IOWA STATE POSTGAME NOTES

TEAM NOTES

- *ISU is now 1-7 all-time in overtime games.
- *This was the second OT game in the series (2005, 2OT at Nebraska).
- *ISU put up its most points against Nebraska since 2004 (34-27 victory).
- *ISU allowed only seven completions today, the lowest since Nov. 20, 2004 (six by Kansas State).

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

Darius Darks

- *With five receptions today, passed the 100-catch mark for his career (103).

Austen Arnaud

- *Three touchdown passes today gives him 42 for his career, moving into second place all-time (40, Todd Bandhauer; 1995-98).
- *Rushed for a season-high 63 yards. Previous high was 59, vs. Kansas.
- *266 yards of total offense today is his most since the opener against Northern Illinois (310).
- *13th career 200-yard passing game.
- *13th career game with at least one passing touchdown and one rushing touchdown.

Jake Williams

- *Snared two touchdown receptions today. He now has four on the season, and nine in his career.
- *First career two-score game.
- *Matched a season best with five catches.

Grant Mahoney

- *Hit a career-long 57-yard field goal in the second quarter.
- *Previous career long was 52 yards (2009 at Nebraska).
- *It's the fourth-longest in ISU history (three kickers at 58).
- *It's his fourth career 50-yarder, second all-time (5, Jeff Shudak, 1987-90).
- *With six points today, moves up to eighth in career scoring (203).
- *Made his 38th career field goal, tied for fifth all-time with Bret Culbertson (2004-07).

Alexander Robinson

- *Recorded 101 yards on a career-high 32 carries. Previous high for rushes was 30 (2009 vs. Colorado).
- *Caught his first touchdown pass of the season, and fourth of his career.
- *Tallied 100+ rushing yards for the third consecutive week (first time since Sept. 12-26, 2009).
- *Is tied for fourth all-time with 13 career 100-yard games (Ennis Haywood 1998-2001, Dwayne Crutchfield 1980-81).
- *First Cyclone with a 100-yard game against Nebraska since 2007 (Jason Scales, 115 yards).

Matt Morton

- *Forced his first career fumble.

Deon Broomfield

- *Made his first career fumble recovery.

Roosevelt Maggitt

- *Made his first career fumble recovery.

Jacob Lattimer

- *Forced his second fumble of the season.

Josh Lenz

- *Season-high 31 receiving yards.
