BENGALS PREVIEW

So far this season, the Bengals have combined for 149 shots including 62 on goal for a .416 shot on goal percentage. ISU has netted 10 goals, with four coming in its home opener against Houston Baptist on Aug. 21. It was the first time the Bengals have scored four goals in a single game since netting five in their 5-4 win over Hawaii on Sept. 14, 2014 at Davis Field.

The Bengals return 14 letter winners, including six starters, from last season's squad that finished 1-17-1. Head Coach Allison Gibson welcomes 11 newcomers to the squad including nine freshmen, and carries a full roster with 28 players which ties for the largest ever under Gibson.

SCOUTING UC IRVINE

This is the second time in program history the Bengals have faced UC Irvine. Idaho State lost at UC Irvine Aug. 24, 2015 3-1.

The Anteaters are 7-1 so far this season with big wins over Pittsburgh (3-0), Oregon (3-2) and Boise State (1-0, OT). As a team, UC Irvine is averaging 14.9 shots per game including 7.1 on goal for a .479 shot on goal percentage. The Anteaters have netted 19 goals on the season for a 2.38 per game average which ties for 37th nationally. UC Irvine's Kiana Palacios ranks sixth nationally with seven total goals.

The Anteaters are led by Head Coach Scott Juniper who is in his 10th season.

SCOUTING UTAH VALLEY

ISU carries a 4-4-2 overall record against UVU. The Bengals fell 5-1 at Utah Valley last season on Sept. 10, 2015.

The Wolverines are 4-3 on the season with big wins over Oklahoma (1-0) and UNLV (2-1). UVU averages 1.43 goals per game off 12.4 shots per game for a .115 shot percentage. Utah Valley has registered an assist on eight of its 10 goals this season. Seven different players have registered a goal. Alexis Peterson leads the pack with three.

UVU is led by Head Coach Brent Anderson who is in his 11th season.

PUTTING ON THE PRESSURE

So far this season the Bengals have been applying pressure to their opponents consistently. In the first six games, ISU has outshot its opponents 108 to 96 including 50 to 38 on goal. However, during this same time frame ISU's shot percentage was just .083 to their opponents' .115, but the Bengal's shot on goal percentage was .463 to their opponent's .396.

SHARING THE ROCK

The Bengals are already making use of their 28-player roster. Last season, the Bengals recorded assists on just half of their 24 goals and relied heavily on forward Maria Sanchez for offensive output as the sophomore recorded 15 of ISU's 24 goals.

With the departure of Sanchez, other players have stepped up. Against Boise State, sophomore Tristen Spooner finished inside the six-yard box off a corner kick from fellow sophomore Nikolina Musto for her first career goal and the first goal of the season for Idaho State.

Again against Houston Baptist, ISU shared the ball. Freshmen forwards Michaela Didericksen and Brooke Kortekaas both scored two goals each, while sophomore Meaghan Bare and Jazmin Lopez each recorded assists, one for Bare and two for Lopez.

So far this season, 16 different Bengals have taken shots, with five players taking 10 or more. Of those players, three are freshmen.

DEFENDING THE FIRST AND LAST

In 2015, ISU struggled to defend during the first and last five minutes of each half. Already this season, the Bengals are showing strength during these times, locking down defensively and preventing the quick score.

In ISU's first eight games, the majority of defensive breakdowns have occurred midway through the first and second half, breakdowns that Head Coach Allison Gibson says are fixable with minor adjustments and a team effort.

Three-time Big Sky Coach of the Year Allison Gibson enters her 11th season as the winningest head coach in Idaho State University history.

During the 2015 season, Gibson was instrumental in the development of Maria Sanchez, the 2015 Big Sky Golden Boot recipient. Sanchez led the conference in shots, shots per game, goals and goals per game and finished ranked tied for 15th in the nation in goals scored on her way to earning Big Sky All-Conference First Team honors.

Idaho State finished in fifth place in the Big Sky Conference in 2014 with a 10-9-1 record (5-4-1 Big Sky) and returned to the Big Sky tournament after a one-year haitus. The Bengals ended a stellar Big Sky tournament run in a 2-1 championship loss to Northern Arizona. Seven members of the 2014 team were honored by the Big Sky. Amanda Ellsworth was named Big Sky Offensive MVP as well as to the first team. Maria Sanchez, Lauren Bermudez, Katherine Roberts, Vanessa Cabilan, Mikaela Carrillo and Taylor McBrde all received honorable mention nods.

The Bengals finished the 2013 season in fifth place, just outside of the Big Sky tournament field with a 7-8-2 record (4-3-2 Big Sky). Despite the disappointing finish, ISU set a school record for 11-straight games of scoring at least one goal. Gibson became the winningest coach in ISU history with a 2-0 victory over Southern Utah on Oct. 6. Six players honored by the Big Sky. Amanda Ellsworth and Allyson Stainbrook were named to the all-conference first-team, Sheridan Hapsic was named to the all-conference second-team and Lia Margolis, Allyssa Kenney and Whitney Peterson received honorable mention nods from the conference.

During the 2012 season, Gibson led her team to a four-match winning streak late in the season to clinch a share of the regular season title and the rights to host the 2012 Big Sky Tournament. The Bengals won the tournament title after defeating both Weber State (semifinal) and Montana (final) on penalty kicks. For her performance in the goal, Sheridan Hapsic was named 2012 Big Sky Tournament MVP. The Bengals made their fifth program NCAA Tournament appearance, facing defending champion Stanford in the first round.

Over her career she has made Davis Field a huge home field advantage for the Bengals. Since 2006, Gibson has led the Bengals to an overall 69-79-20 record and an impressive 44-19-14 record at Davis Field.

During the 2011 season, Gibson had four athletes earn all-conference honors and freshman Amanda Ellsworth was named co-Newcomer of the year as well as all-conference honorable mention. Ellsworth became Gibson's second athlete to be named Newcomer of the Year after Ashley Jones earned the honor in 2009. Jones was named all-conference second team while freshman Mikaela Carrillo and junior Rachel Strawn were named all-conference honorable mention.

During the 2009 season, Gibson led the Bengals to a 10-8-0 season record, her best overall record at Idaho State, as well as ISU's first ever season without a tie. Idaho State posted a 4-3-0 Big Sky record capturing a perfect 4-0-0 record in league play at home at Davis Field. The Bengals held its opponents to eight shots on goal at home and scored 13 goals at Davis Field including a 4-2 victory over Northern Arizona and a 4-0 victory over Weber State.

Gibson made her second Big Sky Tournament appearance in 2009, Idaho State's sixth appearance in history, where three Bengals were named to the all-tournament team: Annamarie Hofstetter, Kacey Ball and Karissa Henage-Fisher. In 2009, Idaho State had three players named to all-conference teams, including freshman Ashley Jones who was named Big Sky Newcomer of the Year. Senior Hofstetter and junior Henage-Fisher earned first team honors while Jones earned second team. Four Bengals earned honorable mentions.

In her first season with the Bengals in 2006, Gibson reestablished the soccer tradition at Idaho State, leading the Bengals to both a Big Sky Conference regular season title and a tournament championship. The tournament title earned the Bengals an automatic bid to the NCAA College Cup, where the team nearly upset 11th-ranked Utah on its home field, falling 3-2 in double overtime. Gibson earned her first Big Sky Conference Coach of the Year for her accomplishments during the 2006 season and had one of her players, Lyndsay Gensler, earn Big Sky Tournament MVP.

Under Gibson's direction, 23 Bengals have landed spots on the Big Sky All-Conference First and Second teams in addition to 23 earning honorable mention accolades. Thirteen Bengals have earned places on the Big Sky All-Tournament team. She places emphasis on academic achievement and on her watch, 67 Bengals also received Big Sky All-Academic honors with a program record 15 athletes earning all-academic honors during the 2013 season.

During the 2007 season Gibson posted a 7-5-6 record. Gibson tied the record for the fewest losses in a season. Unfortunately a string of ties, that set the record for most tied games in a season, kept the Bengals from the Big Sky Conference tournament by one point. Gibson is the only coach in Idaho State history to have an undefeated home season which she achieved in both 2012 and 2007. She also posts the longest home undefeated streak in ISU history with 13 games from 2006-08.

Gibson also serves the soccer community in numerous roles outside of college athletics. She served as the head coach of the U-17 Olympic Development Program team marking the eighth year that the coach has been involved in the program.

Gibson came to Idaho State after a five-year stint as the top assistant at the University of San Francisco of the West Coast Conference, considered one of the nation's best soccer conferences. While serving as an assistant for the Dons, Gibson also served as a head coach in the Region IV Olympic Development Program, for seven years. At USF, Gibson handled all matters of coaching, including practice planning, travel, scouting, recruiting and USF summer camps. She also developed a leadership workshop for student-athletes.

USF's best season was the 2004 campaign, when the Dons went 10-7-3 despite a schedule that included regional and national powerhouses such as the University of Portland and Utah. Gibson has definitely seen the best the nation has to offer, as in her last year San Francisco her team played the nation's toughest schedule, facing 10 teams that qualified for the NCAA College Cup in 2005, including national champion Portland and North Carolina.

Gibson is highly decorated as a player, leading Sonoma State University to a pair of NCAA College Cup appearances, including the Final Four in 1992 and a Final Eight appearance in 1993. She led the Cossacks to a pair of Northern California Althletic Conference championships, earning NCAC Player of the Year both in 1992 and 1993, while leading SSU to a 31-9 composite record. She also earned All-America honors both years from the National Soccer Coaches Association of American. In 2000. Gibson was inducted into Sonoma State's Hall of Fame.

Gibson then became an assistant coach at SSU, helping the Cossacks to a 29-6-1 record over the next two seasons and two more postseason trips.

Gibson graduated from Sonoma State in 1995 with a bachelor's degree in kinesiology, and she earned her master's in 2004 from the University of San Francisco in organization and leadership. She holds a United States Soccer Federation "A" coaching license. She also holds a NSCAA "Premier" Diploma.


