ABOUT CAL

Cal is 2-0 and coming off wins over North Carolina and BYU. Cal is averaging 22.5 points a game and giving up only 17.5 points. The offense is averaging 338.5 yards a game and holding opponents to 294. Patrick Laird leads the running attack with 39 carries for 125 yards. Chase Garbers has seen the majority of time at quarterback. He has thrown for 230 yards, completing 25 passes on 41 attempts with three touchdowns and one interception. Kanawai Noa has caught 10 passes for 108 yards and one touchdown. Evan Weaver leads the defense with 26 tackles.

Rob Phenicie FILE**Career Record: 5-7 overall****Career Big Sky Record: 2-6**

Rob Phenicie is in his fourth year with the Idaho State football program and second as the head coach. After two seasons as wide receivers coach and Assistant Head Coach for the Offense, Phenicie was given the head coaching job in March of 2017. He will continue to coach the wide receivers.

In his first year as head coach, the Bengals knocked off Nevada, 30-28, giving the program their first win over an FBS team in 27 tries. Phenicie also coached four first-team all-conference players in James Madison, Mitch Gueller, Skyler Phillips and Mario Jenkins. The four wins in 2017 was the third most wins by a Bengal team since 2005.

Phenicie came to Idaho State after spending five years at UNLV, two as the offensive coordinator, three as the quarterbacks coach and two as the tight ends coach.

Phenicie is no stranger to the Big Sky Conference. Prior to going to UNLV he worked as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Montana from 2003-09 and from 2000-02 he was the wide receivers coach and recruiting coordinator at Wyoming before being named Co-offensive coordinator for one season.

During his time in Missoula, he guided the Montana offense to three appearances in the FCS National Championship game (2004, 2008 and 2009), and the team made the playoffs every year. In 2006, he was awarded the Mike Campbell Award for the top assistant coach in FCS football. Montana appeared in 18 playoff games during his time as the offensive coordinator.

Phenicie coached the quarterbacks and wide receivers at Cal State Northridge from 1997-98 and at L.A. Valley from 1992-96. Phenicie and his wife Jennifer have one daughter.

POST GAME WESTERN STATE NOTES

- Paea Moala had a career-high 13 tackles.
- Caleb Brown and Kennon Smith had their first career interceptions. Brown scored his first career touchdown on a 28-yard interception return.
- Matt Peterson, Isaiah Brimmer and Demonte Horton caught their first career passes. As a true freshman Horton caught four passes for 47 yards.
- Freshman kickers Kevin Ryan and Campbell Sheidow saw their first action as Bengals. Ryan had four punts for an average of 41 yard a kick while Sheidow was perfect on extra points and made a 36-yard field goal.
- Tanner Gueller surpassed the 6,000 yard mark for career passing yards. He now has 6,173 yards and trails Kevin Yost, who is in fourth place in the ISU career record books, with 6,663 yards.
- Caleb Brown's interception return for a touchdown was the first since Nikko Taylor on Sept. 4, 2016. It was a four-yard return vs. Sacramento State.
- Prior to James Madison's three touchdowns, the last time a Bengal had exactly three rushing touchdowns in a game was Daniel McSurdy on Oct. 25, 2014 at Northern Colorado.
- Prior to James Madison's 114 rushing yards the last time a Bengal rushed for over 100 yards was Madison's 160 and Ty Flanagan's 108 vs. Portland State in 2017.

RECAPING 2017

- Idaho State's 30-28 win over Nevada on Sept. 16 snapped a 27-game losing streak against FBS schools.
- Four wins was the most since the 2014 team went 8-4 and the second most since 2005 (5-6).
- James Madison, Mitch Gueller, Skyler Phillips and Mario Jenkins earned first-team all-conference.
- 1,962 rushing yards is the most since the 2014 team rushed for 2,567 and the third most since the 1996 team rushed for 1,996 yards.
- 19 rushing touchdowns was the fifth most in an ISU single-season.
- Adkin Aguirre had seven tackles or more in eight games and tallied seven turnovers (5 INT and 2 fumble recoveries)
- Michael Dean had a touchdown in seven of the 11 games. He had three 100 plus yard receiving games with a career-high 133 at Nevada.
- Ty Flanagan had a rushing touchdown in 9 of 11 games with a career-high of four vs. Portland State. He rushed for 100 yards or more in three games with a career-high of 108 vs. Portland State.
- Mitch Gueller had four 100 yard receiving games with a career-high of 195 vs. Portland State. He scored his eight touchdowns in a five-game span.
- Tanner Gueller threw a touchdown pass in every game but one (UC Davis). He threw three touchdowns in a game five times with a school record long of 97 vs. Portland State.
- Parker Johnson was 7-8 on field goals with a career-long of 40. He was 21-23 on extra points. His only two misses came at Northern Colorado.
- Joe Martin had five double digit tackle games before suffering a season-ending injury at Sacramento State. He had 20 tackles at Utah State and 14 vs. Cal Poly.
- Brian Fineanganofa has made 18 straight starts on the offensive line. Jacob Molenaar started every game last year.

DID YOU KNOW

- ISU finished with a home record of 3-2 in 2017. In 2013 ISU was 3-3 at home and in 2014 the Bengals were 6-0 at Holt.

RETURNING SKILL PLAYERS

Plenty of experience returns on the offense in 2018. The running back position is led by 2017 first-team all-conference member James Madison. Last season he carried the ball 185 times for 933 yards and five touchdowns. Ty Flanagan, who earned honorable mention all-conference rushed for 634 yards on 11 touchdowns and 125 carries.

The receiver position is led by juniors Michael Dean, who had 52 receptions for 754 yards and eight touchdowns and Mitch Gueller. Gueller finished with 36 receptions on 871 yards and eight touchdowns.

Of the 4,784 yards of total offense in 2017, 4,215 of those yards return for the 2018 season.

BIG PLAY BENGALS

Last year Idaho State showed a knack for making big plays. The Bengal offense had 94 plays of 10-19 yards; 33 plays of 20-29 yards, 16 plays of 30-39 yards; 5 plays of 40-49 yards and 7 plays of 50 yards or more.

THE STREAK IS SNAPPED

Idaho State snapped a 27 game losing streak to FBS schools with its 30-28 victory at Nevada of the Mountain West Conference on Sept. 16, 2017. Prior to that win the last time ISU had beaten an FBS school was 27-24 at Utah State in 2000. Since 2008, the FBS opponents Idaho State has faced are; Air Force, Nebraska, BYU, Oregon State, Washington State, Utah State, Georgia, UNLV, Colorado, Arizona State, Oklaho-

ma, Boise State, Washington, Utah, Idaho and Nevada.

THE GOLDEN VOICE OF ISU ATHLETICS

Jerry Miller has been a part of Idaho State Athletics for 31 years calling games. He has called 1,971 games during this time at ISU. Here is the breakdown and the number of

After playing at ISU, Marvin Lewis started his coaching career in Pocatello, coaching linebackers from 1981-84 and he is now the Cincinnati Bengal coach. Active players in the NFL are Evan Smith with Tampa Bay and Josh Hill with the Saints.
