu return to the field for the 2016 season. Manu enters his senior year and has been a three-year starter at strong safety. As a junior in 2014 Manu was third on the team in tackles with 110 while Jenkins led the defense with 120 tackles as a freshman. Jenkins was also named the Big Sky Conference Freshman of the Year.

GUELLER STARTING QUARTERBACK

Tanner Gueller is the starting quarterback for the Bengals in 2016. As a redshirt freshman in 2015 he started three games and threw for 855 yards and five touchdowns. He was 92-172 with eight interceptions. His 338 passing yards in the opener vs. Simon Fraser ranked as the 63rd best performance in ISU history.

LONG RUN FORD

During Jakori Ford's time at Idaho State he has shown the ability to break loose for the long run. Since arriving in Pocatello he has touchdown runs of 75 (at Oregon State this season), 72 (vs. Simon Fraser in 2014), 69 (vs. Simon Fraser in 2014) and 53 (vs. Montana in 2015).

STRENGTH IN LINEBACKERS

The linebacking group of Hayden Stout, Mario Jenkins, Joe Martin and Jake Pettit are expected to lead the Bengal defense in 2016. Pettit started at linebacker in 2015 and was third on the team in tackles with 91. Stout led the defense with 113 tackles last year and with the return of Jenkins, who had 120 tackles as a redshirt freshman in 2014, the linebacking core will continue to lead the defense.

BENGALS IN THE NFL

Idaho State is one of only three institutions who have two alums as NFL head coaches. Pete Carroll (Seattle) and Hue Jackson (Cleveland) are alums of Pacific while Jeff Fisher (L.A. Rams) and Jack Del Rio (Oakland) are alums of USC. Dirk Koetter (Tampa Bay) finished playing at Idaho State in 1981. After playing at ISU, Marvin Lewis started his coaching career in Pocatello, coaching linebackers from 1981-84 and he is now the Cincinnati Bengal coach. Active players in the NFL are Evan Smith with Tampa Bay and Josh Hill with the Saints. Tyler Kuder is with the Packers but on season-ending injured reserve.

TOUGH SCHEDULE

After playing two teams in the Pac 12 Conference, ISU's conference schedule is not easy. Every team but one on the Bengals league slate finished with a winning record. Sacramento State was the only team that finished with a losing record. The combined overall record for the eight conference teams was 53-39 and the combined conference mark was 40-24.

BENGAL BITES

- Idaho state is 2-17 at home vs. ranked teams since beating No. 5 Eastern Washington 34-30 in Holt on Sept. 24, 2005 and Cal Poly in 2014.
- The highest ranked team ISU has beaten is No. 5 Montana, 28-23 in 1994, No. 5 Montana in 2003 (43-40 in 2 OT) and No. 5 Eastern Washington 34-30 in 2005.
- This year's Bengal football team returns 2,092 yards of its 4,375 tallied during the 2015 season. The rushing attack is led by Jakori Ford's 450 while the receiving yards is led by KW Williams 684.
- Idaho State's last shut out conference win was 34-0 over Weber State on October 26, 2002.

BENGALS VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

Idaho State has defeated two ranked teams in two years. ISU won at home vs. No. 21 Cal Poly in 2014 and beat No. 23/25 North Dakota 37-31 in Grand Forks last year. Prior to that win, ISU was 0-24 vs. ranked teams. Before the win over Cal Poly, the last win over a ranked opponent was a 34-30 win over No. 5 Eastern Washington in Pocatello in 2005.
